## TODAY'S GAME:

Today marks Game Three of the four-game series against Syracuse (2-0) at Alliance Bank Stadium. After yesterday's 5-4 loss in 10 innings, the IronPigs (0-2) will look to win their first game of the year after back-to-back, tragic walk-off losses to open the 2010 season... LHV finished last season in third place in the North Division at 71-73. The Chiefs -- the Nationals' top affiliate -- finished '09 ranked second in the North at 76-68. First-pitch is scheduled for 2 pm.

## WALK THIS WAY?:

The 'Pigs have started with back-to-back, walk-off losses (8-7 in 9 innings; 5-4 in 10) -- marking the first time in franchise history the team has dropped consecutive games on the final swing of the bat... In fact, going back to 7/4/09, the Chiefs have won 3 of their last 8 home games against LHV in walk-off fashion.

## UNHAPPY ALLIANCE (BANK STADIUM):

Not only have the 'Pigs have started with back-to-back, walk-off losses at Alliance Bank Stadium -- they've now lost six consecutive games in Syracuse and are just 4-14 (.222) lifetime at the Chiefs home park.

## SLOW STARTERS:

LHV is now just 12-37 (.245) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in 2009... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB)... LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years).

## TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Nate Bump** -- making his first start in the Phillies system -- is a 6-2, 180-pound, 33-year-old signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/11/09. The Towanda, Pa., native was originally drafted by San Francisco in the first round (25th overall) in 1998 out of Penn State -- where he left as PSU's all-time career leader in wins, strikeouts, starts and innings and became the highest Nittany Lion ever drafted... Bump started 2009 with independent Camden (8-2, 2.49 in 12 GS) before signing with Detroit 7/7/09 and finishing with Toledo (7-1, 2.38 in 10 GS). In all, he was a combined 15-3, 2.44 in 22 GS... After being traded to Florida as part of the Livan Hernandez trade 7/24/99, Bump made his ML debut 6/28/03 at BOS (2.1 ip, 0 er) and has gone 6-7, 4.68 and 1 SV in 113 G, 2 GS over parts of three seasons with the Marlins (2003-05)... Bump has a career record of 49-48, 3.69 in 147 G, 132 GS in MiLB.  
 • NB vs. SYR in 2009: 0-1, 6.75 in 2 GS (12 ip, 17 h, 9 r, 9 er, 2 bb, 5 k, .347)... vs. Rest of IL: 7-0, 1.45 in 8 GS.

RHP **Collin Balester** -- the longest-tenured, home-grown starter in Washington's system and a member of the 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-5, 199-pound, 23-year-old selected by Montreal in the 4th round of the 2004 draft out of Huntington Beach (CA) HS. Balester spent the majority of 2009 with Syracuse (7-10, 4.44 in 20 GS), but did get promoted 7/23-8/26 and made 7 starts with the Nationals (1-4, 6.82). In all, he finished a combined 8-14, 4.97 in 27 GS... With WAS, 16 of 24 runs allowed scored via the home run; of 34 hits allowed, 10 were HR (29%)... Made his NL debut 7/1/08 and defeated Florida (W, 5 ip, h, r, er, 3 bb, 3 k) in a 9-6 win... Entered the 2008 season ranked as the No. 3 Prospect in the system by *Baseball America* (No. 1 in '07; No. 2 in '06)... Pitched for Team USA in the Futures Game on 7/8 (0.1 ip, h, k)... Is an avid surfer -- and his father, Tom, runs a surf board manufacturing company.

• CB vs. LHV in 2009: 0-2, 6.89 ERA in 3 G, 3 GS (15.2 ip, 23 h, 12 r, 12 er, 4 bb, 14 k, 1 hr, .354)

## SERIES INFORMATION:

SYR leads the season series, 2-0, and has now won 10 of the last 12 G (with 3 walk-off wins)... SYR also holds a 22-12 (.647) against LHV -- 14-4 at ABS... SYR won both the 2008 & 2009 season series, 10-6 (6-2 at ABS).

## BACON BITS:

• *More hits, more wins?*: The 'Pigs have out-hit the Chiefs, 13-12 and 10-5... Only the 2nd time in LHV history the 'Pigs lost back-to-back games in which they out-hit their opponents ... and the first time since 6/14-6/15/08 vs. PAW.  
 • *Third Time a Charm?*: The 'Pigs need a win to avoid losing 3 straight for the first time since 8/29-8/30/09 -- all three games against Syracuse at ABS... The last time LHV lost 4 consecutive games was during a 5-game skid 8/15-8/21/09.  
 • *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs are now 0-1 in extra-inning games after going 7-8 in such contests in '09; 6-6 in '08.

## THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP!:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a 2009 I.L. midseason All-Star -- was optioned from Philadelphia to Lehigh Valley yesterday... he will start on Monday in Pawtucket in the place of RHP **Brandon Duckworth** -- who was placed on the D.L. with right turf toe on Friday.

## 2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

## WHO WAS HOT IN SPRING TRAINING:

OF **John Mayberry** hit .409-0-9 (9-22) in 6 G after a respectable stat line in ML Spring Training of 282-1-6 in 21 G... INF **Wilson Valdez** spent the entire camp in with the Phillies and hit .313-1-6 (10-32) in 21 G... RHP **Scott Mathieson** was nearly perfect, going 1-0, 0.00 in 8 G (10 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Nate Bump** finished 1-1, 2.08 in 3 G, 2 GS (13 ip, 14 h, 3 r, 0 bb, 4 k)... RHP **Brandon Duckworth** went 1-1, 2.25 in 3 G, 2 GS (12 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 6 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Jason Anderson** went 1-0, 2.25, SV in 6 g (8 ip, 5 h, 2 er, 0 bb, 6 k).

## 2010 ROSTER BY THE NUMBERS:

The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster (active 24-man) consists of 12 pitchers, 2 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 OF. There are:

- **9 (38%) returning 'Pigs:** RHP Jason Anderson, RHP Alex Concepcion, C Paul Hoover, OF John Mayberry Jr., LHP Brian Mazone, LHP Joe Savery, 1B Andy Tracy, OF Rich Thompson, LHP Jake Woods.
- **4 (17%) members of PHI's 40-Man Roster:** INF Brian Boccock, RHP Scott Mathieson, Mayberry, LHP Mike Zagurski).
- **3 (13%) players originally drafted by the Phillies** -- all pitchers: Mathieson, Savery, Zagurski. One (4%) signed as an amateur free agent (Concepcion); two (8%) were acquired by trade (Mayberry, Mazone); one (4%) claimed off waivers (Boccock); one (4%) by Rule 5 Draft (Sellers) and 16 (67%) signed as minor league FAs.
- **20 (84%) players with MLB experience:** all but Concepcion, Mazone, Savery and INF Neil Sellers.
- The average ML Service Time is **1.093** with the most tenured pitcher RHP Brandon Duckworth (5.025) and the most tenured position player OF DeWayne Wise (4.046).
- The average age is **29.8** with the oldest Tracy (36 years, 3 months, 28 days on Opening Day) and youngest Savery (24 years, 4 months, 4 days).
- **0 (0%) of 12 pitchers appeared in the Majors** last season; 8 of 12 (67%) hitters appeared in MLB in '09.
- **20 (84%) players were born in the U.S.;** two (8%) in the Dominican Republic (Concepcion, INF Wilson Valdez), one (4%) in Venezuela (INF Luis Maza) and one (4%) in Canada (Mathieson).
- **21 (88%) have previous I.L. experience** -- all but Boccock, RHP Brian Gordon and Sellers -- with the most teams represented by Wise (SYR, RIC, TOL, LOU, CHA). 14 (58%) players have I.L. time in other systems.
- **3 (13%) players were taken by SF in the '98 Draft** -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

## PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

*Baseball America* ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

## HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a career record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd amongst all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

## DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

On August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... The 'Pigs finished 71-73, a 16.0-game improvement from 2008. In ending the season 11.5 GB, they finished 21.5 games closer to first place than they did a season ago.

## 2009 SEASON RECAP:

The 'Pigs showed vast improvement in their second season -- finishing just two games under .500 at 71-73 while placing third in the International League's North Division. A season removed from an IL-worst 55-89 campaign, the IronPigs remained in postseason contention until the season's final month in 2009. They also finished with a 3.80 team ERA -- the fifth best among the IL's 14 teams.

## IRONPIGS FINISH SECOND IN ATTENDANCE:

By virtue of 26 consecutive sell-outs, the IronPigs attendance reached 641,335 fans in 2009 -- the second-highest per-game average (9,162) in all of Minor League Baseball. The massive total represents a 6% increase over last year's overall mark (602,033) despite playing one less home game at Coca-Cola Park due to weather.
