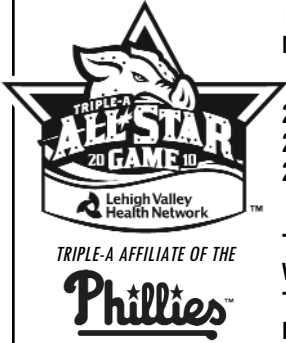

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (1-3) play Game One of a two-game series at McCoy Stadium against the Pawtucket Red Sox (2-2) - Boston's top affiliate. With a 6-5 come-from-behind win at Syracuse (3-1) yesterday, the 'Pigs salvaged the finale of a crazy* opening series with the Chiefs -- they had lost the first three games in walk-off fashion (including back-to-back extra-inning games)... LHV finished last season in third place in the North Division at 71-73. The Paw Sox -- who started by splitting a four-game, home series with Rochester -- finished '09 ranked fifth in the North at 61-82.
 • First-pitch is scheduled for 6:15 p.m... The first "night" game for LHV, which is 20-38 (.345) lifetime during day..

*WHAT A CRAZY WAY TO START THE SEASON:

LHV started '09 by losing 3 consecutive games in walk-off fashion (they only lost 7 walk-off times in 144 games last year; never 2 in a row in team history) -- then scored 2 in the 9th on Sunday to take the finale, 6-5! Two of the games went into extras (5-4 in 10 on Fri.; 8-7 in 12 on Sat.)... The 'Pigs blew 7 leads and the pen was tagged with 4 blown saves...
 • All 4 games were decided by a run -- just the 2nd time LHV's had 4 consecutive one-run games (8/10-8/15/08).

BEST START IN FRANCHISE HISTORY:

At 1-3, the IronPigs are off to their best start in franchise history. By taking the final game of the series in Syracuse, the 'Pigs avoided being swept in a season-opening, four-game series for their third consecutive season (all 3 in franchise history). The were swept by SWB in PNC Field in 2008 and at Coca-Cola Park in 2009.
 • LHV also avoided being swept in a four-game series for the first time since 6/6-6/9/09 @ LOU (14, 4-G series ago).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State. The Vacaville, CA, native spent the bulk of 2009 with LHV, becoming the team's first 11-game winner in going 11-6, 3.35 in 25 G, 24 GS. Named to the 2009 I.L. All-Star team, we was the winning pitcher in the Triple-A All-Star game -- striking out the 'heart of the lineup' on just nine pitchers... He was recalled by Philly three times -- earning his first ML win in a rain-shortened game 5/16 @ WAS (4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k; Rule 10.17-b-2). In all, Carpenter went 1-0, 11.12 in 3 G, 1 GS with PHI... Made his ML debut with PHI 8/27/08 vs. NYM (1.0 ip, 0 r)... Had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game... Among the highlights in his four-year MiLB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k) and a 2007 FSL Championship.
 • *DC made the Phillies Opening Day Roster (Blanton DL'd)... Optioned when Nelson Figueroa claimed off waivers*
 • *Last 6 G of '09: 2-4, 6.29, .344 OBA (37.1 ip, 54 h, 22 r, 22 er, 12 bb, 26 k, 5 hr); First 19 G: 9-2, 2.72, .245*
 • *DC vs. PAW in 2009: 3-0, 1.32 ERA in 4 G, 4 GS (27.1 ip, 19 h, 5 r, 4 er, 6 bb, 21 k, .202, 2 hr)*

RHP **Michael Bowden** -- a member of Boston's 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 215-pound, 23-year-old drafted by Boston as a sandwich pick (47th overall) in the 2005 Draft out of Waubonise Valley (IL) HS. The Illinois native spent the bulk of 2009 with Pawtucket (4-6, 3.13 in 24 G, 24 GS) -- with three separate stints with Boston (1-1, 9.56 in 8 G, 1 GS). While in the IL, Bowden ranked 2nd in OBA (.228) and 5th in WHIP (1.21)... In 2008, Bowden started in Double-A Portland -- where we was named to the EL All-Star team -- and eventually made his ML debut for Boston on 8/30 vs. CHW, starting and winning 8-2 in his first and only ML appearance (5 ip, 7 h, 2 r, 2 er, bb, 3 k). At 21 years, 356 days, became the youngest Sox pitcher to start and win a ML debut since Juan Pena on 5/8/99 (21/315) and the 3rd-youngest AL pitcher to appear in 2008 behind LAA's Nick Adenhardt (4/24/86) and NYY's Phillip Hughes (6/24/86).
 • *MB vs. PAW in 2009: 1-0, 0.87 ERA in 2 G, 2 GS (10.1 ip, 9 h, 1 r, 1 er, 1 bb, 11 k, .237)*

WHO'S HOT:

INF **Wilson Valdez** has multi-hit games in all 4 G to start season (9-19, .474-0-2)... OF **Chris Duffy** has also hit in all 4 G, with a team-high 7 RBI (7-19, .368-1-7)... C **Paul Hoover** has hit in all 3 of his G (.357-0-3)... RHP **Scott Mathieson** recorded the team's lone win and has been unscored upon in his first 2 G (1-0, 4 ip, 2 h, 0 r, bb, 2 k)...

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV won the '09 series, 10-6 -- winning 6 of last 7 G... PAW leads lifetime series, 21-11, after dominating in '08, 15-1 -- which inc. winning the first 9 G (and last 6 G)... It took 12 tries, but LHV finally won its first series all-time vs. PAW, 8/22-8/25/09.

SLOW STARTERS:

After starting 0-3, LHV is just 13-38 (.255) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in record-IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).
 • LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

BACON BITS:

- **Resilience:** The 'Pigs erased 9-inning deficits to take leads in 2 of the 4 G at Syracuse, inc. Sunday's 8-7 win.
- **Blown Leads:** The 'Pigs have blown seven leads in 3 games this season; the bullpen has amassed 4 blown saves... In addition, LHV has allowed runs in the bottom half of innings after the 'Pigs have scored in 7 of 11 innings.
- **Extra Special?:** The 'Pigs are 0-2 in extra-inning games after going 7-8 in such contests in '09; 6-6 in '08.
- **Duffy Huffy???:** OF **Chris Duffy** has a natural cycle in his last 4 AB vs. LHP (2 G): 1B, 2B, 3B, HR

THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP!:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** (#48) -- a 2009 I.L. midseason All-Star -- was optioned from Philadelphia to Lehigh Valley Friday... he will start on Monday in Pawtucket in the place of RHP **Brandon Duckworth** -- who was placed on the D.L. with right turf toe on Friday.

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

2010 ROSTER BY THE NUMBERS:

The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster (active 24-man) consists of 12 pitchers, 2 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 OF. There are:

- **9 (38%) returning 'Pigs:** RHP Jason Anderson, RHP Alex Concepcion, C Paul Hoover, OF John Mayberry Jr., LHP Brian Mazone, LHP Joe Savery, 1B Andy Tracy, OF Rich Thompson, LHP Jake Woods.
- **4 (17%) members of PHI's 40-Man Roster:** INF Brian Bocoock, RHP Scott Mathieson, Mayberry, LHP Mike Zagurski.
- **3 (13%) players originally drafted by the Phillies** -- all pitchers: Mathieson, Savery, Zagurski. One (4%) signed as an amateur free agent (Concepcion); two (8%) were acquired by trade (Mayberry, Mazone); one (4%) claimed off waivers (Bocoock); one (4%) by Rule 5 Draft (Sellers) and 16 (67%) signed as minor league FAs.
- **20 (84%) players with MLB experience:** all but Concepcion, Mazone, Savery and INF Neil Sellers.
- The average ML Service Time is **1.093** with the most tenured pitcher RHP Brandon Duckworth (5.025) and the most tenured position player OF DeWayne Wise (4.046).
- The average age is **29.8** with the oldest Tracy (36 years, 3 months, 28 days on Opening Day) and youngest Savery (24 years, 4 months, 4 days).
- **0 (0%) of 12 pitchers appeared in the Majors** last season; 8 of 12 (67%) hitters appeared in MLB in '09.
- **20 (84%) players were born in the U.S.;** two (8%) in the Dominican Republic (Concepcion, INF Wilson Valdez), one (4%) in Venezuela (INF Luis Maza) and one (4%) in Canada (Mathieson).
- **21 (88%) have previous I.L. experience** -- all but Bocoock, RHP Brian Gordon and Sellers -- with the most teams represented by Wise (SYR, RIC, TOL, LOU, CHA). 14 (58%) players have I.L. time in other systems.
- **3 (13%) players were taken by SF in the '98 Draft** -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a career record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd amongst all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

On August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... The 'Pigs finished 71-73, a 16.0-game improvement from 2008. In ending the season 11.5 GB, they finished 21.5 games closer to first place than they did a season ago.

WHO WAS HOT IN SPRING TRAINING:

OF **John Mayberry** hit .409-0-9 (9-22) in 6 G after a respectable stat line in ML Spring Training of 282-1-6 in 21 G... INF **Wilson Valdez** spent the entire camp in with the Phillies and hit .313-1-6 (10-32) in 21 G... RHP **Scott Mathieson** was nearly perfect, going 1-0, 0.00 in 8 G (10 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Nate Bump** finished 1-1, 2.08 in 3 G, 2 GS (13 ip, 14 h, 3 r, 0 bb, 4 k)... RHP **Brandon Duckworth** went 1-1, 2.25 in 3 G, 2 GS (12 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 6 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Jason Anderson** went 1-0, 2.25,
