TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (2-5) play Game Two of a three-game series against the Rochester Red Wings (2-4) -- Minnesota's top affiliate. With a 5-2 loss last night, the 'Pigs are 0-3 lifetime in home openers and have started 0-1 on this season-long, nine-game Northern Division homestand. Meanwhile, Rochester snapped a two-game skid... Last season, LHV finished third place in the North Division (71-73) while the Wings finished fourth (70-74)...

• First-pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. for Magnet Schedule Night, presented by **Quest Diagnostics**.

FIRST HOME WIN?:

Should the 'Pigs win tonight, it will mark the fastest they've ever won at Coca-Cola Park in a season (Game 2). It took until Game 5 in 2009 (4/13 vs. SYR) and until Game 4 in 2008 (4/14 vs. RIC).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Nate Bump** -- the highest player ever drafted out of Penn State-- is a 6-2, 180-pound, 33-year-old signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/11/09. The Towanda, Pa., native was originally drafted by San Francisco in the first round (25th overall) in 1998 out of PSU -- where he left as the Nittany Lions' all-time career leader in wins, strikeouts, starts and innings... Bump started 2009 with independent Camden (8-2, 2.49 in 12 GS) before signing with Detroit 7/7/09 and finishing with Toledo (7-1, 2.38 in 10 GS). In all, he was a combined 15-3, 2.44 in 22 GS... After being traded to Florida as part of the Livan Hernandez trade 7/24/99, Bump made his ML debut 6/28/03 at BOS (2.1 ip, 0 er) and has gone 6-7, 4.68 and 1 SV in 113 G, 2 GS over parts of three seasons with the Marlins (2003-05)... Bump has a career record of 49-48, 3.69 in 147 G, 132 GS in MiLB.

• Last season, take out Syracuse and Bump was a near perfect 7-0, 1.45 in 8 GS against the rest of the IL.

RHP **Jeff Manship** -- an member of Minnesota's 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-2, 210-pound, 25-year-old who was drafted by the Twins in the 14th round of 2006 out of University of Notre Dame -- after being named 2006 Big East Pitcher of the Year. The native of San Antonio ascended three levels last season and made his ML debut 8/15 vs. Cleveland (1.0 ip, 0 r)... He started 2009 in Double-A New Britain (6-4, 4.28 in 13 GS) and was promoted to ROC on 6/24, going 4-2, 3.22 in 8 GS. He was called up to the Twins on 8/12 (Slowey placed on DL) and he went 1-1, 5.68 in 11 G, 5 GS. Manship moved into the rotation when Liriano went on the DL and earned his first ML win 10/2 vs. KC (5.1 ip, 8h, 4 r, 3 er, bb, 4 k)... Ranked as the No. 20 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*, Manship played in the 2008 Florida State League All-Star Game and was both a 2007 mid- and post-season Midwest League All-Star.

SERIES INFORMATION:

ROC leads the season series, 1-0... LHV won the 2009 series, 10-7 -- winning 7 of the last 9 G... Still, ROC leads the lifetime series, 18-15 (.545) -- but the overall series is tied, 8-8, at Coca-Cola Park.

TRANSACTIONS:

One day after losing INF **Wilson Valdez** to Philadelphia, INF **Melvin Dorta** was promoted to LHV from Double-A Reading -- where he was batting .176-0-0 (3-17) with 2 BB and a SB... Dorta appeared in 94 G in the IL a year ago, and hit .252-3-23 with Norfolk... He logged 35 days of ML Service with Washington ('06) and is a career .261 MiLB hitter.

WHO'S HOT:

OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in all 7 G, with an IL-leading 10 RBI (11-32, .344-1-10)... OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, has hit in the last 5 G (8-20, .400-0-4, 2B, 3B, 5 R)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has back-to-back, multi-hit G (4-9, 2B) -- which featured a career-high tying 4 RBI on 4/13 @ PAW... C **Paul Hoover** has reached safely in all 5 of his G (6-20, .300-0-3, BB, HBP)... RHP **Scott Mathieson** recorded the team's first win and has been unscored upon in his first 2 G (1-0, 4 ip, 2 h, 0 r, bb, 2 k)... LHP **Brian Mazzone** went 5.0 scoreless IP on 4/13 to earn the first win by a starter (4 h, bb, 4 k)

• **Defensive Minded?:** After committing 6 E in the first 4G, the IronPigs have not had an E in the last three games.
 • **Wing Dings:** ROC held LHV to a season-low 2 R last night... Prev., LHV was averaging 7.0 R/G with a low of 4.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Ye Who Laughs First...:* The IronPigs are now 0-3 in series openers to start 2010.
- *...Last Laugh?:* The IronPigs are 2-0 in series finales to start 2010.
- *To the Nines:* With 3 more runs Monday, LHV has scored 8 R in the 9th innings of its 7 games -- taking leads twice.
- *Blown Leads:* The 'Pigs have blown 9 leads in 7 games this season; the bullpen has amassed 4 blown saves...
- *Extra Special?:* The 'Pigs are 0-2 in extra-inning games after going 7-8 in such contests in '09; 6-6 in '08.

SLOW STARTER:

Clean-up hitting 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting just 179-1-3 (5-28) in 7 G... But don't panic! Tracy started 2009 batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G.

SLOW STARTERS:

At 2-5, LHV is just 14-40 (.259) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).
 • LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

GENESIS 1:1: IN THE BIG-INNING (STREAK SNAPPED 4/14!):

LHV did not score more than a run in any inning last night -- snapping their 6-G streak of having at least one inning in each game in which they scored 3-or-more runs... The 8 R scored off Boof Bonser in the 2nd inning on 4/13 @ PAW set a franchise record for runs in an inning (prev. 7, done 4x, last: 6/22/09 @ NOR).

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

2010 ROSTER BY THE NUMBERS:

The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster (active 24-man) consists of 12 pitchers, 2 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 OF. There are:

- **9 (38%) returning 'Pigs:** RHP Jason Anderson, RHP Alex Concepcion, C Paul Hoover, OF John Mayberry Jr., LHP Brian Mazzone, LHP Joe Savery, 1B Andy Tracy, OF Rich Thompson, LHP Jake Woods.
- **4 (17%) members of PHI's 40-Man Roster:** INF Brian Bockock, RHP Scott Mathieson, Mayberry, LHP Mike Zagurski.
- **3 (13%) players originally drafted by the Phillies** -- all pitchers: Mathieson, Savery, Zagurski. One (4%) signed as an amateur free agent (Concepcion); two (8%) were acquired by trade (Mayberry, Mazzone); one (4%) claimed off waivers (Bockock); one (4%) by Rule 5 Draft (Sellers) and 16 (67%) signed as minor league FAs.
- **20 (84%) players with MLB experience:** all but Concepcion, Mazzone, Savery and INF Neil Sellers.
- The average ML Service Time is **1.093** with the most tenured pitcher RHP Brandon Duckworth (5.025) and the most tenured position player OF DeWayne Wise (4.046).
- The average age is **29.8** with the oldest Tracy (36 years, 3 months, 28 days on Opening Day) and youngest Savery (24 years, 4 months, 4 days).
- **0 (0%) of 12 pitchers appeared in the Majors** last season; 8 of 12 (67%) hitters appeared in MLB in '09.
- **20 (84%) players were born in the U.S.;** two (8%) in the Dominican Republic (Concepcion, INF Wilson Valdez), one (4%) in Venezuela (INF Luis Maza) and one (4%) in Canada (Mathieson).
- **21 (88%) have previous I.L. experience** -- all but Bockock, RHP Brian Gordon and Sellers -- with the most teams represented by Wise (SYR, RIC, TOL, LOU, CHA). 14 (58%) players have I.L. time in other systems.
- **3 (13%) players were taken by SF in the '98 Draft** -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a career record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd amongst all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

On August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... The 'Pigs finished 71-73, a 16.0-game improvement from 2008. In ending the season 11.5 GB, they finished 21.5 games closer to first place than they did a season ago.

OF **John Mayberry** hit .409-0-9 (9-22) in 6 G after a respectable stat line in ML Spring Training of 282-1-6 in 21 G...
