TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (3-5) play the finale of a three-game series against the Rochester Red Wings (3-5) -- Minnesota's top affiliate. With a 4-1 win last night, the 'Pigs and 'Wings have split the first two games with a 'rubber match' tonight -- while starting 1-1 on this season-long, nine-game Northern Division homestand... Rochester has dropped three of its last four games... Last season, LHV finished third place in the North Division (71-73) while ROC finished fourth (70-74)... Following tonight's game, the Syracuse Chiefs (6-2) will return for a four-game series at Coca-Cola Park.

• First-pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by **Total Home Improvements**.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN:

Marked the fastest the Pigs have ever won at Coca-Cola Park to start a season (Game 2). It took until Game 5 in 2009 (4/13 vs. SYR) and until Game 4 in 2008 (4/14 vs. RIC).

WITH A WIN TONIGHT:

LHV will have back-to-back wins for the first time this season and will also have its first series victory in 2010.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery**, 24, is a 6-3, 235-pound lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. The native of Bellaire, TX, started 2009 with Double-A Reading -- where he was an Eastern League All-Star while going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS before a promotion on 7/31. With LHV, he went 4-2, 4.38 in 7 GS -- finishing with 16 combined wins for the season, a total tied for 2nd most in MiLB behind Donald Hume of Stockton (17). He enters the season ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

• *After starting 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS in '09, JS won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28-7/9/09 in a span of 15 GS.*
 • **JS vs. LHV in 2009:** 1-0, 1.50, 1 G, 1 GS (6 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 1 er, 5 bb, 0 k, .200) -- his Triple-A Debut (8/2 @ ROC)

LHP **Glen Perkins** -- a member of the Twins 40-Man Roster with 2.131 service time -- is a 6-0, 200-pound, 27-year-old selected by Minnesota in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2004 draft out of University of Minnesota. -- where he was Big Ten Pitcher of the Year in 2004. The native of Lakeview, MN, started last season making his first Twins Opening Day Roster of his career -- and got off to a fast start. The lefty became the first Twins pitcher -- and first MLBer since Pat Hentgen (BAL) in 2001 -- to open a season with 3 GS of at least 8.0 IP and two-or-fewer runs... He finished 6-7, 5.89 in 18 G, 17 GS as he was slowed by two trips to the D.L. (elbow; shoulder) and 3 rehab starts at lower levels... Perkins started 2008 in ROC, then went an impressive 12-4, 4.41 in 26 GS for the Twins... Has gone 18-11, 4.73 in 76 G, 43 GS in MLB... Has a career 3.49 ERA in MiLB... Became the 27th Minnesotan to play for the Twins on his ML debut 9/21/06 @ Boston (1.1 ip, 0 er).

• *Perkins tossed a 2-hit SHO in his only GS at CCP -- a 10-0 win 4/26/08 (9 ip, 2* h, 0 r, bb, 7 k); Victorino had 1*

SERIES INFORMATION:

The 2010 season series is tied, 1-1... LHV won the '09 series, 10-7 -- winning 7 of the last 9 G... Still, ROC leads the lifetime series, 18-16 (.529) -- but LHV leads the overall series, 9-8, at Coca-Cola Park (winning 5 of last 6 in LHV).

DO THE MATH!:

Last night, RHP **Scott Mathieson** (2 ip, 1 h) earned the first LHV save of 2010 -- after the bullpen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR)... In all, the hard-throwing prospect has started his season with 6.0 scoreless innings in 3 G (1-0, 0.00)...

BUMP ON THE BUMP:

Last night, RHP **Nate Bump** (W, 7 ip, 6 h, r, 0 er, 2 bb, k) became the first Pig to record a "Quality Start" in '10 -- while earning the 50th win of his MiLB career... In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- the former Marlin is 8-1, 2.33 in 12 GS (81 ip, 21 er).

MAY DAY! MAY DAY!:

Last night, OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, hit his first HR of the season -- and the 100th HR of his pro career. He's now hit in the last 6 G (9-23, .391-1-5, 2B, 3B, 6 R)... In perhaps a fitting tribute to Jackie Robinson on Jackie Robinson Day, the two African-American players on the team -- OF **Dewayne Wise** and Mayberry -- hit back-to-back HRs in the 4th inning -- marking the 7th time this has been done in LHV history.

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **Chris Duffy** (0-4) had his 7-G hitting streak come to an end, during which time he was .344-1-10 (11-32)... 3B **Cody Ransom** has hit in his last 3 G (4-13, .308-2-5)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has hit in 3 straight games (5-13, .385-0-4, 2B) -- which featured a career-high tying 4 RBI on 4/13 @ PAW... C **Paul Hoover** has reached safely in all 6 of his G (7-23, .304-0-3, BB, HBP)... LHP **Brian Mazone** went 5.0 scoreless IP on 4/13 to earn the first win by a starter (4 h, bb, 4 k)... RHP **Brian Gordon** has made three appearances this season -- all 2.0-IP stints -- and has only allowed a single run (0-0, 1.50)...

BACON BITS:

- *...Last Laugh?*: The IronPigs are 2-0 in series finales to start 2010.
- *Short-Winded?*: The 2:11 time-of-game on Thursday was the shortest of the year by 42 minutes and the 3rd shortest for a 9-inning game in LHV history.
- *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs are 0-2 in extra-inning games after going 7-8 in such contests in '09; 6-6 in '08.

SLOW STARTER:

Clean-up hitting 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting just .219-1-3 (7-32) in 8 G... But don't panic! Tracy started 2009 batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G.

SLOW STARTERS:

At 3-5, LHV is just 15-40 (.273) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).
 • LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

GENESIS 1:1: IN THE BIG-INNING (STREAK SNAPPED 4/14!):

LHV did not score more than a run in any inning last night -- snapping their 6-G streak of having at least one inning in each game in which they scored 3-or-more runs... The 8 R scored off Boof Bonser in the 2nd inning on 4/13 @ PAW set a franchise record for runs in an inning (prev. 7, done 4x, last: 6/22/09 @ NOR).

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

2010 ROSTER BY THE NUMBERS:

- The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster (active 24-man) consists of 12 pitchers, 2 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 OF. There are:
- **9 (38%) returning 'Pigs**: RHP Jason Anderson, RHP Alex Concepcion, C Paul Hoover, OF John Mayberry Jr., LHP Brian Mazone, LHP Joe Savery, 1B Andy Tracy, OF Rich Thompson, LHP Jake Woods.
 - **4 (17%) members of PHI's 40-Man Roster**: INF Brian Bocoock, RHP Scott Mathieson, Mayberry, LHP Mike Zagurski.
 - **3 (13%) players originally drafted by the Phillies** -- all pitchers: Mathieson, Savery, Zagurski. One (4%) signed as an amateur free agent (Concepcion); two (8%) were acquired by trade (Mayberry, Mazone); one (4%) claimed off waivers (Bocoock); one (4%) by Rule 5 Draft (Sellers) and 16 (67%) signed as minor league FAs.
 - **20 (84%) players with MLB experience**: all but Concepcion, Mazone, Savery and INF Neil Sellers.
 - The average ML Service Time is **1.093** with the most tenured pitcher RHP Brandon Duckworth (5.025) and the most tenured position player OF DeWayne Wise (4.046).
 - The average age is **29.8** with the oldest Tracy (36 years, 3 months, 28 days on Opening Day) and youngest Savery (24 years, 4 months, 4 days).
 - **0 (0%) of 12 pitchers appeared in the Majors** last season; 8 of 12 (67%) hitters appeared in MLB in '09.
 - **20 (84%) players were born in the U.S.**; two (8%) in the Dominican Republic (Concepcion, INF Wilson Valdez), one (4%) in Venezuela (INF Luis Maza) and one (4%) in Canada (Mathieson).
 - **21 (88%) have previous I.L. experience** -- all but Bocoock, RHP Brian Gordon and Sellers -- with the most teams represented by Wise (SYR, RIC, TOL, LOU, CHA). 14 (58%) players have I.L. time in other systems.
 - **3 (13%) players were taken by SF in the '98 Draft** -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)...

The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his **1,500th career MiLB win** since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd among all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.
