TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (4-5) play Game Two of a four-game series against the first-place (tied) Syracuse Chiefs (6-3) -- Washington's top affiliate. With an 8-1 win last night, the 'Pigs have won back-to-back games for the first time this season and are now 2-1 on what is now an eight-game, Northern Division homestand... Meanwhile, the Chiefs have gone 3-3 after their three walk-off wins against the 'Pigs to start the season... After these four games, LHV will have played 67% of its 2010 games-to-date against SYR (8 of 12)...

• First-pitch is scheduled for 1:35 p.m. for Dog Bowl Giveaway, as presented by **Lehigh Valley Animal Hospital**.

WITH A WIN TODAY, THE 'PIGS WILL...:

• Get back to .500 for just the 3rd time in team history... LHV has only been at .500 for two days in franchise history (38-38 on 6/28/09; 47-47 on 7/19/09) -- after 220 G and by a Phils' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07 -- span of 318 G (2 years, 1 month, 3 days)... LHV is 0-2 at .500... so the 'Pigs have never been above .500 (in 289 games) and a Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of 339 games...

• LHV will have three straight wins for the first time this season and for the first time since 9/3-9/4/09 (DH, 9/4).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Brian Mazone** -- who is tied with Drew Carpenter for the most career wins in LHV history (12) -- is a 6-4, 200-pound, 33-year-old re-acquired by the Phillies in a trade with the Dodgers for cash considerations, 6/30/09 (LA signed him as a FA last winter). After going just 0-1, 8.44 in 13 G, 0 GS with Triple-A Albuquerque, the Californian finished 2-6, 3.50 in 11 G, 11 GS with the 'Pigs -- then was effective for Obregon in the Mexican Winter League (3-0, 2.39 in 5 G, 5 GS)... Mazone spent all 2008 with LHV, going 9-12, 4.10 in 28 GS and being selected as an IL midseason All-Star -- it was his first MiLB All-Star selection and he tossed a 3-up, 3-down 4th inning (7 pitches, 1 K)... In his IL career, Mazone is currently 28-23, 3.18 ERA in 67 G, 67 GS (390.2 ip, 138 er). As a pro, he has gone 84-62 (.575)... He got called up by PHI to make his ML debut 9/5/06 vs. HOU, but game was postponed; and he hasn't been back.

• **BM finished strong in '09, going 1-2 but w/ a 1.48 ERA in his final 4 starts (24.1 ip, 25 h, 4 r, 4 er, 2 bb, 14 k).**

• **BM vs. SYR in 2009: 0-3, 3.48 ERA in 3 G, 3 GS (10.1 ip, 13 h, 6 r, 4 er, bb, 6 k).**

RHP **Luis Atilano** -- a member of Washington's 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-2, 200-pound, 24-year-old acquired by the Nationals from Atlanta in exchange for 1B Daryle Ward, 8/31/06 (just 21 days after having Tommy John surgery). He was originally drafted by ATL as a sandwich pick (35th overall) in 2003 out of Santurce, P.R... Atilano spent the bulk of 2009 in Double-A Harrisburg (7-8, 4.16 in 21 G, 20 GS) with two starts in Syracuse (2-0, 2.45)... Following season, pitched for P.R. in the '09 Baseball World Cup (3 wins, 2.21 ERA) for Caguas in the P.R. Winter League (2-1, 3.95 and 1 SV in 15 G, 2 GS)... Was a starting pitcher in the 2005 South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

SERIES INFORMATION:

SYR leads the season series, 3-2; and has won 11 of the last 15 (with 4 walk-off wins)... SYR also holds a 23-14 (.621) lifetime edge against LHV -- 15-5 (.750) at ABS... SYR won both the '08 & '09 season series, 10-6 (6-2 at ABS).

TRANSACTIONS:

Today, LHP **Jake Woods** came off the IronPigs roster as he was released by the Phillies and RHP **Oscar Villarreal** was activated off the D.L. (elbow)... Villarreal, 28, did not play in 2009 after undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2008. He was 4.027 ML service time with Arizona (2003-05), Atlanta (2006-07) and Houston (2008)... In 3 G this season, Woods was 0-0, 3.60 (5 ip, 2 er)... He was a valuable asset to LHV in 2009, going 5-2, 3.46 in 42 G, 6 GS.

MAY DAY! MAY DAY!:

Last night, OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, went 3-3 with a HBP while tying franchise single-game records for double (3) and runs scored (4)... He also extended his hitting streak to seven games (12-26, .462-1-7, 4 2B, 3B, 10 R)... On Thursday, he hit his first HR of the season -- and the 100th HR of his pro career.

ROMERO REHAB:

Thursday, Phillies' LHP **J.C. Romero** (elbow) made a ML Rehab appearance, as presented by **Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network** (ip, h, 0 r, 0 bb, 2 k)... He is expected to rehab with LHV again either Sunday or Monday...

DO THE MATH!

Thursday, RHP **Scott Mathieson** (2 ip, 1 h) earned the first LHV save of 2010 -- after the bullpen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR)... In all, the hard-throwing prospect has started his season with 6.0 scoreless innings in 3 G (1-0, 0.00)...

BUMP ON THE BUMP:

Thursday, RHP **Nate Bump** (W, 7 ip, 6 h, r, 0 er, 2 bb, k) became the first Pig to record a "Quality Start" in '10 -- while earning the 50th win of his MiLB career... In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- the former Marlin is 8-1, 2.33 in 12 GS (81 ip, 21 er).

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 8 of 9 G this season and leads LHV with 10 RBI... 3B **Cody Ransom** has hit in his last 4 G (5-15, .333-2-7)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has hit in his last 3 starts (5-14, .357-0-4, 2B) -- which featured a career-high tying 4 RBI on 4/13 @ PAW... C **Paul Hoover** has reached safely in all 6 of his G (7-23, .304-0-3, BB, HBP)... LHP **Brian Mazone** went 5.0 scoreless IP on 4/13 to earn the first win by a starter (4 h, bb, 4 k)... RHP **Brian Gordon** has made three appearances this season -- all 2.0-IP stints -- and has only allowed a single run (0-0, 1.50)...

BACON BITS:

- *Double-Trouble*: The IronPigs have now turned 9 double-plays in 2010 -- and they've only hit into 3...
- *...Last Laugh?*: The IronPigs are 2-0 in series finales to start 2010.
- *Extra Special?*: The 'Pigs are 0-2 in extra-inning games after going 7-8 in such contests in '09; 6-6 in '08.

SLOW STARTER:

Clean-up hitting 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting just .222-1-3 (8-36) in 9 G... But don't panic! Tracy started 2009 batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G.

SLOW STARTERS:

At 4-5, LHV is just 16-40 (.286) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).
• LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

GENESIS 1:1: IN THE BIG-INNING (STREAK SNAPPED 4/14!):

LHV did not score more than a run in any inning Wednesday -- snapping their 6-G streak of having at least one inning in each game in which they scored 3-or-more runs... The 8 R scored off Boof Bonser in the 2nd inning on 4/13 @ PAW set a franchise record for runs in an inning (prev. 7, done 4x, last: 6/22/09 @ NOR).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd among all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

On August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... The 'Pigs finished 71-73, a 16.0-game improvement from 2008. In ending the season 11.5 GB, they finished 21.5 games closer to first place than they did a season ago.

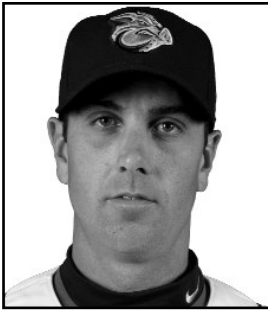
