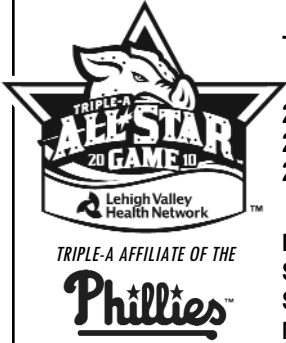

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (5-8) play the finale of a mini two-game series against the Pawtucket Red Sox (6-7) -- Boston's top affiliate. With an 8-4 loss last night to the Sox, the 'Pigs fell to 3-3 on this eight-game, Northern Division home-stand... Meanwhile, the Paw Sox previously split a four-game series at Frontier Field...

• First-pitch is set for 7:05 p.m... RHP **Brad Lidge** will rehab here tonight as presented by **Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network**... Following the game, the 'Pigs will embark on an eight-game Northern Division road trip through Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Rochester.

THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

Coming into the day, LHV is just 5-8 despite the following numbers...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 64-54... The 64 runs is the third-most in the IL
- LHV is batting a whopping .322 (37-115) with Runners in Scoring Position (opponents are at .240)
- LHV has scored first in 10 of the 13 games... going just 5-5 in those games
- LHV has lost 8 games by a total of 14 R (5, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 1, 3-run G; 1, 4-run G)... LHV is just 2-5 in 1-run G

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Brandon Duckworth** -- a 2001 International League MVP making his 2010 season debut -- is a 6-2, 215-pound 34-year-old signed by the Phillies as a minor league FA, 1/13/10. The former Philadelphia Phillie spent all of 2009 in the KC system with Triple-A Omaha -- going 3-6, 5.31 in 20 G, 19 GS... Originally signed by the Phillies as a non-drafter free agent in 1997, Duckworth ascended rapidly in the system and made it up to the Majors in his fourth season. The Salt Lake City native won his ML debut 8/7/01 vs. SD (6 ip, 3 er) and finished his rookie campaign at 3-2, 3.52 in 11 GS. He started 2001 in SWB, going 13-2, 2.63 in 22 G, 20 GS -- leading the IL in ERA and tied for the league lead in wins - which led to his being named MVP as well as IL Rookie of the Year... After parts of three seasons in Philadelphia, Duckworth was traded to Houston as part of the Billy Wagner trade, 11/3/03... In 5.025 ML Service Time, he's gone 23-34, 5.28 and a SV in 134 G, 84 GS with PHI (2001-03), HOU (2004-05) and KC (2006-08)... Career 83-58, 3.88 in MiLB.
 • *This is BD's first appearance in PHI org since '03; first appearance in IL since 6/5/06 w/ IND vs. PAW -- a game he happened to loss to the Paw Sox to snap his 7-game winning streak).*

LHP **Fabio Castro** -- a member of the Boston 40-Man Roster who made 3 appearances for LHV in 2008 (0-2, 8.01, 3 GS) -- is a 5-7, 185-pound, 25-year-old signed by Boston as a minor league FA on 12/4/09. The native of Monte Cristi, D.R., left the Phillies organization when he was traded to Toronto on 9/29/08 as the PTBNL in the Matt Stairs trade, 8/29/09. Originally signed by Chicago-A as a non-drafted FA on 12/26/01, Castro started 2009 in Double-A New Hampshire (2-0, 0.83 in 4 GS) before spending the bulk of the season in Triple-A Las Vegas (7-6, 4.49 in 25 GS)... Castro made his ML debut with Texas on 4/6/06 vs. DET (3.2 ip, 2 r, er, 2 k) but was designated 6/24 and eventually traded to Philadelphia for LHP Daniel Haigwood and cash, 6/29/06. As a rookie with the Phillies, Castro didn't allow a run in his first 17.1 IP and finished 0-1, 1.54 with 1 SV in 16 G... In 1.058 ML Service Time, Casto has gone 0-1, 3.30 and 1 SV in 30 G, 1 GS... He's gone a remarkable 50-28, 3.36 and 21 SV in 239 G, 63 GS in the Minors.

TRANSACTIONS:

Today, RHP **Brandon Duckworth** was activated off DL (rt. turf toe)... To make room RHP **Alex Concepcion** was placed on the DL (right turf toe)... This will be Duckworth's season debut.

SERIES INFORMATION:

PAW leads the 2010 season series, 2-1... LHV won the '09 series, 10-6 -- winning 6 of last 7 G... PAW leads life-time series, 23-12 (.657), after dominating in '08, 15-1 -- which including winning the first 9 G (and the last 6 G)...
 • It took 12 tries, but LHV finally won its first series all-time vs. PAW, 8/22-8/25/09 (then took the final series, 8/31-9/1).
 • *Sockin' Sox:* OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, is batting .373-4-14 in 15 career G vs. PAW (22-59, 7 2B, 10 R, 6 BB).

REHABS CONTINUE:

After back-to-back days of Phillies' LHP **J.C. Romero** then Boston's RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka**, Phillies' RHP **Brad Lidge** (right knee/right elbow) is expected to make a rehab appearance tonight. The 33-year-old right-hander began his current rehab stint with Clearwater on 4/10 and made five appearances, allowing five runs in 4.2 innings of work.

MORE ON LIDGE:

In 2008, Lidge was a perfect 48-for-48 in save opportunities -- including the playoffs -- helping the Phillies to their first World Championship since 1980. During the perfect season, Lidge was virtually unhittable -- posting a 1.95 ERA while striking out 92 batters in 69.1 innings. His statistics were remarkable even better in the postseason, going 7-for-7 in save situations with a 0.96 ERA in nine games.

For his efforts, he finished fourth in 2008 National League Cy Young Award voting and eighth in the N.L. Most Valuable Player voting while also being named to his second All-Star team. Among the various other accolades he received in 2008, Lidge was named Major League Baseball's Comeback Player of the Year and The Sporting News Reliever of the Year, as voted by a panel of 314 Major Leaguers.

One of the top strikeout pitchers of the era, Lidge has also been one of the most dependable, appearing in more games (433) than any reliever since 2004. His all-time strikeout ratio of 12.15 per 9.0 inning pitched is second-best among relievers over the last half-century (Rob Dibble, 12.17).

While the Sacramento native was unable to emulate his 2008 success last season, he did become just the third pitcher in Phils history to record back-to-back 30-SV seasons, joining Ricky Bottalico ('96-97) and Jose Mesa ('01-02).

The Phillies acquired Lidge along with Eric Bruntlett from Houston in exchange for Michael Bourn, Geoff Geary and Mike Costanzo on November 7, 2007. While with the Astros, Lidge logged a pair of 30+ save seasons, including a career-high 42 in 2005, guiding the club to their first-ever N.L. pennant. In 2004, he set an NL record for strikeouts by a reliever in a single-season with 157. Lidge was originally selected by Houston in the first round with the 17th overall pick in the 1998 draft. In portions of eight seasons, he has gone 25-28 with a 3.56 ERA and 195 saves. He also has struck out 714 batters in just 529.0 career innings.

NATE THE GREAT!:

Tuesday, RHP **Nate Bump** (W, 7 ip, 8 h, 0 r, bb, 2 k) became the first 'Pig with 2 wins this season while recording his second quality start -- and he could be a perfect 3-0 had the pen not blown a lead in his first start, 4/10 @ SYR... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the Towanda, Pa., native earned the 50th win of his MiLB career... In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- the former Marlin is now an impressive **9-1, 2.15 in 13 GS** (88 ip, 21 er).

- Bump currently has a 9.2 scoreless innings streak and hasn't allowed an earned run in 16.2 IP.

DO THE MATH!:

Tuesday, RHP **Scott Mathieson** allowed his first run of 2010 in his 5th appearance (H, 0.2 ip, h r, er, 2 bb, 2 k)... He started with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of 2010 -- after the bullpen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR)...

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 11 of 13 G this season and leads LHV with 11 RBI... OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 G (14-40, .350-1-7, 5 2B, 3B, 11 R)... OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit in his last 6 G (8-22, .364-2-7, 2B, 3B, 4 R)... C **Dane Sardinha** has hit safely in all 4 of his games (6-17, .353-1-4)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has hit in his last 5 starts (7-22, .318-0-4, 2B) -- which featured a career-high tying 4 RBI on 4/13 @ PAW... RHP **Brian Gordon** has made 4 appearances this season -- all 2.0-IP stints -- and has only allowed just one run (0-0, 1.13)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed an ER in his 5 G (0-1, 0.00, SV, 4.2 ip, 4 h, r, bb, 2 k)...

MAY DAY! MAY DAY!: MAYBERRY NAMED I.L. BATTER OF WEEK:

Monday, the International League named OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, Batter of the Week for April 12-18... Mayberry hit .524-1-5 (11-21, 4 2B, 3B) in 6 G, leading the IL in AVG, OBP (.583) and R (8) during the week. The 26-year-old collected hits in all six games, including going 5-7 with a 2B, 3B, 2 RBI and 3 R in LHV's 2-game series at Pawtucket... On Thursday, he hit his first HR of the season -- the 100th HR of his pro career... On Saturday, Mayberry tied single-game franchise records with 3 2B and 4 R... The Kansas City, MO, native is now the third 'Pigs ever to win an IL Batter of the Week award, joining **Andy Tracy** (a 3-time winner since '08) and **Michael Taylor** (August 10-16, 2009)...
