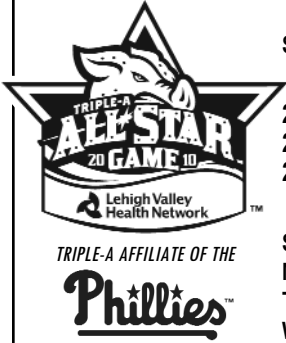

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (6-9) play Game Two of a four-game series against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (8-7) -- the Yankees' top affiliate. With a 6-3 loss last night, the 'Pigs have started 0-1 this eight-game, Northern Division road trip... Meanwhile, the Yankees split their previous two-game series against the Chiefs and have split their last three series... First-pitch tonight is set for 1:05 p.m...

• *Night Owls?*: In franchise history, the 'Pigs are just 20-39 (.339) when playing during daylight hours...

WITH A WIN TODAY:

The IronPigs will be off to their best start (7-9) in franchise history... Their tied at current going 6-9 through the first 15 G (2009)... After 26 games, LHV was 6-10 in 2009 after going 2-14 in 2008...

.500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in **303** games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of **403** games (2 years, 11 months)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 165-238 (.409).

THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

Coming into the day, LHV is just 6-9 despite 5th in AVG (.268) and 6th in ERA (3.59) and the following numbers...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 79-63... Their 79 runs are the 4th-most in the IL
- LHV is batting a whopping .321 (45-140) with Runners in Scoring Position (opponents are at .257)
- LHV has scored first in 11 of the 15 games... going just 6-5 in those games
- LHV has lost 9 games by a total of 17 R (5, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 2, 3-run G; 1, 4-run G)... LHV is just 2-5 in 1-run G

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Brian Mazone** -- who is tied with Drew Carpenter for the most career wins in LHV history (12) -- is a 6-4, 200-pound, 33-year-old re-acquired by the Phillies in a trade with the Dodgers for cash considerations, 6/30/09 (LA signed him as a FA last winter). After going just 0-1, 8.44 in 13 G, 0 GS with Triple-A Albuquerque, the Californian finished 2-6, 3.50 in 11 G, 11 GS with the 'Pigs -- then was effective for Obregon in the Mexican Winter League (3-0, 2.39 in 5 G, 5 GS)... Mazone spent all 2008 with LHV, going 9-12, 4.10 in 28 GS and being selected as an IL midseason All-Star -- it was his first MiLB All-Star selection and he tossed a 3-up, 3-down 4th inning (7 pitches, 1 K)... In his IL career, Mazone is currently 28-23, 3.18 ERA in 67 G, 67 GS (390.2 ip, 138 er). As a pro, he has gone 84-62 (.575)... He got called up by PHI to make his ML debut 9/5/06 vs. HOU, but game was postponed; and he hasn't been back.

- *BM finished strong in '09, going 1-2 but w/ a 1.48 ERA in his final 4 starts (24.1 ip, 25 h, 4 r, 4 er, 2 bb, 14 k).*
- *BM vs. PAW in 2008-09: 0-3, 6.75 ERA in 5 G, 5 GS (24.0 ip, 33 h, 18 r, 18 er, 2 bb, 19 k, .327, 5 hr, 101 ab)*

RHP **Zach McAllister** -- a non-roster invitee to ML Spring Training -- is a 6-5, 230-pound 22-year-old drafted by the Yankees in the 3rd round of 2006 out of Illinois Valley Central HS. The native of Chillicothe, Ill., spent the entire 2009 season in Double-A Trenton -- where he went 7-5, 2.23 in 22 GS and led the Eastern League in ERA... Named Yankees Minor League "Pitcher of the Year" as well as an EL midseason All-Star despite missing over 3 weeks with a trip to the DL (shoulder), 7/16-8/8... In 2008, was a combined 14-9, 2.09 in 25 G between Single-A and Double-A.

- *ZM entered '09 ranked as the No. 5 prospect AND has having the Best Control in system by Baseball America.*
- *ZM has allowed just 1 R in his last 2 GS (10.0 ip) after allowing 4 R in 5.2 IP in his first start of '09 (4/9 vs, BUF).*

SERIES INFORMATION:

SWB leads the season series, 1-0, after winning the '09 series, 10-6 (5-3 both home/away)... SWB also leads the overall series, 25-8 (.758), after going 14-2 against LHV in '08... *LHV won the last 2 G of '09 against SWB (8/20-8/21/09) -- the first time in LHV history they've won 2 straight... Since '07, the NYY affiliate is 35-14 vs. PHI affiliate.*

BACON BITS, PT. 1:

- *Playing all the Hits?*: Despite tying a franchise-record for hits on Thu., LHV has been under 10 hits for 8 the last 9 games after starting with 5 of their first 6 G of 2010 with double-digit hit totals.
- *Ye Who Laughs First?*: With last night's 6-3 loss, the 'Pigs are just 1-5 in series openers to start '10.

BACON BITS, PT. 2:

- *Hit Parade*: LHV's 18 hits Thursday tied a franchise record (4x, last: 4/24/09 vs. PAW). The 12 R tied a season high.
- *...Last Laugh??!!*: With Thursday's win, LHV's now a perfect 4-0 in series finales to start '10 (1 game suspended).

DO THE MATH!:

RHP **Scott Mathieson** started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... and has allowed just 1 R in his first 6 G (8.2 ip)... He On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of 2010 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR)...

NATE THE GREAT!:

Tuesday, RHP **Nate Bump** (W, 7 ip, 8 h, 0 r, bb, 2 k) became the first 'Pig with 2 wins this season while recording his second quality start -- and he could be a perfect 3-0 had the pen not blown a lead in his first start, 4/10 @ SYR... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the Towanda, Pa., native earned the 50th win of his MiLB career... In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- the former Marlin is now an impressive **9-1, 2.15 in 13 GS** (88 ip, 21 er).

- Bump currently has a 9.2 scoreless innings streak and hasn't allowed an earned run in 16.2 IP.

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 12 of 14 G this season and leads LHV with 13 RBI -- going an amazing 7-11 with RISP... OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 G (16-49, .327-1-10, 6 2B, 3B, 12 R)... C **Dane Sardinha** has hit safely in all 5 of his games (7-22, .319-1-5) as has INF **Melvin Dorta** (6-12, 2 R, RBI)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has hit in his last 7 starts (9-28, .321-0-5, 2 2B) -- which featured a career-high tying 4 RBI on 4/13 @ PAW... OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (9-30, .300-3-9, 2 2B, 3B, 4 R)... RHP **Brian Gordon** has made 5 appearances -- all at least 2.0-IP stints -- and has only allowed just 3 R in 12 IP (0-0, 2.25)...

MAY DAY! MAY DAY!: MAYBERRY NAMED I.L. BATTER OF WEEK:

Monday, the International League named OF **John Mayberry, Jr.**, Batter of the Week for April 12-18... Mayberry hit .524-1-5 (11-21, 4 2B, 3B) in 6 G, leading the IL in AVG, OBP (.583) and R (8) during the week. The 26-year-old collected hits in all six games, including going 5-7 with a 2B, 3B, 2 RBI and 3 R in LHV's 2-game series at Pawtucket... On Thursday, he hit his first HR of the season -- the 100th HR of his pro career... On Saturday, Mayberry tied single-game franchise records with 3 2B and 4 R... The Kansas City, MO, native is now the third 'Pigs ever to win an IL Batter of the Week award, joining **Andy Tracy** (a 3-time winner since '08) and **Michael Taylor** (August 10-16, 2009)...

SLOW STARTER:

Clean-up hitting 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting just .204-1-5 (10-49) in 14 G... But don't panic! Tracy started 2009 batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G.

SLOW STARTERS:

At 6-9, LHV is just 18-44 (.290) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).

- LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

CRAZY SERIES VERSUS 'CUSE:

LHV has already played a pair of four-game series against first-place Syracuse... The 'Pigs went 3-5 against the Chiefs -- as 6 of the 8 games were decided by 1 run, including 4 of LHV's 5 losses (the other was decided by 2 runs)... The first 3 games were walk-off wins by Syracuse, which came-from-behind to win in all 5 of its wins!

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd among all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season **1,706-1,541**] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered **1,584-1,327**]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak**, 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad finished above .500 at 9-7 (including Tuesday's exhibition) -- winning 9 of its last 12 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

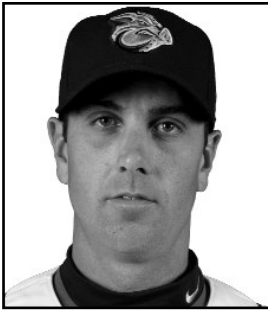
