TONIGHT'S GAME:

The fourth-place IronPigs (9-11) play the finale of a four-game series -- and eight-day road trip -- at Frontier Field against the fifth-place Rochester Red Wings (8-13), the Twins' top affiliate. With a 5-3 win last night, the 'Pigs improved to 3-3 on this (now) seven-game, Northern Division road trip... Meanwhile, the 'Wings have still dropped six of their last eight contests and are just 4-8 in their last 12 games... First-pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m...

- Following the game, LHV returns home for an eight-game, nine-day homestand starting vs. IND tomorrow at 6:35 pm.
- ...*Last Laugh*??: LHV is a perfect 4-0 in series finales to start '10 (1 finale suspended, 1 finale postponed).

WITH A WIN TONIGHT...

- The 'Pigs will have their first win of a four-game series in 2010 and their first win in a road four-game series since taking 3-of-4 at Pawtucket from 8/22/09-8/25/09.
- Win back-to-back games for just the 2nd time in '10 (4/15-4/17...which was actually separated by a suspended game).
- Improve to 10-11 -- which keep them tied for their best start in franchise history through 21 G (10-11 in 2009).
- Have a chance tomorrow to get back to .500 (11-11?) for just the third time in franchise history.

HE WHO LAUGHS FIRST LAUGHS LAST?:

LHV has now jumped on the board first in 15 of their first 20 G (75.0%) -- the most in the IL... IND has done it 14 x (10-4)... Durham -- best team in IL (15-7) -- has scored first 13 times... The 'Pigs have gone 9-6 (.600) in those games -- but the I.L. average is .711 (106-43).

- However, the 'Pigs have blown leads in 8 of their 11 losses (.727).

THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

LHV is now 9-11 despite 3rd in AVG (.278); 3rd in R (104) and 5th in ERA (3.63) and...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 104-81... Their +23 run differential ranks 3rd in the I.L...
- LHV is batting a whopping .305 with Runners in Scoring Position (opponents are at .239)
- LHV has scored first in 15 of the 20 games (75.0%)... going just 9-6 in those games
- LHV has lost 11 games by a total of 19 R (7, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 2, 3-run G; 1, 4-run G)... LHV just 2-7 in 1-run G

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP Brian Mazone -- who is tied with Drew Carpenter for the most career wins in LHV history (13) -- is a 6-4, 200-pound, 33-year-old re-acquired by the Phillies in a trade with the Dodgers for cash considerations, 6/30/09 (LA signed him as a FA last winter). After going just 0-1, 8.44 in 13 G, 0 GS with Triple-A Albuquerque, the Californian finished 2-6, 3.50 in 11 G, 11 GS with the 'Pigs -- then was effective for Obregon in the Mexican Winter League (3-0, 2.39 in 5 G, 5 GS)... Mazone spent all 2008 with LHV, going 9-12, 4.10 in 28 GS and being selected as an IL midseason All-Star -- it was his first MiLB All-Star selection and he tossed a 3-up, 3-down 4th inning (7 pitches, 1 K)... In his IL career, Mazone is currently 29-23, 3.18 ERA in 68 G, 68 GS (396.2 ip, 140 er). As a pro, he has gone 85-62 (.578)... He got called up by PHI to make his ML debut 9/5/06 vs. HOU, but game was postponed; and he hasn't been back.

- **BM vs. ROC in 2008-09:** 2-1, 3.24 ERA in 4 G, 4 GS (25.0 ip, 28 h, 11 r, 9 er, 4 bb, 15 k, .327, 2 hr, 95 ab)

LHP Ryan Mullins -- making his 8th career Triple-A start -- is a 202-pound, 26-year-old drafted by Minnesota in the 3rd round of 2005 out of Vanderbilt University -- where he was First Team All-SEC in 2005. After a stint with Rochester in 2007 (0-3, 10.57 in 4 GS), the Nashville native spent his second consecutive full season in Double-A New Britain in 2009, going 11-11, 4.03 in 28 G, 27 GS -- leading the Eastern League in SO (133) while finishing 3rd in wins and 9th in ERA. He walked just 36 for a 3.7/1 K/BB ratio... After the season, Mullins pitched for Mayaguez in the Puerto Rican Winter League (0-2, 8.22 in 5 G, 4 GS)... Was a 2007 Florida State League All-Star with Fort Myers (3-3, 1.98 in 10 G, 9 GS).

- **RM vs. LHV, 4/14 @ LHV (W, 5-2):** W, 5 ip, 3 h, r, er, bb, 6 k Fell behind on 2-out Ransom RBI-1B in 1st then ret'd 13 of 14 inc. last 9

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the season series, 3-2... LHV won the '09 series, 10-6 -- winning 7 of the last 9 G (and now 10 of last 14)... Still, ROC still leads the lifetime series, 19-18 (.514) -- and ROC leads the overall series at Frontier Field, 10-9.

- **Welcome Back Maza:** 2B Luis Maza is now 6-21, 4 R vs. ROC... He hit .246-15-79 in 180 G w/ ROC 2004-06.
- **Wings Dings:** ROC has stranded 30 runners in 3 G -- and his batting just .158 (6-38) w/ RISP in the series.

WHO'S HOT:

INF **Melvin Dorta** has hit safely in all 7 of his games (10-23, .435-0-3, 6 R, 2 BB)... C **Dane Sardinha** has hit safely in all 6 of his G (10-25, .400-1-5, 6 R)... 3B **Cody Ransom** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (9-30, .300-1-6, 2 2B)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 6 of his last 8 G (10-29, .345-0-5, 2 SB)... 1B **Neil Sellers** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (7-26, .269-0-1, 2 2B)... OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 14 of 18 G and is an amazing 8-16 (.500) with RISP... RHP **Ehren Wassermann** is unscored upon in his last 6.2 IP...

DO THE MATH!:

RHP **Scott Mathieson** started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... and has allowed just 1 R in his first 8 G (10.2 ip, 3-3 in SV opps)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of '10 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR).

GIVE AN 'A' to Z:

LHP **Mike Zagurski** has stranded his last 8 inherited runners -- and stranded bases loaded twice (once with 0 outs; then with 1 out) -- striking out all 5 BF... In his last 6 G, Zagurski is 0-0, 1.69 ERA, 2 H (5.1 ip, 2 r, 1 er, 7 k).

NATE THE GREAT!:

Tuesday, RHP **Nate Bump** (W, 5 ip, 3 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, k) became the first 'Pig with 3 wins this season -- and could be a perfect 4-0 had the pen not blown a lead in his first start, 4/10 @ SYR... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the Towanda, Pa., native earned the 50th win of his MiLB career (1-0)... During his last 3 GS, he had a 10.1 scoreless IP and went 17.1 IP without allowing an ER.

• *In his IL career (7/7/09-present) -- the former Marlin is now an impressive 10-1, 2.23 in 14 GS (93 ip, 23 er).*

SAVERY WHOODINI:

LHP **Joe Savery** has been very effective his entire career in stranding baserunners... In his career, opponents have hit .237 (85-359) with runners in scoring position and just .224 (38-170) with RISP and two out... Bearing down despite the fact he has a career WHIP of 1.53, career .274 OBA and career .297 OBA with the bases empty.

.500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in 308 games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of 408 games (2 years, 11 months, 6 days)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 168-240.

BACON BITS:

- *Win One, Lose One:* LHV has neither won nor lost 2 straight in the last 10 G -- the 'Pigs have alternated wins/losses.
- *Blowin' in the Wind:* LHV has blown leads in 8 of their 11 losses -- including squandering a 2-0 lead in 2nd on Wed.
- *Ye Who Laughs First?:* With Tuesday's 6-3 win, the 'Pigs improved to 2-5 in series openers to start '10.
- *...Last Laugh??:* With Thursday's win, LHV's now a perfect 4-0 in series finales to start '10 (1 game suspended).
- *Night Owls?:* In franchise history, the 'Pigs are just 21-40 (.344) when playing during daylight hours...
- *Among Giants:* Three current 'Pigs were taken by SF in the '98 Draft -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

SLOW STARTER:

Clean-up hitting 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting just .206-1-5 (13-63) in 18 G... But don't panic! Tracy started '09 batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G and started '08 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G... Plus, he has walked a team-high 14 times.

SLOW STARTERS:

At 9-11, LHV is just 21-46 (.313) lifetime in the month of April... LHV started 0-11 in 2008 -- the worst start in recorded IL history -- and 0-4 in '09... Looking back further, the Phils' top affiliate started 0-3 in '07 (Ottawa); 0-2 in '06 (SWB).
• LHV is also 0-3 on Opening Day in its brief history & the Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't won an Opener in the last 11 years.

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd among all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season 1,706-1,541] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered 1,584-1,327]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak**, 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

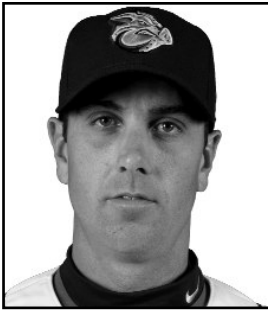
