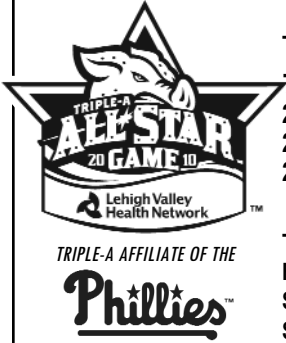

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs officially take the field for the first time in 2010 with the 3rd Annual '222 Showcase' -- an exhibition game against the Double-A Reading Phillies (who are located less than 40 miles away on U.S. Highway 222). The teams have split the first two meetings in the past two seasons (see below), both at FirstEnergy Stadium in Reading. Following this final "tune-up", the IronPigs will open the 2010 season in Syracuse at Alliance Bank Stadium on Thursday at 2 p.m. The Chiefs -- the Nationals' top affiliate -- finished last season 76-68 and in second place in the North Division. The R-Phils will open up at home versus the Portland Sea Dogs on Thursday at 7:05 p.m.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery**, 24, is a 6-3, 235-pound lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. The native of Bellaire, TX, started 2009 with Double-A Reading -- where he was an Eastern League All-Star while going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS before a promotion on 7/31. With LHV, he went 4-2, 4.38 in 7 GS -- finishing with 16 combined wins for the season, a total tied for 2nd most in MiLB behind Donald Hume of Stockton (17). He enters the season ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

• *After starting 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS, Savery won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28/09-7/9/9 in a span of 15 GS.*

LHP **Yohan Flande** -- ranked as the No. 17 Prospect in the system by *Baseball America* -- is a 6-2, 180-pound, 24-year-old southpaw signed by PHI as an amateur free agent on 12/13/04 out of El Seibo, D.R. A member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster, Flande started 2009 in Clearwater (7-1, 2.52 in 13 GS) and was a Florida State League All-Star prior to a 6/30 promotion with Reading (4-4, 4.58 in 13 GS). Although touched up in his first four Double-A starts, (0-2, 7.58) he went 4-2, 3.48 over his final nine. He also earned a hold for the World Team at the '09 Futures Game (ip, 2 h, 2 k).

2010 ROSTER BY THE NUMBERS:

The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster (active 24-man) consists of 12 pitchers, 2 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 OF. There are:

- **9 (38%) returning 'Pigs:** RHP Jason Anderson, RHP Alex Concepcion, C Paul Hoover, OF John Mayberry Jr., LHP Brian Mazone, LHP Joe Savery, 1B Andy Tracy, OF Rich Thompson, LHP Jake Woods.
- **4 (17%) members of PHI's 40-Man Roster:** INF Brian Bockock, RHP Scott Mathieson, Mayberry, LHP Mike Zagurski.
- **3 (13%) players originally drafted by the Phillies** -- all pitchers: Mathieson, Savery, Zagurski. One (4%) signed as an amateur free agent (Concepcion); two (8%) were acquired by trade (Mayberry, Mazone); one (4%) claimed off waivers (Bockock); one (4%) by Rule 5 Draft (Sellers) and 16 (67%) signed as minor league FAs.
- **20 (84%) players with MLB experience:** all but Concepcion, Mazone, Savery and INF Neil Sellers.
- The average ML Service Time is **1.093** with the most tenured pitcher RHP Brandon Duckworth (5.025) and the most tenured position player OF DeWayne Wise (4.046).
- The average age is **29.8** with the oldest Tracy (36 years, 3 months, 28 days on Opening Day) and youngest Savery (24 years, 4 months, 4 days).
- **0 (0%) of 12 pitchers appeared in the Majors** last season; 8 of 12 (67%) hitters appeared in MLB in '09.
- **20 (84%) players were born in the U.S.;** two (8%) in the Dominican Republic (Concepcion, INF Wilson Valdez), one (4%) in Venezuela (INF Luis Maza) and one (4%) in Canada (Mathieson).
- **21 (88%) have previous I.L. experience** -- all but Bockock, RHP Brian Gordon and Sellers -- with the most teams represented by Wise (SYR, RIC, TOL, LOU, CHA). 14 (58%) players have I.L. time in other systems.
- **3 (13%) players were taken by SF in the '98 Draft** -- all in Top 10 rounds -- Bump (1), Vogelsong (5), Ransom (9).

2010 TRIPLE-A SPRING TRAINING RECAP:

Perhaps a harbinger, the Phillies Triple-A Spring Training Squad won its final game to finish above .500 at 8-7 -- winning 8 of its last 11 after starting 0-4. Unofficially, the team batted .266 with a staff ERA of 4.65.

WHO'S HOT:

OF **John Mayberry** hit .450-0-9 (9-20) in 5 G after a respectable stat line in ML Spring Training of 282-1-6 in 21 G... INF **Wilson Valdez** spent the entire camp in with the Phillies and hit .313-1-6 (10-32) in 21 G... RHP **Scott Mathieson** was nearly perfect, going 1-0, 0.00 in 7 G (9 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 9)... RHP **Nate Bump** finished 1-1, 2.08 in 3 G, 2 GS (13 ip, 14 h, 3 r, 0 bb, 4 k)... RHP Brandon Duckworth went 1-1, 2.25 in 3 G, 2 GS (12 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 6 bb, 11 k)... RHP **Jason Anderson** went 1-0, 2.57, SV in 5 g (7 ip, 4 h, 2 er, 0 bb, 4 k).

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 18th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 18th best system: down from 12th in 2009 (22 in '08; 21 in '07; 22 in '06)... The 'Pigs Opening Day Roster features just two players that were ranked in the Top 30: (15) RHP **Scott Mathieson** and (21) LHP **Joe Savery**... The Top 2 both will start in Double-A Reading: (1) OF **Domonic Brown** and (2) LHP **Phillipe Aumont**.

FORTUNE .500?:

With a win in the season-opener on Thursday at Syracuse, the 'Pigs will get above .500 for the first time in team history (289 games)... and for the first time by a Phils' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of 339 games... The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for two days in franchise history (38-38 on 6/28/09; 47-47 on 7/19/09).

HUPPERT CLIMBING CHARTS:

With Lehigh Valley's 5-1 win 5/31/09, 'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** earned his 1,500th career MiLB win since starting his managerial career in 1986. With a career record of 1,551-1,376, 'Hupp' enters the season ranked 3rd amongst all active managers in wins behind (1) Round Rock's **Marc Bombard** [entered season 1,706-1,541] and (2) Orem's **Tom Kotchman** [entered 1,584-1,327]. Unofficially, the record for Minor League wins is held by **Stan Wasiak** 2,530 from 1950-1986; 1,824 needed to crack Top 20.

DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES:

On August 8, LHV improved to 56-57 -- passing its win total from the inaugural season (55-89) with 31 games still to play... The 'Pigs finished 71-73, a 16.0-game improvement from 2008. In ending the season 11.5 GB, they finished 21.5 games closer to first place than they did a season ago.

2009 SEASON RECAP:

The 'Pigs showed vast improvement in their second season -- finishing just two games under .500 at 71-73 while placing third in the International League's North Division. A season removed from an IL-worst 55-89 campaign, the IronPigs remained in postseason contention until the season's final month in 2009. They also finished with a 3.80 team ERA -- the fifth best among the IL's 14 teams.

Offensively, the IronPigs were once again led by a pair of veterans, 1B **Andy Tracy** and INF **Mike Cervenak**. Named an IL All-Star for the first time since 2000, Tracy paced the club in both home runs (26) and RBI (96) for the second consecutive season -- totals that ranked second in the league. In fact, his prodigious HR total was the most by a Phillies farmhand dating back to 1989. Cervenak was also named an All-Star despite suffering a broken wrist that kept him sidelined for 25 days. At season's end, his .305 batting average led the 'Pigs and ranked 9th in the IL.

IL All-Star RHP **Drew Carpenter** guided a much-improved pitching staff that collectively finished the season with a 3.80 ERA. The Vacaville, Calif., native began the season by going 7-1 with a 2.75 ERA and finished the year with a team-record 11 wins and the IL's 6th-best ERA (3.35). Carpenter also earned a rain-shortened win in his first-ever ML League start for the Phillies at Nationals Park (Washington, D.C.) on May 16.

Tracy and Carpenter were among a group of 13 IronPigs that received a promotion to Philadelphia in 2009. Four members of the '08 World Champion team -- RHP **Brett Myers**, RHP **Chad Durbin**, LHP **J.C. Romero** and C **Carlos Ruiz** -- were among a collection of six Phillies that spent time with the IronPigs on ML rehab, along with N.L. All-Star OF **Raul Ibanez** (July 7-9) and three-time Cy Young Award winner RHP **Pedro Martinez** (July 31).

IRONPIGS FINISH SECOND IN ATTENDANCE & EXCEED ELUSIVE 640,000 PLATEAU:

By virtue of 26 consecutive sell-outs, the IronPigs attendance reached 641,335 fans in 2009 -- the second-highest per-game average (9,162) in all of Minor League Baseball. The massive total represents a 6% increase over last year's overall mark (602,033) despite playing one less home game at Coca-Cola Park due to weather. Dating back to July 3, every seat at CCP has been sold for 26 consecutive games for an average of 9,795 fans per contest.

The only Minor League team to eclipse Lehigh Valley in average attendance was the Columbus Clippers (9,526), playing in the brand-new Huntington Park in downtown Columbus. The remainder of the Top 5 includes Sacramento (9,126), Pawtucket (8,937) and Louisville (8,750). Of significance, Coca-Cola Park features the smallest fixed seating capacity of any stadium in all Triple-A baseball.

IRONPIGS TO HOST 2010 TRIPLE-A ALL-STAR GAME:

Lehigh Valley will host the 2010 Triple-A All-Star Game at Coca-Cola Park, as well as the adjoining All-Star Game festivities. The 2010 Triple-A All-Star Game, which will take place July 14 and be televised to a national audience on MLB Network, is the focal point of a multi-day baseball extravaganza that will showcase the Lehigh Valley. The Triple-A All-Star Game - played annually since 1988 -- features the premier players of all 30 ML team's top affiliates as the International League and the Pacific Coast League All-Stars square off in a head-to-head contest.
