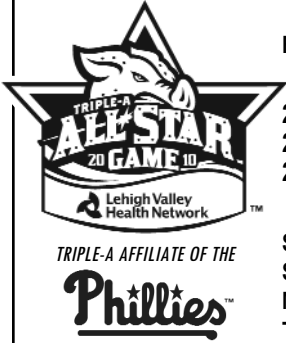

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The fifth-place IronPigs (13-20) play Game One of a four-game series at Coolray Field against the third-place (tied) Gwinnett Braves (15-18) -- Atlanta's top affiliate. With a 2-1 loss at Charlotte last night, the 'Pigs dropped the series to the Knights (16-19), 3-1; and are now 1-3 on this eight-game, South Division road trip. They've lost six of their past eight games... Gwinnett just dropped three straight to lose a home series to Pawtucket, 3-1. The Braves are just 1-6 in their past seven games following a season-high, five-game winning streak... First-pitch is at 7:05 p.m...

• Oy Vey!: The 'Pigs are now a season-high 7.5 GB in the North and back to a season-high 7 games below .500.

## WITH LAST NIGHT'S LOSS...:

• LHV failed to win back-to-back games for just the 2nd\* time in '10 (4/15-4/17...separated by a suspended game).  
 • LHV has dropped its last 2 series, 3-1 (vs. COL, @ CHA)... LHV has not yet won a series in 2010.

## \* "TWO BE, OR NOT TWO BE":

The 'Pigs have only won back-to-back games on one occasion this season, April 15-17... But technically -- due to a suspended game on April 16 -- they have yet to win two straight at any point yet this season (33 G)... Even in 2008, a year they started 2-20, they won two consecutive 4/14-15 (Games 12 & 13)... LHV did it 5x in 25 G in 2009...

• The second lowest total of "two-game win streaks" in the IL is just 4 times -- done by Pawtucket (15-19).

## 'ONE' IS THE LONELIEST...:

With a 2-1 loss last night, LHV fell to 3-12 (.200) in one-run games -- a winning PCT which ranks 13th the IL (LOU)... LHV leads the IL with 15 one-run games, the team 2nd is SWB -- which has gone 10-4 in 14 one-run games...

## TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery**, 24, is a 6-3, 235-pound lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. The native of Bellaire, TX, started 2009 with Double-A Reading -- where he was an Eastern League All-Star while going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS before a promotion on 7/31. With LHV, he went 4-2, 4.38 in 7 GS -- finishing with 16 combined wins for the season, a total tied for 2nd most in MiLB behind Donald Hume of Stockton (17). He enters the season ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

• JS is coming off back-to-back quality starts -- his first 2 QS of 2010 (0-1, 3.75, 12 ip, 15 h, 5 r, 5 er, 3 bb, 7 k).

LHP **Jo-Jo Reyes** -- currently on Atlanta's 15-Day D.L. and on a ML Rehab (right knee) -- is a 6-2, 230-pound, 25-year-old drafted by Atlanta in the 2nd round of 2003 out of Riverside Poly (CA) H.S. The Covina, CA, started 2009 with one start for Gwinnett (L, 6 ip, 4 er) before heading to Atlanta (0-2, 7.00 in 6 G, 5 GS). He finished up with Gwinnett, going 4-2, 2.86 in 15 G, 14 GS)... Reyes started 2008 with Richmond (1-1, 2.31 in 8 GS) before making it back up to Atlanta (3-11, 5.81 in 23 G, 22 GS) -- but finished with a 7-G losing streak (12 GS, 7.81 ERA)... Reyes made his ML debut on 7/7/07 vs. San Diego and went 2-2, 6.22 in 11 GS as a rookie for the Braves. Following the season, he earned the Phil Niekro Award as ATL's Minor League Pitcher of Year (12-5, 3.51 in 27 GS in Class-A).

• JR won his only game vs. LHV in '09, piggy-backing Tim Hudson in a 7-2 win 7/27 @ GWN (3.2 ip, 5 h, 2 er, hr- Tracy)

## SERIES INFORMATION:

GWN won the 2009 season series, 6-2 (took series at CF, 7/24-27)... In '08, LHV and RIC (ATL affiliate) split the series, 4-4 -- with the away team going 3-1 in both sets. LHV earned its first franchise win 4/14/08 vs. RIC after starting 0-11.

## SOUTHERN COMFORT?:

LHV is in a span of eight-straight games against the Southern Division -- starting 1-3. Last season, the 'Pigs went 16-16 vs. the South -- after going 19-13 versus the division in 2008... After starting the season with 21 G vs. the North -- going 9-12 -- LHV is in the midst of 20 straight out-of-division games...

## SAVERY WHOODINI:

LHP **Joe Savery** has been very effective his entire career in stranding baserunners... In his career, opponents have hit .233 (87-373) with runners in scoring position and just .220 (39-177) with RISP and two out...

### RICHIE RICH!

OF **Rich Thompson** went 1-for-4 last night to extend his hitting streak to a LHV season-high 11 games (.386-0-3; 17-44, 2 3B, 4 SB, 5 R)... Thompson, who started the season in a reserve role, has hit .356-0-9 (26-73) since being inserted into the starting lineup nine games into the season... OF **Mike Cervenk** owns the longest hitting streak in franchise history at 18 games, 5/16/08-6/3/08.

### TRACY SHOWING SIGNS?:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 G (9-32, .281-1-3, 3 2B, 3B, 2 BB) -- raising his AVG from .198... He has now has reached base safely in 23 of his last 26 G (he has walked a team-high 18 times)... The 36-year-old 2009 IL All-Star started last season batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G; and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G...  
 • After striking out 21 times in the first 14 G, Tracy has fanned just 9 times in his last 18 G and 69 AB...

### WORD TO THE WISE:

OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit safely in his last 6 G (9-24, .375-0-1, 6 2B, 3B, 3 R) and in 10 of his last 11 GS (16-44, .364-1-2, 9 2B, 2 3B)... He has 7 2B in his last 8 G and leads the Pigs with 19 extra basehits (11 2B, 5 3B, 3 HR).

### THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP:

Even with the QS loss on Monday, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 2-1, 1.53 ERA in his last 3 GS (17.2 ip, 4 r, 3 er) and has reclaimed the top spot as the 'Pigs all-time career wins leader with 14... He had started 1-2, 7.15 in his first 3 GS.

### DO THE MATH!

RHP **Scott Mathieson** -- now 5-for-5 in save opportunities -- has not allowed a R or a BB in his last 8 G (9.0 ip, 6 h, 13 k)... He started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... and has allowed just 1 R in his first 13 G (16.2 ip, 5-5 in SV opps)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of '10 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR).

### NATE THE GREAT!

In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- former Marlin **Nate Bump** is now an impressive 11-2, 2.43 in 17 GS (111 ip, 30 er).

### WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

INF **Melvin Dorta** has hit safely in 10 of his 14 G (13-41, .317-0-5, 7 R, 3 BB)... In his last 3 G, C **Paul Hoover** is 4-10, 2 2B, 3B... OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 18 of 26 G and is batting 9-20 (.450-0-14) w/ RISP... LHP **Antonio Bastardo** in unscored upon in 5 G (3.2 IP).

• *Catching Offense:* LHV catchers Hoover & Sardinha have combined to bat .274-4-18 (32-117, 4 2B) this season.

### HE WHO LAUGHS FIRST LAUGHS LAST?:

LHV has jumped on the board first in 20 of their first 33 G (60.6%) -- 2nd in the IL behind Indianapolis (22 x)... The 'Pigs have gone 11-9\* (.550) in those games... However, the 'Pigs have blown leads in 11 of their 20 losses (55.0%).

\* By going just 11-9 when scoring first, LHV is 13th in the IL in win% (.550; ROC is .500) in those G...

### THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

LHV is now 13-20 despite 6th in AVG (.261); 7th in R (151) and 6th in ERA (3.91) and...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 151-142... a +9 run differential.
- LHV is batting .279 with Runners in Scoring Position and holding opponents to .237 w/ RISP
- LHV has scored first in 20 of the 33 games (60.6%)... going just 11-9 in those games
- LHV has lost 20 games by a total of 42 R (12, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 3, 3-run G; 4, 4+)... LHV is just 2-12 in 1-R G

### .500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in **321** games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of **421** games (2 years, 11 months, 20 days)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 171-247.

### APRIL SHOWERS BRING...???:

LHV is now 4-8 in May... After starting 9-12, LHV is just 21-47 (.309) lifetime in April... LHV has gone 30-41 (.423) in May.

### WONDERFUL WEDNESDAY NIGHT:

With their 6-5 win on 5/12 @ CHA, the Pigs tied their largest come-from-behind win in franchise history (4) when they erased a 5-1 deficit through 7 innings -- a feat they've accomplished 4 times now (last: 7/11/09 @ ROC).

- The win marked their 2nd come-from-behind win when trailing after 8 innings in 2010; and the 7th time in LHV history (7-152)... They only accomplished that feat once in all of '09, when they finished 1-77 when training after 8.
- The Grand Slam by OF **John Mayberry** was the Pigs 1st of the season and 6th all-time... It was also the 2nd they've hit in Charlotte, as OF **Jon Knott** hit a Grand Slam in the 3rd inning 6/19/08 against RHP **Jack Egbert**.
- The Pigs snapped a three-game losing streak, and still have not lost more since a 5-G skid, 8/15-8/20/09.

### MAY DAY! MAY DAY!:

Welcome back to OF **John Mayberry**, who had missed 4 straight games with a swollen foot -- and returned Wednesday with the dramatic 9th-inning, game-winning Grand Slam... In the 5 games they've played without Mayberry this season, the 'Pigs have gone just 1-4 and averaged just 3.2 R/G without him (4.8 R/G with him).
