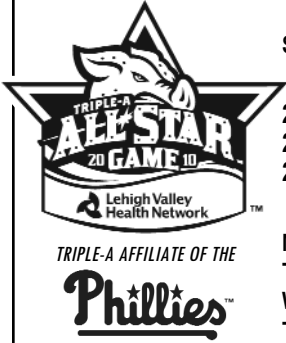

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The sixth-place IronPigs (18-30) play the finale of a four-game series at Huntington Park against the first-place Columbus Clippers (31-19) -- the Cleveland's top affiliate. With a 7-5 loss last night, the 'Pigs have tied their season-long three-game losing streak -- starting 0-3 on this eight-game, West Division road trip. Lehigh Valley has now gone just 7-16 in its last 23 affairs... Columbus has won seven of its last 10 and has taken five consecutive matchups against the Pigs. Once 22-11, the Clippers are now 9-8 in their last 17 games...

- First-Pitch tonight is at 5:05 p.m... Next up is a four-game series in Toledo (27-22) starting Monday at 5:00 p.m.
- *Go West, Young Men:* LHV is 0-3 on its first West road trip of '10 and has started the season 4-11 vs. the West.
- *Oy Vey!* The 'Pigs are now a season-high 12 games below .500 and a season-high 11.5 GB in the North.
- *Last Laugh:* The 'Pigs have gone 7-4 in series finales (one suspended; one postponed)... 11-26 in all others...

LOW TIDE:

• The 'Pigs have fallen to a new low-water mark of 12 games below .500 in 2010 -- tying their low-water mark of 2009 -- from 6/9/09... The 'Pigs haven't been 13 games below since they ended the 2008 season at 55-89.

WITH A WIN TONIGHT, THE PIGS WILL...:

- Avoid losing 4 consecutive games for the first time this season and for the first time since a 5-G skid, 8/15-8/20/09... they're just 1 of 6 teams in the I.L. not to have lost more than 3 consecutive (BUF, IND, SYR, SWB, TOL).
- Being swept in a series for the first time this season and the first time since 8/29-8/30/09 @ SYR (a 3-G series) and for the first time in a 4-G series since 6/6-6/9/09 @ LOU -- 24, 4-game series ago!
- Avoid a new low-water mark of 13-G below .500 -- and potentially falling a season-high 11.5 GB in the North
- Win for the first-time in Huntington Park. LHV was swept in 4 G here last season; they're 0-7 w/ 2 walk-off losses.

HOMECOMING KING:

1B **Andy Tracy**, who lives in Columbus, has had a terrific start to his 'homecoming series." Playing for his first time 5/15, Tracy has gone 6-11 with 3 HR (one a Grand Slam), 9 RBI, 3 R and a 3 BB -- including a franchise-record 6 RBI on Friday night and tying his own record with 2 HR in a game (he's done it 5 of the 7x in LHV history)... Traditionally a slow starter, the Bowling Green alum has hit in 10 of his last 13 G (15-47, .319-4-12, 3 2B)... raising his average from .198 (5/4) to .241.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery**, 24, is a 6-3, 235-pound lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. The native of Bellaire, TX, started 2009 with Double-A Reading -- where he was an Eastern League All-Star while going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS before a promotion on 7/31. With LHV, he went 4-2, 4.38 in 7 GS -- finishing with 16 combined wins for the season, a total tied for 2nd most in MiLB behind Donald Hume of Stockton (17). He enters the season ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

- *After starting '09 at 0-1, 4.50 in 3 GS, JS won 12 consecutive decisions from 4/28-7/9/09 in a span of 15 GS.*
- *JS is coming off 5 straight quality starts -- his first 5 QS of 2010 (1-3, 3.60, 30 ip, 12 er)... He started 0-1, 6.00.*

RHP **Yohan Pino**, 26, is a 6-0, 190-pounder who was signed acquired by Cleveland from Minnesota for RHP Carl Pavano, 9/1/09. He was originally signed by the Twins as a non-drafted free agent 5/12/04 out of Venezuela... Pino started 2009 in Double-A New Britain (5-1, 3.19 in 32 G, 4 GS) before a promotion to Rochester on 7/20. He went 2-2, 2.82 in 8 GS for Rochester then 2-0, 1.29 in 2 GS for Columbus after the trade -- finishing 4-2, 2.49 in 10 IL starts... After the season, pitched for Aragua in the Venezuelan Winter League and went 3-3, 3.65... Pino missed a chunk of 2008 when he was on the D.L. 5/16-7/3/08 (right shoulder strain), but finished 7-7, 4.54 in 26 G, 18 GS in Double-A New Britain... Pino began his pro career 10-1, 0.53 in the DSL in 2004 then led his league in wins in both 2005 (Appy League, 9-2, 3.72 with Rookie Elizabethton) and 2006 (Midwest, 14-2, 1.91 with Low-A Beloit).

- **HE'S A WINNER!** In all, YP boosts a career MiLB winning percentage of .714 (60-24 in 172 G, 89 GS).
- **YP vs. LHV in 2009:** 0-0, 5.40 in 1 GS (5.0 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 3 er, 2 bb, 3 k, .200) -- a 7-4 LHV win on 8/4 @ ROC
- After starting 4-0, 3.68, YP lost his first 5/8 @ LHV (5.1 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 6 k) and is 1-2, 6.20 in last 4 G.

SAVERY WHOODINI:

LHP **Joe Savery** has been very effective his entire career in stranding baserunners... In his career, opponents have hit .234 (93-397) with runners in scoring position and just .214 (40-187) with RISP and two out...

SERIES INFORMATION:

COL leads the season-series, 6-1... COL won the '09 series, 6-2 (swept LHV at Huntington Park, 5/12-15)... The teams split the '08 series, 4-4 -- but that was when COL was w/ WAS. LHV and BUF (CLE's '08 affiliate) split in '08, 8-8.

YE WHO LAUGHS FIRST, LAUGHS BEST?:

LHV has scored first in all 3 games of this series, but is 0-3... The 'Pigs lead the IL in games in which they score first (27), but they've gone just 13-14 (.481) in those games -- for the 2nd worst winning PCT (ROC: 8-9, .471).

- After LHV and ROC, *the next worse winning PCT when scoring first is .600 (PAW is 12-18)!*

NOT POPPING IN THE CLUTCH:

Once batting .312 w/ RISP as a team through 5/2 (23 G), the Pigs are just 40-199 (.201) in the last 25 G -- dropping to .258 for the season... They were 0-4 last night... and in the 11-7 loss Friday, the Pigs went 2-11 w/ RISP.

'ONE' IS THE LONELIEST...:

With the 3-2 loss Thursday, LHV fell to 5-15 (.250) in one-run games -- a winning PCT which ranks 13th in the IL (LOU, .231)... LHV in 1st in the IL w/ 20 one-run games; 2nd is SWB -- which is 15-4 in 19 one-run games!... in 2009, the team that has the worst such win% was Columbus as .395 (17-26)...

- LHV has lost 29 games by a total of 63 R (15, 1-run G; 2, 2-run G; 6, 3-run G; 5, 4+)... LHV is just 5-15 in 1-R G

PITCHING FITS!:

• Red hot prior to the COL series, the LHV staff has allowed 18 ER in 16 IP (10.13 ERA) in the last 2 G... Still... LHV's staff ranks 5th in the IL in ERA (3.72)... Ranked 8th in 5/2, the staff has a 3.40 (224.2 ip, 85 er) in the last 24 G.

- In the last 12 GS, Pigs starters are 4-4 with a more impressive 3.00 ERA (66.0 ip, 22 er) with 7 QS.
- Over the past 18 G, the bullpen has combined to go 2-3, 4 SV, 2.83 ERA (63.2 ip, 20 er).

OFFENSIVE WOES:

In 19 G since May 10 (leaving for previous road trip), LHV has only averaged 3.3 R/G (63/19) after averaging 4.9 R/G in the first 29 G. In addition:

- LHV has batted just .214 (141-659) -- dropping from .268 (6th) as a team to .246 (a season-low 11th).
- LHV has batted just .193 (27-140) with RISP* -- dropping from .291 to .258 overall

ENORMOUS ERRORS:

After going 58.0 consecutive innings w/o an E (5/10-5/17), LHV has committed 12 errors in the last 11 G -- leading to 11 u/e R. *In fact, this includes the game-winning runs in 3 of their last 6 losses!*

APRIL SHOWERS BRING...???:

LHV's now 9-18 in May... After starting 9-12, LHV is just 21-47 (.309) lifetime in April... LHV has gone 35-51 (.407) in May.

THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP:

With Tuesday's win, RHP **Drew Carpenter** is 4-2, 2.58 ERA in his last 6 GS (38.1 ip, 12 r, 11 er) and in back as the 'Pigs all-time career wins leader (16), two ahead of Brian Mazzone (14)... He started 1-2, 7.15 in his first 3 GS...

DO THE MATH!:

RHP **Scott Mathieson** -- now 8-for-8 in save opportunities -- has not allowed a R in his last 8.0 IP (5+ G.. 0-0, 3 SV)... and has allowed just 1 R in his last 14 G (17.0 ip, 10 h, 3, BB, 23 k)... Previously, he had an 8-G, 9.0-IP scoreless streak -- during which time he issued 0 BB -- and also started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of '10 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR).

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **John Mayberry** has hit safely in his last 6 G (10-26, .385-2-3; 4 m-h G)... INF **Neil Sellers** has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 G (11-22, .500-0-5, 4 2B) and in 10 of 12 (15-45, .333-0-5, 5 2B)... INF **Melvin Dorta** has hit in 5 of his last 8 G (6-18, .333-1-3, 2B, 3B)... OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit in 13 of his last 17 GS (20-67, .299-2-3, 9 2B, 2 3B)...

In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.), RHP **Nate Bump** is 11-4, 2.72 in 20 GS (129 ip, 39 er)... RHP **Ryan Vogelsong** has allowed just 1 R in 4 G since moving to pen (0-0, 1.13, 8.0 ip)... RHP **Alex Concepcion** has been unscored upon in 4 of 5 G since off DL (5.0 ip, 5 h, r, er, 0 bb, 4 k)... LHP **Mike Zagurski** has not allowed an ER in his last 10 G (0-2, 2 H, 0.00, 11.2 ip, 6 h, 4 r, 5 bb, 15 k). Z leads IL relievers in K/9 at 13.5 (32 K in 21.1 IP)...

500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in **336** games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of **436** games (3 years, 0 months, 6 days)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 176-258.
