TODAY'S GAME:

The fourth-place IronPigs (12-16) play the finale of a four-game series (and eight-game home stand) against the West's first-place Columbus Clippers (19-11) -- Cleveland's top affiliate. With a 5-3 win last night, the 'Pigs snapped a two-game skid and improved to 3-4 on the home stand... The Indians are still an impressive 8-3 in their last 11 contests. They remain tied with Durham for the IL's top record... Following today's game, the Pigs begin an eight-game South Division road trip Monday, with four-game series at both Charlotte (13-17) and Gwinnett (14-15).

- First-pitch is at 1:35 p.m. for Pink Visor Giveaway Day, presented by **Deb & Joe Corcoran**.
- *Night Owls?*: In franchise history, the 'Pigs are just 22-41 (.349) when playing during daylight hours (4-7 in '10).

WITH A WIN TODAY, THE IRONPIGS WILL...:

- Win two straight games for the 2nd time this season (although technically, they have not done that yet in 2010)*
- Avoid losing their first four-game series at home in '10... The last one LHV dropped was 8/10-8/13 vs. LOU (3-1).
- Finish the home stand at .500... And also improve to .500 at home in 2010 (8-8)...

* "TWO BE, OR NOT TWO BE":

The 'Pigs have only won back-to-back games on one occasion this season, April 15-17... But technically -- due to a suspended game on April 16 -- they have yet to win two straight at any point yet this season (28 G)... Even in 2008, a year they started 2-20, they won two consecutive 4/14-15 (Games 12 & 13)... LHV did it 5x in 25 G in 2009...

- The second lowest total of "two-game win streaks" in the IL is just 2 times -- done by Pawtucket (11-18).

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

LHP **Joe Savery**, 24, is a 6-3, 235-pound lefty drafted by Philadelphia in the first round (19th overall) in 2007 out of Rice University -- where he finished his standout career first-team All-America as a two-way player and earned his 2nd conference Player-of-the-Year award in three seasons. The native of Bellaire, TX, started 2009 with Double-A Reading -- where he was an Eastern League All-Star while going 12-4, 4.41 in 21 G, 20 GS before a promotion on 7/31. With LHV, he went 4-2, 4.38 in 7 GS -- finishing with 16 combined wins for the season, a total tied for 2nd most in MiLB behind Donald Hume of Stockton (17). He enters the season ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

RHP **Carlos Carrasco** -- a former IronPig and member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 215-pound 23-year-old signed acquired by Cleveland with INF Jason Donald, C Lou Marson and LHP Jason Knapp from Philadelphia for LHP Cliff Lee and OF Ben Francisco, 7/29/09... He was originally signed by Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela on 10/25/03 (at age 16 for \$300,000)... Carrasco started 2009 with LHV (6-9, 5.18 in 20 GS) and was assigned to Columbus following the trade (5-1, 3.19 in 6 GS) -- defeating the Pigs and his childhood idol Pedro Martinez at Coca-Cola Park in his Clipper debut, 7/31 (5.1 ip, 8 h, 4 er, bb, 6 k). He combined to go 11-10, 4.64 in 26 IL starts 148 K (1st in IL) before a promotion to Cleveland, 9/1... Made his ML debut 9/1 at DET (L, 3 ip, 9 h, 6 r, 6 er, 3 bb, 3 k) and wound up 0-4, 8.87 in 5 GS in MLB... In 2008, Carrasco flourished in his Triple-A debut with the 'Pigs after his promotion on 8/2/08 -- going 2-2, 1.72 in 6 GS (went 7-7, 4.32 in 20 G with Reading)... In '07, Carrasco was a Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Clearwater prior to a 6/20 promotion to Reading -- where he threw a rain-shortened 6-inning no-hitter 8/21/07 vs. Altoona (2 bb, 8 k)... In '06, captured the Paul Owens Award, awarded to the top pitcher in the system, while helping guide Lakewood to a SAL Championship... Named to the World Team of the All-Star Futures game 3 times (2006-08) and was the starting and winning pitcher (1.0 ip, 2 k) in '08 at Yankee Stadium on 7/13.

- Carrasco is rated as the #8 Prospect in the system by *Baseball America* (#2 in 2009 after #1 in both '07 & '08).
- Carrasco started his IL career by going 2-3, 1.94 (55.2 ip, 12 er, 2 wins blown by pen) in his first 11 GS (2008-09).

SERIES INFORMATION:

COL leads the season-series, 2-1... COL won the '09 series, 6-2 (swept LHV at Huntington Park, 5/12-15)... The teams split the '08 series, 4-4 -- but that was when COL was w/ WAS. LHV and BUF (CLE's '08 affiliate) split in '08, 8-8.

- This marks the return of **Jason Donald** (.236-1-16, 51 G in '09) & **Carlos Carrasco** (7-11, 4.34, 26 GS in '08-09)
- *Shellin'*: **Shelley Duncan** is .333-6-29* (31-93) career vs. LHV -- w/ the most RBI vs. LHV than any other opponent.

NATE THE GREAT!:

In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- former Marlin **Nate Bump** is now an impressive 11-2, 2.51 in 16 GS (104 ip, 29 er).

SAVERY WHOODINI:

LHP **Joe Savery** has been very effective his entire career in stranding baserunners... In his career, opponents have hit .234 (86-368) with runners in scoring position and just .224 (39-174) with RISP and two out...

APRIL SHOWERS BRING...:

LHV is now 3-4 in May... After starting 9-12, LHV is just 21-47 (.309) lifetime in April... LHV has gone 29-37 (.439) in May.

GO WEST, YOUNG MEN!:

After starting the season with 21 G vs. the North -- going 9-12 -- LHV is in the midst of eight straight vs. West Division teams (3-4); and 20 straight out-of-division games... A year ago, the 'Pigs were 13-19 vs. the West.

HE WHO LAUGHS FIRST LAUGHS LAST?:

LHV has jumped on the board first in 19 of their first 28 G (67.9%) -- 2nd in the IL behind Indianapolis (20 x)... The 'Pigs have gone 10-9* (.526) in those games... However, the 'Pigs have blown leads in 11 of their 16 losses (68.8%).
* By going just 10-9 when scoring first, LHV is 12th in the IL in win% (.526) in those G... IL is 141-63 (.691).

THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

LHV is now 12-16 despite 6th in AVG (.269); 4th in R (138) and 5th in ERA (4.04) and...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 133-123... Their +12 run differential ranks 6th in the I.L...
- LHV is batting .299 with Runners in Scoring Position (opponents are at .254)
- LHV has scored first in 19 of the 28 games (67.9%)... going just 10-9 in those games
- LHV has lost 16 games by a total of 38 R (8, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 3, 3-run G; 4, 4+)... LHV is just 2-8 in 1-run G

A KING'S RANSOM:

3B **Cody Ransom** hit the game-winning 3-run HR for LHV on Tue. and a 2-R shot Wed... He's now hit safely in the last 8 G (9-28, .321-3-6, 3 2B) and in 14* of his last 15 G (18-58, .310-4-12, 5 2B)... *ejected in 5th 0-3 on 4/29...
 **Cody Clutch*: 8 of his 14 (57.1%) PA that have produced RBI have either either tied the game or put LHV ahead.

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

2B **Luis Maza** has hit in 9 of his last 11 G (14-44, .318-0-3, 6 R) and in 10 of 13 G (18-50, .360-0-6)... INF **Melvin Dorta** has hit safely in 9 of his 11 games (12-34, .353-0-4, 7 R, 2 BB)... OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit in 5 of his last 6 GS (9-24, .375-1-2, 5 2B, 3B) and, in his last 10 G, is batting .343-1-2 (12-35, 5 2B, 2 3B)... In his last 3 G, C **Paul Hoover** is 4-10, 2 2B, 3B... OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 16 of 22 G and is batting 9-18 (.500-0-14) with RISP...
 * *Catching Offense*: LHV catchers (Hoover, Sardinha) have combined to bat .279-3-17 (29-104, 4 2B) this season.

DO THE MATH!:

RHP **Scott Mathieson** -- now 5-for-5 in save opportunities -- has not allowed a R or a BB in his last 7 G (7.0 ip, 5 h, 11 k)... He started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... and has allowed just 1 R in his first 12 G (14.2 ip, 5-5 in SV opps)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of '10 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR).

TRACY SHOWING SIGNS?:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (5-19, .263, 3 2B, 3B) and now has reached base safely in 19 of his last 21 G (he has walked a team-high 17 times)... The 36-year-old 2009 IL All-Star started last season batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G; and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G...
 * After striking out 21 times in the first 14 G, Tracy has fanned just 4 times in his last 13 G and 48 AB...

THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has won his last 2 GS (2-0, 0.82, 11 ip, 1 r, e er) and has reclaimed the top spot as the 'Pigs all-time career wins leader with 14... He had started 1-2, 7.15 in his first 3 GS.

.500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in **316** games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of **416** games (2 years, 11 months, 15 days)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 170-245.

BACON BITS:

- Clipper Stoppers*: So far in this series, the COL bullpen is a near perfect 1-0, SV, 0.00 ERA (8.2 ip, 7 h, 1 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 7 k).
- Bombs Away*: LHV's 4 HR on Thu. tied a franchise record (6/16/09 @ DUR) and was their top career total at CCP... OF **Chris Duffy** had 2 of the HR last night, becoming the 1st Pigs to HR twice in a game in '10 (6th time in LHV history).
- Still No Shutouts*: LHV has yet to be blanked through the first 28 G of '10... In 2008, they were blanked in G1 (4-0 @ SWB). In 2009, it took til G11 (2-0 @ PAW).
