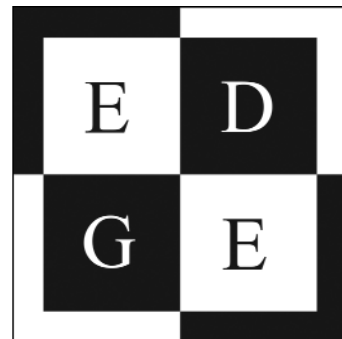

## TODAY'S GAME:

The Lehigh Valley IronPigs (0-10) and the reigning International League Champion Richmond Braves (7-2) -- who are currently in first place in the South Division -- play Game Three of their four-game series.

- The IronPigs' 0-10 start is the slowest in International League history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The IronPigs' nine-game skid is the longest losing streak for the Phillies Triple-A affiliate in the last five seasons (Ottawa lost a season-high eight straight games 7/23-7/28 last season, Scranton-Wilkes Barre lost seven straight to end the 2004 season). Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has lost 13 consecutive games and 10 straight on the road.

- First-Pitch tonight is scheduled for 1:35 p.m. with gates opening at 12:30 p.m.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **J.A. Happ** (who goes by 'J'), is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of the 2004 draft out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. The 25-year-old spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only Major League start 6/7/07 vs. NY-N (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland.

LHP\* **Jo-Jo Reyes**, 23, is a 6-2, 230-pound, southpaw drafted by Atlanta in the 2nd round of the 2003 draft. The Covina, CA native had a stellar 2007 campaign that included an 11-game stint with the Atlanta Braves. The youngster opened the season with Mississippi (AA) and went 8-1 with a 3.56 ERA prior to a promotion to Triple-A on 6/9. He made his Major League debut on 7/7 vs. San Diego. In total, he went 2-2 with a 6.22 ERA (50.2 ip, 55 h, 39 r, 35 er, 30 bb, 27 k) in 11 games and starts for the Braves. Following the campaign he earned the Phil Niekro Award as Atlanta's Minor League Pitcher of the Year. In 2006, Reyes led all Braves Minor Leaguers with 12 wins and 142 strikeouts pitching in both Rome (A) and Myrtle Beach (High-A)

\**Southpaw Struggles:* The IronPigs are only batting .152 (16-105) w/ a .219 OBP and .219 SLG vs. LHP this season.

## SERIES STUFF:

RIC leads the season series, 2-0... The Braves won the 2007 series, 7-1, going 1-2 on the road and 5-0 at home at The Diamond in Richmond.

## TRANSACTIONS:

Today, OF **Chris Snelling** was promoted to the Philadelphia Phillies and OF **Mike Spidale** was assigned to Reading (AA). In 6 G with the R-Phils, Spidale batted .375-0-0 (6-16, 2B, R, BB, 3 K, 3 SB).

## WHO'S HOT:

LHP **Travis Blackley** had a personal Triple-A career-high with 9 K on Monday night... RHP **Ron Chiavacci** has a scoreless innings streak of 10.1 IP and ranks 7th in the IL with a 0.79 ERA...

## STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have been shutout in 3 of 10 G this season (last season OTT was shutout for the 3rd time on 4/30, Game 19) and they've scored just 14 R in 10 G, an average of 1.4/G. The next worst total (Columbus & Syracuse) is 31 -- more than 2.5x the total of LHV. The IronPigs are last in the IL in AVG (.182) and the team is batting just .113 (6-53) with RISP; and .155 (18-116) with runners on base. The 4th hitters in the LHV lineup have 0 RBI and are batting just .108 (4-37).

## MORE TEAM NOTES

### BACON BITS:

- The IronPigs broke a 13.2 inning home scoreless streak with a pair of two-out runs in the fifth inning last night.
- *Home is Where the Wins Are?*: Last season, Ottawa started 2-5 on their season-opening road trip -- but came home to win three in a row and six of their next seven games.
- *No Worries!*: The IronPigs have started 0-10 as manager **Dave Huppert** looks to win his third consecutive league title. In 2005, his South Atlantic League Champion Lakewood BlueClaws started the season 0-9! Even though the SAL plays two separates halves, the BlueClaws finished the first half at 37-32 and wound up 84-55 for the season.
- *Pork Power*: With another HR on Thursday (Jason Jaramillo), the LHV has 5 HR this season. Ottawa had just 1 in their first 27 G in 2007.
- *Schedule Scam?*: The IronPigs first four series of the season feature 3 playoff teams from 2007 (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Richmond and Toledo). Including Pawtucket, the teams combined to go 310-259 last season.

### ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

### WHO'S NEW:

The revamped lineup. A year after Ottawa finished last in the IL in runs scored, the IronPigs team only features only three returning position players from the Lynx squad -- and these three all finished with a higher batting average than the team total (.267): C **Jason Jaramillo** (.271), 3B **Brennan King** (.277) and SS **Gookie Dawkins** (.274). Pitching-wise, nine of the 12 staff members spent time in Ottawa a year ago

### PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

### FAMILIAR FACES:

It is quite possible that early in the season, the IronPigs could post a starting lineup that features eight starters that have appeared in the IL -- but with different Major League affiliates: C **Pete LaForest** (Durham 2002-05), 1B **Andy Tracy** (Ottawa 2000-01, 2006; Norfolk 2002), 2B **Chris Woodward** (Syracuse 1998-2001); SS **Gookie Dawkins** (Louisville 2002; Toledo 2005; Indianapolis 2007), 3B **Mike Cervenak** (Norfolk 2007); OF **Brandon Watson** (Louisville 2006; Columbus 2007); OF **T.J. Bohn** (Richmond 2007) and starting RHP **Ron Chiavacci** (Indianapolis 2005-06; Toledo 2007). In addition, it is possible the save could also come from a non-Phillie IL veteran: as late-inning relievers RHP **John Ennis** previously pitched for Richmond (2003) and Toledo (2003-06) and RHP **Matt Childers** pitched for Indianapolis (2002-04), Richmond (2005) and Columbus (2006).

### TOP PROSPECTS:

25-year-old C **Jason Jaramillo** is among Philadelphia' top 10 prospects according to *Baseball America*. The 2nd-round pick from 2004 hit .271 last year for Ottawa and earned a trip to the Triple-A All-Star Game. He also played well for the United States team at the 2007 World Cup...LHP **J.A. Happ** was 4-6 with a 5.02 ERA in 24 starts for Ottawa last season. It was the first time in his four-year career his ERA was over 2.81...25-year-old RHP **Joe Bisenius** went 3-4 with a 5.48 ERA in his first season at the Triple-A level in 2007. One year earlier he combined to go 8-3 with a 2.25 ERA in 51 games between Class-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading.

### THREE-PEAT:

IronPigs manager **Dave Huppert** comes to Allentown after winning back-to-back league championships. The 50-year-old piloted the 2007 Clearwater Threshers to an 83-57 record and a Florida State League (Advanced-A) title after guiding the 2006 Lakewood Blue Claws to an 84-55 record and a South Atlantic League (Low-A) title. Taking it back farther, Huppert led his team to the post-season in three of his previous four managerial stints including a FSL Co-Championship with Brevard County in 2001. The native of South Gate, Calif., has posted a 1,425-1,214 (.540) career record.

### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
