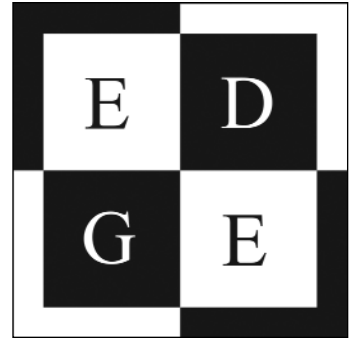

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (1-11) finally found the win column for the first time in franchise history with a 3-1 defeat of the Richmond Braves (8-3) in the series finale last night. Now the IronPigs will look for their first winning streak when the Toledo Mud Hens (7-4) come to town for a four-game set. The Mud Hens were the 2007 West Division Champs.

- With last night's win, there are no more winless teams in MILB (South Bend won two after starting 0-9). The win also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate. The 0-11 start was the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). It was also the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.
- First-Pitch tonight is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 5:50 p.m. (5:30 p.m. for the Club Level).

LHP **Brian Mazone**, 31, is a 6-4, 200-pound left-hander who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/7/07. Mazone actually started 2007 as a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training with the Phillies after leading the International League in ERA (2.03) as a Red Baron in 2006. But after getting off to a fast start with Ottawa (3-2, 2.21 in 6 GS), he had his contract sold to the Samsung Lions of the Korean League on 5/9/07. He finished in Korea by going 7-11 with a 4.18 ERA in 24 GS (125 ip, 130 h, 61 r, 58 er, 45 bb, 76 k).

- Mazone did not face TOL in 2007.

LHP **Jon Connolly**, 24, is a 6-0, 205-pound, southpaw from Oneonta, N.Y., originally selected by Detroit in the 28th round of the 2001 draft. He started the season in Erie (AA) after spending a bulk of 2007 there, going 7-7, 4.58 ERA in 21 G, 19 GS. He went up and down between Erie and Toledo twice and went 1-1, 3.91 ERA in 4 GS with the MudHens last season -- which included a one-hit shutout out (7 IP) of Louisville on 5/17. Connolly spent two seasons in the Cubs organization after a trade on 4/29/04. He signed back with Detroit after being released 3/31/06 (he also had one appearance with independent Nashua in between). In 2003, he was a Midwest League All-Star (mid- and post-season), going 16-3, 1.41 ERA with West Michigan...and a 2004 Florida State League All-Star with Daytona (9-5, 2.40).

- Connolly went 0-1, 6.35 ERA in 1 GS vs. OTT in 2007 (5.2 ip, 9 h, 4 r, 4 er, bb, k).

SERIES STUFF:

Toledo won the 2007 series against OTT, 5-3. The Mud Hens went 3-1 on the road against the Lynx last season.

MORE TRANSACTIONS:

Today, the IronPigs received LHP **Steve Kline**, who was signed by Philadelphia as a minor league FA on 4/11 after being released by San Francisco on 4/4 (he was designated 3/29). To make room, RHP **Joe Bisenius** was placed on the D.L. (left toe). Kline, 35, who grew up a Phillies fan in nearby Lewisburg, PA, ranks 11th in MLB history with career appearances by a left-hander (796) and tied for 40th on the all-time list (leads MLB with 750 outings since '98).

THE KEY-AVACCI

Last night, RHP **Ron Chiavacci** became the first IronPigs player to record a victory (6.0 ip, 3 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 8 k). The 30-year-old Scranton native is now 2nd in the IL in ERA (0.52) and he currently holds a 16.1 scoreless IP streak. He also has recorded the only two 'quality starts' by the IronPigs pitching staff this season.

BACON BITS, PT. I:

- The save by RHP **Matt Childers** last night was the first in LHV history and his first since 8/25/06 @ DUR (61 G ago).
- *Not Seeing Double*: The IronPigs pitching staff has yet to allow a double-digit hit total in '08 (0 for the offense, as well).
- *Ready to Sacrifice*: The 2 SAC-FLYs by the IronPigs last night (King, Smith) were their first two of the season.
- *Lack 'o Runs*: LHV has managed just 19 R in 12 G (1.6/G) -- but that is not the lowest total thus far in MILB. Wisconsin (Midwest) has just 15 R (they've only played 8 G, avg of 1.9/G). The next lowest total is 27 R by New Hampshire (Eastern) with 27 R (12 G, avg of 2.3/G). By comparison, Salt Lake (PCL) has 99 R in 12 G (8.3 R/G).

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT. II:

- *Diet Coke Park?*: After clubbing 5 HR in 8 G on the road trip, the IronPigs are still looking for their first HR at Coca-Cola Park.
- *K.O. KING: J.A. Happ* is tied for the IL lead with 21 K (David Purcey, SYR) after fanning 9 men in each of his last 2 GS.
- *Taketh then Giveth*: Barring their run in a top of the 9th run 4/6 @ SWB (there was no B9), the IronPigs have allowed opponents to score in their very next at-bat in 7 of the 13 innings (54%) they've scored.
- *LOB PROB*: The IronPigs have left 74 (9.3/G) men on base in the last 8 G. For the season, they have 93 LOB as compared to opponent's 83 LOB.
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: The IronPigs bullpen has stranded just 6 of 19 (31.5%) inherited runners to score. Meanwhile, their opponents have stranded 19-21 (90.4%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 until **Gookie Dawkins'** two-run double Sunday.
- *No Worries!*: The IronPigs have started 0-11 as manager **Dave Huppert** looks to win his third consecutive league title. In 2005, his South Atlantic League Champion Lakewood BlueClaws started the season 0-9! Even though the SAL plays two separates halves, the BlueClaws finished the first half at 37-32 and wound up 84-55 for the season.
- *Schedule Scam?*: The IronPigs first four series of the season feature 3 playoff teams from 2007 (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Richmond and Toledo). Including Pawtucket, the teams combined to go 310-259 last season.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have been shutout in 3 of 12 G this season (last season OTT was shutout for the 3rd time on 4/30, Game 19) and they've scored just 19 R in 12 G, an average of 1.6/G. The next worst total in the IL is 38 (Columbus & Rochester) -- twice the total of LHV. The IronPigs are last in the IL in AVG (.185) and the team is batting just .115 (9-78) with RISP; and .145 (22-152) with runners on base. The 4th hitters in the LHV lineup have 0 HR and 1 RBI (0 in first 11 G) in the 12 G and are batting just .133-0-1 (6-45).

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

FAMILIAR FACES:

It is quite possible that early in the season, the IronPigs could post a starting lineup that features eight starters that have appeared in the IL -- but with different Major League affiliates: C **Pete LaForest** (Durham 2002-05), 1B **Andy Tracy** (Ottawa 2000-01, 2006; Norfolk 2002), 2B **Chris Woodward** (Syracuse 1998-2001); SS **Gookie Dawkins** (Louisville 2002; Toledo 2005; Indianapolis 2007), 3B **Mike Cervenak** (Norfolk 2007); OF **Brandon Watson** (Louisville 2006; Columbus 2007); OF **T.J. Bohn** (Richmond 2007) and starting RHP **Ron Chiavacci** (Indianapolis 2005-06; Toledo 2007). In addition, it is possible the save could also come from a non-Phillie IL veteran: as late-inning relievers RHP **John Ennis** previously pitched for Richmond (2003) and Toledo (2003-06) and RHP **Matt Childers** pitched for Indianapolis (2002-04), Richmond (2005) and Columbus (2006).

THREE-PEAT:

IronPigs manager **Dave Huppert** comes to Allentown after winning back-to-back league championships. The 50-year-old piloted the 2007 Clearwater Threshers to an 83-57 record and a Florida State League (Advanced-A) title after guiding the 2006 Lakewood Blue Claws to an 84-55 record and a South Atlantic League (Low-A) title. Taking it back farther, Huppert led his team to the post-season in three of his previous four managerial stints including a FSL Co-Championship with Brevard County in 2001. The native of South Gate, Calif., has posted a 1,425-1,214 (.540) career record.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other profession-

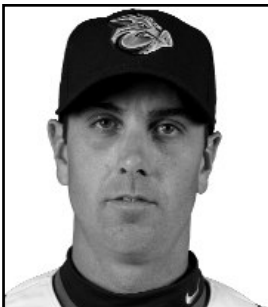
