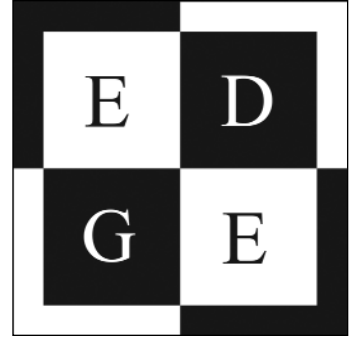

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (2-14) open up a seven-game road trip starting tonight with North Division foe Syracuse (9-7). With their 8-3 loss to Toledo (10-5) last night, the IronPigs have dropped three in a row and finished their inaugural home-stand at just 2-6 (dropped three-of-four to both Richmond and Toledo). Meanwhile, the Chiefs -- who just swept the Bisons in Buffalo, have won four in a row and six of seven games since starting the season at 3-6.

- *Road Woes:* Lehigh Valley is 0-8 on the road this season. Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has lost 10 straight road games and gone 2-15 in its last 17 games as visitors.
- First-Pitch is scheduled for 6:00 p.m.

RHP **Ron Chiavacci**, 30, is a 6-0, 175-pound right-hander out of nearby Scranton, Pa., who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 11/20/07. An anchor of Western Division Champion Toledo's rotation, Chiavacci finished the 2007 season 3rd in the I.L. in wins (12), 4th in strikeouts (126) and 5th in ERA (3.39) -- in all he finished 12-6 in 26 G, 23 GS (151.1 ip, 148 h, 64 r, 57 er, 43 bb, 126 k). He was originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 44th round of the 1998 Draft. The Kutztown University product had the honor of starting the exhibition game versus the Phillies 3/30 (L, 5 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 5 k). He held Ryan Howard 0-2 with a strikeout (looking).

THE KEY-AVACCI

In his last start (4/14 vs. RIC), RHP **Ron Chiavacci** became the first IronPigs player to record a victory (6.0 ip, 3 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 8 k). The Scranton native currently leads the IL in ERA (0.52) and he currently holds a 16.1 scoreless IP streak. He also has recorded the only two 'quality starts' by the IronPigs pitching staff this season.

LHP **Jo Matumoto**, 37, is a 5-10, 170-pound right-hander from Sao Paulo, Brazil, who was signed by Toronto as a non-drafted free agent 2/23/07. Of Japanese descent, Matumoto went to Japan to pitch professionally from 1996-2001 in an "industrial league" (essentially the Japanese equivalent of the Minor League Baseball). Matumoto return home to pitch for the Brazilian National team as was the MVP of the 2005 South American Games. Last season, he pitched exclusively in New Hampshire (AA), going 3-4, 3.54 ERA with 1 SV in 45 G, 5 GS (86.0 ip, 74 h, 37 r, 34 er, 43 bb, 77 k).

- *Matumoto had been unscored upon in 4 of 5 G (allowed 4 ER in 2 IP on 4/14 vs. NBR). His last outing was an IP of perfect relief 4/17 @ HAR. His best outing came in a W on 4/11 vs. CT (3 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 er, 0 bb, 2 k).*

SERIES STUFF:

SYR won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

PIGLETS:

INF **Mike Cervenk** has hit safely in his last 4 G (5-17, .294-1-3) and his last 3 hits have been for extra bases -- including the first IronPigs HR at Coca-Cola Park 4/17 (Game 6, AB #171)... OF **Valentino Pascucci** has hit safely in his last 3 G (5-12) and has back-to-back multi-hit G. On Thursday, he finally picked up his first RBI (had started 0-17 with runners on base) and last night he hit his first HR. He led all of Triple-A with 34 HR last season with Albuquerque... OF **T.J. Bohn** has had 3 OF assists in his last 2 G. He leads the team with 5. In addition, he has hit in the last 2 G (3-8) after starting the season 3-30... 3B **Brennan King** snapped his 5-G hit streak Thursday and his 10-G errorless streak last night... 1B **Andy Tracy**, left the game early last night (0-2), snapping his 4-G RBI streak...The 'Pigs are just 1-14 with the bases loaded this season; ironically the one hit was by **Gookie Dawkins**, who has been demoted to AA...

BACON BITS, PT I:

- The IronPigs are 0-4 in series openers this season.
- After not allowing a double-digit hit total in their first 13 G, LHV has given up 11 hits to TOL each of the past 2 G.
- The 'Pigs have scored just 31 R in 16 G (1.9 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 64 (COL) -- more than 2x the LHV total.
- *Slowly but Surely?:* For the first time this season, the team is batting above the 'Mendoza Line' at .201. The offense is now batting .246 (34-138) in the last 4 G after batting just .185 in their first 12 G.

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT II:

- *Thou Shalt Not Steal?:* The CS of Matt Joyce by C **Pierre-Luc LaForest** in the 6th Thursday was the first CS by an IronPigs catcher since Opening Day (4/3 @ SWB) when C **Jason Jaramillo** gunned down Justin Christian. Opponents are 20-23* (8%) stealing bases this season. *One CS was on a Travis Blackley pickoff.
- *Taketh then Giveth:* The IronPigs have allowed opponents to score in their very next at-bat in 9 of the 20 innings (45%) they've scored.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F:* In the last 4 G, the LHV bullpen has allowed just 4 R in 18.2 IP (1.93 ERA) with 2 SV & 3 holds.
- *You're in Good Hands:* LHV has only committed 5 E in their last 7 G. The opponents have 10 E.
- *LOB PROB:* The IronPigs have a double-digit LOB total in 4 of the last 6 G (55 LOB, 9.2/G). For the season, they have 127 LOB (7.9/G).
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* The IronPigs bullpen has stranded just 11 of 25 (44.0%) inherited runners to score. Meanwhile, their opponents have stranded 19-21 (90.4%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 until **Gookie Dawkins'** two-run double last Sunday.
- *No Worries:* The IronPigs have started 0-11 as manager **Dave Huppert** looks to win his third consecutive league title. In 2005, his South Atlantic League Champion Lakewood BlueClaws started the season 0-9! Even though the SAL plays two separates halves, the BlueClaws finished the first half at 37-32 and wound up 84-55 for the season.
- *Schedule Scam?:* The IronPigs first four series of the season feature 3 playoff teams from 2007 (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Richmond and Toledo). Including Pawtucket, the teams combined to go 310-259 last season.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

With the IronPigs 6-4 loss Wednesday, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 131 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 31 runs in 16 games, an average of 1.9 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 64 (Columbus) -- more than twice the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.201) and the team is batting just .119 (13-109) with RISP; and .178 (37-208) with runners on base. The 'Pigs have been shutout 3 times.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

FAMILIAR FACES:

It is quite possible that early in the season, the IronPigs could post a starting lineup that features eight starters that have appeared in the IL -- but with different Major League affiliates: C **Pete LaForest** (Durham 2002-05), 1B **Andy Tracy** (Ottawa 2000-01, 2006; Norfolk 2002), 2B **Chris Woodward** (Syracuse 1998-2001); SS **Gookie Dawkins** (Louisville 2002; Toledo 2005; Indianapolis 2007), 3B **Mike Cervenak** (Norfolk 2007); OF **Brandon Watson** (Louisville 2006; Columbus 2007); OF **T.J. Bohn** (Richmond 2007) and starting RHP **Ron Chiavacci** (Indianapolis 2005-06; Toledo 2007). In addition, it is possible the save could also come from a non-Phillie IL veteran: as late-inning relievers RHP **John Ennis** previously pitched for Richmond (2003) and Toledo (2003-06) and RHP **Matt Childers** pitched for Indianapolis (2002-04), Richmond (2005) and Columbus (2006).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
