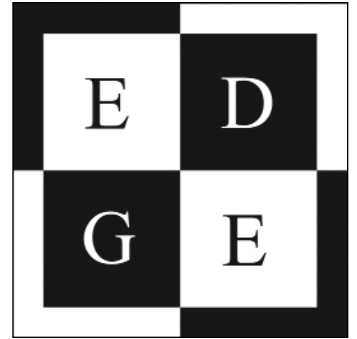

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (2-17) and Syracuse Chiefs (12-7) play the finale of a four-game series at Alliance Bank Stadium after Lehigh Valley dropped its sixth consecutive game Monday night, 4-2. With their victory, the second-place Chiefs have now won seven games in a row and nine of their last 10 games since starting the season at 3-6. Going back to last season, Syracuse has won six straight games against the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate.

- *Road Woes:* Lehigh Valley is 0-11 on the road this season. Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has lost 13 straight road games and gone 2-18 in its last 20 games as visitors.
- First-Pitch is scheduled for 2:00 p.m.

LHP **Travis Blackley**, 25, is a 6-3, 200-lb lefthander who was selected by the Phillies from San Francisco in the Rule 5 draft, 12/6/07 -- and outrighted to Lehigh Valley when the Giants declined to take him back at the end of Spring Training. The Australia native appeared in two games with San Francisco (0-0, 7.27 ERA in 8.2 ip) last year after spending the bulk of his season with the Fresno Grizzlies (10-8, 4.66 ERA, 28 gs, 161.2 ip, 156 h, 87 r, 84 er, 68 bb, 121 k). Blackley was originally signed by Seattle 10/29/00 prior to being traded to SF for OF Jason Ellison on 4/1/07, and he made in to the majors with the Mariners as a 21-year-old in 2004 (won his ML debut in a start 7/1/04 vs. TEX). The Aussie played for the World squad in the 2003 Futures Game at Cellular Field (Chi) and was on Australia's provisional roster for the inaugural World Baseball Classic.

LHP **John Parrish**, 30, is a 5-11, 176-pound lefty from Owing Mills, MD, who signed by Toronto as a minor league free agent 1/2/08 after a spending the end of the season with Seattle. A former 25th-round pick by Baltimore in 1996, Parrish started 2007 with the Orioles, going 2-2, 5.40 ERA in 45 G, 0 GS before being claimed off waivers by the Mariners on 8/9/07. He appeared in 8 G with Seattle (0-0, 6.97) and 3 with Tacoma (1-0, 14.54). Originally born in Lancaster, PA, Parrish missed 2006 after having Tommy John surgery 7/15/05. He is 12-12, 4.63 in 161 ML games (10 GS).

- Parrish will be making his first start of 2008. *Last time out (4/16 @ BUF): W, 4.2 ip, 1 h, 2 r, 0 er, 3 bb, 5 k.*

SERIES STUFF:

SYR leads the season-series, 3-0. The Chiefs also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

TRANSACTION:

OF **Javon Moran** (#3) has been promoted to LHV from REA (AA), where he was batting .176-0-6 (12-67, 2 SB) in 17 G.

PIGLETS:

C **Jason Jaramillo** has set a new IronPigs franchise record with a 7-game hitting streak (8-28, .286) -- passing OF **Brandon Watson** who started the season with a 6-gamer... OF **Valentino Pascucci** has hit safely in 5 of his last 6 G (8-20, .400-1-5, 6 BB) with 3 multi-hit games in his last 5 G. He has reached base safely in his last 7 G. After 0 HR and 0 RBI in his first 13 G (he started 0-17 with runners on base), he has added one HR and RBI's in 4 of his last 6 G... UTL **Joey Hammond** has a 3-game hitting streak (4-11) and has reached safely in his first 7 G as an IronPig (6 hits, 4 BB)...

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 18-48 (.273) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 35-84 (.294) and a combined 40 GB.

- No team in the Phillies system is above .500. The farm system combined is 23-50, ranking 29th in the MLB.

MORE TEAM NOTES

MISERY LOVES COMPANY (ALL LOST SUNDAY):

At 2-17, the IronPigs aren't alone with the worst record in MILB -- Tuscon (PCL, AAA, Arizona) is also 2-17. In addition there is still a 2-15 team -- St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM). In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is 17-1.

BACON BITS:

- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 0-11 against their fellow North Division foes (all road games).
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: In the last 7 G, the LHV bullpen has allowed just 4 R in 25.2 IP (1.40 ERA) w/ 2 SV & 3 holds.
- The 'Pigs have scored just 37 R in 18 G (2.1 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 64 (Rochester) -- 27 more than LHV's total.
- *Thou Shalt Not Steal?*: The CS of Matt Joyce by C **Pierre-Luc LaForest** in the 6th Thursday (4/17) was the first CS by an IronPigs catcher since Opening Day (4/3 @ SWB) when C **Jason Jaramillo** gunned down Justin Christian. Opponents are 22-26* (84.6%) stealing bases this season. *Two CS were on pickoffs (Blackley, Mazone).
- *No Worries!*: The IronPigs started 0-11 as manager **Dave Huppert** looks to win his third consecutive league title. In 2005, his South Atlantic League Champion Lakewood BlueClaws started the season 0-9! Even though the SAL plays two separates halves, the BlueClaws finished the first half at 37-32 and wound up 84-55 for the season.
- *Schedule Scam?*: The IronPigs first four series of the season feature 3 playoff teams from 2007 (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Richmond and Toledo). Including Pawtucket, the teams combined to go 310-259 last season.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 135 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 37 runs in 18 games, an average of 2.1 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 64 (Rochester) -- 27 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.212) and the team is batting just .129 (16-124) with RISP; and .185 (45-243) with runners on base. The 'Pigs have been shutout 3 times.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

FAMILIAR FACES:

It is quite possible that early in the season, the IronPigs could post a starting lineup that features eight starters that have appeared in the IL -- but with different Major League affiliates: C **Pete LaForest** (Durham 2002-05), 1B **Andy Tracy** (Ottawa 2000-01, 2006; Norfolk 2002), 2B **Chris Woodward** (Syracuse 1998-2001); SS **Gookie Dawkins** (Louisville 2002; Toledo 2005; Indianapolis 2007), 3B **Mike Cervenak** (Norfolk 2007); OF **Brandon Watson** (Louisville 2006; Columbus 2007); OF **T.J. Bohn** (Richmond 2007) and starting RHP **Ron Chiavacci** (Indianapolis 2005-06; Toledo 2007). In addition, it is possible the save could also come from a non-Phillie IL veteran: as late-inning relieves RHP **John Ennis** previously pitched for Richmond (2003) and Toledo (2003-06) and RHP **Matt Childers** pitched for Indianapolis (2002-04), Richmond (2005) and Columbus (2006).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

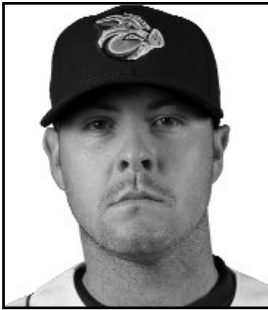
