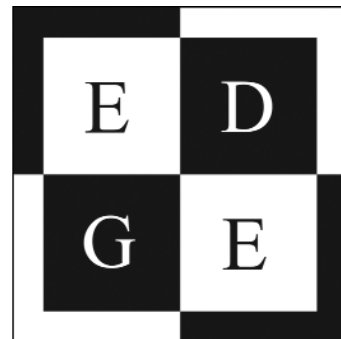

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (2-18) will play five-straight games against the fourth-place Rochester Red Wings (8-11) beginning tonight with Game One of a three game series at Frontier Field. Lehigh Valley enters the series having been swept at Syracuse (13-7) and after having dropped its seventh-consecutive contest yesterday afternoon, 13-6, at Alliance Bank Stadium. The Red Wings just lost two-of-three at SWB after they won back-to-back affairs vs. Richmond.

- *Road Woes:* Lehigh Valley is 0-12 on the road this season. Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has lost 14 straight road games and gone 2-19 in its last 21 games as visitors.
- First-Pitch is scheduled for 6:35 p.m.

**LHP J.A. Happ** (who goes by 'J'), is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of the 2004 draft out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. The 25-year-old spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only Major League start 6/7/07 vs. NY-N (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland. \*\* Happ is currently tied for the International League lead with 24 strikeouts (Garrett Olson, NOR).

**RHP Kevin Mulvey**, 22, is a 6-2, 190-pound right-hander from Parlin, NJ, who was acquired by Minnesota from the Mets in the Johan Santana trade 2/2/08. Originally selected by NYM in the 2nd round of the 2006 draft out of Villanova, Mulvey spent the bulk of last season with Double-A Binghamton, where he went 11-10 with a 3.32 ERA in 26 GS. He made it up to New Orleans and the end of the season and pitched 13 scoreless innings (which included one postseason start). The Mets organizational Pitcher of the Year, Mulvey was an Eastern League All-Star and selected to pitch for the Team USA in MLB's 2007 Futures Game. He was ranked as the No. 4 Prospect in the NYM organization prior to this season.

- *Last time out (4/17 vs. RIC):* W, 7.0 ip, 6 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 9 k.

## SERIES STUFF:

This is the first-ever meeting between ROC and LHV. The Red Wings won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

## WHO'S HOT:

**C Jason Jaramillo** is riding an IronPigs franchise-high 8-game hitting streak (9-32, .281) -- passing OF **Brandon Watson** who started the season with a 6-gamer... OF **Valentino Pascucci** has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 G (10-23, .435-1-5, 8 BB) with 4 multi-hit games in his last 6 G. He has reached base safely in his last 8 G... UTL **Joey Hammond** has a 4-game hitting streak (5-16) and has reached safely in his first 8 G as an IronPig (7 hits, 4 BB)...Closer **Matt Childers** has a 6.1 scoreless IP streak and has not allowed a R in his last 6 G. He is 2-2 (100%) in his SV opportunities.

- OF **Brandon Watson** has missed the last two days (left shoulder) and remains day-to-day.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 18-49 (.269) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 35-85 (.292) and a combined 40 GB.

- No team in the Phillies system is above .500. The farm system combined is 25-52, ranking 29th in the MLB.

## MORE TEAM NOTES

### MISERY (NO LONGER) LOVES COMPANY:

Tuscon (PCL, AAA, Arizona) erased a 6-3 seventh-inning deficit last night to defeat Fresno, 7-6, to pull to 3-17 -- leaving the 2-18 IronPigs with the worst record in MILB (they two teams had been tied all last week). Now, the only other two-win team is 2-17 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM).

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is 17-1.

### BACON BITS:

- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 0-12 against their fellow North Division foes (all road games).
- The 6 R scored by LHV yesterday was a season-high; but so were the 13 R and 14 hits they allowed. After not allowing a double-digit hit total in its first 14 G, the pitching staff has allowed 4 in the last 6 G, with opponents batting .294 (59-201).
- In the last spin through the rotation, LHV starters combined to go 0-5 with an 8.10 ERA (23.1 ip, 21 er), a .296 OBA (29-98) and 12 extra-base hits in 5 GS. It was in far contrast to the previous turn in which the starters went 2-1 with a 3.12 ERA (26.0 ip, 9 er), a .212 OBA (21-99) and 5 extra-base hits.
- The IronPigs did not hit a HR in the Syracuse series. Their last HR (Pascucci, 4/18, 9th) was 138 ABs ago.
- *LOB PROB*: After 12 LOB yesterday, LHV has double-digit LOB total in 7 G in 2008. For the season, they have 160 LOB (8.0/G).
- *Schedule Scam?*: LHV has started the season playing 5 of the Top 7 teams in the IL -- with combined records of 58-34 (.630). In fact, the IronPigs first 4 series of the season feature 3 playoff teams from '07 (SWB, RIC and TOL). Including Pawtucket, the teams combined to go 310-259 last season.
- The 'Pigs have scored just 45 R in 20 G (2.25 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 64 (Rochester) -- 24 more than LHV's total.
- *Thou Shalt Not Steal?*: The CS of Matt Joyce by C **Pierre-Luc LaForest** in the 6th Thursday (4/17) was the first CS by an IronPigs catcher since Opening Day (4/3 @ SWB) when C **Jason Jaramillo** gunned down Justin Christian. Opponents are 23-27\* (85.1%) stealing bases this season. \*Two CS were on pickoffs (Blackley, Mazone).
- *No Worries??:* The IronPigs started 0-11 as manager **Dave Huppert** looks to win his third consecutive league title. In 2005, his South Atlantic League Champion Lakewood BlueClaws started the season 0-9! Even though the SAL plays two separates halves, the BlueClaws finished the first half at 37-32 and wound up 84-55 for the season.

### THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 137 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

### STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 45 runs in 20 games, an average of 2.25 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 64 (Rochester) -- 24 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.216) and the team is batting just .143 (20-140) with RISP. The 'Pigs have been shutout 3 times.

### SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

### PRESEASON NOTES:

#### ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

#### PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

#### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

#### THREE-PEAT:

IronPigs manager **Dave Huppert** comes to Allentown after winning back-to-back league championships. The 50-year-old piloted the 2007 Clearwater Threshers to an 83-57 record and a Florida State League (Advanced-A) title after guiding the 2006 Lakewood Blue Claws to an 84-55 record and a South Atlantic League (Low-A) title. Taking it back farther, Huppert led his team to the post-season in three of his previous four managerial stints including a FSL Co-Championship with Brevard County in 2001. The native of South Gate, Calif., has posted a 1,425-1,214 (.540) career record.
