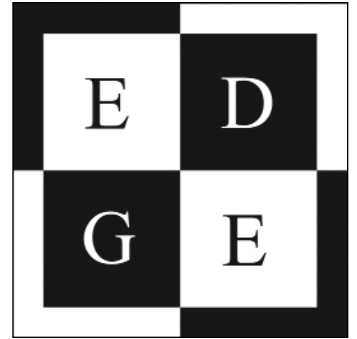

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (2-19) play Game Two of a three-game series against the fourth-place Rochester Red Wings (9-11) at Frontier Field (the teams follow with a two-game set at Coca-Cola Park). Lehigh Valley lost the opening game last night, 5-3, having blown a 3-1 lead in the 8th inning. With the defeat, the 'Pigs are now on an eight-game losing streak and are a season-high 12 games back in the North. The Red Wings have gone 4-2 in their last six games.

- **Road Woes:** Lehigh Valley is 0-13 on the road this season. Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has lost 15 straight road games and gone 2-20 in its last 22 games as visitors.
- First-Pitch is scheduled for 6:35 p.m.

RHP Ron Chiavacci, 30, is a 6-0, 175-pound right-hander out of Scranton, Pa., who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 11/20/07. An anchor of Western Division Champion Toledo's rotation, Chiavacci finished the 2007 season 3rd in the I.L. in wins (12), 4th in strikeouts (126) and 5th in ERA (3.39) -- in all he finished 12-6 in 26 G, 23 GS (151.1 ip, 148 h, 64 r, 57 er, 43 bb, 126 k). He was originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 44th round of the 1998 Draft. The Kutztown University product had the honor of starting the exhibition game versus the Phillies 3/30 (L, 5 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 5 k). He held Ryan Howard 0-2 with a strikeout (looking).

LHP Brian Duensing, 25, is a 5-11, 211-pound left-hander from Omaha, NE, who was selected by Minnesota in the third round of the 2005 draft out of University of Nebraska (where he underwent Tommy John surgery). He started 2007 with New Britain (4-1, 2.96 in 9 GS) before his promotion to Rochester on 5/30 -- then went on to finish third in the IL in ERA (3.24) and tied for third in wins (11). In all he was 11-5 with a 3.24 ERA in 19 GS (3 CG). Duensing pitched in the IBAF World Cup in Taiwan on 11/18 and allowed one hit in the first three innings for Team USA in their 6-3 victory over Cuba in the Gold Medal Game. He is ranked as the No. 8 Prospect in the Twins system by *Baseball America*.

SERIES STUFF:

ROC leads the season series, 1-0. The Red Wings also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

WHO'S HOT:

LHP **J.A. Happ** recorded 8 K last night -- one away from tying his season-high -- and continues to lead the IL in strikeouts (32)... C **Jason Jaramillo** is riding an IronPigs franchise-high 9-game hitting streak (10-36, .278)... OF **Valentino Pascucci** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 G (11-26, .423-1-6, 10 BB) with 4 multi-hit games in his last 7 G. He has reached base safely in his last 9 G and in 22 of his last 37 plate appearances (.594)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 9 straight games... UTL **Joey Hammond** has a 5-game hitting streak (6-20, .300) and has reached safely in his first 9 G as an IronPig (8 hits, 4 BB)... OF **Michael Spidale** also has a 5-game hitting streak (6-22, .273)... Closer **Matt Childers** has a 7.2 scoreless IP streak and has not allowed a R in his last 7 G. He is 2-2 (100%) in his SV opportunities.

- OF **Javon Moran** scored 2 R in his LHV debut. Including REA, he has a 3-G hit steak (5-9) & a 3-G SB streak (3).
- OF **Brandon Watson** has missed the last three days (left shoulder) and remains day-to-day.

BACON BITS, PT. I:

- **Northern Exposure:** The IronPigs are 0-13 against their fellow North Division foes (all road games).
- **Comeback Trail:** By blowing a 3-1 lead, the 'Pigs have seen opponents come from behind to win 7 G (3rd time they've spoiled a 2-R lead). By comparison, LHV has just one come-from-behind win.
- **Fighting over Inheritance:** The IronPigs bullpen has allowed its last 9 inherited runners to score -- and for the season has only stranded 13 of 36 (36.1%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 24-28 (85.7%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 13-13 (100%) saves.
- **You're in Good Hands:** LHV has not committed an error in the last 3 G and has a 26.2-innings errorless streak.
- Andy Tracy's HR last night snapped LHV's homerless skid at 163 AB and was the first since Pascucci's on 4/18.

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT. II:

- *LOB PROB*: After 11 LOB last night, LHV has double-digit LOB total in 8 G. For the season, they have 171 LOB (8.1/G).
- The 'Pigs have scored just 48 R in 21 G (2.3 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 69 (ROC) -- 21 more than LHV.
- After not allowing a double-digit hit total in its first 14 G, the pitching staff has allowed 4 in the last 7 G, with opponents batting .291 (68-234).
- *Thou Shalt Not Steal?!*: The CS of Randy Ruiz last night by C **Jason Jaramillo** in the 2nd was just the third CS by an IronPigs catcher, and Jaramillo's first since Opening Day (4/3 @ SWB). Opponents are 23-28* (82.1%) stealing bases this season. *Two CS were on pickoffs (Blackley, Mazone).

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 18-50 (.265) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 35-86 (.289) and a combined 41 GB.

- No team in the Phillies system is above .500. The farm system combined is 27-54, ranking 29th in the MLB.

MISERY (NO LONGER) LOVES COMPANY:

At 2-19, the IronPigs have the worst record in MILB after Tuscon (PCL, AAA, Arizona) defeated Fresno, 7-6, on Tuesday to pull to 3-17. The only other two-win team in the land is St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM), now 2-18.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is 17-1.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 138 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 48 runs in 21 games, an average of 2.29 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 69 (Rochester) -- 21 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.215) and the team is batting just .148 (23-155) with RISP. The 'Pigs have been shutout 3 times.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

PORK POWER, PT 2:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). In fact, it took Ottawa 14 games and 481 AB before **Brennan King** hit their first HR... This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

THREE-PEAT:

IronPigs manager **Dave Huppert** comes to Allentown after winning back-to-back league championships. The 50-year-old piloted the 2007 Clearwater Threshers to an 83-57 record and a Florida State League (Advanced-A) title after guiding the 2006 Lakewood Blue Claws to an 84-55 record and a South Atlantic League (Low-A) title. Taking it back farther, Huppert led his team to the post-season in three of his previous four managerial stints including a FSL Co-Championship with Brevard County in 2001. The native of South Gate, Calif., has posted a 1,425-1,214 (.540) career record.
