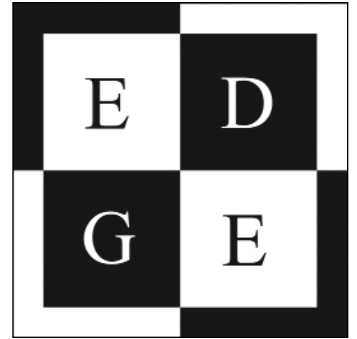

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (3-20) return home for a mini four-game homestand starting tonight with a two-game set against the fourth-place Rochester Red Wings (10-12) -- after the Red Wings took two-of-three at Frontier Field the past three days. However, Lehigh Valley snapped its nine-game losing streak with a 6-2 win in the series finale last night. The 'Pigs remain a season-high 13.0 games back in the North. The Red Wings have gone 5-3 in their last eight games.

- The win last night gave the IronPigs their first win on the road AND their first win against the North (15 tries).
- First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 5:50 p.m. (5:30 p.m. for the Club Level). Tonight is Jimmy Rollins Bobblehead Night, presented by **Nacci Printing, Inc.** The first 2,500 (12 and under) will receive a bobblehead.

RHP **J.D. Durbin**, who appeared in 18 games with Philadelphia last season, is a 6-0, 208-pound righthander who was claimed by the Phillies off waivers from Boston, 4/14/07. He also appeared in one 2007 game for Arizona prior to being claimed off waivers by Boston, 4/9/07 (was designated three times in all last season) and later became the only MLB rookie to record a shutout (7/22 @ SD) and a save (8/7 vs. FLA) last season. Overall, Durbin went 6-5 with a 5.15 ERA in 18 G, 10 GS with Philadelphia and 2-4 with a 4.55 ERA in 10 GS for Ottawa. A former 2nd round pick by Minnesota in the 2000 draft, Durbin made it up to the Twins for a four-game stint in 2004 (0-1, 7.36, 1 GS).

LHP **Glen Perkins**, 25, is a 6-0, 200-pound left-hander selected by Minnesota in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2004 draft out of University of Minnesota. -- where he was Big Ten Pitcher of the Year in 2004. The native of Lakeview, MN, started last season in Rochester (0-0, 1.50 in 1 GS) before a promotion to Minnesota 4/12. With the Twins, Perkins went 0-0, 3.14 ERA in 19 G (all relief) -- but missed two months with a muscle strain in his left shoulder. In between stints in the Majors, he rehabbed with New Britain (0-2, 11.05 in 3 GS), Fort Myers (0-0, 27.00 in 1 GS) and GCL Twins (0-0, 1.80 in 3 GS). He became the 27th Minnesotan to play for the Twins when he made his ML debut 9/21/06 @ Boston (1.1 scoreless IP).  
 • Perkins lost last time out (4/21 @ SWB) despite a solid line: L, 5.0 ip, 6 h, 1 r, 1 er, 2 bb, 2 k.

## SERIES STUFF:

ROC leads the season series, 2-1. The Red Wings also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

## WHO'S HOT:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit a HR in 3 consecutive games and now leads the team with 4 HR. His first HR came in his first AB of 2008; he then went 59 AB without a HR until 3 in his last 11 AB of this series. Tracy also has a 4-G hitting streak (5-17) and a 4-G RBI streak (7 RBI)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has hit a HR in the last 2 G and has reached base safely in 11 straight contests. He has had 6 TB (2 1B, 2B, 2 HR) each of the last 2 nights which both tie the franchise-high. He also has a 4-G hitting streak (8-17, .471-2-5)... C **Jason Jaramillo** is riding an IronPigs franchise-high 10-game hitting streak (12-40, .300)... OF **Valentino Pascucci** has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 G (12-31, .387-1-6, 12 BB) with 4 multi-hit games in his last 9 G & multi-BB games in 5 of his last 7 G. He has reached base safely in his last 11 G and in 25 of his last 44 plate appearances (.568)... OF **Javon Moran** has scored 4 R in just 3 G as an IronPig. He is already the only IronPigs to have scored 2+ R in 2 G... Closer **Matt Childers** has an 8.2 scoreless IP streak and has not allowed a R in his last 8 G. He is 2-2 (100%) in SV opportunities...LHP **J.A. Happ** recorded 8 K Wednesday and continues to lead the IL in strikeouts (32)...  
 • OF **Brandon Watson** has missed the last five days (left shoulder) and remains day-to-day.

## VICTORINO TO MAKE GOOD SHEPHERD REHAB WITH IRONPIGS:

Phillies CF **Shane Victorino** (see page 11) will continue his ML rehab assignment joining the IronPigs tonight and Sunday. Victorino has been on the DL since 4/12 (strained right calf). He started his rehab Wednesday with Clearwater and went 2-5, RBI in 2 G before going 1-3 with Reading last night. He was batting .234-0-2 this season with the Phillies after hitting .281-12-47 with 37 SB and 10 outfield assists in 131 games last season. ## MORE TEAM NOTES

### BACON BITS:

- Tonight, the IronPigs will look to win back-to-back games for the second time this season and for the second time in a span of 37 games (going back to last season, starting after the Lynx won two straight games 8/21/07-8/21/07).
- The IronPigs 6 R last night tied a season-high (lost 13-6 on 4/22 @ SYR), as did the 2 HR in a game (3rd time). LHV had a 3-run HR (Cervenak) and a 2-run HR (Tracy). Previously, 8 of their 10 HR were solo shots...and the other two were just 2-run shots.
- The 4-R margin of victory for the IronPigs last night marks their largest lead on the season. They had previously led by 3 in a 4-1 win 4/15 vs. TOL.
- *Heating Up?*: The IronPigs batted .254 (61-240) and averaged 3.6 R/G on the 7-game road trip. Previously, they were batting .201 with 1.9 R/G.
- *Clubbin'*: The IronPigs have hit 5 HR in their last 3 G after they went 4 G and 163 AB without a HR.
- *You're in Good Hands*: A Spidale throwing error (E-7) Thursday night snapped the team's errorless streak at 29.1 inn. LHV has just 2 E in last its last 5 G.
- *Relief?*: The bullpen had been hot until the last 4 G, in which the pen has gone 0-1, 10.22 ERA (12.1 ip, 14 er). In the previous 7 G, the bullpen has allowed just 4 R in 25.2 IP (1.40 ERA) w/ 2 SV & 3 holds.
- *LOB PROB*: LHV has double-digit LOB total in 8 G. For the season, they have 180 LOB (7.8/G).
- The HR allowed by LHP **Vic Darensbourg** on Thursday night was the first IL HR he's allowed since 8/1/06 -- a span of 70 ip, 65 G.
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: The IronPigs bullpen has allowed its last 9 inherited runners to score -- and for the season has only stranded 13 of 36 (36.1%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 26-30 (86.7%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 13-13 (100%) saves.
- *Thou Shalt Not Steal?*: The CS of Randy Ruiz Wednesday by C **Jason Jaramillo** was just the third CS by an IronPigs catcher, and Jaramillo's first since Opening Day (4/3 @ SWB). Opponents are 24-29\* (82.8%) stealing bases this season. \*Two CS were on pickoffs (Blackley, Mazone).

### OUT OF THE MILB CELLARI:

With their win last night, the IronPigs (3-20) no longer have the worst record in MILB! The dubious honor of owning the worst record now belongs to the 2-20 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM). The only other 3-win team is Tuscon (PCL, AAA, Arizona), which remains in the hunt at 3-19.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is 19-1.

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 19-51 (.271) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 36-87 (.293) and a combined 42.0 GB.

- No team in the Phillies system is above .500. The farm system combined is 31-57, now ranking 29th in MLB.

### THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 139 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

### STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 56 runs in 23 games, an average of 2.4 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 78 (Durham) -- 22 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.218) and the team is batting just .155 (26-168) with RISP. The 'Pigs have been shutout 3 times.

### SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

### PRESEASON NOTES:

#### ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

#### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

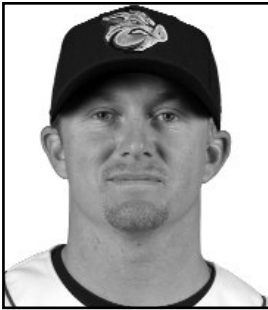
