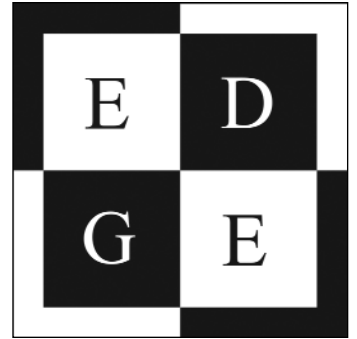

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (3-22) start the second two-game series game on their four-game homestand with tonight's game against the second-place Syracuse Chiefs (15-10) -- who swept the IronPigs in four games at Alliance Bank Stadium April 19-22. After its first day off of the season, Lehigh Valley starts a string of 22 consecutive games having dropped 11 of its past 12 games. The 'Pigs remain 13.5 games back in the North. Meanwhile, the Chiefs -- who just split a rain-shortened series, 1-1, with SWB -- has gone 12-4 after starting 3-6, including an 8-game winning streak.

• First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 5:50 p.m. (5:30 p.m. for the Club Level). Note that tomorrow's Education Day, presented by **The Crayola Factory**, is scheduled to start at 10:35 a.m.!

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of the 2004 draft out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. The 25-year-old spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only Major League start 6/7/07 vs. NY-N (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland. ** Happ is currently tied for the International League lead with 32 strikeouts (Kei Igawa, SWB).

LHP David Purcey, 26, is a 6-5, 240-pound left-hander selected by Toronto in the first round (16th overall) in the 2004 draft from University of Oklahoma -- where he was named to the freshman All-Big 12 Conference team in 2002. Purcey made his ML debut on 4/18 vs. DET and left in the 5th of a 1-1 game (4.1 ip, 2 h, 1 r, 1 er, 7 bb, 3 k). The Dallas native spent all of 2007 in New Hampshire (AA), going 3-5 with a 5.37 ERA in 11 GS before undergoing surgery in June for cysts in his forearm and triceps. Ranked No. 9 in the Toronto system by *Baseball America*, he received a \$1.6 M signing bonus.

• *Purcey turned in a quality start despite losing, 3-1, his last start (4/23 @ PAW): 6 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 2 er, 4 bb, 9 k.*

SERIES STUFF:

SYR leads the season-series, 4-0, after its home sweep 4/19-4/22. The Chiefs also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6. *Going back to last season, Syracuse has won 7 straight games against the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate.*

TONS 'O TRANSACTIONS:

(REMOVED FROM ROSTER): Today, the Phillies released OF **Valentino Pascucci** (.232-1-7) -- who led the team in OBA (.370), had batter .316-1-7 in his last 12 G and reached base safely in 25 of his last 51 plate appearances (49%)... OF **Michael Spidale** was assigned to Reading (AA)... RHP **Joe Bisenius** was assigned to Reading (AA)... LHP **Travis Blackley** was placed on the Disabled List (right groin).

(ADDED TO ROSTER): OF **T.J. Bohn** was optioned to Lehigh Valley from Philadelphia Phillies (he went 1-3 with a 2B and 2 RBI in 7 G). He is batting .186-0-0 (8-43) in 14 G with LHV... RHP **Jason Anderson** promoted to Lehigh Valley from Reading (he was 0-1, 10.29 in 7 G). He is 0-0, 7.73 and 1 BS (2.1 ip, 2 r) in 2 G with LHV... OF **Rich Thompson** was promoted to Lehigh Valley from Reading (he was 3-10 with a 3B and an RBI in 3 G). Last season with Tucson, he batted .295-3-41 with 15 SB in 111 G.

(ADDITIONAL NOTE): INF **Oscar Robles** has been claimed off waivers from SD and assigned to Lehigh Valley. He will not be added to the roster until he reports. .208-1-10 in 14 G with Portland (PCL, AAA, SD).

WHO'S HOT:

DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 13 straight contests and has hit safely in 5 of his last 6 G (10-24, .417-2-5)... C **Jason Jaramillo's** franchise-high 10-game hit streak came to an end Sat. He is 0-7 in 2 G since... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit a HR in 3 of his last 5 G. In addition, he has hit safely in 5 of last 6 G (.261-3-7; 6-23) and reached safely in last 7 G... SS **Chris Woodward** has hit in 3 of his last 5 G (6-19, 0 E)... **Matt Childers** has an 8.2 scoreless IP streak and has not allowed a R in his last 8 G. He is 2-2 (100%) in SV opps...LHP **J.A. Happ** recorded 8 K in his last start (4/23 @ ROC) and continues to lead the IL in Ks (32)... OF **Brandon Watson** returned Sun. after missing 6 G (left shoulder) but was 0-4.

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS:

- The IronPigs outthit the Red Wings, 8-5, on Sunday. LHV has gone just 1-5 in the 6 games they've outthit their opponent.
- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 1-16 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
- *Lack o Runs, I*: LHV has scored just 57 runs in 25 games, an average of 2.3 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 95 (DUR) -- 38 more than LHV.
- *Lack o Runs, II*: After scoring just 1 R in their two games against ROC, LHV has scored 0-2 R in 15 of 25 (60%) games.
- *Clubbin'*: The IronPigs have hit 5 HR in their last 5 G after they went 4 G and 163 AB without a HR.
- *Relief?*: The bullpen had been hot until the last 6 G, in which the pen has gone 0-2, 7.92 ERA (25.0 ip, 22 er). In the previous 7 G, the bullpen has allowed just 4 R in 25.2 IP (1.40 ERA) w/ 2 SV & 3 holds.
- *LOB PROB*: LHV has double-digit LOB total in 8 G. For the season, they have 190 LOB (7.6/G).
- The HR allowed by LHP **Vic Darensbourg** on Thursday night was the first IL HR he's allowed since 8/1/06 -- a span of 70 ip, 65 G.
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: The IronPigs bullpen has only stranded 17 of 40 (42.5%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 26-30 (86.7%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 13-13 (100%) saves.

OH NO! BACK IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (3-22) have the worst record in MILB. St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) has improved to 4-21 and Nashville (PCL, AAA, MIL) is at 5-18. Meanwhile, Tucson (PCL, AAA, Arizona) has improved to 6-19; Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) is also at 6-19.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is now 21-2.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 19-53 (.264) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 36-89 (.288) and a combined 42.5 GB.

- Reading is the only team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 35-62, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 142 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 57 runs in 25 games, an average of 2.3 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 95 (Durham) -- 38 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.214) and the team is batting just .148 (26-176) with RISP. The 'Pigs have been shutout 4 times.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
