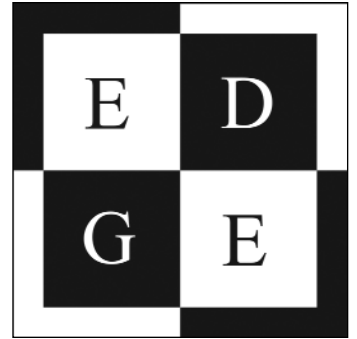

TONIGHT'S GAME:

Opening Day! The Lehigh Valley IronPigs travel to PNC Field in Moosic for their season-opener against the 2007 Northern Division Champion Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees (Triple-A affiliate of New York). Tonight's game will also mark the official return of affiliated baseball to the Lehigh Valley for the first time in 47 years -- when the Allentown Red Sox moved their Eastern League (AA) entry to Jamestown, Pa., following the 1960 season. The region did have an independent league baseball team -- the Allentown Ambassadors of the Northeast/Northern Leagues from 1997-2003. First-Pitch is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

• *The Phillies' Triple-A Team finished with a record of 6-8-4 during Minor League Spring Training games, not including Saturday's 1-0 loss to the Devil Rays -- in which no current IronPigs participated -- or either of the two exhibition games: a 5-3 loss to the Philadelphia Phillies on Sunday or the 6-2 win at Reading (AA) on Tuesday.*

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of the 2004 draft out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. The 25-year-old spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only Major League start 6/7/07 vs. NY-N (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland.

• Overall, Happ had a 5.11 ERA in 3 GS (12.1 ip, 8 h, 8 r, 7 er, 6 bb, 7 k) in Minor League Spring Training. He also appeared in two games during Major League Spring Training and went 0-0, 2.25 (4 ip, 3 h, r, er, bb, k).

• *Happ vs. SWB in 2007:* 1-1, 12.15 ERA in 2 GS (6.2 ip, 8 h, 9 r, 9 er, 7 bb, 6 k, .320)

LHP Kei Igawa, a member of the Yankees' 40-Man Roster, is a 6-4, 200-pound lefty out of Ibaraki, Japan. He signed with New York on a 5-year, 20-million dollar contract on 12/27/06 after the Yankees were the highest bidders once Igawa was posted by the Hanshin Tigers (11/16/06). A No. 2 draft choice of the Hanshin Tigers in 1998, Igawa spent a couple of years in the Hanshin minor league system prior to entering the rotation in 2001. In his first full season season as a starter, Igawa went 9-13 for the last-placed Tigers, but finished with a Central League second-best 2.67 ERA. In 2002, he improved to 14-9 and finished third in ERA (2.49), while leading the CL with 206 K. In 2003, the Tigers won the Central League pennant and Igawa won the MVP in the Central League going 20-5 with a 2.80 ERA and was third with 179 strikeouts. He also won the Sawamura Award (Japanese equivalent of the Cy Young Award).

In eight seasons in Japan, we went 86-60 with a 3.14 ERA in 190 G (1244 ip, 1174 k) while leading in Ks three times (2002, '04, '06) and appearing in the Nippon Professional Baseball All-Star Game thrice (2001, '02, '03).

• Overall, Igawa went 1-1 with a 5.56 ERA in 5 G, 1 GS (11.1 ip, 12 h, 7 r, 7 er, 7 bb, 6 k) in Major League S.T.

• *Igawa vs. OTT in 2007:* Did not face the Lynx last season.

SERIES STUFF:

SWB won the season series, 10-6, with wins in the last 3 games. OTT actually won the first 3 meetings in 2007.

TUESDAY RECAP:

The IronPigs defeated the Reading Phillies (AA), 6-2, in an exhibition game at First Energy Stadium. Lehigh Valley only had four hits -- but the first three of them were home runs. 1B **Mike Cervenak** got the team going with a solo shot off RHP **Carlos Carrasco** in the second and OF **Chris Snelling** followed with a three-run homer in the third to give the IronPigs a quick, 4-0. RHP **J.D. Durbin** started and went four innings -- allowing just one hit and one unearned run -- and the bullpen (**Kevin Beirne**, **Joe Bisenius** and **Matt Childers**) held the lead. C **Jason Jaramillo** had the other two hits, including a solo home run of his own in the 6th off LHP **Shane Youman**.

MORE TEAM NOTES

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

WHO'S HOT:

In the two exhibition games, OF **Chris Snelling** went 3-6 with a HR, 3 RBI and 2 BB... INF **Mike Cervenak** had the first IronPigs RBI (3/30) and first HR (4/1, solo shot off Carlos Carrasco in the 2nd)...Rule 5 draftee 2B **Casey Smith** spent the bulk of March in Major League Spring Training and impressed his new employer with his bat -- hitting .333 (8-24). Even after his assignment to Triple-A camp, Smith hit .350 (7-20, 3 2B, 3 RBI). Smith, who was selected by the Phillies out of the Angels organization, batted .290-2-53 with Triple-A Salt Lake last season . . . 2007 Ottawa starting 3B **Brennan King** led the club in batting this spring, swinging to the tune of .407-1-6 (11-27, 3 2B). He also managed to go 4-13 (.308-0-3, 2 2B) in Major League Spring Training . . . SS **Gookie Dawkins** only batted .222 (10-45), but he led the team with 3 HR. . . RHP **Jason Anderson** appeared in 5 games and pitched 9.2 scoreless innings -- only yielding two hits -- in Minor League Spring Training.

WHO'S NEW:

The revamped lineup. A year after Ottawa finished last in the IL in runs scored, the IronPigs team only features only three returning position players from the Lynx squad -- and these three all finished with a higher batting average than the team total (.267): C **Jason Jaramillo** (.271), 3B **Brennan King** (.277) and SS **Gookie Dawkins** (.274). Pitching-wise, nine of the 12 staff members spent time in Ottawa a year ago

PORK POWER:

The Ottawa Lynx managed just one home run in their first 27 games last season and finished the year last in the IL with 59 (23 fewer than the next team; 87 fewer than IL leading Durham). This season could be different for the IronPigs, as the Phillies this off-season signed OF **Val Pascucci**, who was the 2007 Pacific Coast League HR leader with 34 for Albuquerque; 1B **Andy Tracy**, who led New Orleans with 23 HR in 2007; INF **Mike Cervenak**, who swatted 15 HR with Norfolk; and C **Pete LaForest**, who belted 29 HR in just 296 at-bats with Portland (AAA) last year. Even the newly acquired utility INF **Chris Woodward** hit 13 home runs in only 90 games for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2002.

FAMILIAR FACES:

It is quite possible that early in the season, the IronPigs could post a starting lineup that features eight starters that have appeared in the IL -- but with different Major League affiliates: C **Pete LaForest** (Durham 2002-05), 1B **Andy Tracy** (Ottawa 2000-01, 2006; Norfolk 2002), 2B **Chris Woodward** (Syracuse 1998-2001); SS **Gookie Dawkins** (Louisville 2002; Toledo 2005; Indianapolis 2007), 3B **Mike Cervenak** (Norfolk 2007); OF **Brandon Watson** (Louisville 2006; Columbus 2007); OF **T.J. Bohn** (Richmond 2007) and starting RHP **Ron Chiavacci** (Indianapolis 2005-06; Toledo 2007). In addition, it is possible the save could also come from a non-Phillie IL veteran: as late-inning relievers RHP **John Ennis** previously pitched for Richmond (2003) and Toledo (2003-06) and RHP **Matt Childers** pitched for Indianapolis (2002-04), Richmond (2005) and Columbus (2006).

TOP PROSPECTS:

25-year-old C **Jason Jaramillo** is among Philadelphia' top 10 prospects according to *Baseball America*. The 2nd-round pick from 2004 hit .271 last year for Ottawa and earned a trip to the Triple-A All-Star Game. He also played well for the United States team at the 2007 World Cup...LHP **J.A. Happ** was 4-6 with a 5.02 ERA in 24 starts for Ottawa last season. It was the first time in his four-year career his ERA was over 2.81...25-year-old RHP **Joe Bisenius** went 3-4 with a 5.48 ERA in his first season at the Triple-A level in 2007. One year earlier he combined to go 8-3 with a 2.25 ERA in 51 games between Class-A Clearwater and Double-A Reading.

THREE-PEAT:

IronPigs manager **Dave Huppert** comes to Allentown after winning back-to-back league championships. The 50-year-old piloted the 2007 Clearwater Threshers to an 83-57 record and a Florida State League (Advanced-A) title after guiding the 2006 Lakewood Blue Claws to an 84-55 record and a South Atlantic League (Low-A) title. Taking it back farther, Huppert led his team to the post-season in three of his previous four managerial stints including a FSL Co-Championship with Brevard County in 2001. The native of South Gate, Calif., has posted a 1,425-1,214 (.540) career record.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the St. Cardinals (1940, 1942-1952, 1954-56), the Philadelphia Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

ROSTER REVIEW

A corps of Minor League veterans, several top prospects and four members of the Philadelphia Phillies 40-Man Roster headline the inaugural Lehigh Valley IronPigs roster, announced Saturday. In addition, a trio of top prospects according to Baseball America -- C **Jason Jaramillo**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and RHP **Joe Bisenius** -- will all begin the season with the IronPigs.

C **Jason Jaramillo**, 25, is a member of the Philadelphia 40-Man Roster and was rated the No. 10 Prospect in the Phillies' system by *Baseball America* in 2008. A second-round pick by Philadelphia in 2004, Jaramillo appeared in the 2007 I.L. All-Star Game in 2007 and finished batting .271 with six homers and 56 RBI.

LHP **J.A. Happ**, a former third rounder in 2004 and member of the Philadelphia 40-Man Roster, appeared in his first and only Major League game June 30 against the New York Mets last year. He spent the remainder of last season with Ottawa and went 4-6 with a 5.02 ERA. The 25-year-old had an impressive 2006 campaign that included a midseason Florida State League All-Star selection. His success continued at Double-A, going 6-2 with a 2.65 ERA in 12 GS with the Reading Phillies. Baseball America ranks Happ as the No. 11 Prospect in the Phillies organization.

RHP **Joe Bisenius**, a member of the Phillies 40-Man Roster, appeared in 35 games with the Ottawa Lynx after starting the 2007 season on the Philadelphia Opening Day Roster. Selected by the Phillies in the 12th round of the 2004 draft, Bisenius pitched two scoreless innings in his first stint in the Major Leagues and finished 3-4 overall with a 5.48 ERA at Triple-A.

Expected to join Happ in the rotation is RHP **Travis Blackley**, a Rule-5 draft selection in December that spent last season with Triple-A Fresno in the Giants organization. The 25-year-old posted impressive numbers a year ago, winning 10 games at Triple-A prior to making a pair of starts for the Giants in September.

In addition to Happ and Blackley, the starting rotation is expected to feature experienced veterans like LHP **Brian Mazone** and RHP **Ron Chiavacci**. Mazone has posted stellar numbers the last two years, going 16-5 with a 2.07 ERA in 26 starts as a Phillies farmhand. After leading the IL with a 2.03 ERA in 2006, he spent the majority of last season pitching for the Samsung Lions of the Korean League. Chiavacci is coming off a 12-win campaign with the Mud Hens a season ago. Originally from Scranton, Pa., Chiavacci finished third in the IL in wins (12), fourth in strikeouts (126), and fifth in ERA (3.39). Originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 44th round of the June 1998 draft, the right-hander attended Lackawanna Junior College and Kutztown University.

The Lehigh Valley pitching staff will consist of several holdovers from last year's Ottawa ball club, including right-handers **Jason Anderson**, **Matt Childers**, **J.D. Durbin**, **John Ennis** and **Gary Knotts**.

The staff also includes a pair of experienced veterans in RHP **Kevin Beirne** and LHP **Vic Darensbourg**. Beirne, 34, did not pitch in 2007 after spending five seasons overseas in Japan from 2002-2006. Darensbourg, 37, went 6-2 with an impressive 1.72 ERA in 50 relief appearances with Triple-A Toledo (Detroit) in 2007.

Remarkably, with the exceptions of Ron Chiavacci and Brian Mazone, the balance of the pitching staff has Major League experience.

In terms of position players, the Phillies made several Minor League free agent acquisitions to bolster an offense that hit a league-low 53 home runs in 2007. Expected to make a significant contribution is OF **Valentino Pascucci**, who led all of Triple-A baseball with 34 home runs in Albuquerque (Florida) last year.

Alongside Pascucci in the outfield will be **Brandon Watson**, who set an IL record by hitting safely in 43 consecutive games last year with Columbus (Washington). A non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training, the California native has appeared in 40 big league games over the past three seasons. Watson is a career .305 hitter with 188 stolen bases in nine seasons and 900 Minor League games.

Additional outfielders on the Opening Day roster include **Chris Snelling** and **T.J. Bohn**. The former was acquired by the Phillies in an offseason trade with Tampa. Last season, Snelling split time between three teams -- Washington, Oakland and Sacramento (AAA) -- but spent the bulk of the season on the D.L. He is a .311 career hitter in 493 minor league games and has appeared Team Australia in the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney. Bohn, a member of the 40-Man Roster, split time between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Richmond (Atlanta) last year, hitting .235 with 25 RBIs.

Splitting catching duties with Jaramillo is slugger C **Pete LaForest**, who spent time on both the San Diego Padres and Phillies rosters during the 2007 season. He hit .278 in 36 at-bats at the Major League level after hitting 29 homers and 72 RBI with the Triple-A Portland (San Diego). Originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 1995 June draft, LaForest played on Team Canada in both the 2004 Olympic Games and in the inaugural World Baseball Classic.

An experienced infield is guided by 1B **Andy Tracy**, who has been playing professionally since 1996 and has hit 20 or more home runs six times in his career. Tracy will be joined by 2B **Casey Smith** on the right side of the infield. Smith, selected by the Phillies in the Rule-5 draft, had a successful 2007 season at the plate with Salt Lake City (Los Angeles-AL), batting .290 with 53 RBIs.

The middle infield tandem also includes SS **Gookie Dawkins**, a former second-round draft pick by Cincinnati in 1997 who made his Major League debut as a 20-year-old in 1999. Now 28, the South Carolina native has appeared in 55 games at the big league level -- but none since a three-game stint with Kansas City in 2003. Known for his defensive ability, Dawkins also hit .274 in 31 games in Ottawa last season after the Phillies acquired him from Seattle on August 1.

Brennan King is expected to retain the starting third base position that he held all of last year in Ottawa. A former second-round selection by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 1999 draft, King spent all of last season with the Lynx -- where he hit .277 in 122 games. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native has spent the previous two seasons in the Phillies organization after signing as Minor League free agent in 2005.

Remaining infielders include a pair of off-season acquisitions, **Mike Cervenak** and **Chris Woodward**. Cervenak spent last season in the IL with the Norfolk Tides and hit .283 with 15 home runs and 78 RBI in 140 games. Woodward, 31, was signed to a Minor League contract on Friday. He hit .393 (11-for-28) in 15 games for the New York Yankees during Spring Training. He spent last season with the Atlanta Braves and has also played for the New York Mets (2005-06) and the Toronto Blue Jays (1999-2004). Woodward has a .243 career average at the big league level, with 15 homers and 186 runs.

As announced in December, the team will be led by manager **Dave Huppert**, hitting coach **Greg Gross** and pitching coach **Rod Nichols**. The field staff is rounded out by athletic trainer **Jason Kirkman** and strength coach **Ryan Driscoll**.
