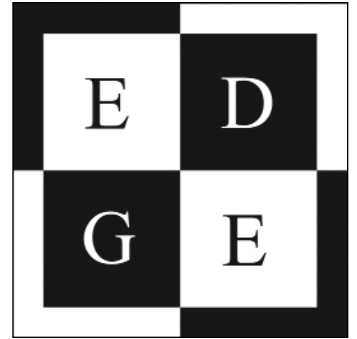

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (3-23) play the finale of their two-game series and their four-game homestand with today's affair against the second-place Syracuse Chiefs (16-10) -- who are 5-0 against the 'Pigs this season. Lehigh Valley has lost three in a row and 12 of its past 13 games -- and is a season-high 14.5 games back in the North Division. Meanwhile, the Chiefs have gone 13-4 after starting 3-6, including an 8-game winning streak April 15-22.

• First-Pitch is at 10:35 a.m. for Education Day, presented by **The Crayola Factory**. Gates will open at 9:25 a.m.

RHP Kevin Beirne (pronounced /burn/), 34, is a 6-4, 210-pound right-hander signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 1/8/07. The Houston native did not pitch in 2007 after having foot surgery following his release from Detroit on 3/9/07. Originally an 11th-round selection by Chicago-AL in 1995, Beirne spent the previous four seasons pitching in Japan. He made his ML debut with the White Sox 5/17/00 at Yankee Stadium and went 1-3, 6.70 in 29 G, 1 GS as a rookie. He has also appeared in the ML with Toronto (0-0, 12.86 in 5 G in 2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2-0, 3.41 in 12 G, 3 GS in 2002). The former Texas A&M attendee lettered twice in football as a WR for the Aggies. His father, Jim, was a WR/TE for the Houston Oilers & San Diego Chargers from 1968-76.

• *This will be Beirne's first start of 2008 & his first in the US since 9/28/02 vs. SD (W, 5.2 ip, 4 h, 2 r, 2 er, 0 bb, 3 k).*

LHP Bill Murphy, 26, is a 5-11, 216-pound left-hander claimed off waivers by Toronto from Arizona on 3/17/08. The Anaheim native was originally selected by Oakland in the 3rd round of the 2002 draft out of Cal State-Northridge in Riverside, CA. He was traded to Florida on 12/23/03 to complete the trade in which Marlins sent LHP Mark Redman to Athletics for RHP Mike Neu and a player to be named later. He was then traded twice prior to the 2004 trade deadline: to Los Angeles-NL with RHP Brad Penny and 1B Hee-Seop Choi on 7/30/04 for C Paul LoDuca, OF Juan Encarnacion and RHP Guillermo Mota. The next day he was traded to Arizona with C Koyie Hill and OF Reggie Abercrombie on 7/31/04 for C Brent Mayne and OF Steve Finley. He was then designated by Arizona during Spring Training. He started 2007 with Tucson and was 3-3, 3.68 in 59 G, 9 GS before his promotion to the Diamondbacks in September -- during which time he went 0-0, 5.68 in 10 G. In 2005, he was a member of Team USA in the regional qualifying event for the 2006 Olympic Games...as a Minor Leaguer in Oakland's system, he tossed a no-hitter on June 10, 2002 while playing for Kane County, falling 2 outs shy of a perfect game.

SERIES STUFF:

SYR leads the season-series, 5-0, after its home sweep 4/19-4/22. The Chiefs also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6. *Going back to last season, Syracuse has won 8 straight games against the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate.*

TRANSACTIONS RECAP:

Yesterday, the Phillies released OF **Valentino Pascucci**. OF **Michael Spidale** was assigned to Reading (AA). RHP **Joe Bisenius** was assigned to Reading (AA). LHP **Travis Blackley** was placed on the Disabled List (right groin). OF **T.J. Bohn** was optioned to Lehigh Valley from Philadelphia Phillies. RHP **Jason Anderson** promoted to Lehigh Valley from Reading and OF **Rich Thompson** was promoted to Lehigh Valley from Reading.

BACON BITS, PT I:

• The IronPigs were shutout for the 5th time last night (2nd time in 3 days they were 2-hit and blanked). It took OTT until 5/28/07 (Game #47) to record their 5th blanking last season. LHV has scored 0-2 R in 16 of 26 (61.5%) games.
 • *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 4 GS, LHV LH starters are a combined 1-0, 0.67 (27 ip, 2 er), .114 OBA (10-88).
 • In their last 4 G on the road, LHV batted .259 w/ 4.25 R/G. In the last 3 G at home, LHV is .135 (12-39) w/ 0.3 R/G.
 • LHV has scored just 57 runs in 26 G, an average of 2.2 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 99 (DUR) -- 42 more.
 • *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 1-17 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
 • *Diet Coke Park?:* The 'Pigs have hit just 2 of their 12 HR at home (none in the past 3 G and 0 in their last 98 AB).

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT II:

- *Relief?:* In the last 7 G, the pen has gone 0-3, 7.67 ERA (27.0 ip, 23 er). In the previous 7 G, it had a 1.40 ERA (25.2 ip, 4 er) w/ 2 SV & 3 holds.
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* The IronPigs bullpen has only stranded 17 of 40 (42.5%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 26-30 (86.7%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 13-13 (100%) saves.

WHO'S HOT:

The longest hitting streaks on the club are at just 2 G (Andy Tracy, Casey Smith)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 13 of the last 15 G and hit safely in 5 of his last 7 G (10-27, .370-2-5)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit a HR in 3 of his last 6 G. In addition, he has reached base safely in his last 8 G and hit safely in 6 of his last 7 G (.280-3-7; 7-25)... Closer **Matt Childers** had his scoreless IP streak snapped at 10.1 last night -- allowing his first ER of the year and picking up his first loss of 2008. He is 2-2 (100%) in SV opps... LHP **J.A. Happ** has turned in 'quality starts' in his last 2 G. Although he doesn't have a win to show for it, he has a 0.64 ERA (14 ip, 1 er) and a .111 OBA (5-45) in those starts while fanning 13 batters in those 2 GS...

OH NO! BACK IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (3-23) have the worst record in MILB. As of Monday, St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) has improved to 4-21 and Nashville (PCL, AAA, MIL) is at 5-18. Meanwhile, Tucson (PCL, AAA, Arizona) has improved to 6-19; Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) is also at 6-19.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 21-2.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 19-54 (.260) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 36-90 (.286) and a combined 43.5 GB.

- As of Monday, Reading was the only team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 35-62, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 143 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

The IronPigs have scored just 57 runs in 26 games, an average of 2.2 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 99 (Durham) -- 42 more than the LHV total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.209) and the team is batting just .148 (26-176) with RISP. The 'Pigs have been shutout 5 times.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

PRESEASON NOTES:

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

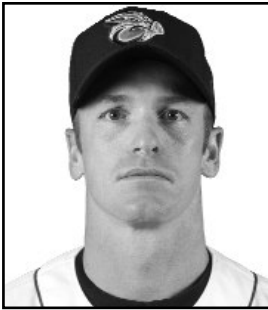
