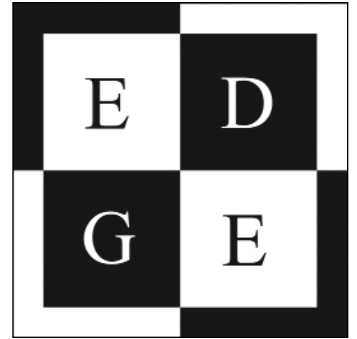

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (6-30) play Game Two of a four-game series with the second-place Columbus Clippers (20-16) at Coca-Cola Park after winning in walk-off fashion, 4-3, in 10 innings last night. The win snapped the IronPigs two-game skid as well as the Clippers' seven-game winning streak. Even so, the 'Pigs remain a season-high 20.0 games back in the North Division. The Clippers -- Triple-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals -- have still won seven of their last eight games and have gone 18-7 since starting 2-9.

• First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. and gates will open at 5:50 p.m. (5:30 p.m. for Club Level) for Baseball Giveaway Series #1, presented by **Kuhnsville Car Wash**. The first 3,500 fans will get a free logo baseball.

RHP **Gary Knotts** -- who is making his first start of the season -- is a 6-4, 215-pound right-hander from Decatur, AL, signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 7/31/07. He started 2007 with the Independent League Newark Bears, where he was an Atlantic League All-Star and led the league in ERA -- going 7-5, 2.65 in 16 GS. He then pitched with both Reading (1-2, 0.86 in 3 GS) and Ottawa (1-2, 5.89 in 3 GS) -- where he fired a 1-0 shutout of Rochester on 8/30 for the 1,000th victory in Lynx franchise history. Originally selected by Florida in the 11th round of 1995, Knotts made his ML debut 7/28/01 at CIN and has four years of ML service with the Marlins and the Detroit Tigers (13-16, 5.45 and 2 SV in 86 G, 38 GS).

RHP **Steven Shell**, 25, is a 6-5, 190-pound right-hander out of Cleburne, TX, signed by Washington as a minor league free agent 11/22/07 -- and invitee to ML Spring Training. Originally a 3rd-round pick by Los Angeles-A in 2001 out of El Reno (OK) HS, Shell spent the majority of 2007 with Salt Lake (AAA), going 7-3, 4.73 in 31 G, 7 GS. He started the season with Arkansas (0-0, 0.68 in 5 G) before a promotion on 4/13/07. Shell was a member of the California League All-Star Team in 2003 & 2004 with Rancho Cucamonga.

• *Shell is coming off his first start of '08, a no-decision in a 7-6 win 5/5 vs. ROC: 5.0 ip, 6 h, 5 r, 5 er, 0 bb, 3 k.*

## SERIES STUFF:

COL leads the season-series, 3-2, after taking the first series at Cooper Stadium 5/1-5/4. COL won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 5-3 (2-2 on the road).

## WHO'S HOT:

The offense is heating up, having batted .279 (50-179) in the last 5 G... 1B **Andy Tracy**'s franchise-record 11-game hitting streak came to an end last night (0-3, 2 BB). Tracy has still reached base safely in his last 18 G and hit in 11 of his last 12 G (13-45, .289-2-7)... OF **Jon Knott** has a 6-G hitting streak (11-24, .458-2-3, 4 2B) with 4 multi-hit G. He has reached base safely in all 7 G as an IronPig... 3B **Brennan King** has a 4-G hit streak (7-21, 2B)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (9-25, .360-1-3, 2 2B, 3B, 6 R)... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 G (13-32, .406, 8 R)... LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 3 consecutive starts and now owns 80% of LHV's wins. In his last 5 GS, Mazone is 4-1, 1.65 (32.2 ip, 27 h, 9 r, 6 er, 8 bb, 13 k)... With a franchise-high 13 K last night, LHP **J.A. Happ** leads the IL with 55 K. In his last 4 GS, Happ has gone just 0-1 but with a 0.67 ERA (27 ip, 2 er, 31 k) and a .156 OBA (14-90)...

## TRANSACTIONS:

RHP **Kevin Beirne** was released Thursday. The Phillies acquired both SS **Mike Rouse** (.234-3-9 in 24 G with Charlotte) and LHP **Steven Randolph** (0-1, 1.23 with 2 SV in 11 G with Round Rock) and assigned them to Lehigh Valley yesterday. INF **Joey Hammond** was assigned to Reading.

## BACON BITS, PT. I:

• *Firsts!*: LHV had its first: 1) walk-off victory, 2) extra-innings win, and 3) win in a 1-R game in last night's 4-3 defeat of COL.  
 • Tonight, the IronPigs will look to win back-to-back games for the second time this season and for the second time in a span of 45 games (going back to last season, starting after the Lynx won two straight games 8/21/07-8/21/07).  
 • *Damn Yankees!*: With SWB's comeback win last night, LHV has yet to gain 1.0 G on first place in '08 (36 days).

# MORE TEAM NOTES

## BACON BITS, PT. II:

- *A Case of the Runs!*: LHV has scored 25 R in the past 5 G -- an AVG of 5.0 R/G. They averaged just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 G of 2008.
- *Hit Parade*: The team is batting .279 (50-179, 6 HR) in the last 5 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .224. They're also batting .295 (13-44) w/ RISP in the 5 G. LHV's 15 hits on Wednesday night was a franchise-high (prev. 14 on 4/19 @ SYR).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 10 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 3-3, 1.33 (61.0 ip, 9 er) w/ a .160 OBA (33-206).
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 0-8 with a 9.73 ERA in their last 9 GS (37.0 ip, 40 er).
- *Relief?*: In the past 6 G, the LHV bullpen is 1-1, 2 BS, 11.50 ERA (18 ip, 23 er). In the previous 3 G, the pen had a 1.54 ERA (11.2 ip, 2 er).
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 26 of 58 (44.8%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 40-49 (81.6%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 19-19 (100%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!*: The IronPigs have 10 sacrifices (6 bunts, 4 flies) in the past 9 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.
- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).

## TOUGH STARTING SCHEDULE:

The seven IL teams the IronPigs have faced this season have a 140-102 (.579) record. EVEN IF YOU TAKE OUT THEIR GAMES AGAINST LEHIGH VALLEY, THEIR OPPONENTS ARE STILL 110-97 (.531). The other six IL teams the IronPigs have yet to face are just 95-108 (.468).

## IN THE ma-ZONE!:

Steve Carlton, anyone? 'Lefty' **Brian Mazone** has won 3 consecutive starts and now owns 80% of LHV's wins. In his last 5 GS, Mazone is 4-1 with a 1.65 ERA (32.2 ip, 27 h, 9 r, 6 er, 8 bb, 13 k). In 1972, **Steve Carlton** won the NL Cy Young Award winning 27 G for a team whose final record was 59-97 (46% -- a modern-day ML record). In his IL career, Mazone is 20-8, 2.26 ERA in 33 GS (210.2 ip, 53 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning%!

## TRAPPED IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (6-30) continue to own the worst record in MILB -- trailing 8-26 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) by 3.0 games. No other team has fewer than 10 wins. Lexington (South Atlantic, A, HOU) is 10-24; Tuscon (PCL, AAA, AZ) is 11-25; Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) is 11-24 and New Hampshire (Eastern, AA, TOR) is 11-22. In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 27-7.

• *The 6-30 start puts LHV on pace to go just 21-123 (.146). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

• According to ESPN's Jayson Stark, the worst winning percentage in Minor League history is .127 by the 1951 Granite Falls Graniteers (14-96) of the Western Carolina League. That team lost its last 33 games and 59 of their its last 60.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 22-60 (.268) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 39-96 (.289) and a combined 48.0 GB

- No team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 53-86, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

## THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 153 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

## STRUGGLING TO SCORE:

For the season, the IronPigs have scored just 97 runs in 36 games, an average of 2.7 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 133 (DUR) -- 36 more than the Lehigh Valley total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.224) and the team is batting just .175 (46-263) with RISP. The 'Pigs have already been shutout five times and have scored 0-2 R in 18 of 36 (50.0%) of their games

## SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

## PRESEASON NOTES:

### HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. 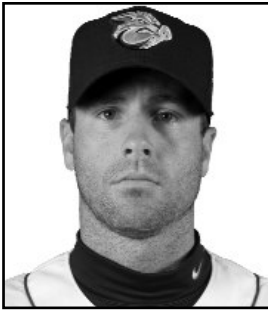
