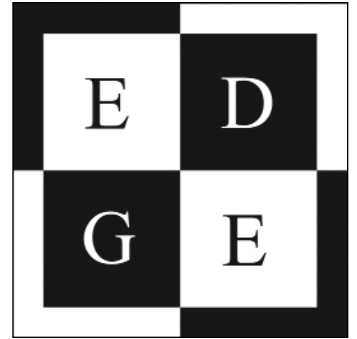

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (8-31) will play Game One of a four-game series at Coca-Cola Park with the Norfolk Tides (13-24), who own the second-worst record in the International League. Lehigh Valley lost last night, 6-3, but still took three-of-four from the Columbus Clippers (who had come in with a seven-game winnings streak) to start this eight-game homestand. With SWB sweeping a doubleheader last night, the 'Pigs are again a season-high 20.0 games back in the North Division. The Tides -- Triple-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles -- come to Allentown with a seven-game losing streak after being swept in four games at Pawtucket. They have gone just 2-12 in their last 14 games.

* First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. and gates will open at 5:50 p.m. (5:30 p.m. for Club Level).

1-2-3...CONTACT!:

The IronPigs first-ever, three-game winning streak came to an end last night... but was the longest streak by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an dubious string of 156 games without back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

LHP **Les Walrond** will make his third IronPigs appearance after starting the season with the Iowa Cubs (PCL, AAA) -- where he went 1-1, 6.55 in 7 G, 0 GS. Walrond, 31, is a 6-3, 205-pound left-hander out of Tulsa, OK, who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 4/29/08. Originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of 1998 out of University of Kansas, Walrond spent the 2007 season exclusively in Iowa, where he was 11-5, 4.77 in 27 G, 24 GS. He made his ML debut with Kansas City on 6/8/03 and later appeared in 10 G with Chicago-N in 2006. In his ML career, Walrond has gone 0-3, 7.46 in 17 G, 2 GS (25.1 ip, 30 h, 22 r, 21 er, 19 bb, 27 k).

RHP **Jon Leicester**, 29, is a 6-2, 220-pound right-hander out of Huntington Beach, CA, signed by Baltimore as a minor league free agent 11/3/06. He was original selected by Chicago-N in the 11th round of 2000 out of University of Memphis University (majored in communications). Leicester spent much of last season on the Orioles 60-Day DL (posterior deltoid) but made 10 appearances with Baltimore (2-3, 7.59 in 10 G, 5 GS) and 13 with Norfolk (3-3, 2.22 in 13 G, 11 GS). He made his ML debut with the Cubs 6/9/04 vs. STL and earned his first ML win 6/13/04. In his ML career, Leicester has gone 7-6, 5.88 in 48 G, 6 GS with 1 CG (9/23/07 at Texas).

SERIES STUFF:

First-ever meeting between the clubs. NOR won the 2007 season series vs. OTT, 6-2, going 3-1 both home & away.

WHO'S HOT:

The offense is heating up, having batted .262 (72-275) in the last 8 G. LHV has averaged 4.5 R/G in the last 8 G (36) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 G of 2008. .. 1B **Andy Tracy's** franchise-record 11-G hitting streak came to an end Thursday and his streak of reaching base safely in 19 G snapped Sunday (0-1 as PH)... OF **Jon Knott**, who has walk-off GW hits in 2 of the last 4 G, now has an 9-G hitting streak (15-33, .455-2-5, 5 2B, .788 SLG) with 5 multi-hit G. He has reached base safely in all 10 G as an IronPig... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 G (17-41, .415, 11 R)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has at least 1 RBI in each of his last 5 GS (.375-0-7, 9-24)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 6 of his last 7 starts (9-27, .333-1-3, 2 2B, 3B, 6 R)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 6 of his last 8 G (9-29, .310-0-2) and hasn't committed an error in his last 20 G... With a franchise-high 13 K on Thursday, LHP **J.A. Happ** leads the IL with 55 K. In his last 4 GS, Happ has gone just 0-1 but with a 0.67 ERA (27 ip, 2 er, 31 k) and a .156 OBA (14-90)... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a R in his first 2 G and 3.0 IP with LHV. He has a personal 6.1 scoreless IP streak... LHP **R.J. Swindle** has not allowed a R in his first 3 G and 3.2 IP with LHV. He has a personal 12.0 scoreless IP streak...

BACON BITS, PT I:

* After losing their first 10 series, the IronPigs just won their first series in franchise history, 3-games-to-1 vs COL.
 * *Resilient Pigs:* LHV is 4-3 in their last 7 G (2 comebacks). Even in the 3 Ls, the tying R came to the plate in the 9th.

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT II:

- *Now that's Relief!*: After the BS on Friday night, the LHV bullpen went 11.2 scoreless IP. Since then, the corps is 3-0 with a 0.56 ERA (16 ip, 1 er).
- *A Case of the Runs!*: LHV has scored 33 R in the past 7 G -- an AVG of 4.7 R/G. They averaged just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 G of 2008.
- *Hit Parade*: The team is batting .262 (72-275, 6 HR) in the last 8 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .225. They're also batting .304 (21-69) w/ RISP in the 8 G. LHV's 15 hits last Wednesday night was a franchise-high (prev. 14 on 4/19 @ SYR).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 10 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 3-3, 1.88 (67.0 ip, 14 er) w/ a .183 OBA (42-229).
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 0-9 with a 9.28 ERA in their last 11 GS (43.2 ip, 45 er).
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 28 of 60 (46.7%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 41-50 (82.0%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 20-21 (95.2%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!*: The IronPigs have 13 sacrifices (8 bunts, 5 flies) in the past 12 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.
- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).

IN THE ma-ZONE!

Steve Carlton, anyone? 'Lefty' **Brian Mazone** has won 3 consecutive decisions and owns 50.0% of LHV's wins. In his last 6 GS, Mazone is 4-1 with a 2.56 ERA (38.2 ip, 36 h, 14 r, 11 er, 10 bb, 15 k). In 1972, **Steve Carlton** won the NL Cy Young Award winning 27 G for a team whose final record was 59-97 (46% -- a modern-day ML record). In his IL career, Mazone is 20-8, 2.41 ERA in 34 GS (216.2 ip, 58 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning%!

- Along with a PH appearance by Mazone on 5/10 vs. Columbus, the IronPigs are now 6-3 in games in which Mazone appears.

TRYING TO ESCAPE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (8-31) continue to own the worst record in MILB -- trailing 8-29 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) by just 1.0 game. No other team has fewer than 10 wins. Lexington (South Atlantic, A, HOU) is 12-24; Tuscon (PCL, AAA, AZ) is 12-27; Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) is 13-25.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 30-7.
- *The 8-31 start puts LHV on pace to go just 30-114 (.210). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*
- According to ESPN's Jayson Stark, the worst winning percentage in Minor League history is .127 by the 1951 Granite Falls Graniteers (14-96) of the Western Carolina League. That team lost its last 33 games and 59 of their its last 60.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 24-61 (.282) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 41-97 (.297) and a combined 48.0 GB

- One team in the Phillies system is above .500. The farm system combined is 58-91, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE:

For the season, the IronPigs have scored just 108 runs in 39 games, an average of 2.8 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 145 (SYR) -- 37 more than the Lehigh Valley total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.225) and the team is batting just .188 (54-288) with RISP. The 'Pigs have already been shutout five times and have scored 0-2 R in 19 of 39 (48.7%) of their games

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

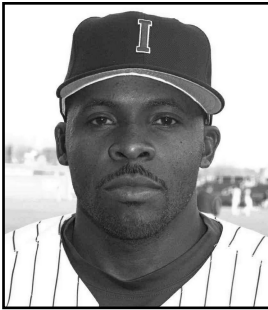
