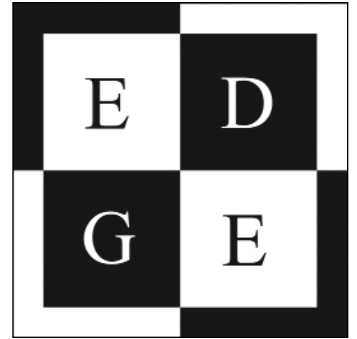

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (11-32) travel for a four-game series with the fourth-place Buffalo Bisons (19-23) at Dunn Tire Park. Lehigh Valley finished the homestand at 6-2 but had their three-game winning streak snapped by blowing a 5-2 lead in a 9-6 loss to Norfolk last night. The 'Pigs are 18.0 games back in the North. The Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) just split a series with Pawtucket (won last night, 4-2) and have gone 12-7 since starting the season at 7-16. First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m.

1-2-3...CONTACT!:

During their eight-game homestand (Columbus, Norfolk), the IronPigs had a pair of three-game winning streaks -- significant because the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate went a dubious string of 156 games without back-to-back-to-back wins (since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07). The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four (4/14-4/19/07).

RHP **Ron Chiavacci**, 30, is a 175-pound right-hander out of Scranton, Pa., who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 11/20/07. An anchor of Western Division Champion Toledo's rotation, Chiavacci finished the 2007 season 3rd in the I.L. in wins (12), 4th in strikeouts (126) and 5th in ERA (3.39) -- in all he finished 12-6 in 26 G, 23 GS (151.1 ip, 148 h, 64 r, 57 er, 43 bb, 126 k). He was originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 44th round of the 1998 Draft. The Kutztown University product had the honor of starting the exhibition game versus the Phillies 3/30 (L, 5 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 5 k). He held Ryan Howard 0-2 with a strikeout (looking). Chiavacci also had an IronPigs franchise record 17.1 scoreless IP streak earlier this season over a span of four starts (4/5-4/19).

• After starting 1-0, 0.59 (.200) in his first 3 GS, Chiavacci is 0-4, 8.25 (24.0 ip, 22 er, 34-96, .354) in his last 5 GS.

RHP **Jeff Harris**, 33, is a 6-1, 190-pound right-hander out of Alameda, CA, signed by Cleveland as a minor league free agent 12/13/06. The journeyman made his ML debut with Seattle in 2005 (2-5, 4.19 in 11 G, 8 GS) after spending 2001-03 in Independent League baseball (Chico in 2001-02; Quebec in 2003) and starting 2004 with Aquascalints (Mexican). He spent all of 2007 with Buffalo, going 6-9, 4.68 in 27 G, 22 GS. He is 81-48, 3.51 in his MILB career.

• Harris lost his last appearance (in relief) 5/12 @ ROC (L, 5-1): L, 2.0 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 4 er, 0 bb, 2 k.

• Harris won his last start, 4-1, on 4/26 vs. PAW: W, 6.0 ip, 5 h, 1 r, 1 er, 1 bb, 6 k. In 2 GS, he is 1-0, 1.93 ERA.

SERIES STUFF:

This is the first-ever meeting between the clubs. BUF & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 8-8 (4-4 at each venue).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .275 (111-404, 10 HR) in the last 12 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .232. They have averaged 5.1 R/G (61) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .315 (34-108) w/ RISP in the 12 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations.

WHO'S HOT:

OF **Jon Knott** snapped his franchise-record 12-game hitting streak last night (0-3, 2 BB). He has hit in 12 of his last 13 G (19-44, .432-2-7, 5 2B, .682 SLG) and Knott now is 8-12 with 5 BB with RISP... 1B **Andy Tracy** had a franchise-record 5 RBI last night and has a 4-G hit streak (5-12, .417-2-7) and has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 G. He would have reached in 25 straight but had his streak halted at 19 as a PH on 5/11... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 G (20-50, .400, 14 R). He has multi-hit G in 6 of his last 9 G and has scored at least 1 R in 8 of his last 9 G (12 R)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 5 of last 6 G (10-25, .400-0-9) and has a 6-G R streak (9 R). His 8-start RBI streak ended last night... OF **Rich Thompson** has 3 multi-hit G in his last 4 G (6-17) and has hit in 9 of his last 11 starts (15-44, .341-1-4, 3 2B, 2 3B, 9 R)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 10 of his last 12 G (13-43, .302-0-5) and hasn't committed an error in his last 24 G... LHP **Les Walrond** has not allowed a R in his last 9.1 IP... LHP **Steve Kline** has not allowed a R in his last 4 appearances (6.1 IP)... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a R in his first 3 G and 4.1 IP with LHV. He has a personal 7.2 scoreless IP streak...

BACON BITS:

- *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
- The IronPigs were 5 outs away from their first-ever sweep and the first four-game series sweep by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since SWB swept OTT (Baltimore) at home from 7/29/06-8/1/06.
- After losing their first 10 series, the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has won back-to-back series for the first time since 4/17-4/26/07 (when OTT took 3-of-4 from both CHA & SWB). They went 45 series without taking two straight. They now look to win 3 straight series for the first time since SWB won three in a row 8/21-8/30/06 (at BUF, BUF, SYR).
- *Bullpen Boof:* The IronPigs pen was very strong over the homestand but was handed a BS and a L last night (3 ip, 7 r, 5 er). After a BS last Friday, the bullpen corps had gone 3-0, 0.69, 3 SV (26 ip, 2 er) in the previous 6+ G.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 13 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 5-3, 2.12 (85.0 ip, 20 er) w/ a .211 OBA (63-298).
- *...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-9 with a 8.69 ERA in their last 12 GS (48.2 ip, 47 er).
- *Though Shalt Not Steal?:* In the first 20 G, LHV catchers had thrown out just 2 of 25 (8%) SB attempts (and the pitchers had 2 POs that led to CSs). Since 4/23 (last 23 G), LHV catchers have gunned down 12 of 35 (34%) SB attempts (and the pitchers added 6 POs that led to CSs). During the span, C **Jason Jaramillo** improved from 1-19 (5.3%) to 12-50 (24%) by gunning down 11 of the last 31 (35.5%) SB attempts.
- *One-derful:* After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 4-0 in their last 4 such G.
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 30 of 63 (47.6%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 41-52 (78.8%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 20-21 (95.2%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!:* The 'Pigs have 17 sacrifices (10 bunts, 7 flies) in the past 16 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

IN THE ma-ZONE!: Steve Carlton, anyone? Even though his won was blown last night, 'Lefty' **Brian Mazzone** has won 3 straight decisions and owns 36.4% of LHV's wins. In his last 7 GS, Mazzone is 4-1, 2.62 ERA (44.2 ip, 45 h, 16 r, 13 er, 10 bb, 20 k). In 1972, **Steve Carlton** won the NL Cy Young Award winning 27 G for a team whose final record was 59-97 (46% -- a modern-day ML record). In his IL career, Mazzone is 20-8, 2.47 ERA in 35 GS (222.2 ip, 60 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning%!

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 6-4 in games in which Mazzone appears.

OUT OF THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (11-32) are no longer own the worst record in MiLB as they have a 2.0-game lead over the 8-33 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM).

• *The 11-32 start puts LHV on pace to go 37-107 (.257). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

• According to ESPN's Jayson Stark, the worst winning percentage in MiLB history is .127 by the 1951 Granite Falls Graniteers (14-96) of the Western Carolina League. That team lost its last 33 games and 59 of their last 60.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 27-62 (.303) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 44-98 (.310) and a combined 46.0 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
