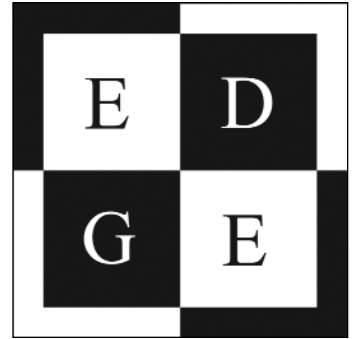

TONIGHT'S GAMES:

After a rain out on Sunday, the IronPigs (11-33) have their first doubleheader in franchise history when they play Games Two and Three of a four-game series with the fourth-place Buffalo Bisons (20-23) at Dunn Tire Park. Lehigh Valley dropped its second straight game with a 5-2 loss in the series opener Saturday night -- and the 'Pigs are now 1-19 against the Northern Division and are 18.5 games back in the North. The Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) won their second straight game and are 13-7 since starting the season at 7-16. First-Pitch is at 5:30 p.m.

PITCHING MATCHUP - GAME ONE:

LHP **Les Walrond** will make his third IronPigs appearance after starting the season with the Iowa Cubs (PCL, AAA) -- where he went 1-1, 6.55 in 7 G, 0 GS. Walrond, 31, is a 6-3, 205-pound left-hander out of Tulsa, OK, who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 4/29/08. Originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of 1998 out of University of Kansas, Walrond spent the 2007 season exclusively in Iowa, where he was 11-5, 4.77 in 27 G, 24 GS. He made his ML debut with Kansas City on 6/8/03 and later appeared in 10 G with Chicago-N in 2006. In his ML career, Walrond has gone 0-3, 7.46 in 17 G, 2 GS (25.1 ip, 30 h, 22 r, 21 er, 19 bb, 27 k).

• *Last time out, Walrond started the first and only SHO in LHV history in a 7-0 win 5/13 vs. NOR (7 ip, 5 h, 5 k)*

RHP **Brian Slocum**, 27, is a 6-3, 210-pound right-hander selected by Cleveland in the 2nd round (63rd overall) in the 2002 draft out of Villanova (only third player ever selected as high as 2nd round from Villanova). A native of East Rochelle, NY, Slocum sent most of 2007 on the DL after suffering a forearm injury on 5/11. He started the season 2-2, 4.15 ERA in 5 G, 5 GS. Slocum made his ML debut 4/22/06 @ KC (2 ip, 3 h, 2 r, 2er, 2 bb, 2 k). In all, he appeared in 8 G, 2 GS with the Indians in 2006 going 0-0, 5.60 ERA in 17.2 IP. Slocum led the Carolina League in wins (15) in 2004.

• *Slocum didn't figure in the decision his last start, a 6-5 BUF win on 5/13 v. PAW: n/d, 4.1 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 4 er, 3 bb, 2 k.*

PITCHING MATCHUP - GAME TWO:

LHP **Travis Blackley**, 25, is a 6-3, 200-lb lefthander who was selected by the Phillies from San Francisco in the Rule 5 draft, 12/6/07 -- and outrighted to Lehigh Valley when the Giants declined to take him back at the end of Spring Training. The Australia native appeared in two games with San Francisco (0-0, 7.27 ERA in 8.2 ip) last year after spending the bulk of his season with the Fresno Grizzlies (10-8, 4.66 ERA, 28 gs, 161.2 ip, 156 h, 87 r, 84 er, 68 bb, 121 k). Blackley was originally signed by Seattle 10/29/00 prior to being traded to SF for OF Jason Ellison on 4/1/07, and he made in to the majors with the Mariners as a 21-year-old in 2004 (won his ML debut in a start 7/1/04 vs. TEX). The Aussie played for the World squad in the 2003 Futures Game at Cellular Field (Chi) and was on Australia's provisional roster for the inaugural World Baseball Classic. *Blackley did not face Toledo in 2007.*

LHP **Jason Stanford**, 31, is a 6-1, 209-lb lefthander who was acquired by Cleveland in April after starting the year with the Columbus Clippers (2-2, 10.05 in 5 G, 3 GS). The native of Tucson, AZ, was originally signed by Cleveland as a non-drafted free agent 11/16/99 out of UNC-Charlotte (where he was 2-time Conference USA selection) before being signed by Washington 11/17/07. He spent a bulk on 2007 in Buffalo, going 5-1, 4.11 in 18 G, 14 GS with some time up in Cleveland (1-1, 4.78 in 8 G, 2 GS). Last year, he became only player in the modern era to play for Buffalo in 7 straight seasons and set Bisons modern-day record for strikeouts. The 2003 IL All-Star made ML debut at 7/6/03 at MIN and earned first ML win 9/26/03 at TOR (tossing 6.0 shutout innings). He began 2004 as member of CLE's starting rotation, but season was cut short after undergoing Tommy John surgery (James Andrews on 7/29/04). Stanford has twice pitched for Team USA (2003 Olympic Trials in Panama, 2001 in Chinese Taipei).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .267 (116-435, 10 HR) in the last 13 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .230. They have averaged 4.8 R/G (63) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .300 (36-120) w/ RISP in the 13 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations.

WHO'S HOT:

OF **Jon Knott** snapped his franchise-record 12-game hitting streak Friday, but he has hit in 12 of his last 14 G (19-47, .404-2-7, 5 2B, .638 SLG) and Knott now is 8-13 with 5 BB with RISP. He has reached base safely in all 15 G with LHV... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit safely and scored at least 1 R in each of his last 5 G (8-21, .381, 7 R). He has also hit in 12 of his last 14 G (21-54, .389, 15 R) and has scored at least 1 R in 9 of his last 10 G (13 R)... INF Oscar Robles has a 5-G hitting streak (6-18, .333)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (5-16, .313-2-7) and has reached base safely in 24 of his last 26 G... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (11-28, .393-0-10) and scored at least 1 R in 6 of 7 (9 R). He has at least 1 RBI in 9 of his last 10 starts... OF **Rich Thompson** has 3 multi-hit G in his last 4 G (6-17) and has hit in 9 of his last 11 starts (15-44, .341-1-4, 3 2B, 2 3B, 9 R)... 3B **Brennan King** hasn't committed an error in his last 25 G... LHP **Les Walrond** has not allowed a R in his last 9.1 IP... LHP **Steve Kline** has not allowed a R in his last 5 appearances (7.2 IP)... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a R in his first 3 G and 4.1 IP with LHV. He has a personal 7.2 scoreless IP streak...

BACON BITS:

- *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 1-19 against their fellow North Division foes (1-15 on the road).
- LHV has lost 2 in a row -- both after leading by at least 2 R at one point (12th time opponent has a comeback W).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 13 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 5-3, 2.12 (85.0 ip, 20 er) w/ a .211 OBA (63-298).
- *...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-10 with a 8.46 ERA in their last 13 GS (55.1 ip, 52 er).
- *Bullpen Boof:* The IronPigs pen was very strong over the homestand but was handed a BS and a L on Friday (3 ip, 7 r, 5 er). After a BS last Friday, the bullpen corps had gone 3-0, 0.69, 3 SV (26 ip, 2 er) in the previous 6+ G.
- *Though Shalt Not Steal?:* In the first 20 G, LHV catchers had thrown out just 2 of 25 (8%) SB attempts (and the pitchers had 2 POs that led to CSs). Since 4/23 (last 24 G), LHV catchers have gunned down 12 of 36 (33.3%) SB attempts (and the pitchers added 6 POs that led to CSs). During the span, C **Jason Jaramillo** improved from 1-19 (5.3%) to 12-50 (24%) by gunning down 11 of the last 31 (35.5%) SB attempts.
- *One-derful:* After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 4-0 in their last 4 such G.
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 30 of 64 (46.9%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 41-52 (78.8%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 21-22 (95.5%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!:* The 'Pigs have 18 sacrifices (10 bunts, 8 flies) in the past 17 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

IN THE ma-ZONE!: Steve Carlton, anyone? Even though his won was blown last night, 'Lefty' **Brian Mazone** has won 3 straight decisions and owns 36.4% of LHV's wins. In his last 7 GS, Mazone is 4-1, 2.62 ERA (44.2 ip, 45 h, 16 r, 13 er, 10 bb, 20 k). In 1972, **Steve Carlton** won the NL Cy Young Award winning 27 G for a team whose final record was 59-97 (46% -- a modern-day ML record). In his IL career, Mazone is 20-8, 2.47 ERA in 35 GS (222.2 ip, 60 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning%!

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 6-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

OUT OF THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (11-33) are no longer own the worst record in MiLB as they have a 2.5-game lead over the 8-34 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM).

• *The 11-33 start puts LHV on pace to go 36-108 (.250). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

• According to ESPN's Jayson Stark, the worst winning percentage in MiLB history is .127 by the 1951 Granite Falls Graniteers (14-96) of the Western Carolina League. That team lost its last 33 games and 59 of their last 60.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 27-63 (.300) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 44-99 (.308) and a combined 46.0 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

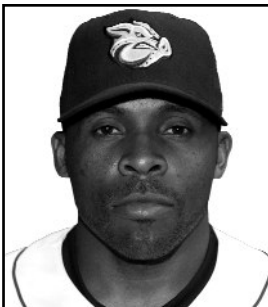

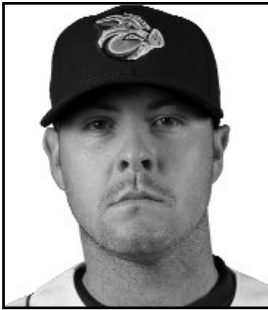
