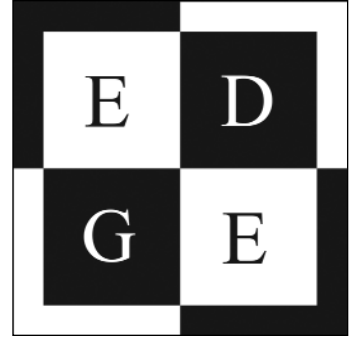

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (12-34) will play the finale of a four-game series with the fourth-place Buffalo Bisons (21-24) at Dunn Tire Park. Lehigh Valley split its first-ever doubleheader last night, losing Game One, 3-2, but taking Game Two, 9-1 -- snapping a three-game losing streak. The 'Pigs are now 2-20 against the Northern Division and pulled to 18.0 games back in the North. The Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) had a three-game winning streak snapped in the 'night cap' but are still 14-8 since starting the season at 7-16. First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m.

- With a win tonight, the IronPigs will have 'not lost' a road series for the first time this season (currently 0-6 in their road series). They will also have won or split in three straight series after losing the first 10 in team history.
- The IronPigs have a day off tomorrow then start an 8-game homestand featuring Charlotte & Indianapolis.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

**LHP J.A. Happ** (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only ML start on 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland.

- *Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is the most in the IL this season. He currently leads the league with 61 K\*\*.*
- *In his last 5 GS, Happ has gone just 1-1 but with a 1.69 ERA (32 ip, 6 er, 37 k) and a .193 OBA (21-109).*

**RHP Adam Miller**, 23, is a 6-4, 200-pound right-hander selected by Cleveland in the 1st round (31st overall) in the 2003 draft out of McKinney (TX) HS. Ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 1 Prospect in the Cleveland system, Miller spent all of last season with Buffalo, going 5-4, 4.82 in 19 G, 11 GS -- though limited to just 65.1 IP because of a pair of injuries (bruised ligament in rt. middle finger; rt. elbow inflammation). He did make two appearances for Double-A Akron in the 2007 Eastern League Playoffs. The 2006 EL Pitcher of the Year led the EL in wins, going 15-6, 2.75 in 26 G, 24 GS. He originally committed to attend University of Arizona prior to signing with the Indians.

- *Miller was a tough-luck loser his last start, 5/15 vs. PAW-G1 (L, 2-0): L, 6.0 ip, 2 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 2 k.*

## \*\*STRIKEOUT KINGS:

The Phillies have 3 of the Top 5 strikeout pitchers in all of MILB: (1) **Antonio Bastardo**, 67 (REA, EL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 65 (LAK, SAL); (3) Trevor Cahill, 62 (STO, CAL); (T4) **J.A. Happ**, 61; (T4) Thomas Hanson, 61 (MIS, SOU).

## GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .265 (130-491, 11 HR) in the last 15 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .231. They have averaged 4.9 R/G (74) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .311 (41-132) w/ RISP in the 15 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .211 for the season.

## WHO'S HOT:

The LHV **bullpen** has not allowed a R in the series (7.2 ip)... OF **Brandon Watson** has a 7-G hitting & 7-G run streak (12-28, .429, 9 R). He has also hit in 14 of his last 16 G (25-61, .410, 18 R) and has scored at least 1 R in 11 of his last 12 G (15 R)... INF **Oscar Robles** also has a 7-G hit streak (8-24, .333)... OF **Jon Knott** has reached base safely in all 17 G with LHV... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (8-23, .348-2-9) and has reached base safely in 26 of his last 28 G... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 7 of his last 9 G (14-35, .400-2-12) and scored at least 1 R in 8 of 9 (12 R). He has at least 1 RBI in 10 of his last 12 starts... 3B **Brennan King** hasn't committed an error in his last 26 G...

## THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a R in his last 7.2 ip and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 3 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has not allowed a R in his last 5 G (7.2 ip)... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a R in his first 4 G and 5.1 IP with LHV. He has a personal 8.2 scoreless IP streak...

## SERIES STUFF:

BUF leads the season series, 2-1. BUF & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 8-8 (4-4 at each venue).

## BACON BITS:

- The 9 R in Game Two last night were a season-high for the IronPigs (prev. 8 on 5/14 vs. NOR); the 7 runs in the 3rd inning and the 10 men to the plate were also season-highs (prev. 4 R on 5 occasions and 9 men 4/22 @ SYR).
- *Fast Starts:* The IronPigs have scored in the first inning of all 3 games in the series (2 runs each in the past 2 G).
- *Gotta have Heart!:* Since the arrival of **Jon Knott** on 5/2, the IronPigs heart of the lineup (Cervanak-Tracy-Knott) has combined to go .315-7-39 (57-181, 11 2B, 28 BB, .492 SLG, .407 OBP) in 19 G.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F:* Even though the IronPigs pen had a BS and a L on Friday (3 ip, 5 er), the relief corps has gone 4-1, 1.72, 3 SV (36.2 ip, 7 er) in the last 10+ G.
- *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 2-20 against their fellow North Division foes (2-16 on the road).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 15 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 5-4, 2.36 (91.2 ip, 24 er) w/ a .227 OBA (74-326).
- *...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-10 with a 8.46 ERA in their last 13 GS (55.1 ip, 52 er).
- *Though Shalt Not Steal?:* In the first 20 G, LHV catchers had thrown out just 2 of 25 (8%) SB attempts (and the pitchers had 2 POs that led to CSs). Since 4/23 (last 26 G), LHV catchers have gunned down 12 of 37 (32.4%) SB attempts (and the pitchers added 6 POs that led to CSs). During the span, C **Jason Jaramillo** improved from 1-19 (5.3%) to 12-50 (24%) by gunning down 11 of the last 31 (35.5%) SB attempts.
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 32 of 66 (48.5%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 42-53 (79.2%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 22-23 (95.6%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!:* The 'Pigs have 19 sacrifices (10 bunts, 9 flies) in the past 19 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

*IN THE ma-ZONE!:* Steve Carlton, anyone? Even though his win was blown last start, 'Lefty' **Brian Mazone** has won 3 straight decisions and owns 33.3% of LHV's wins. In his last 7 GS, Mazone is 4-1, 2.62 ERA (44.2 ip, 45 h, 16 r, 13 er, 10 bb, 20 k). In 1972, **Steve Carlton** won the NL Cy Young Award winning 27 G for a team whose final record was 59-97 (46% -- a modern-day ML record). In his IL career, Mazone is 20-8, 2.47 ERA in 35 GS (222.2 ip, 60 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning%!

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 6-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

## OUT OF THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (12-34) are no longer own the worst record in MiLB as they have a 3.0-game lead over the 8-34 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM).

- *The 12-34 start puts LHV on pace to go 38-106 (.261). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

- According to ESPN's Jayson Stark, the worst winning percentage in MiLB history is .127 by the 1951 Granite Falls Graniteers (14-96) of the Western Carolina League. That team lost its last 33 games and 59 of their last 60.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 28-64 (.304) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 45-100 (.310) and a combined 45.5 GB

## SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

## PRESEASON NOTES:

### HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
