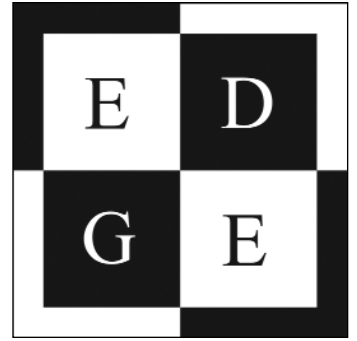

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (13-34) return home for an eight-game homestand to play Game One of a four-game series against the Charlotte Knights (18-27) at Coca-Cola Park. The 'Pigs -- who were off yesterday -- have won two straight games after a dramatic, 6-5, victory in 10 innings on Tuesday in Buffalo. Lehigh Valley has pulled to within 17.0 games in the North Division. The Knights (White Sox affiliate) are in third place in the South Division. They just lost three-of-four against Durham and have lost seven of their last nine games. In fact, the team is just 5-14 after starting 13-13.

• **PHINALLY HEATING UP:** The IronPigs are 7-4 in their last 11 games (after starting 5-30). After losing their first 10 series in franchise history, they have not lost a series in their last three (won two, split one)

• Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. (5:30 p.m. Club Level) for Phillie Phanatic night, presented by **Nazareth Powerhouse Gym**.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Brian Mazone**, 31, is a 6-4, 200-pound left-hander who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/7/07. Mazone actually started 2007 as a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training with the Phillies after leading the International League in ERA (2.03) as a Red Baron in 2006. But after getting off to a fast start with Ottawa (3-2, 2.21 in 6 GS), he had his contract sold to the Samsung Lions of the Korean League on 5/9/07. He finished in Korea by going 7-11 with a 4.18 ERA in 24 GS (125 ip, 130 h, 61 r, 58 er, 45 bb, 76 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 20-8, 2.47 ERA in 35 GS (222.2 ip, 60 er). As a pro, he has gone 76-46 -- a .623 winning percentage.

• In his last 7 GS, Mazone is 4-1, 2.62 ERA (44.2 ip, 45 h, 16 r, 13 er, 10 bb, 20 k).

LHP **Wes Whisler**, 25, is a 6-5, 240-pound left-hander selected by Chicago-A in the 2nd round of the 2004 draft out of UCLA (where he batted .303-34-129, went 11-14, 4.99 in 49 G, 43 GS and was the 2002 Pac-10 Freshman of the Year). The native of Noblesville, IN, spent the entire 2007 season with Birmingham (AA), going 6-13, 5.00 in 28 G, 27 GS. Once ranked by *Baseball America* as having the 'Best Raw Power' and as the 'Best Athlete' (along with Josh Fields) in the White Sox' 2004 draft class, Whisler appeared in 11 G as a hitter in 2004 with Kannapolis (.289-1-5 in 38 AB).

• Whisler won his first 5 GS (5-0, 1.26 ERA)... but has gone 0-1, 3.70 in his last 3 GS.

• Whisler pitched well but had his W blown in his last start, 5/16 vs. SYR (L, 7-2): n/d, 6.0 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 2 bb, 4 k.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .267 (142-532, 11 HR) in the last 16 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .233. They have averaged 5.0 R/G (80) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .299 (43-144) w/ RISP in the 16 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .209 for the season.

WHO'S HOT:

The LHV **bullpen** only allowed 1 R in the Buffalo series, going 2-0, 0.77 with a SV (11.2 ip)... INF **Oscar Robles** has a current team-high 8-G hitting streak (11-28, .393, 6 BB, 6 R). He reached safely in his first 5 AB on Tuesday...

OF **Brandon Watson** had his 7-G hitting & 7-G run streak snapped on Tuesday. Still, he has hit in 14 of his last 17 G (25-66, .379, 18 R) and has scored at least 1 R in 11 of his last 13 G (15 R)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 9 of his last 10 G (18-41, .439-2-13) and scored at least 1 R in 9 of 10 G (14 R). He has at least 1 RBI in 11 of his last 13 starts... OF **Jon Knott** has reached base safely in all 18 G with LHV. With his game-tying, two-out, two-run 3B on Tuesday, he is now 9-16 w/ RISP... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 5 of his last 8 G (8-25, .320-2-9) and has reached base safely in 26 of his last 29 G... 3B **Brennan King** hasn't committed an error in his last 26 G...

THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a run in his last 7.2 IP and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 3 G... LHP **Steve Kline** also has a 7.2 scoreless IP streak in his last 5 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a run in his first 4 G and 5.1 IP with LHV. Combined with Round Rock, he has a personal 8.2 scoreless IP streak and is 1-1, 0.90 ERA and 3 SV.

SERIES STUFF:

This is the first-ever meeting between the two clubs. CHA & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 4-4 (home teams 3-1).

BACON BITS:

- *Extra! Extra!*: The IronPigs are now 2-1 in the extra innings after their 6-5 win in 10 at Buffalo on Tuesday.
- The IronPigs 3-run comeback Tuesday was their second-largest of the season (4 R on 5/14 vs. NOR). It was their first franchise win when training after 5 inning (had been 0-24).
- *Klutch Knott*: The game-tying, 9th-inning, two-out, two-run 3B by **Jon Knott** on Tuesday was his 3rd game-winning/game-tying hit in the 9th inning or later in the past 12 games.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: Even though the IronPigs pen had a BS and a L on Friday (3 ip, 5 er), the relief corps has gone 5-1, 1.55, 4 SV (40.2 ip, 7 er) in the last 11+ G.
- *You're in Good Hands*: LHV has not committed an E in the last 3 G and the Pigs have 0 E in their last 23 innings.
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 5-1 in their last 6 such G.
- The 9 R in Game 2 on Monday were a season-high for the IronPigs (prev. 8 on 5/14 vs. NOR); the 7 runs in the 3rd inning and the 10 men to the plate were also season-highs (prev. 4 R on 5 occasions and 9 men 4/22 @ SYR).
- *Gotta have Heart!*: Since the arrival of **Jon Knott** on 5/2, the IronPigs heart of the lineup (**Mike Cervenak/Andy Tracy/Jon Knott**) has combined to go .320-7-43 (62-194, 11 2B, 3B, 28 BB, .495 SLG, .405 OBP) in 20 games.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 16 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 5-4, 2.58 (97.2 ip, 28 er) w/ a .232 OBA (81-349).
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-10 with a 8.46 ERA in their last 13 GS (55.1 ip, 52 er).
- *Though Shalt Not Steal?*: In the first 20 G, LHV catchers had thrown out just 2 of 25 (8%) SB attempts (and the pitchers had 2 POs that led to CSs). Since 4/23 (last 27 G), LHV catchers have gunned down 13 of 38 (34.2%) SB attempts (and the pitchers added 6 POs that led to CSs). During the span, C **Jason Jaramillo** improved from 1-19 (5.3%) to 13-51 (25.5%) by gunning down 12 of the last 32 (37.5%) SB attempts.
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 32 of 66 (48.5%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 43-56 (76.8%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 22-24 (91.7%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 20 sacrifices (10 bunts, 10 flies) in the past 20 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

PHILLIES PHANNERS:

Although the Phillies farm system still has the worst combined record of the 30 major league teams, Philadelphia does have three of the top four Minor League strikeout leaders – a list that includes IL strikeout leader **J.A. Happ**: (1) **Drew Naylor**, 71 (LAK, SAL); (2) Trevor Cahill, 68 (STO, CAL); (3) **Antonio Bastardo**, 67 (REA, EL); (4) **J.A. Happ**, 66. Happ also holds the single-game high in the IL this season after fanning 13 Clippers on May 9.

OUT OF THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (13-34) are no longer own the worst record in MiLB as they have a 3.5-game lead over the 9-37 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM).

• *The 13-34 start puts LHV on pace to go 40-104 (.277). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 29-64 (.312) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 46-100 (.315) and a combined 44.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard – 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman – 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** – 1,425; (4) Dave Miley – 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet – 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey – 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer – 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones – 1,209.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley – which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

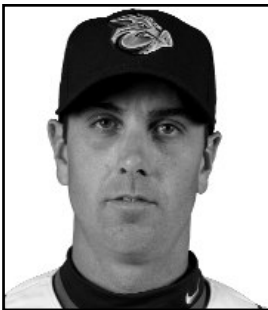
