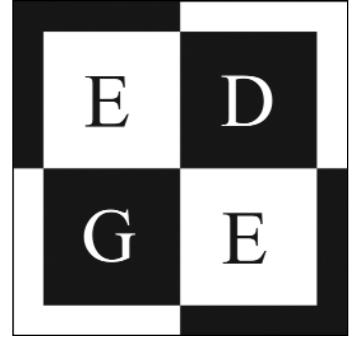

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (14-34) play Game Two of a four-game series against the Charlotte Knights (18-28) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 7-2 victory last night, the 'Pigs have won three straight games and have started their eight-game homestand at 1-0. Lehigh Valley remains 17.0 games in the North Division. The Knights (White Sox affiliate) remain in third place in the South Division but have lost three consecutive games and eight of their last 10 affairs. In fact, the team is just 5-15 after starting 13-13. First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. (5:30 p.m. Club Level) for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by **Chevrolet**.

• **PHINALLY HEATING UP:** The IronPigs are 9-4 in their last 13 games (after starting 5-30). After losing their first 10 series in franchise history, they have not lost a series in their last three (won two, split one)

## IT'S AS EASY AS...1-2-3!:

In the last 13 games, the IronPigs have had a trio of three-game winning streaks -- significant because the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate had previously gone a dubious string of 156 games without back-to-back-to-back wins (since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07). The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four (4/14-4/19/07) and the Triple-A team has not had a five-game winning streak since Scranton/Wilkes-Barre won five-straight 8/11/06-8/15/06.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

RHP **Ron Chiavacci**, 30, is a 175-pound right-hander out of Scranton, Pa., who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 11/20/07. An anchor of Western Division Champion Toledo's rotation, Chiavacci finished the 2007 season 3rd in the I.L. in wins (12), 4th in strikeouts (126) and 5th in ERA (3.39) -- in all he finished 12-6 in 26 G, 23 GS (151.1 ip, 148 h, 64 r, 57 er, 43 bb, 126 k). He was originally drafted by the Montreal Expos in the 44th round of the 1998 Draft. The Kutztown University product had the honor of starting the exhibition game versus the Phillies 3/30 (L, 5 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 5 k). He held Ryan Howard 0-2 with a strikeout (looking). Chiavacci also had an IronPigs franchise record 17.1 scoreless IP streak earlier this season over a span of four starts (4/5-4/19).

• *After starting 1-0, 0.59 (.200) in his first 3 GS, Chiavacci is 0-5, 7.92 (30.2 ip, 27 er, 44-124, .355) in his last 6 GS.*

RHP **Tomo Ohka**, 32, is a 6-1, 200-pound right-hander out of Kyoto, Japan, signed by Chicago-A as a free agent 2/21/08. Originally signed by the Red Sox in 1999 after spending 5 seasons with the Yokohama Bay Stars of the Japanese Central League, Ohka made it to the ML in 1999 and went 3-6, 3.12 in 13 G, 12 GS. He has pitched parts of the last nine seasons in the Majors (Boston, Montreal, Washington, Milwaukee, Toronto) and has a combined record of 50-36, 4.14 ERA in 184 G, 172 GS. He began lasr season with Toronto (2-5, 5.79 in 10 GS) and was designated for assignment by the Blue Jays 6/707. He then signed a minor league contract with St. Louis 6/19/07 and went 0-2, 6.87 in 3 GS with Memphis (AAA). He later signed a minor league contract with Seattle on 8/5/07 and went 0-3, 10.32 in 4 GS with Tacoma (AAA). He pitched a perfect game for Pawtucket on 6/1/00 vs. Charlotte.

## GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .269 (152-566, 12 HR) in the last 17 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .235. They have averaged 5.1 R/G (87) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .303 (47-155) w/ RISP in the 17 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .214 for the season.

## WHO'S HOT:

In the last 5 G, the **LHV bullpen** has gone 2-0, 0.71 with a SV (12.2 ip, 1 er)... INF **Oscar Robles** has a current team-high 8-G hitting streak (11-28, .393, 6 BB, 6 R). He reached safely in his first 5 AB on Tuesday... INF **Mike Cervenak** has a 6-G hit streak (13-25, .520-1-7) hit in 10 of his last 11 G (20-45, .444-2-16) and scored at least 1 R in 10 of 11 G (16 R). He has at least 1 RBI in 12 of his last 14 starts (19 RBI)... OF **Brandon Watson** had his 7-G hitting & run streak snapped on Tuesday. Still, he has hit in 15 of his last 18 G (26-71, .366, 19 R) and has scored at least 1 R in 12 of his last 14 G (16 R)... OF **Jon Knott** has reached base safely in all 19 G with LHV... SS **Mike Rouse** has back-to-back multi-hit G (5-8, HR, 4 BB)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 6 of his last 9 G (10-28, .357-2-11) and has reached base safely in 27 of his last 30 G... 3B **Brennan King** hasn't committed an error in his last 28 G...

## THE STREAKING STEVES:

LHP **Steve Kline** has a 8.2 scoreless IP streak over his last 6 G... RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a run in his last 7.2 IP and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 3 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has not allowed a run in his first 4 G and 5.1 IP with LHV. Combined with Round Rock, he has a personal 8.2 scoreless IP streak and is 1-1, 0.90 ERA and 3 SV.

## SERIES STUFF:

LHV leads the season series, 1-0. CHA & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 4-4 (home teams 3-1).

## BACON BITS:

• *Hit Parade*: For the first time this season, the IronPigs have had 3 consecutive double-digit hit totals (11, 12, 10). LHV has gone 6-1 in their last 7 G with a double-digit hit total.

• *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: Even though the IronPigs pen had a BS and a L on Friday (3 ip, 5 er), the relief corps has gone 5-1, 1.51, 4 SV (41.2 ip, 7 er) in the last 12+ G.

• *Gotta have Heart!*: Since the arrival of **Jon Knott** on 5/2, the IronPigs heart of the lineup (**Mike Cervenk/Andy Tracy/Jon Knott**) has combined to go .327-7-48 (67-205, 15 2B, 3B, 29 BB, .512 SLG, .410 OBP) in 21 games.

• *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 17 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 6-4, 2.56 (105.2 ip, 30 er) w/ a .233 OBA (88-378).

• *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC.

IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-10 with a 8.46 ERA in their last 13 GS (55.1 ip, 52 er).

• *Though Shalt Not Steal?*: In the first 20 G, LHV catchers had thrown out just 2 of 25 (8%) SB attempts (and the pitchers had 2 POs that led to CSs). Since 4/23 (last 27 G), LHV catchers have gunned down 13 of 38 (34.2%) SB attempts (and the pitchers added 6 POs that led to CSs). During the span, C **Jason Jaramillo** improved from 1-19 (5.3%) to 13-51 (25.5%) by gunning down 12 of the last 32 (37.5%) SB attempts.

• *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 32 of 66 (48.5%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 44-57 (77.2%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 22-24 (91.7%) saves.

• *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 22 sacrifices (12 bunts, 10 flies) in the past 21 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

## IN THE ma-ZONE!

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 5 straight decisions. After starting 0-2 in his first 2 GS, Mazone is 5-1, 2.56 in his last 8 GS (52.2 ip, 52 h, 15 er, 10 bb, 23 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 21-8, 2.42 ERA in 36 GS (230.2 ip, 62 er). As a pro, he has gone 77-46 -- a .626 winning percentage. Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 7-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

## PHILLIES PHANNERS:

Although the Phillies farm system still has the worst combined record of the 30 major league teams, Philadelphia does have three of the top four Minor League strikeout leaders -- a list that includes IL strikeout leader **J.A. Happ**: (1) **Drew Naylor**, 71 (LAK, SAL); (2) Trevor Cahill, 68 (STO, CAL); (3) **Antonio Bastardo**, 67 (REA, EL); (4) **J.A. Happ**, 66. Happ also holds the single-game high in the IL this season after fanning 13 Clippers on May 9.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 30-64 (.319) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 47-100 (.320) and a combined 44.5 GB

## SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

## PRESEASON NOTES:

### HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
