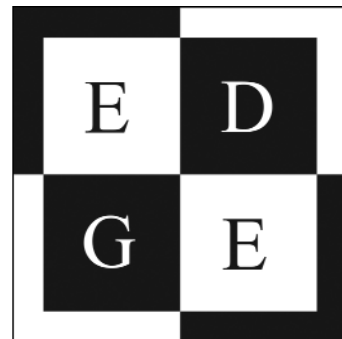

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (15-35) play the finale of a four-game series against the Charlotte Knights (19-29) at Coca-Cola Park. With a dramatic, 5-4 walk-off victory in 10 innings last night, Lehigh Valley is now 2-1 on the eight-game homestand and 10-5 in the last 15 games. The 'Pigs have pulled to 17.0 games back in the North Division. The Knights (White Sox affiliate) have now dropped nine of their last 12 affairs and Charlotte is just 6-16 after starting 13-13.

- By taking a 2-1 lead in this four-game series, the IronPigs have assured themselves at least a split of the four-game series. They have either won or split four consecutive series now after starting the season losing their first 10.
- First-Pitch tonight is at 6:05 p.m. There will be postgame Memorial Day Eve Fireworks, presented by **Coors Light**.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Les Walrond** will make his fifth IronPigs appearance after starting the season with the Iowa Cubs (PCL, AAA) -- where he went 1-1, 6.55 in 7 G, 0 GS. Walrond, 31, is a 6-3, 205-pound left-hander out of Tulsa, OK, who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 4/29/08. Originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of 1998 out of University of Kansas, Walrond spent the 2007 season exclusively in Iowa, where he was 11-5, 4.77 in 27 G, 24 GS. He made his ML debut with Kansas City on 6/8/03 and later appeared in 10 G with Chicago-N in 2006. In his ML career, Walrond has gone 0-3, 7.46 in 17 G, 2 GS (25.1 ip, 30 h, 22 r, 21 er, 19 bb, 27 k).

- *Walrond started the first and only SHO in LHV history in a 7-0 win 5/13 vs. NOR (7 ip, 5 h, 5 k)*

RHP **Rob Bell**, 31, is a 6-5, 220-pound right-hander signed by Chicago-A in April after being released by Washington at the end of this Spring Training. Bell was originally selected by Atlanta in the 3rd round of 1995 out of Marlboro (NY) H.S. -- turning down a scholarship to Wake Forest to sign. Bell was then traded to Cincinnati along with LHP Denny Neagle and OF Michael Tucker for 2B Bret Boone and LHP Mike Remlinger on 11/10/98, and he would make his debut with the Reds on 4/8/00 vs. CHI (fanned 9 in that game; most by a Red in an ML debut since records were kept in 1968). He went on to go 7-8, 5.00 in 26 GS in 2000 and would later pitch in with Texas (2001-02), Tampa Bay (2003-05) and Baltimore (2007). Last season pitched with both Norfolk (4-3, 2.97 in 10 GS) and the Orioles (4-3, 5.94 in 30 G, 0 GS).

- *Bell (who pitched a scoreless IP on THU) lost his last start 5/10 @ TOL (5-3): L, 5.0 ip, 9 h, 5 r, 5 er, 1 bb, 4 k.*

SERIES STUFF:

LHV leads the 2008 season series, 2-1. CHA & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 4-4 (home teams 3-1).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .271 (171-631, 13 HR) in the last 19 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .237. They have averaged 4.9 R/G (93) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .300 (51-170) w/ RISP in the 19 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .216 for the season.

'NAK ATTACK:

INF **Mike Cervenak** has an 8-G hit streak (15-28, .536-2-8) and a 6-G run streak (9 R) -- and he is now 3rd in the IL in hits (57), 4th in R (33) and 8th in AVG (.318). He leads the club with 17 multi-hit games. Cervenak has also hit in 12 of his last 13 G (23-53, .434-3-17); has scored at least 1 R in 12 of 13 G (17 R); and has at least 1 RBI in 13 of his last 16 starts (20 RBI). The franchise-high for total bases in a game is 6 -- a feat Cervenak has accomplished 4 times.

TO BE, OR KNOTT TO BE:

The answer is 'clutch'. With his game-winning, walk-off 1B in the 10th last night, OF **Jon Knott** has all three GW-RBIs in their three walk-off victories this season. He also has 4 game-tying or game-winning hits from the 9th inning-on. He his now batting .338-2-13 in 21 G with LHV (reaching safely in all 21 G) and is 10-21 (.476) w/ RISP.

THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a run in his last 11.1 IP and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 4 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has a 8.2 scoreless IP streak over his last 6 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has allowed just 1 R in his first 5 G and 6.0 IP with LHV. Combined with Round Rock, he had a personal 9.0 scoreless IP streak and is now 1-1, 1.31 ERA and 3 SV.

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

In the last 7 G, the LHV bullpen has gone 3-0, 1.21 with a SV (22.1 ip, 3 er)... INF **Oscar Robles** had his 9-G hitting streak snapped last night (0-4). Still, he has hit it 9 of his last 10 G (12-35, .343, 6 BB, 6 R)... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit in 17 of his last 20 G (29-80, .363, 19 R) and has scored at least 1 R in 12 of his last 16 G (16 R)... C **Jason Jaramillo** has a 3-game hitting streak (4-8, RBI) and has gunned down 12 of the last 32 (37.5%) SB attempts... C **John Suomi** has a 3-G hitting streak (4-10, HR)... 1B **Andy Tracy** is batting .294-2-11 (10-34) in his last 11 G and has reached base safely in 28 of his last 32 G... 3B **Brennan King** hasn't committed an error in his last 30 G...

BACON BITS:

- *Extra! Extra!*: The IronPigs are now 3-1 in the extra innings after their 5-4 win last night.
- *The Next Day...*: The IronPigs faced their 2nd knuckleballer last night. The game after they faced their first knuckleballer (Charlie Zink, 4/9 @ PAW), they scored 2 R on 9 hits 4/10 @ PAW (David Pauley)...but none til the 4th.
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 6-1 in their last 7 such G.
- *No J.J.? No Problem!*: The IronPigs won their first game last night in which C **Jason Jaramillo** did not start. They had been 0-9 in games started by all other catchers.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 6-1, 1.49, 4 SV (48.1 ip, 8 er) in the last 13+ G.
- *Gotta have Heart!*: Since the arrival of **Jon Knott** on 5/2, the IronPigs heart of the lineup (**Mike Cervenak/Andy Tracy/Jon Knott**) has combined to go .323-8-50 (73-226, 18 2B, 3B, 33 BB, .518 SLG, .409 OBP) in 23 games.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 18 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 6-4, 2.72 (109.0 ip, 33 er) w/ a .237 OBA (93-393).
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-11 with a 8.22 ERA in their last 14 GS (61.1 ip, 56 er).
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 36 of 70 (51.4%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 44-57 (77.2%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 23-26 (88.4%) saves.
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 23 sacrifices (12 bunts, 11 flies) in the past 23 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

IN THE ma-ZONE!

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 5 straight decisions. After starting 0-2 in his first 2 GS, Mazone is 5-1, 2.56 in his last 8 GS (52.2 ip, 52 h, 15 er, 10 bb, 23 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 21-8, 2.42 ERA in 36 GS (230.2 ip, 62 er). As a pro, he has gone 77-46 -- a .626 winning percentage. Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 7-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

PHILLIES PHANNERS:

Although the Phillies farm system still has the worst combined record of the 30 major league teams, Philadelphia does have three of the top four Minor League strikeout leaders -- a list that includes IL strikeout leader **J.A. Happ**: (1) Trevor Cahill, 77 (STO, CAL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 71 (LAK, SAL); (2) **Antonio Bastardo**, 69 (REA, EL); (4) **J.A. Happ**, 66. Happ also holds the single-game high in the IL this season after fanning 13 Clippers on May 9.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 31-65 (.323) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 48-101 (.322) and a combined 44.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

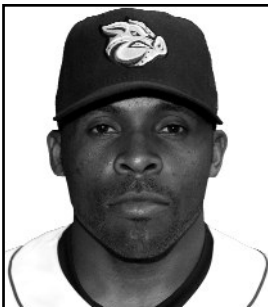
