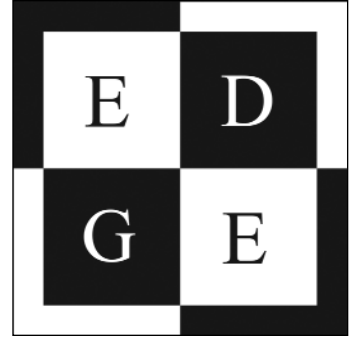

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (15-36) play Game One of a four-game series at Coca-Cola Park against the Indianapolis Indians (25-26), who reside in fourth-place in the West Division. With a 3-2 loss to Charlotte in 10 innings last night, Lehigh Valley split the series with the Knights and the team is now 2-2 on the eight-game homestand. The 'Pigs have gone 10-6 in the last 16 games and remain 17.0 games back in the North Division. The Indians (Pirates affiliate) won two straight games to split a four-game series at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. They've gone just 6-8 in their last 14 games.

- The IronPigs have either won or split four consecutive series now after starting the season losing their first 10.
- First-Pitch tonight is at 6:05 p.m. Gates will open at 5:00 p.m. for Military Appreciation Day, presented by **John Yurconic Agency & Donegal Insurance Group**. The first 2,500 fans will receive a Rally Towel and the 'Pigs will wear camouflage jerseys that will be auctioned off after the game (proceeds going to the Blue Star Mothers of America).

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only ML start on 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland.

- *Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is the most in the IL this season. He currently leads the league with 66 K**.*
- *In his last 6 GS, Happ has gone just 1-1 but with a 2.37 ERA (38 ip, 10 er, 42 k) and a .212 OBA (28-132).*

RHP Jason Davis, 28, is a 6-6, 210-pound right-hander signed by Pittsburgh on 3/30/08 after being released by Texas at the end of this Spring Training (non-roster invitee). Davis was originally selected by Cleveland in the 21st round of 1999 out of Cleveland State (TN) CC. The Charleston, TN, native made his ML debut 9/9/02 vs. TOR (4 ip, 3 h, 1 er, 0 bb, 4 k) and spent the entire 2003 season in the Indians rotation in 2003 (8-11, 4.68 in 27 GS). He was up and down with Cleveland until last season, when he was designated 5/7/07 -- then traded to Seattle on 5/13/07 for a PTBNL. He combined to go 2-0, 5.84 in 24 G, 0 GS before going to Tacoma (0-2, 7.11 in 5 GS) and then shutting down his season 8/19 (personal matters). Overall, his ML totals are 20-22, 4.78 with 1 SV in 130 G, 52 GS.

- *Davis was a hard-luck loser in his last start 5/21 vs. LOU (2-0): L, 6.0 ip, 4 h, 2 r, 2 er, 1 bb, 5 k.*
- *Davis has not won in his last three decisions, but has a 2.41 ERA (18.2 ip, 6 r, 5 er) in those games.*

**PHILLIES PHANNERS:

Philadelphia has three of the top four Minor League strikeout leaders -- a list that includes IL strikeout leader **J.A. Happ**: (1) Trevor Cahill, 77 (STO, CAL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 71 (LAK, SAL); (2) **Antonio Bastardo**, 69 (REA, EL); (4) **J.A. Happ**, 66. Happ also holds the single-game high in the IL this season after fanning 13 Clippers on May 9.

TRANSACTION:

OF Javon Moran returns to LHV after being promoted from Reading (.291-0-9, 36 G). He hit in 211-0-2 in 5 G w/ LHV.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .269 (180-669, 13 HR) in the last 20 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .237. They have averaged 4.8 R/G (95) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .287 (52-181) w/ RISP in the 20 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .213 for the season.

'NAK ATTACK:

INF Mike Cervenak has an 9-G hit streak (16-33, .485-2-10) -- and he is now 3rd in the IL in hits (58), 5th in R (33) and 8th in AVG (.315). He leads the club with 17 multi-hit games. Cervenak has also hit in 13 of his last 14 G (24-58, .414-3-19); has scored at least 1 R in 12 of 14 G (17 R); and has at least 1 RBI in 14 of his last 17 starts (22 RBI). The franchise-high for total bases in a game is 6 -- a feat Cervenak has accomplished 4 times.

SERIES STUFF:

This is the first-ever meeting between these clubs. IND won the 2007 season series, 5-3 (2-2 on the road).

TO BE, OR KNOTT TO BE:

The answer is 'clutch'. With his game-winning, walk-off 1B in the 10th on Saturday, OF **Jon Knott** has all three GW-RBIs in their three walk-off victories this season. He also has 4 game-tying or game-winning hits from the 9th inning-on. He is batting .316-2-13 in 22 G with LHV (reaching safely in 21 of 22 G) and is 10-23 (.435) w/ RISP.

THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a run in his last 11.1 IP and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 4 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has allowed just 1 R in his last 10.0 IP (7 G) and had a 8.2 scoreless IP streak over his previous 6 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has allowed just 1 R in his first 5 G and 6.0 IP with LHV. Combined with Round Rock, he had a personal 9.0 scoreless IP streak and is now 1-1, 1.31 ERA and 3 SV.

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

In the last 8 G, the **LHV bullpen** has gone 3-1, 1.37 with a SV (26.1 ip, 4 er)... INF **Oscar Robles** had his 9-G hitting streak snapped Saturday (0-4). Still, he has hit it 9 of his last 10 G (12-35, .343, 6 BB, 6 R)... OF **Brandon Watson** has hit in his last 4 G (7-18, .389) and in 18 of his last 21 G (32-84, .381, 20 R). He has also scored at least 1 R in 13 of his last 17 G (17 R)... C **John Suomi** has a 4-G hitting streak (5-15, .333, HR)... C **Jason Jaramillo** has a 3-game hitting streak (4-8, RBI) and has gunned down 12 of the last 32 (37.5%) SB attempts... 3B **Brennan King** has a 3-G hit streak (4-12) and hasn't committed an error in his last 31 G... 1B **Andy Tracy** has reached base safely in 29 of his last 33 G...

BACON BITS:

- *Close Calls, Pt. 1:* Four of the last 7 G have been decided by just 1 R.
- *Close Calls, Pt. 2:* The 'Pigs last nine loses have all been tight enough for SV situations for the opponent -- you have to go back to 5/4 for an 8-1 loss at COL for the last time LHV has been defeated 'comfortably' (20 G ago).
- *Extra! Extra!* The IronPigs are now 3-2 in the extra innings after their 3-2 loss last night.
- *One-derful:* After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 6-2 in their last 8 such G.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F:* The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 6-2, 1.55, 4 SV (52.1 ip, 9 er) in the last 14 G. They've now stranded their last 8 inherited runners.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 19 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 6-4, 2.74 (115.0 ip, 35 er) w/ a .236 OBA (98-416).
- *...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-11 with a 8.22 ERA in their last 14 GS (61.1 ip, 56 er).
- *Sacrifice!:* The 'Pigs have 24 sacrifices (13 bunts, 11 flies) in the past 24 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

IN THE ma-ZONE!

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 5 straight decisions. After starting 0-2 in his first 2 GS, Mazone is 5-1, 2.56 in his last 8 GS (52.2 ip, 52 h, 15 er, 10 bb, 23 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 21-8, 2.42 ERA in 36 GS (230.2 ip, 62 er). As a pro, he has gone 77-46 -- a .626 winning percentage. Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 7-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 31-66 (.320) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 48-102 (.320) and a combined 44.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
