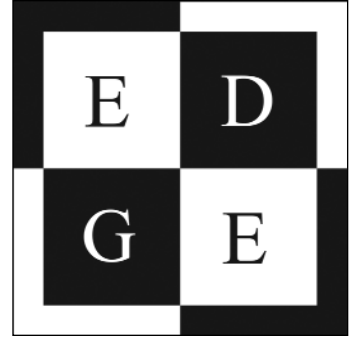

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (17-37) play the finale of a four-game series at Coca-Cola Park against the Indianapolis Indians (26-28), who stand in fourth-place in the West Division. With a 6-5 loss last night, Lehigh Valley is now 4-3 on this eight-game homestand and 12-7 in the last 19 games. The 'Pigs have are back to 17.0 games behind in the North. The Indians (Pirates affiliate) have gone just 7-10 in their last 17 games. First-Pitch today is at 12:05 p.m. Gates will open at 11:00 a.m.

- By winning Tuesday night, the IronPigs are guaranteed at least a split of this series. The have now either won or split 5 consecutive series after starting the season losing their first 10 series.
- Following today's game, the IronPigs embark on an eight-game road trip through Louisville and Indianapolis.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Travis Blackley**, 25, is a 6-3, 200-lb lefthander who was selected by the Phillies from San Francisco in the Rule 5 draft, 12/6/07 -- and outrighted to Lehigh Valley when the Giants declined to take him back at the end of Spring Training. The Australia native appeared in two games with San Francisco (0-0, 7.27 ERA in 8.2 ip) last year after spending the bulk of his season with the Fresno Grizzlies (10-8, 4.66 ERA, 28 gs, 161.2 ip, 156 h, 87 r, 84 er, 68 bb, 121 k). Blackley was originally signed by Seattle 10/29/00 prior to being traded to SF for OF Jason Ellison on 4/1/07, and he made in to the majors with the Mariners as a 21-year-old in 2004 (won his ML debut in a start 7/1/04 vs. TEX). The Aussie played for the World squad in the 2003 Futures Game at Cellular Field (Chi) and was on Australia's provisional roster for the inaugural World Baseball Classic.

- *Blackley is making his third start since coming off the D.L. (on from 4/29-5/19 with a right groin strain)*

RHP **Luis Munoz**, 26, is a 6-2, 193-pound right-hander out of San Pedro de Macoris, D.R., signed by the Pirates as a non-drafted free agent 7/3/00. A member of the 2007 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star, Munoz spent most of last season with Altoona, going 12-5, 3.63 in 25 G, 23 GS, with a stint in Indy (2-1, 3.12 in 3 GS). Munoz was also a member of the 2006 South Atlantic League All-Star Team when he went 6-2, 3.28 in 16 G, 14 GS with Hickory. In his eight-year MILB career, Munoz is 37-25, 3.80 in 125 G.

- *Munoz won his last start, 6-3, on 5/24 @ SWB: L, 6.0 ip, 5 h, 3 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 3 k.*
- *Munoz has gone 1-1 in his last 3 GS, but with a 7.72 ERA (16.1 ip, 14 er) and a .294 OBA (20-68).*

SERIES STUFF:

LHV leads the 2008 season series, 2-1. IND won the 2007 season series, 5-3 (2-2 on the road).

'NAK ATTACK:

INF **Mike Cervanak** has an 12-G hit streak (22-49, .449-2-12) -- tying Jon Knott's franchise-record 12-gamer. He is now 2nd in the IL in hits (59), 5th in AVG (.323) and 5th in R (34). He leads the club with 18 multi-hit games. Cervanak has also hit in 16 of his last 17 G (29-69, .420-3-21); has scored at least 1 R in 13 of 17 G (18 R); has at least 1 RBI in 16 of his last 20 starts (24 RBI); and now has an extra basehit in 6 of last 7 G (6 2B, 3B, HR).

WHO'S HOT:

In the last 11 G, the **LHV bullpen** has gone 3-1, 1.53 with 2 SV (35.1 ip, 6 er)... **C Jason Jaramillo** has a 6-game hitting streak (10-19, .526-0-1, 4 2B, 5 R). He has gunned down 14 of the last 34 (41.2%) SB attempts and has had 3 POs... **OF Brandon Watson** has hit in his last 6 G (10-28, .357) and in 20 of his last 23 G (35-94, .372, 20 R)... **3B Brennan King** has a 5-G hit streak (8-18, .444) and hasn't committed an error in his last 33 G... **INF Oscar Robles** has hit in 12 of his last 13 G (15-45, .333, 7 BB, 7 R)... **C John Suomi** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (5-16, .313, HR)... **OF Javon Moran** is batting a combined .381 (32-84) since his demotion to REA on 5/1... **1B Andy Tracy** has reached base safely in 31 of his last 36 G and is errorless in 2008... **LHP J.A. Happ** has gone 2-1, 2.20 ERA (45 ip, 11 er, 46 k) in his last 7 GS. He leads the IL with 70 K, and holds the '08 IL game-high (13 K)... **RHP Gary Knotts** has not allowed a R in his last 7.2 IP (3+ G)...

BACON BITS, PT. 1:

- *Close Calls:* The 'Pigs last 10 losses have all been tight enough for SV situations for the opponent -- you have to go back to 5/4 for an 8-1 loss at COL for the last time LHV has been defeated 'comfortably' (24 G ago).

BACON BITS, PT. 2:

- *Though Shalt Not Steal:* IND came into the series first in the IL in SB (64) -- with 23 SB in the previous 13 G. Not only do they have 0 SB in the series, but the IronPigs have 4 CS (2 by pitchers POs) and 2 POs (both by Jaramillo). In the first 20 G, the 'Pigs were 4-29 (86%) nailing SB attempts; in the last 34 G, they're 23-49 (47%) with 3 POs.
- *Bottoms Up!:* Spots 6-8 (Jaramillo-King-Rouse) in the lineup the last 2 G are 12-20 with 10 R (of the 12) & 4 RBI.
- *Hit Parade:* The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 7 of last the 9 G (tied in one) and are 6-3 in those 9 G -- 6 of those games they've had double-digit hit totals. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *You're in Good Hands:* LHV has not committed an E in the last 4 G (and last 42.1 innings), and they haven't had a multi-error game in their last 13 G -- they've had just 4 E in those 13 G while their opponents have 13 E.
- *Gaining Ground:* LHV no longer has the 2nd-worst record in MILB after pulling ahead of Lexington (SAL, Houston) yesterday. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F:* The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 6-2, 1.61, 5 SV (61.1 ip, 11 er) in the last 17 G. They've now stranded their last 10 inherited runners.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 21 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 8-4, 2.65 (129.0 ip, 38 er) w/ a .237 OBA (110-464).
- *...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-12 with a 8.54 ERA in their last 15 GS (65.1 ip, 62 er).
- *Sacrifice!:* The 'Pigs have 28 sacrifices (16 bunts, 12 flies) in the past 27 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

The IronPigs are batting .271 (199-734, 13 HR) in the last 22 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .241. They have averaged 4.7 R/G (104) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .295 (65-220) w/ RISP in the 22 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .223 for the season.

IN THE ma-ZONE!:

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 6 straight decisions. After starting 0-2 in 2 GS, he is 6-1, 2.56 in his last 9 GS (59.2 ip, 17 er, 10 bb, 27 k). Mazone leads the IL and is 2nd in MILB with 72.2 IP -- and has not issued a BB in his last 21.1 IP (3+ GS). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 22-8, 2.42 ERA in 37 GS (237.2 ip, 64 er). As a pro, he has gone 78-46 -- a .629 win%.

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 8-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** has not allowed a run in his last 11.1 IP and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 4 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has allowed just 1 R in his last 10.0 IP (7 G) and had a 8.2 scoreless IP streak over his previous 6 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has allowed just 2 R in his first 6 G and 8.0 IP with LHV. Combined with Round Rock, he had a personal 9.0 scoreless IP streak and is now 1-1, 1.59 ERA and 3 SV.

TO BE, OR KNOTT TO BE:

The answer is 'clutch'. With his game-winning, walk-off 1B in the 10th on Saturday, OF **Jon Knott** has all three GW-RBIs in their three walk-off victories this season. He also has 4 game-tying or game-winning hits from the 9th inning-on. He is batting .393 (11-28) w/ RISP.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 33-67 (.330) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 50-103 (.327) and a combined 44.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

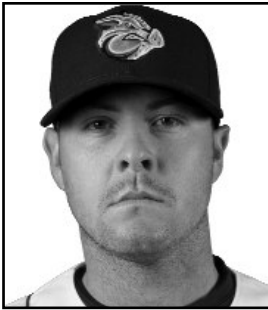
