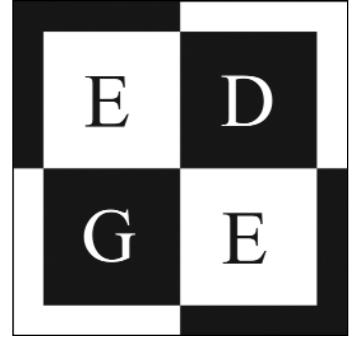

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (4-26) will play the series finale of a four-game set against the third-place Columbus Clippers (15-15) at Cooper Stadium. Lehigh Valley has lost a pair of one-run games (3-2 last night) after taking the series opener. The 'Pigs have now lost 16 of their past 18 games and are now a season-high 17.0 games back in the North Division. Meanwhile, the Clippers have won five of their last six games and have gone 13-6 after starting the season at 2-9.

- *Split Personality?*: An IronPigs win today would force a split of the four-game series. They've started 2008 by dropping their first eight series. The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won a series since Ottawa took three of four at Buffalo from 8/8/08-8/11/08 (17 series ago).

- First-Pitch is at 1:05 p.m. this afternoon. The 'Pigs next travel to Toledo for a four-game set vs. the MudHens.

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of the 2004 draft out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. The 25-year-old spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only Major League start 6/7/07 vs. NY-N (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland. *Happ is currently 2nd in the International League with 37 strikeouts (David Purcey, SYR, 39).*

- *HAPPY Days*: In his last two GS, Happ has gone 0-0, 0.64 ERA (14 ip, 1 er, 13 k) and a .111 OBA (5-45).

RHP Jason Bergmann, 26, is a 6-4, 216-pound right-hander selected by Montreal in the 11th round of the 2002 draft out of Rutgers University. The native of Neptune, NJ, spent the bulk of 2007 with the Nationals, going 6-6, 4.45 in 21 G, 21 GS -- and he had the 6th lowest OBA in the NL at .231. He was 5-0 in 9 GS after the All-Star Break before taking a loss on the last day of the season (9/30 @ PHI). He also took a no-hitter into the 8th on 5/14 at ATL before it was broken up on a leadoff HR by Brian McCann. He did make a rehab appearance in Columbus, going 2-1, 1.50 in 5 GS. A member of the 2003 South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star Team, Bergmann made his ML debut 8/28/05 vs. STL -- striking out the side in the 9th (Mabry, Eckstein, Seabol). He earned his first ML win 8/30/05 @ ATL.

- *Bergmann was brilliant in his last start, an 8-1 win 4/29 @ IND: W, 8.0 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 6 k.*

SERIES STUFF:

COL leads the season-series, 2-1. COL won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 5-3 -- going 3-1 at Cooper Stadium.

WHO'S HOT:

1B **Andy Tracy** has a 6-G hit streak (7-21, .333-1-3) has hit a HR in 4 of his last 10 G. In addition, he has reached base safely in his last 12 G and hit safely in 10 of his last 11 G (.300-4-10; 12-40)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 17 of the last 18 G and hit safely in 9 of his last 11 G (15-44, .341-2-6) with 5 multi-hit G. He leads the club with 7 m-h G... 2B **Oscar Robles** has hit safely in his first 2 G as a IronPig (2-9)... 2B **Casey Smith** snapped his 4-G hit streak as a PH (0-1) Friday night, but has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 G (5-15, 2B)... Closer **Matt Childers**, who had his scoreless IP streak snapped at 10.1 on Tuesday night, is now 3-3 (100%) in SV opps... RHP **John Ennis** has not allowed a R in his last 2 G (3.1 ip) retiring 11 of his last 12 batters faced... LHP **Brian Mazone**, who owns 75% of LHV's wins in 2008, has gone 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA in his last 4 GS (25 ip, 22 h, 8 r, 5 er, 5 bb, 9 k)...

BACON BITS, PT I:

- *Down with ITP*: The inside-the-park HR by **Rich Thompson** last night was the first such HR in franchise history.
- *First Time for Everything*: With **Larry Broadway's** HR last night, 5 of the last 6 HR allowed by LHV were the players' first of the year -- including one each in the past three games (**Javi Herrera** in G1, **Yurendell DeCaster** in G2).
- *Playin the Hits?*: The 'Pigs outhit Columbus, 7-6, last night. LHV has gone 2-6 when they've outhit the opponent.
- *Bullpen is Back*: The pen ended its scoreless streak at 8.2 IP. Still, in the last 3 G, the pen has a SV, a 1.54 ERA (11.2 ip, 2 er, 3 bb, 17 k), a .146 OBA (6-41) and is 5-5 stranding runners. In the previous 8 G, the pen went 0-3, 7.22 ERA.

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT II:

- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 6 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 2-1, 1.27 (35.1 ip, 5 er) with a .143 OBA (17-119).
- *Sacrifice!:* The IronPigs have 7 sacrifices (4 bunts, 3 flies) in the past 3 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.
- *Road Warriors?:* In their last 7 G on the road, LHV is batting .246 w/ 3.9 R/G (59-240, 27 R). In their last 4 G at home, LHV is .190 (24-126) w/ 1.3 R/G.
- *Popping in the Clutch:* LHV is 7-25 (.280, 10 RBI) w/ RISP over the past 3 G after starting 2008 at .141 (26-184).
- LHV has scored just 71 R in 30 G, an average of 2.4 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 113 (DUR) – 42 more.
- *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
- *Arriving on the Strand:* The IronPigs bullpen has now stranded its last eight inherited runners (8-8). For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 24 of 49 (49.0%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 31-36 (86.1%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 17-17 (100%) saves.

TRAPPED IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (4-26) continue to own the worst record in MILB -- trailing 7-22 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) by 3.5 games. South Bend (Midwest, A-, Arizona) is 8-19 and Tucson (PCL, AAA, Arizona) is now at 9-21. Other teams not too far ahead are Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) at 9-20 and Nashville (PCL, AAA, MIL) at 9-19.

- In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 24-4.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 20-57 (.260) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 37-93 (.285) and a combined 45.0 GB

- No team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 41-75, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 147 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

For the season, the IronPigs have scored just 71 runs in 30 games, an average of 2.4 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 113 (Durham) -- 42 more than the Lehigh Valley total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.215) and the team is batting just .158 (33-209) with RISP. The 'Pigs have already been shutout five times and have scored 0-2 R in 17 of 30 (56.7%) of their games

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard – 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman – 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert – 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley – 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet – 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey – 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer – 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones – 1,209.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
