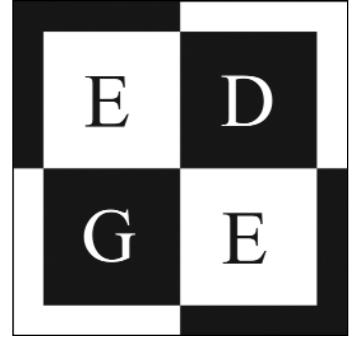

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (4-27) continue their eight-game road trip with Game One of a four-game set against the West Division leading Toledo Mud Hens (20-10) at Fifth-Third Field. Lehigh Valley has lost three straight games after taking the series opener at Columbus (16-15). The 'Pigs have now lost 17 of their past 19 games and are now a season-high 18.0 games back in the North Division. Meanwhile, the Mud Hens just took three of four from Rochester and have gone 9-3 in their last 12 games. First-Pitch is at 6:30 p.m.

• With their 8-1 loss in the series finale at Cooper Stadium yesterday, the IronPigs have started 2008 by dropping their first nine series (five sweeps). The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won a series since Ottawa took three of four at Buffalo from 8/8/08-8/11/08 (17 series ago).

RHP **Kevin Beirne** (pronounced /burn/), 34, is a 6-4, 210-pound right-hander signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 1/8/07. The Houston native did not pitch in 2007 after having foot surgery following his release from Detroit on 3/9/07. Originally an 11th-round selection by Chicago-AL in 1995, Beirne spent the previous four seasons pitching in Japan. He made his ML debut with the White Sox 5/17/00 at Yankee Stadium and went 1-3, 6.70 in 29 G, 1 GS as a rookie. He has also appeared in the ML with Toronto (0-0, 12.86 in 5 G in 2001) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2-0, 3.41 in 12 G, 3 GS in 2002). The former Texas A&M attendee lettered twice in football as a WR for the Aggies. His father, Jim, was a WR/TE for the Houston Oilers & San Diego Chargers from 1968-76.

LHP **Jon Connolly**, 24, is a 6-0, 205-pound, southpaw from Oneonta, N.Y., originally selected by Detroit in the 28th round of the 2001 draft. He started the season in Erie (AA) after spending a bulk of 2007 there, going 7-7, 4.58 ERA in 21 G, 19 GS. He went up and down between Erie and Toledo twice and went 1-1, 3.91 ERA in 4 GS with the MudHens last season -- which included a one-hit shutout out (7 IP) of Louisville on 5/17. Connolly spent two seasons in the Cubs organization after a trade on 4/29/04. He signed back with Detroit after being released 3/31/06 (he also had one appearance with independent Nashua in between). In 2003, he was a Midwest League All-Star (mid- and post-season), going 16-3, 1.41 ERA with West Michigan...and a 2004 Florida State League All-Star with Daytona (9-5, 2.40).

## SERIES STUFF:

TOL leads the season-series, 3-1, taking the final 3 G at Coca-Cola Park in the series 4/15-4/18. The 'Hens also won the 2007 series vs. OTT, 5-3 -- but the teams were an even 2-2 at Fifth-Third Field.

## WHO'S HOT:

1B **Andy Tracy** has a 7-G hit streak (8-25, .320-1-3) has hit a HR in 4 of his last 11 G. In addition, he has reached base safely in his last 13 G and hit safely in 11 of his last 12 G (.295-4-10; 13-44)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 17 of the last 19 G and hit safely in 9 of his last 12 G (15-48, .313-2-6) with 5 multi-hit G. He leads the club with 7 m-h G... Newcomers 2B **Oscar Robles** (2-11, 2 BB) and OF **Jon Knott** (4-12, BB) have both reached base safely in all 3 G as IronPigs... RHP **John Ennis** has not allowed a R in his last 2 G (3.1 ip) retiring 11 of his last 12 batters faced... LHP **Brian Mazone**, who owns 75% of LHV's wins in 2008, has gone 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA in his last 4 GS (25 ip, 22 h, 8 r, 5 er, 5 bb, 9 k)... In his last two GS, LHP **J.A. Happ** is only 0-1 but with a 0.45 ERA (20 ip, 2 r, 1 er, 18 k) and a .152 OBA (10-66). He had his scoreless streak snapped at 14.0 IP with an unearned R in the 6th yesterday...

## BACON BITS, PT I:

• LHV was 0-9 with runners in scoring position in their 8-1 loss yesterday. They're now just .151 (33-219) with RISP  
 • The pen allowed 7 R (6 ER) in 2.0 IP yesterday. In the prev. 3 G, the pen had a SV and a 1.54 ERA (11.2 ip, 2 er).  
 • *Lack o Runs, I:* LHV has scored just 72 R in 31 G (avg of 2.3 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 118 (DUR) -- 42 more.  
 • *Lack o Runs, II:* After scoring just 1 R yesterday @ COL, LHV has scored 0-2 R in 18 of 31 (58.1%) games.

## MORE TEAM NOTES

### BACON BITS, PT II:

- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 7 GS, IronPigs LH starters are 2-2, 1.09 (41.1 ip, 5 er) with a .157 OBA (22-140).
- *Sacrifice!:* The IronPigs have 8 sacrifices (5 bunts, 3 flies) in the past 4 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.
- *Northern Exposure:* The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
- *Fighting over Inheritance:* The IronPigs bullpen allowed all 3 inherited runners to score last night snapping their string of stranding 8 straight. For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 24 of 52 (46.1%). Meanwhile, opponents have stranded 31-36 (86.1%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 18-18 (100%) saves.
- *Down with ITP:* The inside-the-park HR by **Rich Thompson** Saturday was the first such HR in franchise history.
- *First Time for Everything:* With **Larry Broadway's** HR on Saturday, 5 of the last 6 HR allowed by LHV were the players' first of the year -- including one in 3 of the past 4 games (**Javi Herrera** in G1, **Yurendell DeCaster** in G2).

### TRAPPED IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (4-27) continue to own the worst record in MILB -- trailing 7-23 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) by 3.5 games. The only other single-digit win-total teams are Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) at 9-21, South Bend (Midwest, A-, Arizona) at 9-19 and New Hampshire (Eastern, AA, Toronto) at 9-19. In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 24-4.

• *The 4-27 start puts LHV on pace to go just 19-125 (.132). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 20-58 (.256) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 37-94 (.282) and a combined 46.0 GB

- No team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 42-78, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

### THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 148 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

### STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

For the season, the IronPigs have scored just 72 runs in 31 games, an average of 2.3 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 118 (Durham) -- 46 more than the Lehigh Valley total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.214) and the team is batting just .151 (33-219) with RISP. The 'Pigs have already been shutout five times and have scored 0-2 R in 18 of 31 (58.1%) of their games

### SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

### PRESEASON NOTES:

#### HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

#### ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

#### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

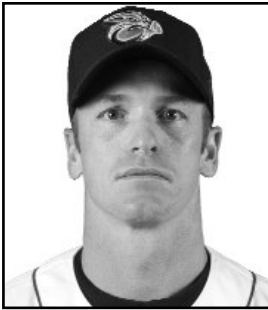
