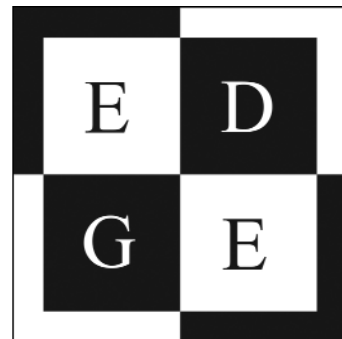

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (4-28) continue their eight-game road trip with Game Two of a four-game set against the West Division leading Toledo Mud Hens (21-10) at Fifth-Third Field. With an 11-7 loss last night, Lehigh Valley has now lost four straight games and 18 of their past 20 games. The 'Pigs remain a season-high 18.0 games back in the North Division. The Mud Hens have won three straight games and are 10-3 in their last 13 games. First-Pitch is at 6:30 p.m.

- Toledo has won four consecutive games against LHV since Mazone defeated TOL, 4-1, in G1 on 4/15/08.

LHP **Brian Mazone**, 31, is a 6-4, 200-pound left-hander who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/7/07. Mazone actually started 2007 as a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training with the Phillies after leading the International League in ERA (2.03) as a Red Baron in 2006. But after getting off to a fast start with Ottawa (3-2, 2.21 in 6 GS), he had his contract sold to the Samsung Lions of the Korean League on 5/9/07. He finished in Korea by going 7-11 with a 4.18 ERA in 24 GS (125 ip, 130 h, 61 r, 58 er, 45 bb, 76 k).

- Mazone, who owns 75% of LHV's wins, is 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA in his last 4 GS (25 ip, 22 h, 8 r, 5 er, 5 bb, 9 k)
- Mazone 4/15 vs. TOL: W, 5.0 ip, 7 h, r, er, bb, k (Allowed solo HR to Melian in 2nd; stranded 7 in 5 ip)

RHP **Yorman Bazardo**, 23, is a 6-2, 220-pound, right-hander acquired by Detroit from Seattle for OF Jeff Frazier on 2/2/07. After originally being signed as a non-drafted free agent by Florida 7/19/00, the Venezuela native was traded with Mike Flannery to Seattle for LHP Ron Villone on 7/31/05. Bazardo started 2008 with the Tigers (0-0, 24.00, 3 g, 3 ip, 7 h, 8 r, 8 er, 5 bb, 3 k). He spent most of last season with Toledo, going 10-6, 3.75 in 23 G, 21 GS -- but had three stints with Detroit, going an impressive 2-1, 2.28 in 11 G, 2 GS. He made his ML debut with Florida in 2005 (1.2 ip, 4 er) but recorded his first ML win 9/25/07 vs. MIN (7 ip, 6 h, 0 er, 3 bb, 5 k).

- Bazardo won his last start, 5-1, on 5/1 vs. ROC: W, 5.0 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 2 k.

SERIES STUFF:

TOL leads the season-series, 4-1, taking the final 3 G at Coca-Cola Park in the series 4/15-4/18. The 'Hens also won the 2007 series vs. OTT, 5-3 -- but the teams were an even 2-2 at Fifth-Third Field.

- Both of OF **Timo Perez's** HR have come vs. LHV (.412-2-4 in 4 G). All of OF **Jackson Melian's** 6 RBI (and his lone HR) are vs. LHV (.333-1-6 in 5 G). **Jeff Larish** is .333-1-6 in 5 G vs. LHV.

TRANSACTIONS:

Today, RHP **Jason Anderson** was assigned to Reading (AA) and LHP **R.J. Swindle** was promoted to Lehigh Valley from Reading (AA) -- where he was 1-0, 0.54 ERA in 11 G (16.2 ip, 8 h, 1 r, 1 er, 1 bb, 16 k, .143).

WHO'S HOT:

1B **Andy Tracy** has an 8-G hit streak (9-30, .300-1-4) and has reached base safely in his last 14 G. He has also hit safely in 12 of his last 13 G (.286-4-11; 14-49)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in 3 straight (5-12, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI, 3 R)... DH **Mike Cervenak** has reached base safely in 18 of the last 20 G and hit safely in 10 of his last 13 G (16-53, .302-2-6) with 5 multi-hit G. He leads the club with 7 m-h G... Newcomers 2B **Oscar Robles** (3-16, 2 BB, 4 G) and OF **Jon Knott** (4-12, BB, 3 G) have both reached base safely in all games as IronPigs... RHP **John Ennis** has not allowed a R in his last 2 G (3.1 ip) retiring 11 of his last 12 batters faced... In his last two GS, LHP **J.A. Happ** is only 0-1 but with a 0.45 ERA (20 ip, 2 r, 1 er, 18 k) and a .152 OBA (10-66). He had his scoreless streak snapped at 14.0 IP with an unearned R Sunday...

BACON BITS, PT I:

- The 7 R scored by LHV last night was a franchise (they had previously scored 6 twice). They are 1-2 in these games.
- The 4 R scored by LHV in the 6th tied a season-high for R in an inning; the 5 hits in the 6th was a franchise-high.
- Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 7 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 2-2, 1.09 (41.1 ip, 5 er) w/ a .157 OBA (22-140).
- ...But Righties?:* There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone 0-8 with a 10.52 ERA in their last 8 GS (31.2 ip, 37 er).

MORE TEAM NOTES

BACON BITS, PT II:

- In the past 2 G, the pen has allowed 12 ER in 7.0 IP (15.43). In the previous 3 G, the pen had a 1.54 ERA (11.2 ip, 2 er).
- *Lack o Runs, I*: LHV has scored just 79 R in 32 G (avg of 2.5 R/G). The IL's next lowest total is 119 (DUR) -- 40 more.
- *Sacrifice!*: The IronPigs have 8 sacrifices (5 bunts, 3 flies) in the past 5 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.
- *Fighting over Inheritance*: For the season, the IronPigs bullpen has still only stranded 24 of 52 (46.1%). Meanwhile, opponents have now stranded 35-43 (81.4%). In fact, they had stranded the first 17 inherited runners of '08. In addition, opponent bullpens have converted 19-19 (100%) saves.
- *Northern Exposure*: The IronPigs are 1-18 against their fellow North Division foes (1-14 on the road).
- *First Time for Everything*: With **Larry Broadway's** HR on Saturday, 5 of the last 6 HR allowed by LHV were the players' first of the year -- including one in 3 of the past 4 games (**Javi Herrera** in G1, **Yurendell DeCaster** in G2).

TRAPPED IN THE MILB CELLAR!:

The IronPigs (4-28) continue to own the worst record in MILB -- trailing 7-24 St. Lucie (Florida State, A+, NYM) by 3.5 games. The only other single-digit win-total team is Mississippi (Southern, AA, ATL) at 9-22. In stark contrast, Salt Lake (PCL, AAA, LAA) is at 25-5.

• *The 4-28 start puts LHV on pace to go just 18-126 (.125). The worst full-season winning percentage in the 125 years of the International League is the 1888 Albany team (19-86, .181) and the 1904 Rochester team (28-105, .211). The highest loss total is the 1927 Reading team (43-123, .259).*

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A / MINOR LEAGUE STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, the Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 20-59 (.263) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 37-95 (.280) and a combined 46.0 GB

- No team in the Phillies system above .500. The farm system combined is 45-79, ranking last (30th) in MLB.

THIRD TIME'S NO CHARM

The Phillies' Triple-A affiliate has not won three straight games since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07 -- an amazingly dubious string of 149 games with out back-to-back-to-back wins. The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four games, 4/14/07-4/19/07.

STRUGGLING TO SCORE...CONT.:

For the season, the IronPigs have scored just 79 runs in 32 games, an average of 2.5 R/G. The next lowest total in the IL is 119 (Durham) -- 40 more than the Lehigh Valley total. The IronPigs are still last in the IL in AVG (.219) and the team is batting just .164 (38-232) with RISP. The 'Pigs have already been shutout five times and have scored 0-2 R in 18 of 32 (56.3%) of their games

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN:

The IronPigs roster consists of 18 (75%) players who have already played in the Major Leagues -- with 37-year-old reliever LHP **Vic Darensbourg** having the most service time on the roster. Darensbourg has appeared in 309 games over the course of nine seasons (1998-2005). The average age of the Opening Day roster is 30.04-years-old with Darensbourg being the oldest and LHP **Travis Blackley** (25, won't turn 26 until November). The roster also features four members of the Phillies 40-Man Roster (RHP **Joe Bisenius**, OF **T.J. Bohn**, LHP **J.A. Happ** and C **Jason Jaramillo**).

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

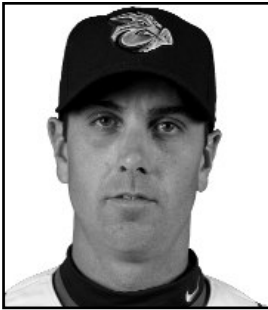
