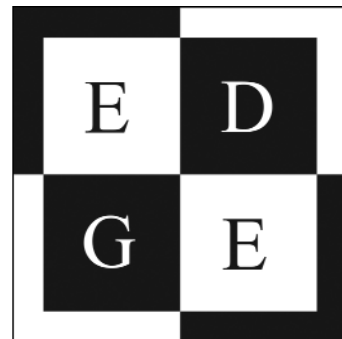

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (18-39) play Game Three of a four-game series against the Louisville Bats (34-23), who are now tied for first place in the West with Toledo. With a 9-3 loss last night, Lehigh Valley has started 0-2 on this eight-game road trip and has now lost three of its last four games and fallen to 18.0 games behind in the North. Even so, the 'Pigs 13-9 in the last 22 games after starting 5-30. The Bats (Reds affiliate) have now won four straight games and have taken six of their last seven. The Bats have gone 14-7 in their last 21 games. First-Pitch tonight is at 6:15 p.m.

• The 'Pigs will now try to salvage a split of the series. They've yet to win a road series and are 5-24 on the road.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Brian Mazone**, 31, is a 6-4, 200-pound left-hander who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/7/07. Mazone actually started 2007 as a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training with the Phillies after leading the International League in ERA (2.03) as a Red Baron in 2006. But after getting off to a fast start with Ottawa (3-2, 2.21 in 6 GS), he had his contract sold to the Samsung Lions of the Korean League on 5/9/07. He finished in Korea by going 7-11 with a 4.18 ERA in 24 GS (125 ip, 130 h, 61 r, 58 er, 45 bb, 76 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 22-8, 2.42 ERA in 37 GS (237.2 ip, 64 er). As a pro, he has gone 78-46 -- a .629 winning percentage.

• After starting 0-2, 6.23 in his first 2 GS, *Mazone is 6-1, 2.56 in his last 9 GS (59.2 ip, 17 er, 10 bb, 27 k).*

• Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, *the IronPigs are now 8-4 in games in which Mazone appears.*

• *Mazone is 3rd the IL and 10th in MILB in IP (72.2). He has not walked a batter in his last 21.2 IP (3+ GS)*

RHP **Homer Bailey**, 22, is a 6-4, 205-pound right-hander selected by Cincinnati in the first round (7th overall) of 2004 out of La Grange (TX) HS. Ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 2 prospect in the Reds System (behind Jay Bruce), Bailey made his ML debut 6/8/07 vs. CLE (W, 5 ip, 5 h, 2 er, 4 bb, 3 k) -- becoming the youngest Red to debut as a starter since Milt Wilcox on 9/5/70 and the first Reds starter to win in his debut since Larry Leubbers on 7/9/93. He started the season in Louisville (6-3, 3.07 in 12 GS) before his promotion to Cincinnati, where he went 4-2, 5.76 in 9 GS -- and had wins blown in 3 of his 9 GS. The 2006 Florida State League All-Star led La Grange HS to state baseball titles in 2001 & 2004. He's also ranked as having both the best fastball and curveball in the organization.

• *Bailey has not won in his last 5 GS, going 0-2 with a 6.59 ERA (27.1 ip, 20 er). His last win was 4/30 vs. TOL.*

• *Bailey pitched well in a no-decision his last start, a 2-1 loss on 5/27 @ COL: n/d, 6.0 ip, 5 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 4 k.*

## BACON BITS, PT. 2:

• The 9 R allowed last night were the most by LHV since 5/16 vs. NOR (9-6 loss). The 17 H is the 2nd highest total against LHV this season (20 on 4/26 vs. ROC).

• *Close Calls*: Last night snapped the 'Pigs streak of their last 11 losses being tight enough for a SV situations for the opponent. It had been since 5/4 (an 8-1 loss at COL) for the last time LHV was defeated 'comfortably' (25 G ago).

• *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have out-hit their opponents in 9 of last the 12 G (tied in one) and are 7-5 in those 12 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 8 G. They only out-hit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).

• *Getting Series-ous*: After winning their previous series, 3-games-to-1 vs. IND, the 'Pigs have now either won or split 5 consecutive series after starting the season losing their first 10 series. They've won three and split two.

• *Though Shalt Not Steal*: In the first 20 G, the 'Pigs were just 4-29 (86%) nailing SB attempts; in the last 36 G, the catchers have thrown out 24-53 (45.3%) with 3 POs.

• *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 7-2, 1.87, 6 SV (72.1 ip, 15 er) in the last 20 G. They've stranded their last 10 inherited runners.

• *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 23 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 8-6, 3.27 (143.0 ip, 52 er)...

• *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-12 with a 8.54 ERA in their last 15 GS (65.1 ip, 62 er).

• *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 30 sacrifices (18 bunts, 12 flies) in the past 30 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

• *Gaining Ground*: LHV no longer has the 2nd-worst record in MILB after pulling ahead of Lexington (SAL, Houston) yesterday. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.

## 'NAK ATTACK:

Yesterday, INF **Mike Cervenak** continued on with his franchise-record 15-G hitting streak (26-61, .426-2-13). He is now T-1st in the IL in hits (67), 3rd in AVG (.324) and T-5th in R (35). He leads the club with 19 multi-hit games. Cervenak has also hit in 19 of his last 20 G (33-81, .407-3-22); has scored at least 1 R in 14 of 20 G (19 R); has at least 1 RBI in 17 of his last 23 starts (25 RBI); and now has an extra basehit in 6 of last 10 G (6 2B, 3B, HR).

## GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .275 (231-839, 14 HR) in 26 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .245. They have averaged 4.8 R/G (126) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .296 (74-250) w/ RISP in the 24 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .228 for the season.

## THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** snapped his scoreless streak at 13.2 IP last night, but has only allowed 1 R in his last 14.1 IP (0.63) and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 5 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has allowed just 1 R in his last 11.0 IP (8 G) and had a 8.2 scoreless IP streak... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has allowed just 3 R in his first 7 G and 11.0 IP with LHV and had a 9.0 scoreless streak. Combined with Round Rock, he is 1-1, 1.75, 3 SV.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 34-69 (.330) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 51-105 (.327) and a combined 46.5 GB

## SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

## PRESEASON NOTES:

### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

### HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

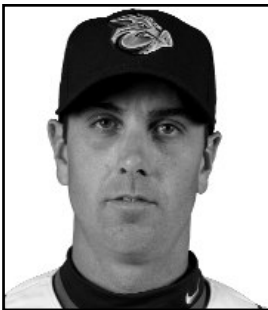
