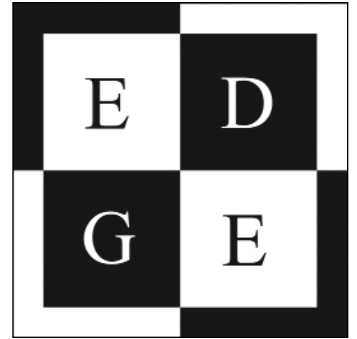

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (23-43) play Game One of a four-game series against the Buffalo Bisons (30-35) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 4-1 loss to Rochester last night, Lehigh Valley failed to complete their first sweep in franchise history -- but still took the series, 2-1. The 'Pigs have won three of their last five games and have started this season-long 11-game homestand at 2-1. Further, the 'Pigs are 12-9 in their last 21 games and have gone 18-13 since starting the season 5-30. They are 17.0 games back of SWB in the North. The fourth-place Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) just took two-of-three at Pawtucket and have won two straight games. Even so, Buffalo is just 5-7 in its last 12 contests.

- First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6 p.m. for Mini-Bat Giveaway Night, presented by **Commerce Bank**.
- *Ruby Tuesday*: The 'Pigs are 6-3 on Tuesdays, their best record (only winning record) on any day of the week.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected in the 3rd round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only ML start on 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first 3 seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game. He currently leads the IL in K (81)**.

- *Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is tied for a single-game high in the IL in '08 (Charlie Morton, RIC; 6/3 vs. DUR).*
- *After starting the season 0-3, 5.59 in his first 4 GS, Happ is 3-2, 3.28 (57.2 ip, 21 er, 57 k) in his last 9 GS.*
- *Happ 5/20 @ BUF: n/d, 6 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 4 er, 1 bb, 5 k Allowed solo HR in 1st (Choo) & 2-R HR in 2nd (Cooper); retired 13 of last 18*

****PHILLIES PHANNERS:** PHI has 3 of the top 4 MILB strikeout leaders -- a list that includes LHP **J.A. Happ**: (1) Trevor Cahill, 99 (STO, CAL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 91 (LAK, SAL); (3) **Antonio Bastardo**, 82 (REA, EL); (4) **J.A. Happ**, 81.

RHP Dan Reichert, 31, is a 6-3, 175-pound right-hander from Turlock, CA, signed by Cleveland as a minor league free agent 5/30/08 -- he had been pitching for the Maryland Blue Crabs (Independent) and was 3-1, 3.40 and 3rd in the Atlantic League with 38 K. Selected in the first-round (7th overall) by KC in 1997 out of University of the Pacific, Reichert made his ML debut 7/16/99 (at the age of 23) -- going 2-2, 9.25 in 8 GS his rookie season. In all, he has gone 21-25, 5.55 and 2 SV in 124 G, 51 GS for KC (1999-2002) and TOR (2003). Since then, he has been bouncing around in the Milwaukee and Seattle systems as well as with the independent Nashua Pride (2006) and Lincoln Saltdogs (2007).

SERIES STUFF:

The 2008 season series is tied, 2-2. BUF & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 8-8 (4-4 at each venue).

TRANSACTIONS:

OF **Chris Snelling** (#9) has accepted his assignment to LHV from Philadelphia. He played in 4 G with PHI and was 2-4, 2B, HR. He started the season with the IronPigs and batted .231-0-1 in 9 G (6-26, 7 BB) until his promotion on 4/13. To make room, RHP **Jason Anderson** was reassigned to Reading.

C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in 14 of his last 15 G (.412-0-6, 21-51, 10 R)... OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in his last 5 G (9-22, .409-1-7, 4 R) and in 9 of his last 10 (15-41, .366-1-11, 7 R)... OF **Jon Knott** has hit safely in his last 5 G (7-19, .368, 3 2B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 7 of his last 9 G (14-32, .438-1-6) raising his AVG by 31 pts... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 20 of his last 23 G (.355-2-13, 33-93)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (11-29, .379-2-6) and in 14 of his last 16 (21-60, .350-2-11). BACON BITS:

- The IronPigs avoided a shutout with a R in the 9th last night. They haven't been shutout since 4/29 (span of 40 G) after being shutout in 5 of their first 26 G.
- *Getting Series-ous*: After starting the season losing their first 10 series, the IronPigs have now either won or split 7 of the last 8 series. They've won four, split three and lost one.
- *Close Calls*: Of the IronPigs last 13 loses, 11 (84.6%) have been by three or fewer runs (5 have been by just 1 R).
- *Start Me Up! Pt 1*: In the last 9 G, LHV starters are 3-3, 2.60 ERA (55.1 ip, 16 er) -- with 3 additional wins blown.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 2*: For the first time this year, the IronPigs have 7 consecutive 'quality starts' (would be 9 straight, but they did not stretch out Gary Knotts for a 6th inning in his 5 ip, 2 r start 6/2 @ LOU).
- *HR Drought*: LHV has not homered in the last 6 G since 6/3 -- when they had a franchise-record 4 HR. And they hadn't had a conventional HR* in the 7 G before that (*they did have an ITP HR). LHV (34) is 13th in the IL in HR ahead of NOR (29).
- *Extra! Extra!*: The IronPigs are now 5-2 in extra-inning games; the Red Wings fell to 4-6 in extra-inning affairs.
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 8-5 in their last 13 such G.
- *Home is Where the Bats Are...*: In the last 7 G at Coca-Cola Park, LHV is batting .325 (79-243) with 5.4 R/G (38).
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 15 of last the 21 G (tied in one) and are 12-9 in those 21 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 13 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 28 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 10-8, 3.17 (187.1 ip, 66 er)...
- *...But Righties*: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Star' in their last 17 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-13, 7.55 ERA in their last 17 GS (76.1 ip, 64 er).
- The win by RHP **Gary Knotts** on Saturday was the first by a RH starter since he won 5/15 vs. NOR. It was also the first 'quality start' by a RH starter in 17 GS (since RHP **Ron Chiavacci's** last win 4/14 vs. RIC).
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 38 sacrifices (23 bunts, 15 flies) in the past 38 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

GAINING GROUND:

- *Pt. 1*: LHV has pulled to within 2.5 games of Charlotte (3.0 behind NOR) as they try to climb out of the IL cellar.
- *Pt. 2*: LHV has pulled to within 4.0 games of Rochester as they try to climb out of the IL North Division cellar.
- *Pt. 3*: LHV has climbed another spot in MILB by pulling ahead of Rome (SAL, Atlanta) last Sunday -- now a better record than 3 other teams. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.

WALK THIS WAY!:

The walk-off Sunday was the fourth of the season for the IronPigs, and their first since 5/24 vs. CHA. It was also the first time someone other than **Jon Knott** had the game-winning hit -- as **Andy Tracy** drove in **Mike Cervenak** in the 10th for the victory. It was the LHV's first walk-off victory on 5/9 vs. COL that coincided with the IronPigs turnaround. They were 5-30 at the time of that first walk-off win, they are 18-12 since...

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .276 (319-1154, 18 HR) in 35 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .250. They have averaged 4.6 R/G (160) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .297 (102-344) w/ RISP in the 34 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .240 for the season.

HAPPY DAYS:

LHP **J.A. Happ** has won in 3 of his last 4 decisions and is 3-2, 3.28 in his last 9 GS (57.2 ip, 21 er). His 10 Ks last start put him back in 1st in the IL (81 K), 4th best in MILB. Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is the most in the IL in '08.

CERVENAK'S STREAK OVER:

Wednesday, INF **Mike Cervenak** went 0-4, snapping his franchise-record 18-game hitting streak -- the longest hitting streak in the IL in 2008 (previously 17 by Andy Phillips, LOU; and Alex Escobar, COL). The longest hitting streak in MILB in 2008 is 28 games by **Michael Jones** with Greensboro (SAL) from 4/9-5/7. Cervenak batted .423-2-13 (30-71) during the streak, which lasted from 5/16-6/3.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 39-73 (.348) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 56-109 (.339) and a combined 45.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.
