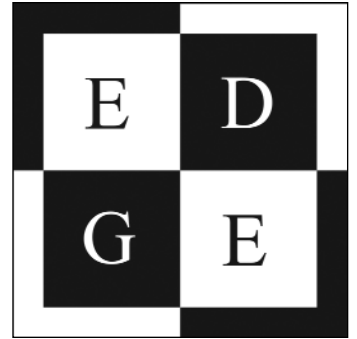

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (24-43) will play Game Three of a four-game series against the Buffalo Bisons (30-37) at Coca-Cola Park. With the first-ever doubleheader sweep* in franchise history (7-3, 3-0), the 'Pigs have won four of their five games to start this season-long 11-game homestand at 4-1. Further, the 'Pigs are 14-9 in their last 23 games and 20-13 since starting the season 5-30. They are now 16.0 games back of SWB in the North. The fourth-place Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) are just 5-9 in its last 14 contests. First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. There will be a postgame fireworks show presented by **Central Pennsylvania College**.

* The IronPigs are 3-1 in DH games now. Last season, Ottawa went just 5-15 in 10 DH with no sweeps.

• With a win tonight, the IronPigs/Phillies Triple-A affiliate will have their 4th, three-game win streak in 34 G -- significant because the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate had previously gone a dubious string of 156 games without three straight (since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07). The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was 4 (4/14-4/19/07)

PITCHING MATCHUP:

RHP **Gary Knotts** -- who is making his fourth start of the season -- is a 6-4, 215-pound right-hander from Decatur, AL, signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 7/31/07. He started 2007 with the Independent League Newark Bears, where he was an Atlantic League All-Star and led the league in ERA -- going 7-5, 2.65 in 16 GS. He then pitched with both Reading (1-2, 0.86 in 3 GS) and Ottawa (1-2, 5.89 in 3 GS) -- where he fired a 1-0 shutout of Rochester on 8/30 for the 1,000th victory in Lynx franchise history. Originally selected by Florida in the 11th round of 1995, Knotts made his ML debut 7/28/01 at Cincinnati and has four years of ML service with the Marlins and the Detroit Tigers (13-16, 5.45 and 2 SV in 86 G, 38 GS).

RHP **Matt Ginter**, 30, is a 6-1, 220-pound right-hander from Winchester, KY, signed by Cleveland as a minor league free agent 12/21/07. He spent most of 2007 in the St. Louis organization with Memphis -- going 2-6, 4.06 and 1 SV in 31 G, 8 GS -- before being released and signing with Milwaukee (pitched 1 G in relief for Nashville). Selected by Chicago-A in the 1st round (22nd overall) in 1999, Ginter made his ML debut in just his second pro season -- winning with a scoreless inning of relief 9/1/00 vs. Anaheim. In parts of six ML seasons, Ginter has combined to go 4-4, 5.46 and 1 SV in 92 G, 15 GS for the White Sox (2000-03), NYM (2004) and Detroit (2005). He has since appeared in the minors with the Boston, Pittsburgh, St. Louis and Milwaukee organizations. Ginter was originally drafted by NYY in 17th round of 1996, but did not sign -- playing three years at Mississippi State. He also played with Team USA in 1998.

• Ginter lost his last start, 9-1, on 6/7 @ PAW: L, 6 ip, 9 h, 7 r, 6 er, 2 bb, 4 k, hr.

• Prior to his last, he had a string of 6 consecutive starts with just 0-2 ER (3-2, 3.46 ERA).

SERIES STUFF:

LHV now leads the season series, 4-2 --having won four straight games over the Bisons. BUF & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 8-8 (4-4 at each venue).

MORE FROM MAZONE:

LHP **Brian Mazone** turned in the first IronPigs complete game and shutout in franchise history in the second game of LHV's doubleheader sweep of Buffalo on Wednesday. In his seven innings, the 31-year-old lefty retired 17 of the last 18 batters faced and allowed just three hits and two walks while fanning seven to improve to 7-4. After starting 0-2, 6.23 in his first 2 GS, Mazone is now 7-2, 2.39 in his last 12 GS (79.0 ip, 21 er, 14 bb, 38 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 23-9, 2.38 ERA in 40 GS (257.0 ip, 68 er). As a pro, he has gone 79-47 -- a .627 winning percentage. The California native leads the IL in IP (92.0) -- a total that is tied for first in MILB (Jhoulys Chacin, ASH).

HAPPY DAYS:

LHP **J.A. Happ** has won in 4 of his last 5 decisions and is 4-2, 3.45 in his last 10 GS (62.2 ip, 24 er). He remains the IL leader with 87 K -- which is third best in MILB. Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is still tied for the most in the IL in '08 with **Charlie Morton** (RIC).

PHILLIES PHANNERS:

PHI has 3 of the top 4 MILB strikeout leaders -- a list that includes LHP **J.A. Happ**: (1) Trevor Cahill, 99 (STO, CAL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 97 (LAK, SAL); (3) **J.A. Happ**, 81; (4) **Antonio Bastardo**, 82 (REA, EL).

BACON BITS:

- *Comeback Pigs*: The IronPigs erased a 2-1 deficit in G1 last night -- marking their 11 come-from-behind victory.
- *Home Sweet Home*: The IronPigs are above .500 (17-16) for the first time in franchise history.
- *Home is Where the Bats Are...*: In the last 9 G at Coca-Cola Park, LHV is batting .320 (94-294) with 5.3 R/G (48).
- *Getting Series-ous*: After starting the season losing their first 10 series, the IronPigs have now either won or split 8 of the last 9 series. They've won four, split three and lost one -- and have clinched at least a split in this series.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 1*: In the last 11 G, LHV starters are 5-3, 2.54 ERA (67.1 ip, 19 er) -- with 3 additional wins blown.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 2*: IronPigs starters have 8 'quality starts' in their last 9 G (including a string of 7 straight 6/3-6/9).
- *Close Calls*: Of the IronPigs last 13 loses, 11 (84.6%) have been by three or fewer runs (5 have been by just 1 R).
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 8-5 in their last 13 such G.
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 16 of last the 23 G (tied in one) and are 14-9 in those 23 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 13 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 30 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 12-8, 3.12 (199.1 ip, 69 er)...
- *...But Righties*: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 17 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-13, 7.55 ERA in their last 17 GS (76.1 ip, 64 er).
- The win by RHP **Gary Knotts** on last Saturday was the first by a RH starter since he won 5/15 vs. NOR. It was also the first 'quality start' by a RH starter in 17 GS (since RHP **Ron Chiavacci's** last win 4/14 vs. RIC).

GAINING GROUND:

Once at least 9.0 games behind every team in the IL (5-30 on May 8), the Lehigh Valley IronPigs have:

- (1) Pulled to within 1.0 game of Norfolk (2.5 behind Charlotte) as they try to climb out of the IL cellar;
- (2) Pulled to within 3.0 games of Rochester as they try to climb out of the IL North Division cellar;
- (3) Climbed up another spot in MILB on Wednesday by pulling ahead of New Hampshire (EL, Toronto) -- and now has a better record than 4 other teams. They climbed out of the cellar over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.

WALK THIS WAY!:

The walk-off Sunday was the fourth of the season for the IronPigs, and their first since 5/24 vs. CHA. It was also the first time someone other than **Jon Knott** had the game-winning hit -- as **Andy Tracy** drove in **Mike Cervenak** in the 10th for the victory. It was the LHV's first walk-off victory on 5/9 vs. COL that coincided with the IronPigs turnaround. They were 5-30 at the time of that first walk-off win, they are 20-13 since...

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .277 (334-1205, 19 HR) in 37 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .251. They have averaged 4.6 R/G (170) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .298 (107-359) w/ RISP in the 34 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .242 for the season.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 41-73 (.360) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 58-109 (.347) and a combined 45.0 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

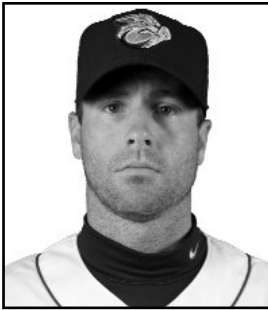
