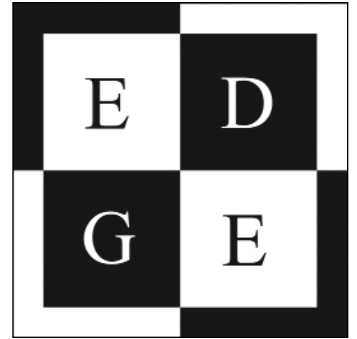

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (25-44) play the finale of a four-game series against the Buffalo Bisons (31-37) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 5-4 loss last night, Lehigh Valley snapped its four-game winning streak over the Bisons and is now 4-2 on this season-long 11-game homestand. The 'Pigs are 14-10 in their last 24 games and 20-14 since starting the season 5-30. They remain 16.0 games back of SWB in the North. The fourth-place Bisons (Cleveland affiliate) are just 6-9 in their last 15 contests. Next up on the homestand will be a four-game series against Pawtucket (40-29).

• First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6:00 p.m. for Friday Night Fireworks, presented by Chevrolet.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Travis Blackley**, 25, is a 6-3, 200-lb lefthander who was selected by the Phillies from San Francisco in the Rule 5 draft, 12/6/07 -- and outrighted to Lehigh Valley when the Giants declined to take him back at the end of Spring Training. The Australia native appeared in two games with San Francisco (0-0, 7.27 ERA in 8.2 ip) last year after spending the bulk of his season with Fresno (10-8, 4.66 in 28 GS). Blackley was originally signed by Seattle 10/29/00 prior to being traded to SF for OF Jason Ellison on 4/1/07, and he made in to the majors with SEA as a 21-year-old in 2004 (won his ML debut in a start 7/1/04 vs. TEX). The Aussie played for the World squad in the 2003 Futures Game at Cellular Field (Chi) and was on Australia's provisional roster for the inaugural World Baseball Classic.

- Blackley is making his sixth start since coming off the D.L. (on from 4/29-5/19 with a right groin strain)
- Blackley has posted back-to-back quality starts (1-0, 2.25); LHV has gone 5-0 in his last 5 GS (4.03 ERA)
- Blackley 5/19 @ BUF-2: n/d, 2.0 ip, 2 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 2 k Off DL: stranded 3 in first (Gonzalez F-8) 2-out RBI 2B (Barfield) in 2nd

LHP **John Halama**, 36, is a 6-5, 215-pound left-hander from Brooklyn, NY, signed by Cleveland as a minor league free agent 6/5/08 (originally selected by Houston in the 23rd round of 1994). Like Dan Reichert, Halama started 2008 with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (Ind.) in the Atlantic League -- he was 4-1, 1.91 in 8 GS. Halama made his ML debut in 1998 with HOU. At midseason, he was sent to SEA along with Freddy Garcia and Carlos Guillen for Randy Johnson. He won a career-high 14 G with SEA in 2000 (14-9, 5.08 ERA in 30 GS). In nine ML seasons, Halama combined to go 56-48, 4.65 in 262 G, 119 GS with Houston (1998), Seattle (1999-02), Oakland (2003), Tampa Bay (2004), Boston (2005), Washington (2005), and Baltimore (2006). He also pitched for the Long Island Ducks (Ind.) in 2007 before being selected by the Blue Crabs in the 2008 expansion draft. In 2001, he threw one of only 8 perfect games in the history of the PCL.

- Halama won his last start (Buffalo debut), 9-5, on 6/8 @ PAW: W, 6 ip, 4 h, 3 r, 3 er, 2 bb, 4 k, 2 hr.

SERIES STUFF:

LHV now leads the season series, 4-3 -- though BUF snapped its 4-G losing streak to LHV last night. BUF & OTT tied the 2007 season series, 8-8 (4-4 at each venue).

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Last Laugh?*: LHV will try to win its 5th series of 2008 tonight. However, the 'Pigs are just 4-14 in series finales.
- *Getting Series-ous*: After starting the season losing their first 10 series, the IronPigs have now either won or split 8 of the last 9 series. They've won four, split three and lost one -- and have clinched at least a split in this series.
- *Lack 'o Lefties*: After facing 12 LH starters in their first 27 G (44%), LHV has only faced 6 in the last 42 G (14%). The IronPigs are 5-13 against LH starters this season, winning their last one on 6/11 vs. BUF-G1 (David Huff).
- *HR Drought*: LHV has only homered in 3 of the last 17 G (and in one of the games, it was an inside-the-park HR). The 'Pigs did have a franchise-record 4 HR on 6/3, but only have 6 conventional HR* in these 17 G. LHV (35 HR) is 13th in the IL in HR ahead of just NOR (29).
- *Home is Where the Bats Are...*: In the last 10 G at Coca-Cola Park, LHV is batting .315 (103-327) w/ 5.2 R/G (52).
- *Start Me Up! Pt 1*: In the last 12 G, LHV starters are 5-4, 2.99 ERA (72.1 ip, 24 er) -- with 3 additional wins blown.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 2*: IronPigs starters have 8 'quality starts' in the last 10 G (including a string of 7 straight 6/3-6/9).
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outthit their opponents in 16 of last the 24 G (and tied in two) and are 14-10 in those 23 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 13 G. They only outthit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 30 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 12-8, 3.12 (199.1 ip, 69 er)...
- *...But Righties*: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 18 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-14, 7.64 ERA in their last 18 GS (81.1 ip, 69 er).

MORE FROM MAZONE:

LHP **Brian Mazone** turned in the first IronPigs complete game and shutout in franchise history in the second game of LHV's doubleheader sweep of Buffalo on Wednesday. In his seven innings, the 31-year-old lefty retired 17 of the last 18 batters faced and allowed just three hits and two walks while fanning seven to improve to 7-4. After starting 0-2, 6.23 in his first 2 GS, Mazone is now 7-2, 2.39 in his last 12 GS (79.0 ip, 21 er, 14 bb, 38 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 23-9, 2.38 ERA in 40 GS (257.0 ip, 68 er). As a pro, he has gone 79-47 -- a .627 winning percentage. The California native leads the IL in IP (92.0) -- a total that is tied for first in MILB (Jhoulys Chacin, ASH).

HAPPY DAYS:

LHP **J.A. Happ** has won in 4 of his last 5 decisions and is 4-2, 3.45 in his last 10 GS (62.2 ip, 24 er). He remains the IL leader with 87 K -- which is third best in MILB. Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is still tied for the most in the IL in '08 with **Charlie Morton** (RIC).

PHILLIES PHANNERS:

PHI has 3 of the top 4 MILB strikeout leaders -- a list that includes LHP **J.A. Happ**: (1) Trevor Cahill, 99 (STO, CAL); (2) **Drew Naylor**, 97 (LAK, SAL); (3) **J.A. Happ**, 87; (4) **Antonio Bastardo**, 86 (REA, EL).

GAINING GROUND:

Once at least 9.0 games behind every team in the IL (5-30 on May 8), the Lehigh Valley IronPigs have:

- (1) Pulled to within 1.0 game of Norfolk (3.5 behind Charlotte) as they try to climb out of the IL cellar;
- (2) Pulled to within 4.0 games of Rochester as they try to climb out of the IL North Division cellar;
- (3) Climbed up another spot in MILB on Wednesday by pulling ahead of New Hampshire (EL, Toronto) -- and now has a better record than 4 other teams. They climbed out of the cellar over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .277 (343-1238, 19 HR) in 38 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .251. They have averaged 4.6 R/G (174) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .301 (111-369) w/ RISP in the 38 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .245 for the season.

WALK THIS WAY!:

The walk-off Sunday was the fourth of the season for the IronPigs, and their first since 5/24 vs. CHA. It was also the first time someone other than **Jon Knott** had the game-winning hit -- as **Andy Tracy** drove in **Mike Cervenak** in the 10th for the victory. It was the LHV's first walk-off victory on 5/9 vs. COL that coincided with the IronPigs turnaround. They were 5-30 at the time of that first walk-off win, they are 20-13 since...

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 41-74 (.356) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 58-110 (.345) and a combined 45.0 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

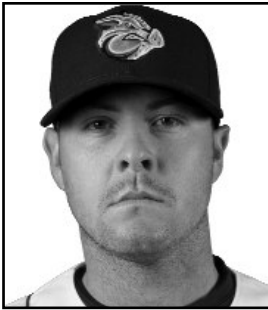
