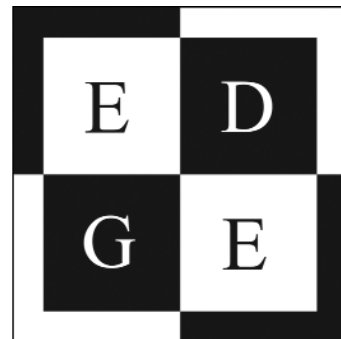

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (19-39) play the finale of a four-game series against the Louisville Bats (34-24), who are back to 1.0 games back of Toledo in the West Division. With a 5-4 win in 10 innings last night, Lehigh Valley is now 1-2 on this eight-game road trip and pulled to 17.0 games behind in the North. The 'Pigs are 8-5 in their last 13 games and have gone 14-9 since starting the season 5-30. The Bats (Reds affiliate) snapped their four-game win streak, but have still taken six of their last eight contests. In a longer stretch, the Bats have gone 14-8 in their last 22 games.

- First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m. The IronPigs will next travel to Indianapolis for a four-game series.
- With a win tonight, the 'Pigs will split the series with Louisville. They have won or split their last five series after losing their first 10 series to start the season.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

RHP **Gary Knotts** -- who is making his third start of the season -- is a 6-4, 215-pound right-hander from Decatur, AL, signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 7/31/07. He started 2007 with the Independent League Newark Bears, where he was an Atlantic League All-Star and led the league in ERA -- going 7-5, 2.65 in 16 GS. He then pitched with both Reading (1-2, 0.86 in 3 GS) and Ottawa (1-2, 5.89 in 3 GS) -- where he fired a 1-0 shutout of Rochester on 8/30 for the 1,000th victory in Lynx franchise history. Originally selected by Florida in the 11th round of 1995, Knotts made his ML debut 7/28/01 at Cincinnati and has four years of ML service with the Marlins and the Detroit Tigers (13-16, 5.45 and 2 SV in 86 G, 38 GS).

RHP **Daryl Thompson**, 22, is a 6-0, 180-pound right-hander -- and a member of the Reds 40-Man Roster -- acquired by Cincinnati in an eight-player trade with Washington on 7/13/06 (along with LHP Bill Bray, SS Royce Clayton, INF Brendan Harris and RHP Gary Majewsky for OF Austin Kearns, SS Felipe Lopez and RHP Ryan Wagner). Originally selected by Montreal in the 8th round of 2003 out of La Plata (MD) HS, Thompson split last season between Dayton (5-0, 0.96 in 5 GS) and Sarasota (9-5, 3.77 in 22 GS). His combined 14 wins led all Reds farmhands (14-5, 3.18).

- Thompson started the season in Chattanooga, going 3-2, 1.76 in 10 GS. He allowed 0 er in 4 GS.
- Thompson dazzled in his AAA debut his last start, a 2-1 win on 5/28 @ COL: W, 7.0 ip, 4 h, 1 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 6 k.

LOU now leads the 2008 season series, 2-1. LOU & OTT split the 2007 season series, 4-4 (2-2, 2-2).

RHP **Ron Chiavacci** was traded to Houston today as the player to be named later for LHP **Stephen Randolph**.

BACON BITS, PT. 2:

- *Casey at the Bat*: Last night's game winning PH RBI-1B by **Casey Smith** was the first PH RBI for the IronPigs this season. Previously, LHV pinch-hitters were 3-26 (.115-0-0).
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 7-3 in their last 10 such G.
- *To Be the Best...*: The IronPigs are now 3-22 against the Top 5 teams in the IL (SWB, PAW, LOU, TOL, SYR).
- *Gaining Ground*: LHV has climbed another spot in MILB by pulling ahead of Rome (SAL, Atlanta) yesterday -- now a better record than three other teams. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.
- *Close Calls*: Saturday snapped the 'Pigs streak of their last 11 loses being tight enough for a SV situations for the opponent. It had been since 5/4 (an 8-1 loss at COL) for the last time LHV was defeated 'comfortably' (25 G ago).
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 10 of last the 13 G (tied in one) and are 8-5 in those 13 G - with double-digit hit totals in 9 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Getting Series-ous*: After winning their previous series, 3-games-to-1 vs. IND, the 'Pigs have now either won or split 5 consecutive series after starting the season losing their first 10 series. They've won three and split two.
- *Though Shalt Not Steal*: In the first 20 G, the 'Pigs were just 4-29 (86%) nailing SB attempts; in the last 36 G, the catchers have thrown out 24-53 (45.3%) with 3 POs.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 8-2, 1.89, 7 SV (76.0 ip, 16 er) in the last 21 G. They've stranded 13 of their last 14 inherited runners.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 23 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 8-6, 3.31 (149.1 ip, 55 er)...
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-12 with a 8.54 ERA in their last 15 GS (65.1 ip, 62 er).
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 33 sacrifices (20 bunts, 13 flies) in the past 31 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

'NAK ATTACK:

Yesterday, INF **Mike Cervenak** extended his franchise-record hitting streak to 16 G (27-62, .435-2-13). He is now 1st in the IL in hits (68), 3rd in AVG (.327) and T-5th in R (36). He leads the club with 19 multi-hit games. Cervenak has also hit in 20 of his last 21 G (34-82, .415-3-22); has scored at least 1 R in 15 of 21 G (20 R); has at least 1 RBI in 17 of his last 23 starts (25 RBI); and has an extra basehit in 6 of last 11 G (6 2B, 3B, HR).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .277 (243-876, 14 HR) in 27 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .246. They have averaged 4.9 R/G (131) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .295 (78-264) w/ RISP in the 24 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .230 for the season.

IIN THE ma-ZONE!:

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 6 straight decisions (and had two wins blown). After starting 0-2 in 2 GS, he is 6-1, 2.73 in his last 10 GS (66.0 ip, 20 er, 11 bb, 30 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 22-8, 2.47 ERA in 38 GS (244.0 ip, 67 er). As a pro, he has gone 78-46 -- a .629 win%.

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 9-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

THE STREAKING STEVES:

RHP **Steve Green** snapped his scoreless streak at 13.2 IP on Saturday, but has only allowed 1 R in his last 14.1 IP (0.63) and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 5 G... LHP **Steve Kline** has allowed just 1 R in his last 12.0 IP (9 G) and had a 8.2 scoreless IP streak... LHP **Stephen Randolph** has allowed just 3 R in his first 7 G and 11.0 IP with LHV and had a 9.0 scoreless streak. Combined with Round Rock, he is 1-1, 1.75, 3 SV.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 35-69 (.337) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 52-105 (.331) and a combined 45.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

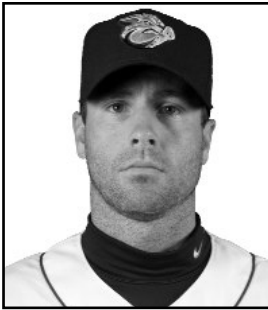
