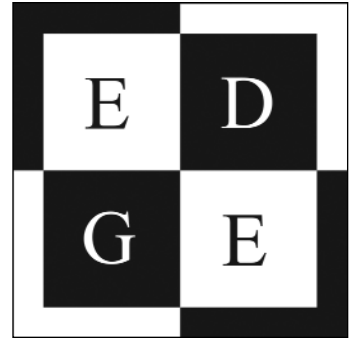

TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (28-49) play the finale of a four-game series against the third-place Charlotte Knights (32-44) at Knights Stadium. With a 3-2 win last night, the IronPigs have started their eight-game South Division road trip 2-1. Lehigh Valley has lost six of its last nine games -- but the improved 'Pigs are still 17-15 in their last 22 games and 23-19 since starting the season 5-30. They remain 18.0 games back of PAW in the North. The Knights (White Sox affiliate) are now 9-6 in their last 15 games. First-Pitch today is at 2:15. The 'Pigs next play four games in Durham.

With a win today, the IronPigs/Phillies Triple-A affiliate will:

- Win their first road series in LHV franchise history & first since 8/8-8/11/07 @ BUF (12 road series ago)
- Win back-to-back road games for just the third time this season. They have not won three straight road games since the *Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons ended the 2006 season with three straight victories (9/1-9/4/06)*.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP Brian Mazone, 31, is a 6-4, 200-pound left-hander who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 12/7/07. Mazone actually started 2007 as a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training with the Phillies after leading the International League in ERA (2.03) as a Red Baron in 2006. But after getting off to a fast start with Ottawa (3-2, 2.21 in 6 GS), he had his contract sold to the Samsung Lions of the Korean League on 5/9/07. He finished in Korea by going 7-11 with a 4.18 ERA in 24 GS (125 ip, 130 h, 61 r, 58 er, 45 bb, 76 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 23-10, 2.46 ERA in 41 GS (263.0 ip, 72 er). As a pro, he has gone 79-48 -- a .622 winning percentage.

- After starting 0-2, 6.23 in his first 2 GS, *Mazone is 7-3, 2.65 in his last 13 GS (85.0 ip, 25 er, 17 bb, 44 k)*.
- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, LHV is now 10-6 in games in which Mazone appears (2 wins blown).
- Mazone is T-1st the IL (Charlie Haeger) and T-5th in MILB in IP (98.0). He is also 8th in the IL in ERA (3.12).
- Two GS ago (6/11 vs. BUF-2), Mazone turned in the first CG & SHO in franchise history (7 ip, 3 h, 2 bb, 6 k).
- Mazone 5/22 vs. CHA (7-2) W, 8.0 ip, 7 h, 2 r, 2 er, 0 bb, 3 k Retired 15 of first 20 before 1B and 2-R HR (Eldred) in 6th

RHP Lance Broadway, 24, is a 6-3, 190-pound right-hander selected by Chicago-A in the 1st round (15th overall) of 2005 out of Texas Christian University -- where he went 15-1, 1.62 as a senior and was named Conference USA Male Athlete of the Year & Pitcher of the Year (led all D-I pitchers in wins). He made his ML debut 9/7 vs. MIN (0.2 ip, 0 er) and later won his first (and only) start 9/27 vs. KC (6 ip, 2 h, 0 r, 8 k). He finished 1-1, 0.87 in 4 G, 1 GS with CHI after spending the entire MILB season with CHA (8-9, 4.65 in 26 GS). He is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 2 Prospect in the White Sox system. As an amateur, threw the first no-hitter in Northwoods League history.

- Broadway has won his last 2 GS. Previously, he was winless in 5 GS (0-3, 6.32) after starting 5-1, 1.13 in 7 GS.
- Broadway wasn't sharp, but won his last start, 6-5 on 6/17 @ RIC: W, 5.0 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 4 k.

SERIES STUFF:

LHV now leads the season series, 4-3 (teams split 5/22-25 in Allentown). CHA & OTT tied the '07 season series, 4-4.

INJURY UPDATE:

OF **Chris Snelling** missed his second consecutive game (knee) as did 1B **Andy Tracy** (hamstring, day-to-day).

WHO'S HOT:

OF **Brandon Watson** has a 6-G hit streak (7-25, 4 R)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (12-24) and in 14 of his last 18 G (26-59, .441-2-11) raising his AVG by 51 pts. He is batting to .367 (22-60) w/ RISP... C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in his last 7 of last 8 G (10-31, .323) and in 20 of his last 22 G (.385-0-8, 30-78, 12 R)... OF **Jon Knott** has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 G (16-49, .327-2-11, 4 2B)... OF **Chris Snelling** has hit in 9 of his last 10 GS w/ LHV (11-30, .367)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 20 of his last 27 G (29-96, .302-2-15) -- raising his AVG from .212 to .246. On defense, he has 1 E in his last 52 G (went 46 consecutive G w/o an E)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 30 of his last 34 G (.348-3-19, 47-135)... RHP **Matt Childers** is 3-0 with 5 SV and a 1.72 (15.2 ip, 3 er) in his last 12 G... RHP **Steve Green** has a scoreless IP streak of 11.1 IP. He's gone 3-0, 0.67 (27.0 ip, 2 er) in his last 12 G and has retired 80 of last 102 BF (78.4%).

IT AIN'T EASY BEING GREEN?:

RHP **Steve Green** now has a scoreless IP streak of 11.1 IP. He has gone 3-0, 0.67 (27.0 ip, 2 er) in his last 12 G and has retired 80 of last 102 batters faced (78.4%). On 6/15, the Quebec native made a spot start -- his first since 7/24/06 (after 81 consecutive relief appearances) and shutout the league's highest scoring offense, Pawtucket, in his four innings (4.0 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 1 bb, 6 k) -- retiring 12 of the 14 BF.

'BLACK' MAGIC:

LHP **Travis Blackley** has turned in 4 consecutive 'quality starts' (his first 4 of '08) and is 3-0, 2.67 (27 ip, 8 er) in his last 4 GS. In addition, the 'Pigs are 7-0 in the last 7 G he has started -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.

- The 8.0 IP for Blackley on Thursday was his longest Triple-A outing of his career and the longest since 7/22/06 vs. Frisco (8.2 ip) when he was with San Antonio. He went 8.0 one other time in '06 (8.0 on 7/6/06 vs. Midland

BACK IN THE I.L. CELLAR:

After spending the first 70 days if the season in last place in the IL, the IronPigs crawled ahead of Norfolk with a better winning percentage on June 13. The 'Pigs remained out of the cellar for three days, but are now back in the cellar after being swept by Pawtucket in their last series.

- With an IronPigs win and a Tides' loss last night, LHV now trails Norfolk by only 1.0 games again.

BACON BITS:

- *Getting Series-ous*: The IronPigs have clinched at least a split of this series and now either won or split 9 of the last 11 series. They've won five, split three and lost just two. They started the season losing their first 10 series.

- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The LHV bullpen earned a W and a SV in 3.1 scoreless IP last night. The corps has allowed just 1 R in 7.1 IP in this series (1.23 ERA).

- LHV drew 1 BB last night and has only drawn 22 BB in the last 12 G (1.8). Their 10th in the IL with 217 BB.

- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 20 of last the 31 G (and tied in three) and are 17-14 in those 31 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 17 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).

- *To Be the Best...*: The 'Pigs are 3-27 (.100) against the Top 5 teams in the IL (SWB, SYR, LOU, PAW, TOL).

- *HR Drought*: LHV has only homered in 6 of the last 25 G (and in one of the games, it was an inside-the-park HR). The 'Pigs did have a franchise-record 4 HR on 6/3, but only have 8 conventional HR* in these 25 G. LHV (39 HR) is 13th in the IL in HR ahead of just NOR (32).

- *Northern Lights?*: LHV is now 7-6 in its last 12 G vs. North Division teams. The 'Pigs started just 1-20 vs. division rivals.

- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 33 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 13-12, 3.40 (230.1 ip, 87 er)...

- *...But Righties*: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 20 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-14, 7.02 ERA in their last 20 GS (91.0 ip, 71 er).

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 44-79 (.359) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 61-116 (.345) and a combined 47.0 GB.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

- Through their first 31 G (May 5), the IronPigs batted .214, averaged just 2.3 R/G and hit just .151 w/ RISP.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert -- 1,425**; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.

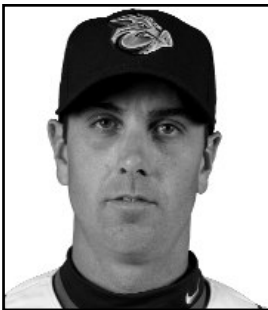
