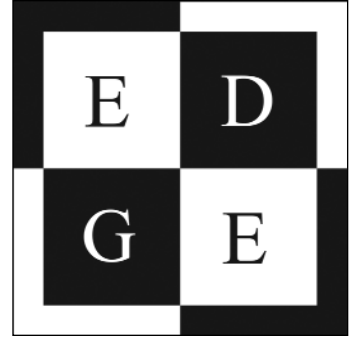

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (28-50) play Game One of a four-game series against the first-place Durham Bulls (41-35) at Durham Bulls Athletic Park (1995). With a 7-2 loss yesterday, the IronPigs split the four-game series in Charlotte and still have failed to win a road series in 2008. They have started this eight-game South Division road trip 2-2. Lehigh Valley has lost seven of its last 10 games -- but the improved 'Pigs are still 17-16 in their last 23 games and 23-20 since starting the season 5-30. They are back to 19.0 games back of PAW in the North. The Bulls (Tampa Bay affiliate) have won three straight games as they just took a home series from Norfolk, 3-1. Durham has also won six of its last eight games and has gone 26-14 (.650) since starting 15-21 through 5/11. First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m.

- *First Impressions:* The 'Pigs are 10-11 in series openers -- they've gone 9-4 in their last 13 after starting 1-7.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound lefty selected in the 3rd round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only ML start on 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first 3 seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida St. League All-Star Game.

- *He is currently 2nd the IL with 90 K (David Purcey, SYR, 93) and 7th in MLB (Trevor Cahill, MID, 109).*
- *Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is tied for a single-game high in the IL in '08 (Charlie Morton, RIC; 6/3 vs. DUR).*
- *After starting the season 0-3, 5.59 in his first 4 GS, Happ is 4-3, 3.54 (68.2 ip, 27 er) in his last 11 GS.*

RHP Mitch Talbot, 24, is a 6-2, 200-pound right-hander originally selected by Houston in the 2nd round (70th overall) of the 2002 draft out of Canyon View (UT) HS. The Cedar City, Utah, native was traded with SS Ben Zobrist to Tampa Bay in exchange for INF Aubrey Huff and cash considerations on 7/12/06. Talbot spent all of 2007 with Durham, going 13-9, 4.53 in 29 gs -- his 13 wins tied for 3rd in the organization and matched a Durham record also held by former Ray RHP Dave Eiland ('98). Talbot led the IL with 29 GS and ranked 3rd with 161.0 IP in 2007, both career highs. Prior to the 2006 trade, he went 6-4 with a team-best 3.39 ERA for Corpus Christi, 8th lowest in the Texas League.

- *2007: Talbot hurled a 7.0-inning, complete-game shut-out on 6/6/07 at Ottawa (7.0 ip, 5 h, 0 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 3 k).*
- *Has been recognized by Baseball America for having the best change-up in his organization 3 times.*
- *Talbot has lost his last 2 GS (0-2, 10.80) after winning 5 straight decisions from 4/30-6/6 (5-0, 1.55, 8 GS).*
- *Talbot lost his last start, 8-1, on 6/17 @ BUF: L, 4.2 ip, 9 h, 7 r, 6 er, 1 bb, 5 k.*

SERIES STUFF:

This is the first-ever meeting between these clubs. DUR won the 2007 series vs. OTT, 5-3 (2-2 in Durham).

INJURIES, ETC.:

OF **Chris Snelling** (knee) and 1B **Andy Tracy** (hamstring, day-to-day) have both missed 3 consecutive games after leaving Thursday's game. OF **T.J. Bohn** has need suspended 2 games for arguing with umpire **Andy Vincent**.

WHO'S HOT:

OF **Brandon Watson** has a 7-G hit streak (8-30, 4 R)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 7 of his last 8 G (12-24) and in 14 of his last 18 G (26-59, .441-2-11) raising his AVG by 51 pts. He is batting to .367 (22-60) w/ RISP... C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in his last 7 of last 8 G (10-31, .323) and in 20 of his last 22 G (.385-0-8, 30-78, 12 R)... OF **Jon Knott** has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 G (18-52, .346-2-11, 5 2B)... OF **Chris Snelling** has hit in 9 of his last 10 GS w/ LHV (11-30, .367)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 21 of his last 28 G (31-100, .310-3-16) -- raising his AVG from .212 to .250. IT AIN'T EASY BEING GREEN?:

RHP **Steve Green** now has a scoreless IP streak of 11.1 IP. He has gone 3-0, 0.67 (27.0 ip, 2 er) in his last 12 G and has retired 80 of last 102 batters faced (78.4%). On 6/15, the Quebec native made a spot start -- his first since 7/24/06 (after 81 consecutive relief appearances) and shutout the league's highest scoring offense, Pawtucket, in his four innings (4.0 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 1 bb, 6 k) -- retiring 12 of the 14 BF.

'BLACK' MAGIC:

LHP **Travis Blackley** has turned in 4 consecutive 'quality starts' (his first 4 of '08) and is 3-0, 2.67 (27 ip, 8 er) in his last 4 GS. In addition, the 'Pigs are 7-0 in the last 7 G he has started -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.

- The 8.0 IP for Blackley on Thursday was his longest Triple-A outing of his career and the longest since 7/22/06 vs. Frisco (8.2 ip) when he was with San Antonio. He went 8.0 one other time in '06 (8.0 on 7/6/06 vs. Midland

BACON BITS:

- *Getting Series-ous:* With the split in Charlotte, the IronPigs have now either won or split 9 of the last 11 series. They've won five, split four and lost just two. They started the season losing their first 10 series.

- *Thou Shalt Not Steal:* The 'Pigs haven't allowed a SB in their last 7 G and since the 1st inn of 6/14 (69 inn. ago).
- LHV drew 2 BB last night and has only drawn 24 BB in the last 13 G (1.8). They're 10th in the IL with 219 BB.

- *Hit Parade:* The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 20 of last the 32 G (and tied in four) and are 17-15 in those 32 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 18 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).

- *To Be the Best...:* The 'Pigs are 3-27 (.100) against the Top 5 teams in the IL (SWB, SYR, LOU, PAW, TOL).

- *HR Drought:* LHV has only homered in 7 of the last 26 G (and in one of the games, it was an inside-the-park HR). The 'Pigs did have a franchise-record 4 HR on 6/3, but only have 9 conventional HR* in these 26 G. LHV (40 HR) is tied for 12th in the IL in HR (with RIC) ahead of just NOR (32).

- *Northern Lights?:* LHV is now 7-6 in its last 12 G vs. North Division teams. The 'Pigs started just 1-20 vs. division rivals.

- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 34 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 13-13, 3.47 (236.1 ip, 91 er)...

- *...But Righties:* RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Star' in their last 20 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-14, 7.02 ERA in their last 20 GS (91.0 ip, 71 er).

BACK IN THE I.L. CELLAR:

After spending the first 70 days of the season in last place in the IL, the IronPigs crawled ahead of Norfolk with a better winning percentage on June 13. The 'Pigs remained out of the cellar for three days, but are now back in the cellar after being swept by Pawtucket in their last series.

- LHV still trails Norfolk by only 1.0 game to climb back out of 14th.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 44-80 (.355) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 61-117 (.343) and a combined 48.0 GB.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

- Through their first 31 G (May 5), the IronPigs batted .214, averaged just 2.3 R/G and hit just .151 w/ RISP.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.

HUPPERT USED TO WINNING

IronPigs skipper **Dave Huppert** started the season in 3rd place in wins amongst active managers. The Top 8 also includes Scranton/Wilkes-Barre manager Dave Miley: (1) Marc Bombard -- 1,646; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,490; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- 1,425; (4) Dave Miley -- 1,268; (5) Rick Sweet -- 1,264; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,247; (7) Dave Machemer -- 1,233; (8) Bobby Jones -- 1,209.
