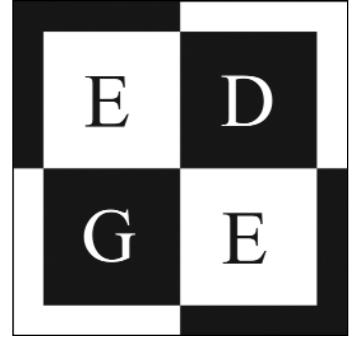

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (32-51) play Game Two of a three-game weekend series against the third-place Syracuse Chiefs (44-36) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 10-2 win last night, the IronPigs have won three consecutive games and are 6-3 in their last nine games. LHV has now scored 10 runs in back-to-back games (they hadn't scored 10 before). The improved 'Pigs are 21-17 in their last 28 games and 27-21 since starting the season 5-30. They remain 20.0 games behind PAW. The Chiefs (Toronto affiliate) have lost back-to-back games and have gone just 5-9 in their last 14 contests.

• First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m. The game features a Reggie performance, presented by **myBIGUPS.com**.

IT'S AS EASY AS...1-2-3!:

The IronPigs have tied their franchise record with a 3-game winning streak (4th time). The 'Pigs have had all four of these 3-G win streaks in the past 48 G after the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate had previously gone a dubious string of 156 games without back-to-back-to-back wins (from 5/5/07-5/11/08). The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four (4/14-4/19/07) and the Triple-A team has not had a 5-game winning streak since SWB won 5-straight 8/11-8/15/06.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP J.A. Happ (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound lefty selected in the 3rd round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of 2007 with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 in 24 GS) and made his first and only ML start 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first 3 seasons (2004-06), Happ advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the '06 Florida State League All-Star Game.

- Happ currently leads the IL with 99 K -- 3rd best in MiLB (Trevor Cahill, MID, 109; Drew Naylor, CLE, 100).
- Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is tied for a single-game high in the IL in '08 (Charlie Morton, RIC; 6/3 vs. DUR).
- After starting the season 0-3, 5.59 in his first 4 GS, Happ is 5-3, 3.25 (74.2 ip, 27 er) in his last 12 GS.
- Happ 4/29 vs. SYR (L, 1-0): n/d, 7.0 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 er, 4 bb, 5 k Duel w/ Purcey; stranded 3 in first 3 IP; ret'd 13 of last 14; Left 0-0

Just ONE!: Monday night marked the 3rd time LHP **J.A. Happ** allowed just 1 hit in a GS (1 in 5 ip on 4/13 @ RIC; 1 in 7 ip 4/29 vs. SYR). Amazingly, this was the first of these three outings he earned a victory.

RHP Scott Richmond, 28, is a 6-5, 225-pound right-hander from Langley, BC, Canada signed by Toronto as a non drafted free agent in October 2007 after spending three years with the Edmonton Cracker-Cats of the independent Northern League. He was named a Northern League All-Star in 2007 and finished 10-9, 4.26 in 23 GS. In three years with Edmonton, he combined to go 14-19, 4.37 and 12 SV in 82 G, 31 GS. Prior to this season, the former Oklahoma State pitcher played for Team Canada in the 2007 IBAF World Cup. While at OSU, Richmond and was an honorable mention All-Big 12 Conference pick as a Cowboy senior in 2005. He finished his OSU career 6-9, 3.66 and 7 SV in 164.2 IP.

- Richmond won his last start with New Hampshire, 4-2, on 6/23 @ New Britain: W, 7.0 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 5 k.
- Prior to winning his last start, Richmond had a three-start losing streak 6/7-6/18, going 0-3, 4.42 ERA.

SERIES STUFF:

SYR leads the 2008 series, 6-1, taking the last 2 G at CCP 4/29-4/30. The Chiefs also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6. Last night's LHV win snapped SYR's 9-game winning streak against the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate.

OF **Jon Knott** has homered in 3 straight G (has 5 in last 9 G) and has hit safely in 7 of 9 G (11-31, .355-5-14) and 16 of his last 20 G (24-70, .343-5-20, 6 2B)... C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in 23 of his last 26 G (.366-1-13, 34-93, 14 R)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 24 of his last 33 (36-118, .305-4-21) -- raising his AVG from .212 to .252. WHO'S HOT (PITCHING):

The bullpen has not allowed a R in the last 9.2 IP and is 2-0 with 2 SV and a 0.00 ERA in the last 2+ G... RHP **Matt Childers** is 3-0 with 7 SV and a 0.96 (18.2 ip, 2 er) in his last 14 G... RHP **Steve Green** had his scoreless IP streak snapped at of 12.1 IP Wednesday. Still, he's gone 4-0, 1.24 (29.0 ip, 4 er) in his last 14 G, retiring 86 of the last 112 BF (76.7%)... LHP **Travis Blackley** is 3-1, 3.00 (33 ip, 11 er) in his last 5 GS. In addition, the 'Pigs are 7-1 in the last 8 G he has started -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.

BACON BITS:

- After not scoring 10 runs in any of their first 81 G, the 'Pigs have scored a franchise-record 10 in back-to-back G.
- **Power Up!**: The 'Pigs have HRed in 6 straight G for the first time in LHV history. Previously, they had 3-straight twice. OF **Jon Knott** has HRed in 3 straight games tying the franchise record (Andy Tracy, 4/23-4/25).
- **Northern Lights?**: LHV is now 8-6 in its last 14 G vs. North Division teams. The 'Pigs started just 1-20 vs. division rivals. In fact, last night was their first win against any of the Top 3 teams in the North. LHV started 0-18 vs. PAW, SYR, SWB.
- **First Impressions**: LHV is now 12-11 in series openers -- they've gone 11-4 in their last 15 after starting 1-7.
- **Going on the Offensive!**: LHV is now 12th in AVG (.255) and has now passed two teams (BUF, RIC) in R (313) -- they'd been in last all season (first 84 days until 6/26); they once trailed the next highest run total (13th) by 46 R back on 5/5!
- **Getting Series-ous**: With the road series win at DUR, the IronPigs have now either won or split 10 of the last 12 series. They've won six, split four and lost just two. They started the season losing their first 10 series.
- **Road Warriors**: The 'Pigs have gone 10-8 in their last 18 road games. They started the season 3-22 on the road.
- **Out of the IL Cellar!**: LHV remains out of last place in the I.L. (by 1.0 G). They've been out for 7 days this season.
- **Clutch Knott**: OF **Jon Knott's** game-winning HR in the 8th on Wed. was his 5th GT or GW RBI from 8th inn.-on.
- **Hit Parade**: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 22 of last the 37 G (and five tied; outhit in just 10 G) and are 21-16 in those 37 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 20 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- The SHO on Monday marked the third of the season for LHV (second 9-inn. SHO) -- all since May 13. Meanwhile, the 'Pigs haven't been shutout since 4/29 (span of 56 G) after being shutout in 5 of their first 26 G.
- **Lovin' Lehigh Lefties**: In their last 38 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 15-14, 3.36 (260.0 ip, 97 er)...
- **...But Righties**: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 21 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-14, 7.43 ERA in their last 21 GS (95.2 ip, 79 er).

TRANSACTIONS, ETC:

Thursday, the IronPigs had their first transactions since 6/10. OF **Chris Snelling** placed on DL (lt. knee inflammation) retroactive to 6/24. RHP **Kris Benson** promoted to LHV from Clearwater (A). Benson made his first two appearances of '08 with CLE, combining to go 0-2, 8.10 in 2 GS (6.2 ip, 10 h, 6 r, 6 er, 3 bb, 6 k, 3 hr). He missed all of 2007 recovering from right rotator cuff surgery in March.... OF **Rich Thompson** has missed the last 5 G (oblique).

OUT OF THE I.L. CELLAR:

LHV climbed back ahead of NOR on Monday and out of the I.L. cellar -- (they climbed out for three days June 13-15) The IronPigs spent the first 70 days if the season in last place in the IL. They're 1.0 up on NOR for the first time.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 48-81 (.372) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 65-118 (.355) and a combined 49.0 GB.

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

- Through their first 31 G (May 5), the IronPigs batted .214, averaged just 2.3 R/G and hit just .151 w/ RISP.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
