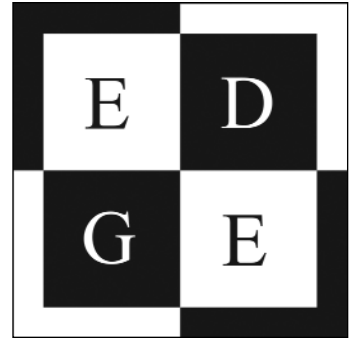

## TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (33-51) play the finale of a three-game weekend series against the third-place Syracuse Chiefs (44-37) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 2-1 win last night, the 'Pigs have won a franchise-record four straight games and are 7-3 in their last 10 games. The improved 'Pigs are 22-17 in their last 39 games and 28-21 since starting the season 5-30. Lehigh Valley is now 19.0 games behind PAW. The Chiefs (Toronto affiliate) have lost three consecutive games and have gone just 5-10 in their last 15 contests. Next up for LHV will be a pair of games in Rochester before returning home.

- First-Pitch today is at 1:35 p.m. for Ryan Howard Bobblehead Day, presented by **KAN-DO HOMES**.
- With a win today, the IronPigs will sweep a series (3 or 4 games) for the first time in franchise history and for the first time since the SWB Red Barons took three straight at SYR from 8/7/06-8/8/06.

## FORE!:

The IronPigs have set a franchise-record with a 4-game winning streak -- the longest by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa won 4 straight 4/14-4/19/07 -- the Lynx longest winning streak of 2007.

- Today, the IronPigs will look to a 5th straight for the first time since SWB won 5-straight 8/11-8/15/06.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

RHP **Kris Benson**, 33, is a 6-4, 205-pound right-hander from Atlanta, GA, signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent 2/13/08 after missing the entire 2007 season on Baltimore's D.L. recovering from right rotator cuff surgery (then released by the Orioles 11/1/07). Benson was the first overall pick in the 1996 draft by Pittsburgh out of Clemson University -- where he was the 1996 ACC Player of the Year and Athlete of the Year as well as *Baseball America's* College Player of the Year. He last spent the 2006 season with Baltimore, going 11-12, 4.82 in 30 GS. Benson made his ML debut 4/9/99 with a win over CHI-N and went on to lead rookie pitchers in ERA (4.07), IP (196.2) and K (184). He has spent 7 seasons in MLB, combining to go 68-73 with a 4.34 in 195 GS with Pittsburgh (1999-2004), New York-N (2004-05) and Baltimore (2006). A member of the 1996 U.S. Olympic Team, Benson was also named to both the Carolina League (A+) & Southern League (AA) 1997 All-Star Teams.

- Benson made his only 2 appearances w/ Clearwater, going 0-2, 8.10 in 2 GS (6.2 ip, 10 h, 6 r, 6 er, 3 bb, 6 k, 3 hr).
- Benson lost his last start, 2-1, on 6/24 vs. Vero Beach: L, 4.2 ip, 7 h, 1 r, 1 er, 2 bb, 3 k (2-out, RBI-1B in 5th)

RHP **Mike MacDonald**, 26, is a 6-1, 185-pound right-hander selected by Toronto in the 15th round in 2004 out of University of Maine. A Maine native, MacDonald began the year in New Hampshire (AA) and went 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA in 4 relief appearances before a mid-April promotion. He spent most of 2007 with Syracuse (6-8, 4.88 ERA in 23 GS) and ranked 2nd on the team in IP (134.2) and 3rd in K (83). In 2006, he led the Eastern League in starts (28) and finished third in wins (13) and IP (171.1). While at the University of Maine, he was named America East Pitcher of the Year during his senior campaign. He also set a school-record by compiling 284 career strikeouts.

- MacDonald has made just 3 starts, most recently on 6/15 @ TOL (2.0 ip, 1 h, 0 r, 0 bb, 1 k)
- MacDonald has gone 0-0, 0.56 in his last 6 G (SV, 16.0 ip, 8 h, r, er, 2 bb, 8 k) & in unscored upon in 9 of 11 G.

## SERIES STUFF:

SYR leads the 2008 series, 6-2, but the IronPigs have won the last 2 G after SYR had a 9-game winning streak against the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate going back to '07. The Chiefs also won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

## WHO'S HOT (OFFENSE):

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in his last 6 G (11-22, .500-2-6); 13 of his last 14 G (23-46, .500-3-11) and in 20 of his last 24 G (37-81, .457-4-17) raising his AVG by .69 pts! He is batting to .369 (24-65) w/ RISP... OF **Jon Knott** has homered in 5 of his last 10 G and has hit safely 16 of his last 21 G (24-74, .324-5-20, 6 2B)... C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in 24 of his last 27 G (.365-1-13, 35-96, 14 R)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in his last 3 G (5-11, 4 RBI) and in 25 of his last 34 (38-121, .314-4-22) -- raising his AVG from .212 to .256. On defense, he has 1 E in his last 59 G (went 46 consecutive G w/o an E)... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in his last 4 G (7-17) with 3-straight multi-hit G & in 35 of his last 41 G (.345-3-22, 57-165)... OF **T.J. Bohn** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (7-19, .368-1-1, 4 2B)...

## WHO'S HOT (PITCHING):

The bullpen has not allowed a R in the last 9.2 IP and is 2-0 with 2 SV and a 0.00 ERA in the last 2+ G... RHP **Matt Childers** is 3-0 with 8 SV and a 0.92 (19.2 ip, 2 er) in his last 15 G... RHP **Steve Green** had his scoreless IP streak snapped at of 12.1 IP Wednesday. Still, he's gone 4-0, 1.24 (29.0 ip, 4 er) in his last 14 G, retiring 86 of the last 112 BF (76.7%)... LHP **Stephen Randolph** is unscored upon in his last 3 G (3.1 ip) -- retiring his last 11 BF. LHP **Travis Blackley** is 3-1, 3.00 (33 ip, 11 er) in his last 5 GS. In addition, the 'Pigs are 7-1 in the last 8 G he has started -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.... LHP **J.A. Happ** has gone 3-1, 2.51 (32.1 ip, 24 h, 9 er) in his last 5 GS.

## BACON BITS:

- *Fast Starts:* The IronPigs have scored at least 1 R in the first inning in 7 of their last 10 G.
- *One-derful:* After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 12-7 in their last 19 such G.
- *Last Laugh?:* LHV will try to sweep its first series of 2008 tonight. However, the 'Pigs are just 6-16 in series finales.
- *Northern Lights?:* LHV is now 9-6 in its last 15 G vs. North Division teams. The 'Pigs started just 1-20 vs. division rivals. In fact, last night was their first win against any of the Top 3 teams in the North. LHV started 0-18 vs. PAW, SYR, SWB.
- *Getting Series-ous:* With their win last night, the IronPigs have now either won or split 11 of the last 13 series. They've won seven, split four and lost just two. They started the season losing their first 10 series.
- *Going on the Offensive!, Pt 1:* In their last 53 G (since 5/5) LHV is batting .280 (499-1782) averaging 4.6 R/G.
- *Going on the Offensive!, Pt 2:* LHV is now 11th in AVG (.256) and has now passed two teams (BUF, RIC) in R (315) -- they'd been in last all season (first 84 days until 6/26); they once trailed the next highest run total (13th) by 46 R back on 5/5!
- *Road Warriors:* The 'Pigs have gone 10-8 in their last 18 road games. They started the season 3-22 on the road.
- *Out of the IL Cellar!:* LHV is out of last place in the I.L. by 2.5 G (NOR). They've been out for 8 days this season.
- *Klutch Knott:* OF **Jon Knott's** game-winning HR in the 8th on Wed. was his 5th GT or GW RBI from 8th inn.-on.
- *Hit Parade:* The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 23 of last the 38 G (and five tied; outhit in just 10 G) and are 22-16 in those 38 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 21 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- The SHO on Monday marked the third of the season for LHV (second 9-inn. SHO) -- all since May 13. Meanwhile, the 'Pigs haven't been shutout since 4/29 (span of 56 G) after being shutout in 5 of their first 26 G.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 39 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 15-14, 3.30 (267.2 ip, 98 er)...
- *...But Righties:* RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 21 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-14, 7.43 ERA in their last 21 GS (95.2 ip, 79 er).

## TRANSACTIONS, ETC:

Thursday, the IronPigs had their first transactions since 6/10. OF **Chris Snelling** placed on DL (lt. knee inflammation) retroactive to 6/24. RHP **Kris Benson** promoted to LHV from Clearwater (A). Benson made his first two appearances of '08 with CLE, combining to go 0-2, 8.10 in 2 GS (6.2 ip, 10 h, 6 r, 6 er, 3 bb, 6 k, 3 hr). He missed all of 2007 recovering from right rotator cuff surgery in March.... OF **Rich Thompson** has missed the last 5 G (oblique).

## OUT OF THE I.L. CELLAR:

LHV climbed back ahead of NOR on Monday and out of the I.L. cellar -- (they climbed out for three days June 13-15) The IronPigs spent the first 70 days if the season in last place in the IL. They're 1.0 up on NOR for the first time.

## PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 49-81 (.377) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 66-118 (.359) and a combined 48.0 GB.

## SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

- Through their first 31 G (May 5), the IronPigs batted .214, averaged just 2.3 R/G and hit just .151 w/ RISP.

## PRESEASON NOTES:

### BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
