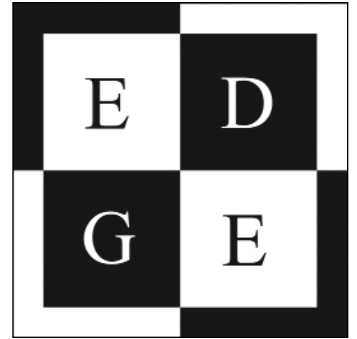

## TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (33-52) start a two-game road series tonight against the fifth-place Rochester Red Wings (38-47) at Frontier Field. With a 6-3 loss last night, the 'Pigs snapped their franchise-record, four-game winning streak\*. Even so, Lehigh Valley still took the series vs. SYR, 2-games-to-1, and is 7-4 in the last 11 games. The improved 'Pigs are 28-22 since starting the season 5-30, but are still 20.0 games behind PAW. The Red Wings (Minnesota affiliate) lost their previous series to Pawtucket, 2-games-to-1. Still, they've gone 12-8 in the last 20 games. First-Pitch tonight is at 7:05 p.m.

- The 'Pigs are coming off their first winning road trip in LHV franchise history (5-3 in 4 G @ CHA; 4 G @ DUR)
- *Road Warriors:* The 'Pigs have gone 10-8 in their last 18 road games. They started the season 3-22 on the road.
- *First Impressions:* LHV is 12-11 in series openers -- they've gone 11-4 in their last 15 after starting 1-7.

### With a win tonight, the IronPigs/Phillies Triple-A affiliate will:

- Win 3 straight road games for the first time since SWB ended the 2006 season with 3 straight wins (9/1-9/4/06). The IronPigs won the last two games in Durham on 6/25-6/26.

### \*FORE!:

The IronPigs set a franchise-record with a 4-game winning streak 6/25-6/28 -- the longest by a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate since Ottawa won 4 straight 4/14-4/19/07 -- the Lynx longest winning streak of 2007. The Phillies' Triple-A affiliates have not won 5 straight for the first time since SWB won 5-straight games 8/11-8/15/06.

## PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Travis Blackley**, 25, is a 6-3, 200-lb lefthander who was selected by the Phillies from San Francisco in the Rule 5 draft, 12/6/07 -- and outrighted to Lehigh Valley when the Giants declined to take him back at the end of Spring Training. The Australia native appeared in two games with San Francisco (0-0, 7.27 ERA in 8.2 ip) last year after spending the bulk of his season with Fresno (10-8, 4.66 in 28 GS). Blackley was originally signed by Seattle 10/29/00 prior to being traded to SF for OF Jason Ellison on 4/1/07, and he made in to the majors with SEA as a 21-year-old in 2004 (won his ML debut in a start 7/1/04 vs. TEX). The Aussie played for the World squad in the 2003 Futures Game at Cellular Field (Chi) and was on Australia's provisional roster for the inaugural World Baseball Classic.

- Blackley has turned in 4 QS in his last 5 GS (his first 4 of '08) and is 3-1, 3.00 ERA (33 ip, 11 er) in his last 5 GS.
- The 'Pigs are 7-1 in the last 8 G he has started (had been 7-0) -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.
- Blackley vs. ROC: 0-0, 2.45 in 2 GS (11.0 ip, 10 h, 3 r, 3 er, 7 bb, 8 k, hr. 244).

RHP **Francisco Liriano**, 24, is a 6-2, 225-pound right-hander acquired by Minnesota with RHP Joe Nathan and RHP Boof Bonser from San Francisco for C.A.J. Pierzynski on 11/14/03. Originally signed by SF as a non-drafted free agent 9/9/00 out of San Cristobal, D.R., Liriano missed the entire 2007 season recovering from T.J. Surgery on his left elbow (11/6/06). Liriano his ML debut 9/5/05 vs. TEX in relief then earned his first ML win 9/30 vs. DET (7 ip, 8 k). He was promoted in 2005 after leading all MiLB in K (204) and being named to *Baseball America's* MiLB All-Star Team, Triple-A All-Star Team and Triple-A Player of the Year. As a "rookie" in 2006, Liriano went 12-3, 2.16 in 28 G, 16 GS and was named to the A.L. All-Star Team -- he was 10-1, 1.83 at the break, becoming just the 2nd rookie in ML history to have at least 10 wins and a sub-2.00 ERA (Jerry Koosman, 1968: 11-4, 1.91). He set the Twins all-time rookie K record at 144, breaking Bert Blyleven's mark of 135 in 1970 -- leading all A.L. rookies. He also 2nd in the class in ERA (2.16) and W (12) and finished 3rd in the R.O.Y. voting behind Justin Verlander and Jonathan Papelbon.

- Liriano started the season with Minnesota, but was 0-3, 11.32 in 3 GS (@ KC, vs. CLE, @ OAK).
- Liriano's won his last 4 decisions, going 4-0, 4.86 in 5 GS (29.2 ip, 16 er). He was 0-2, 4.18 in his first 8 GS.
- Liriano won his last start, though not dominate, on 6/25 @ LOU (W, 10-8): W, 5.1 ip, 9 h, 6 r, 5 er, 1 bb, 3 k.

## SERIES STUFF:

ROC leads the series, 5-3; but LHV took the last series, 2-1, at Coca-Cola Park from 6/7-6/9. ROC won the previous series at Frontier Field, 2-1, from 4/23-4/25. The 'Wings won the 2007 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

## ANDY TRACY NAMED INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE BATTER-OF-THE-WEEK

The IL announced today that 1B **Andy Tracy** has been named the IL's Batter-of-the-Week for the period from June 23-29 -- becoming the first IronPigs player to win a Player of the Week (took until the 12th week). For the week, Tracy hit .520-2-6, leading the IL with 13 hits, 10 runs and a .625 on-base percentage. The 34-year-old was also at or near the top of the League in several other offensive categories. He was tied for 1st in extra-base hits (6) and doubles (4), while he finished 2nd in batting average (.520) and slugging percentage (.920). His hot bat this week increased Tracy's average on the season to .314, the third-best mark in the IL. His .413 on-base percentage is best in the IL. The native of Bowling Green, Ohio, hit safely in all seven games this week, including five multi-hit performances (and four in a row to end the week). He homered twice and drove in six runs, giving him a club best 13 HR and 50 RBI on the year. Tracy helped spark the IronPigs to a 5-2 week, including their first-ever road series victory, which came in DUR.

### WHO'S HOT:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in his last 7 G (13-25, .520-2-6); 14 of his last 15 G (25-49, .510-3-11) and in 21 of his last 25 G (39-84, .464-4-17) raising his AVG by .73 pts! He is batting to .369 (24-65) w/ RISP... OF **Jon Knott** has homered in 5 of his last 11 G and has hit safely 16 of his last 22 G (24-78, .308-5-20, 6 2B)... C **Jason Jaramillo** has hit in 24 of his last 27 G (.365-1-13, 35-96, 14 R)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in his last 4 G (6-15, 4 RBI) and in 26 of his last 35 (39-125, .312-4-22) -- raising his AVG from .212 to .256. On defense, he has 1 E in his last 60 G (went 46 consecutive G w/o an E)... OF **T.J. Bohn** has hit in 5 of his last 6 G (9-23, .391-1-1, 4 2B)...INF **Mike Cervanak** has hit in 4 of his last 5 G (7-22) with 3 multi-hit G & in 35 of his last 42 G (.335-3-22, 57-170)...

### WHO'S HOT (PITCHING):

The bullpen had its scoreless streak snapped at 15.0 IP in the 9th yesterday. Still, the corps is 2-0, 2 SV, 1.13 (16, 2 ip) in the last 3+ G... RHP **Matt Childers** is 3-0 with 8 SV and a 0.92 (19.2 ip, 2 er) in his last 15 G... LHP **Stephen Randolph** is unscored upon in his last 3 G (3.1 ip) -- retiring his last 11 BF... RHP **John Ennis** has not allowed a R in his last 5.1 IP (3 G)... LHP **Travis Blackley** is 3-1, 3.00 (33 ip, 11 er) in his last 5 GS. In addition, the 'Pigs are 7-1 in the last 8 G he has started -- all after he came of the DL (groin) on 5/19.... LHP **J.A. Happ** has gone 3-1, 2.51 (32.1 ip, 24 h, 9 er) in his last 5 GS.

### BACON BITS:

- *Fast Starts:* The IronPigs have scored at least 1 R in the first inning in 7 of their last 11 G.
- *Northern Lights?:* LHV is 9-7 in its last 16 G vs. North Division teams. The 'Pigs started just 1-20 vs. division rivals. In fact, the 2 wins against SYR were their firsts against any of the Top 3 in the North (started 0-18 vs. PAW, SYR, SWB).
- *Getting Series-ous:* The IronPigs have now either won or split 11 of the last 13 series. They've won seven, split four and lost just two. They started the season losing their first 10 series.
- *Out of the IL Cellar!* LHV is out of last place in the I.L. by 1.5 G (NOR). They've been out for 8 days this season.
- *Going on the Offensive!, Pt 1:* In their last 53 G (since 5/5) LHV is batting .281 (511-1820) averaging 4.6 R/G.
- *Going on the Offensive!, Pt 2:* LHV is now 10th in AVG (.257) and has passed two RIC in R -- they'd been in last all season until 6/26 (first 84 days of 2008); they once trailed the next highest run total (13th) by 46 R back on 5/5!
- *Hit Parade:* The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 24 of last the 39 G (and five tied; outhit in just 10 G) and are 22-17 in those 39 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 22 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Klutch Knott:* OF **Jon Knott's** game-winning HR in the 8th on Wed. was his 5th GT or GW RBI from 8th inn.-on.
- *One-derful:* After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 12-7 in their last 19 such G.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties:* In their last 39 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 15-14, 3.30 (267.2 ip, 98 er)...
- *...But Righties:* RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 22 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-15, 7.50 ERA in their last 22 GS (99.2 ip, 83 er).

### OUT OF THE I.L. CELLAR:

LHV climbed back ahead of NOR on 6/23 and out of the I.L. cellar -- (they climbed out for three days June 13-15) The IronPigs spent the first 70 days if the season in last place in the IL.

### PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 49-82 (.374) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 66-119 (.357) and a combined 49.0 GB.

### SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

- Through their first 31 G (May 5), the IronPigs batted .214, averaged just 2.3 R/G and hit just .151 w/ RISP.

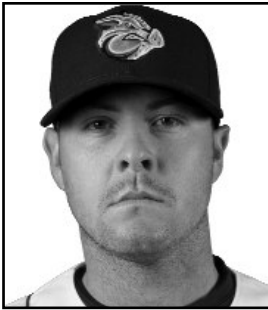
