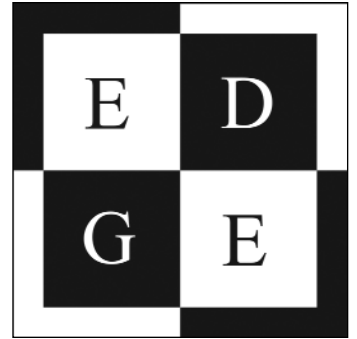

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (20-41) play Game Three of a four-game series against the Indianapolis Indians (29-32) at Victory Field. Lehigh Valley blew a 3-2 lead in the 8th inning yesterday and lost, 4-3 -- so the team is now 2-4 on this eight-game road trip. Still, the 'Pigs are 9-7 in their last 16 games and have gone 15-11 since starting the season 5-30. They remain 17.0 games behind in the North. The fourth-place Indians (Pirates affiliate) snapped a three-game losing streak but are just 6-9 in their last 15 G. Indy has gone just 18-28 since their fast 11-4 start. First-Pitch tonight is at 7:00 p.m.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **J.A. Happ** (who goes by 'J'), 25, is a 6-6, 200-pound left-hander selected by Philadelphia in the third-round of 2004 out of Northwestern University. An Illinois native, Happ is a current member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster and ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the organization. He spent most of the 2007 season with Ottawa (4-6, 5.02 ERA in 24 starts), yet made his first and only ML start on 6/7/07 vs. NYN (L, 4 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 5 k). In his first three seasons (2004-06), Happ rapidly advanced through the system posting a combined record of 16-15 with an impressive 2.49 ERA and a trip to the 2006 Florida State League All-Star Game in Lakeland.

- Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is the most in the IL in '08. He's currently 2nd in the IL w/ 71 K (Parrish, SYR, 72).
- Happ suffered his worse loss of '08 last start (5/31 @ LOU, L, 5 ip, 13 h, 8 r, 8 er, 0 bb, 1 k). In his previous 7 GS, Happ had gone 2-1 with a 2.20 ERA (45 ip, 11 er, 46 k) and a .218 OBA (34-156).
- Happ 5/26 vs. IND: W, 7 ip, 6 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 4 k Retired 9 of 1st 10 BF; lone R in 5th; stranded 3 in 5th (Thompson 4-6)

RHP **Jason Davis**, 28, is a 6-6, 210-pound right-hander signed by Pittsburgh on 3/30/08 after being released by Texas at the end of this Spring Training (non-roster invitee). Davis was originally selected by Cleveland in the 21st round of 1999 out of Cleveland State (TN) CC. The Charleston, TN, native made his ML debut 9/9/02 vs. TOR (4 ip, 3 h, 1 er, 0 bb, 4 k) and spent the entire 2003 season in the Indians rotation in 2003 (8-11, 4.68 in 27 GS). He was up and down with Cleveland until last season, when he was designated 5/7/07 -- then traded to Seattle on 5/13/07 for a PTBNL. He combined to go 2-0, 5.84 in 24 G, 0 GS before going to Tacoma (0-2, 7.11 in 5 GS) and then shutting down his season 8/19 (personal matters). Overall, his ML totals are 20-22, 4.78 with 1 SV in 130 G, 52 GS.

- Davis is just 1-3 in his last 5 GS, but has a 2.67 ERA (30.1 ip, 10 r, 9 er) in those games.
- Davis snapped a 3-start losing streak with a 4-3 win his last outing, 5/31 vs. TOL: W, 5.2 ip, 4 h, r, er, 3 bb, 4 k.
- Davis 5/26 @ LHV: L, 6 ip, 7 h, 3 r, 3 er, 3 bb, 3 k Single R in 1st (Tracy RBI-1B), 4th (Robles RBI-1B) & 5th (Tracy HR)

SERIES STUFF:

LHV leads the 2008 season series, 4-2, after taking the first series 5/26-5/29. IND won the 2007 series, 5-3.

CERVENAK'S STREAK OVER:

Yesterday, INF **Mike Cervenak** went 0-4, snapping his franchise-record 18-game hitting streak -- the longest hitting streak in the IL in 2008 (previously 17 by Andy Phillips, LOU; and Alex Escobar, COL). The longest hitting streak in MLB in 2008 is 28 games by **Michael Jones** with Greensboro (SAL) from 4/9-5/7.

Cervenak batted .423-2-13 (30-71) during the streak, which lasted from 5/16-6/3. Still, he has hit in 18 of his last 19 G (.400-2-13, 30-75) and in 22 of his last 24 G (37-95, .389-3-22). He is 1st in the IL in hits (71), 6th in AVG (.321) and T-4th in R (38). He leads the club with 20 multi-hit games.

CATCHING FIRE: JARAMILLO AND SUOMI

LHV Catchers -- **Jason Jaramillo** and **John Suomi** -- have combined to hit safely in their last 17 consecutive games. Now that Cervenak's streak is over, **Jason Jaramillo** has the 'Pigs longest hitting streak at 11 G (.486-0-4, 18-37, 8 R) -- which is also the 3rd longest current streak in the IL (Brent Clevlen, TOL, 15; Omir Santos, NOR, 12). Earlier this season, Jaramillo had a 10-game streak (4/14-4/25). **John Suomi** has hit safely in his last 6 starts (.320-1-3, 8-25), but he doesn't have a streak because of a PH appearance 5/28 (6-3). Jaramillo has also gunned down 14 of the last 37 (37.8%) SB attempts and has had 3 POs...

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

In the last 16 G, the LHV bullpen has gone 8-3, 2.25, 7 SV (84.0 ip, 21 er) in the last 24 G. They've stranded 15 of their last 18 inherited runners... SS **Mike Rouse** has hit safely in his last 9 G (12-34, .353-0-8)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 10 of his last 11 G (16-40, .400-2-9). He hasn't committed an error in his last 38 G... RHP **Steve Green** snapped his scoreless streak at 13.2 IP on Saturday, but has only allowed 2 R in his last 16.1 IP (1.10) and is 2-0 w/ a HOLD in his last 7 G... LHP **Travis Blackley** had his first W and QS of season Tuesday (6 ip, 1 er) and was 2-2 at the plate with a 2B and a SAC-bunt.

BACON BITS:

- Yesterday's loss marked the first time the 'Pigs pen blew a lead and lost since 5/16 (18 games ago), when the NOR erased a 5-2 deficit by scoring 7 R in the last 3 IP for a 9-6 victory.
- *Close Calls*: Of the IronPigs last 14 losses, 12 (86%) have being tight enough for a SV situations for the opponent.
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outthit their opponents in 12 of last the 16 G (tied in one) and are 9-7 in those 16 G - with double-digit hit totals in 10 G. They only outthit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Gaining Ground*: LHV has climbed another spot in MILB by pulling ahead of Rome (SAL, Atlanta) on Sunday -- now a better record than three other teams. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 7-4 in their last 10 such G.
- *Though Shalt Not Steal*: In the first 20 G, the 'Pigs were just 4-29 (86%) nailing SB attempts; in the last 40 G, the catchers have thrown out 24-56 (42.9%) with 3 POs.
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 8-3, 2.25, 7 SV (84.0 ip, 21 er) in the last 24 G. They've stranded 15 of their last 18 inherited runners.
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 25 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 9-6, 3.24 (161.1 ip, 58 er)...
- *...But Righties?*: There hasn't been a 'Quality Start' by a RH starter since RHP Ron Chiavacci's win 4/14 vs. RIC. IronPig RH starters have gone just 1-13 with a 8.19 ERA in their last 16 GS (70.1 ip, 64 er).
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 35 sacrifices (22 bunts, 13 flies) in the past 34 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

HOMERUNS (JUNE 3):

The four HRs hit by the IronPigs on Tuesday (6/3) was a season-high -- and it came after LHV started the road trip without a HR in the Louisville series. LHV hadn't had a HR since the inside-the-park HR by Javon Moran in the 1st inning 5/29 vs. IND (47.2 innings span) -- and they hadn't had a 'traditional' HR in 7+ games (68.2 innings span).

- The back-to-back HRs by **Andy Tracy** and **Brennan King** were also a franchise first.
- **Brennan King** also became the first IronPig with a 2-HR game. He hadn't homered since 4/7 (Game 4) -- a span of 173 AB. His 8 total bases last night also tied a franchise record with **Javon Moran** (5/29 vs. IND).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .275 (270-981, 18 HR) in 30 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .247. They have averaged 4.7 R/G (141) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .293 (83-283) w/ RISP in the 29 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .229 for the season.

IIN THE ma-ZONE!:

LHP **Brian Mazone** has won 6 straight decisions (and had two wins blown). After starting 0-2 in 2 GS, he is 6-1, 2.73 in his last 10 GS (66.0 ip, 20 er, 11 bb, 30 k). In his IL career, Mazone is currently 22-8, 2.47 ERA in 38 GS (244.0 ip, 67 er). As a pro, he has gone 78-46 -- a .629 win%.

- Along with a PH appearance on 5/10, the IronPigs are now 9-4 in games in which Mazone appears.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 36-71 (.336) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 53-107 (.331) and a combined 45.5 GB

SLOW START

The IronPigs' 0-11 start was the worst start in all of Minor League Baseball and the slowest in IL history in the last 30 years (the 2000 Richmond Braves and the 2001 Columbus Clippers both started 0-8). The first win in franchise history -- a 3-1 victory 4/14 vs. RIC -- also snapped a 14-game losing streak (dating back to last year) for a Phillies' Triple-A affiliate and was the first win for an affiliated team in the Lehigh Valley since the 1960 Allentown Red Sox.

PRESEASON NOTES:

BASEBALL IS BACK:

The IronPigs inaugural season will snap a 47-year draught of affiliated baseball in the Lehigh Valley -- which has been void since the Allentown Red Sox of the Eastern League departed for Johnstown following their stint from 1958-60. Other major league teams once represented in the LV were the Cardinals (1940, 1942-52, 1954-56), the Phillies (1941), the Boston Braves (1939) and the Brooklyn Dodgers (1935-36). The only other professional baseball team in the LV during the draught were the independent Allentown Ambassadors (1997-2003) of the Northern/Northeast Leagues.
