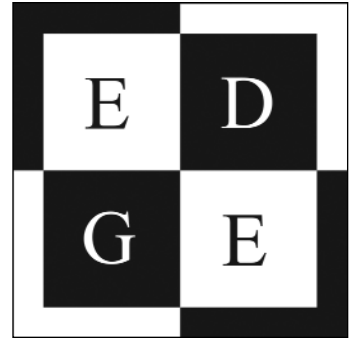

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (23-42) play the finale of a three-game series against the Rochester Red Wings (26-39) at Coca-Cola Park. With a walk-off 5-4 victory in 10 innings yesterday, Lehigh Valley has won three of its last four games and started this season-long 11-game homestand at 2-0. The 'Pigs are now 12-8 in their last 20 games and have gone 18-12 since starting the season 5-30. They have pulled to 16.5 games behind in the North. The fifth-place Red Wings (Minnesota affiliate) are now just 3-7 in the last 10 games. Since 12-12 when they last playing Lehigh Valley on 4/27, the 'Wings have gone just 14-27. Starting tomorrow, Buffalo will arrive in Allentown for a four-game series.

- First-Pitch is at 7:05 p.m. Gates will open at 6 p.m. for IronPigs Fan Dance-Off, presented by 69 News/WFMZ-TV.

With a win tonight, the IronPigs/Phillies Triple-A affiliate will:

- Have their 4th, three-game win streak in 30 G -- significant because the Phillies' Triple-A affiliate had previously gone a dubious string of 156 games without back-to-back-to-back wins (since Ottawa won three in a row 5/3/07-5/5/07). The Lynx longest winning streak of 2007 was four (4/14-4/19/07)
- Sweep a series (3 or 4 games) for the first time in franchise history and for the first time since the SWB Red Barons took three straight at SYR from 8/7/06-8/8/06.

PITCHING MATCHUP:

LHP **Les Walrond** will make his eighth start with the IronPigs after beginning the season with the Iowa Cubs (PCL, AAA) -- where he went 1-1, 6.55 in 7 G, 0 GS. Walrond, 31, is a 6-3, 205-pound left-hander out of Tulsa, OK, who was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent 4/29/08. Originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of 1998 out of University of Kansas, Walrond spent the 2007 season exclusively in Iowa, where he was 11-5, 4.77 in 27 G, 24 GS. He made his ML debut with Kansas City on 6/8/03 and later appeared in 10 G with Chicago-N in 2006. In his ML career, Walrond has gone 0-3, 7.46 in 17 G, 2 GS (25.1 ip, 30 h, 22 r, 21 er, 19 bb, 27 k).

- Walrond started the first and only SHO in LHV history in a 7-0 win 5/13 vs. NOR (7 ip, 5 h, 5 k)

LHP **Brian Duensing**, 25, is a 5-11, 211-pound left-hander from Omaha, NE, who was selected by Minnesota in the third round of the 2005 draft out of University of Nebraska (where he underwent Tommy John surgery). He started 2007 with New Britain (4-1, 2.96 in 9 GS) before his promotion to Rochester on 5/30 -- then went on to finish third in the IL in ERA (3.24) and tied for third in wins (11). In all he was 11-5 with a 3.24 ERA in 19 GS (3 CG). Duensing pitched in the IBAF World Cup in Taiwan on 11/18 and allowed one hit in the first three innings for Team USA in their 6-3 victory over Cuba in the Gold Medal Game. He is ranked as the No. 8 Prospect in the Twins system by *Baseball America*.

- Duensing was *completely robbed of a W* his last GS (6/4 @ BUF): n/d, 8 ip, 4 h, 0 r, 0 bb, 3 k (left up 6-0 in 9th).
- Duensing hasn't earned a W since 4/24 vs. LHV. After that win, he is winless in 8 GS (0-2, 5.00; 45 ip, 25 er).
- Duensing 4/24 vs. LHV: W, 7 ip, 3 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 5 k Retired 11 of first 12 BF til solo HR in 4th (Tracy); then retired 10 of last 11

ROC leads the series, 4-3, after sweeping 2 G at CCP 4/26-27. The 'Wings also won the '07 season-series vs. OTT, 10-6.

OF **Jon Knott** has hit safely in his last 4 G (6-15, 3 2B)... 1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 6 of his last 8 G (12-28, .429-1-6) raising his AVG by 26 pts... INF **Mike Cervenak** has hit in 19 of his last 22 G (.360-2-13, 32-89)... 3B **Brennan King** has hit in 6 of his last 7 G (10-25, .400-2-6) and in 13 of his last 15 G (20-56, .357-2-11). WALK THIS WAY!:

The walk-off win last night was the fourth of the season for the IronPigs, and their first since 5/24 vs. CHA. It was also the first time someone other than **Jon Knott** had the game-winning hit -- as **Andy Tracy** drove in **Mike Cervenak** in the 10th for the victory. It was the LHV's first walk-off victory on 5/9 vs. COL that coincided with the IronPigs turnaround. They were 5-30 at the time of that first walk-off win, they are 18-12 since...

BACON BITS:

- *Extra! Extra!*: The IronPigs are now 5-2 in extra-inning games; the Red Wings fell to 4-6 in extra-inning affairs.
- *Home Sweet Home*: The IronPigs now are .500 at home (15-15) for the first time this season.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 1*: In the last 8 G, LHV starters are 3-2, 2.39 ERA (49 ip, 13 er) -- with 3 additional wins blown.
- *Start Me Up! Pt 2*: For the first time this year, the IronPigs have six consecutive 'quality starts' (would be eight straight, but they did not stretch out Gary Knotts for a 6th inning in his 5 ip, 2 r start 6/2 @ LOU).
- *One-derful*: After starting the season 0-8 in one-run games, they IronPigs have gone 8-5 in their last 13 such G.
- *HR Drought*: LHV has not homered in the last 5 G since 6/3 -- when they had a franchise-record 4 HR. And they hadn't had a conventional HR* in the 7 G before that (*they did have an ITP HR). LHV (34) is 13th in the IL in HR ahead of NOR (29).
- *Home is Where the Bats Are...*: In the last 6 G at Coca-Cola Park, LHV is batting .335 (70-209) with 6.2 R/G (37).
- *Popping in the Clutch*: In their first 31 G, the IronPigs batter just .151 w/ RISP. In their last 34 G, the IronPigs are batting .301 w/ RISP.
- *Hit Parade*: The 'Pigs have outhit their opponents in 15 of last the 20 G (tied in one) and are 12-8 in those 20 G -- with double-digit hit totals in 13 G. They only outhit their opponents in 12 of the first 45 G (11-34).
- *Lovin' Lehigh Lefties*: In their last 27 GS, 'Pigs LH starters are 10-7, 3.13 (181.0 ip, 63 er)...
- *...But Righties*: RH starters have only had 1 'Quality Start' in their last 17 GS (on 6/7, Gary Knotts snapped an 16-start QS drought since 4/14). LHV RH starters have gone just 2-13, 7.55 ERA in their last 17 GS (76.1 ip, 64 er).
- The win by RHP **Gary Knotts** on Saturday was the first by a RH starter since he won 5/15 vs. NOR. It was also the first 'quality start' by a RH starter in 17 GS (since RHP **Ron Chiavacci's** last win 4/14 vs. RIC).
- *Spelling R-E-L-I-E-F*: The 'Pigs relief corps has gone 9-3, 2.67, 7 SV (94.1 ip, 28 er) in the last 28 G. They've stranded 15 of their last 19 inherited runners.
- *Sacrifice!*: The 'Pigs have 37 sacrifices (23 bunts, 14 flies) in the past 37 G. They only had 9 SACs in the first 27 G.

GAINING GROUND:

- *Pt. 1*: LHV has pulled to within 2.0 games of Charlotte (2.5 behind NOR) as they try to climb out of the IL cellar.
- *Pt. 2*: LHV has pulled to within 3.0 games of Rochester as they try to climb out of the IL North Division cellar.
- *Pt. 3*: LHV has climbed another spot in MILB by pulling ahead of Rome (SAL, Atlanta) last Sunday -- now a better record than 3 other teams. They climbed out of the cellar and over St. Lucie (FSL, NY-N) on 5/13.

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE:

Since 5/5, the 'Pigs are batting .277 (310-1120, 18 HR) in 34 G, raising the team AVG from .214 to .249. They have averaged 4.8 R/G (159) after averaging just 2.3 R/G in the first 31 games of 2008. They're also batting .301 (101-336) w/ RISP in the 34 G after starting .151 (33-219) in those situations in 31 G -- improving to .241 for the season.

HAPPY DAYS:

LHP **J.A. Happ** has won in 3 of his last 4 decisions and is 3-2, 3.28 in his last 9 GS (57.2 ip, 21 er). His 10 Ks last start put him back in 1st in the IL (81 K), 3rd best in MILB. Happ's 13 K on 5/9 vs. COL is the most in the IL in '08.

CERVENAK'S STREAK OVER:

Wednesday, INF **Mike Cervenak** went 0-4, snapping his franchise-record 18-game hitting streak -- the longest hitting streak in the IL in 2008 (previously 17 by Andy Phillips, LOU; and Alex Escobar, COL). The longest hitting streak in MILB in 2008 is 28 games by **Michael Jones** with Greensboro (SAL) from 4/9-5/7. Cervenak batted .423-2-13 (30-71) during the streak, which lasted from 5/16-6/3.

HOMERUNS (JUNE 3):

The four HRs hit by the IronPigs on Tuesday (6/3) was a season-high -- and it came after LHV started the road trip without a HR in the Louisville series. LHV hadn't had a HR since the inside-the-park HR by Javon Moran in the 1st inning 5/29 vs. IND (47.2 innings span) -- and they hadn't had a 'traditional' HR in 7+ games (68.2 innings span).

- The back-to-back HRs by **Andy Tracy** and **Brennan King** were also a franchise first.
- **Brennan King** also became the first IronPig with a 2-HR game. He hadn't homered since 4/7 (Game 4) -- a span of 173 AB. His 8 total bases last night also tied a franchise record with **Javon Moran** (5/29 vs. IND).

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to last season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 39-72 (.351) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 56-108 (.341) and a combined 45.0 GB

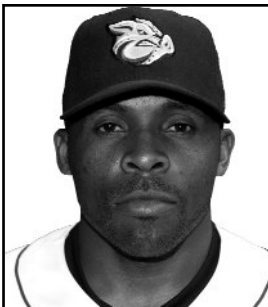
