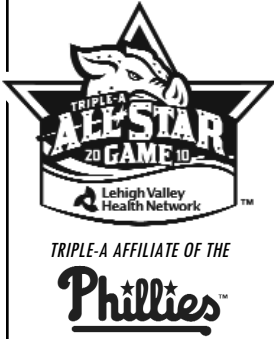

TONIGHT'S GAME:

The fourth-place IronPigs (12-17) begin an eight-game South Division road trip with Game One of a four-game series against the fourth-place Charlotte Knights (13-18) -- the White Sox top affiliate. With a 4-3 loss to the Clippers in 10 innings yesterday, the 'Pigs dropped their home series against Columbus, 3-1, and finished at just 3-5 on their eight-game West Division home stand... The Knights lost 8-3 yesterday to split a home series with Pawtucket. After starting 7-3, Charlotte has gone just 6-15 (.286) in its last 21 games -- including an eight-game skid from 4/18-25.

- First-pitch is at 7:15 p.m.... The Pigs started their trip by boarding a bus to Newark Int'l at 3 a.m. this morning.

SOUTHERN COMFORT?:

Tonight, LHV will play its first game against a Southern Division. Last season, the 'Pigs went 16-16 vs. the South -- after going 19-13 versus the division in 2008... After starting the season with 21 G vs. the North -- going 9-12 -- LHV is in the midst of 20 straight out-of-division games...

"TWO BE, OR NOT TWO BE":

The 'Pigs have only won back-to-back games on one occasion this season, April 15-17... But technically -- due to a suspended game on April 16 -- they have yet to win two straight at any point yet this season (29 G)... Even in 2008, a year they started 2-20, they won two consecutive 4/14-15 (Games 12 & 13)... LHV did it 5x in 25 G in 2009...

- The second lowest total of "two-game win streaks" in the IL is just 2 times -- done by Pawtucket (11-18).
- That being said, the 'Pigs have not lost 3 straight since the first 3 G of 2010 (all walk-off losses at Syracuse).

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** -- a member of the Phillies' 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-3, 225-pound, 24-year-old drafted by Philadelphia in the 2nd round of 2006 out of Long Beach State. The Vacaville, CA, native spent the bulk of 2009 with LHV, becoming the team's first 11-game winner in going 11-6, 3.35 in 25 G, 24 GS. Named to the 2009 I.L. All-Star team, we was the winning pitcher in the Triple-A All-Star game -- striking out the 'heart of the lineup' on just nine pitchers... He was recalled by Philly three times -- earning his first ML win in a rain-shortened game 5/16 @ WAS (4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 er, 3 bb, 4 k; Rule 10.17-b-2). In all, Carpenter went 1-0, 11.12 in 3 G, 1 GS with PHI... Made his ML debut with PHI 8/27/08 vs. NYM (1.0 ip, 0 r)... Had a stellar 2007 season in Clearwater -- where he led the Florida State League in wins (17) and shutouts (2) while being selected to play in the 2007 FSL All-Star Game... Among the highlights in his four-year MiLB career was a 7-inning perfect game 8/27/07 vs. Fort Myers (7 ip, 7 k) and a 2007 FSL Championship.

- DC made the Phillies Opening Day Roster (Blanton DL'd)... Optioned when Nelson Figueroa claimed off waivers
- Last 11 G (09-10): 5-6, 4.85, .322 OBA (59.1 ip, 78-242, 32 er, 37 k, 7 hr); First 19 G of 2009: 9-2, 2.72, .245
- DC vs. CHA in 2009: 1-0, 1.29 in 1 GS (7 ip, 6 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 4 k, .231) -- a 2-1 win on 6/11 at CCP (Egbert)

RHP **Carlos Torres** -- a member of the White Sox 40-Man Roster -- is a 6-1, 190-pound 27-year-old drafted by Chicago-A in the 15th round of 2004 out of Kansas State (where he was the highest Wildcat drafted since 1998). The native of Santa Cruz, Calif., started 2009 with Charlotte -- going 10-4, 2.39, 1 SV in 23 G, 20 GS and leading the IL in ERA, OBA (.207) and SO/9 IP (9.1)... Named to the mid- and post-season IL All-Star teams as well as being selected as the Triple-AAA Starting Pitcher of the Year by MiLB.com... Made his ML debut in a start 7/22 vs. TAM (n/d, 6 ip, 3 er)... Earned his first win on 9/3 at CHC with 7.0 scoreless IP... Became the first Sox pitcher since John Snyder ('98) to throw at least 7.0 scoreless IP within the first 3 GS of career... Finished 1-2, 6.04 in 8 G, 5 GS with Chicago... A 2008 Southern League Midseason All-Star, Torres also pitched collegiately at Allen Hancock (CA) JC, Grossmont (CA) JC and San Jose State... Torres enters the season ranked as the No. 16 Prospect in the system by *Baseball America*.

- CT vs. LHV in 2009: 0-0, 1.50 in 1 GS (6 ip, 8 h, 2 r, 1 er, 3 bb, 7 k, .320) -- a 3-2 loss on 6/12 at CCP
- After winning his '10 debut 4/9 @ GWI (6 ip, 4 h, 0 r, bb, 8 k), CT has lost his last 4 dec's, going 0-4, 6.26 in 5 G.

SERIES INFORMATION:

The 2009 season-series was tied, 4-4... They also split the '08 series, 4-4... CHA holds a 5-3 edge at CKS (3-1 in '09).

- This marks return of **Dewayne Wise** (.321-9-25, 62 G in '08-09) & **Ehren Wassermann** (12-7, 2.54, 13 SV; 113 G in '07-09)

BACON BITS, PT. 1:

- Oy Vey!: The 'Pigs are now a season-high 5 games below .500 and a season-high 5.5 games back in the North.
- Close, But No...: With the 4-3 loss in 10 inn. Sunday, LHV is now 0-3 in extras & 2-9 in 1-R games (only LOU is worse, 1-8).

THAT'S HOW WE DREW IT UP:

RHP **Drew Carpenter** has won his last 2 GS (2-0, 0.82, 11 ip, 1 r, e er) and has reclaimed the top spot as the 'Pigs all-time career wins leader with 14... He had started 1-2, 7.15 in his first 3 GS.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING...???:

LHV is now 3-5 in May... After starting 9-12, LHV is just 21-47 (.309) lifetime in April... LHV has gone 29-38 (.433) in May.

HE WHO LAUGHS FIRST LAUGHS LAST?:

LHV has jumped on the board first in 19 of their first 29 G (65.5%) -- 2nd in the IL behind Indianapolis (21 x)... The 'Pigs have gone 10-9* (.526) in those games... However, the 'Pigs have blown leads in 11 of their 17 losses (64.7%).

* By going just 10-9 when scoring first, LHV is 12th in the IL in win% (.526) in those G... IL is 145-65 (.690).

THE NUMBERS DON'T ADD UP:

LHV is now 12-17 despite 6th in AVG (.268); T-4th in R (141) and 5th in ERA (4.03) and...

- LHV has outscored their opponents this season, 141-130... Their +11 run differential ranks 6th in the I.L...
- LHV is batting .291 with Runners in Scoring Position (opponents are at .252)
- LHV has scored first in 19 of the 29 games (65.5%)... going just 10-9 in those games
- LHV has lost 17 games by a total of 39 R (9, 1-run G; 1, 2-run G; 3, 3-run G; 4, 4+)... LHV is just 2-9 in 1-run G

.500 ALLERGY:

The 'Pigs have only been at .500 for just two times in LHV history... and they still have never been above .500 in 317 games... In fact, the Phillies Triple-A affiliate has not been above .500 since Ottawa was 22-21 on 5/24/07 -- a span of 417 games (2 years, 11 months, 16 days)... Since that point, the teams have combined to go 170-246.

A KING'S RANSOM:

3B **Cody Ransom** hit the game-winning 3-run HR for LHV on Tue. and a 2-R shot Wed... He's hit safely in 8 of the last 9 G (9-32, .281-3-6, 3 2B) and in 14 of his last 16 G (18-62, .290-4-12, 5 2B)...

• *Cody Clutch*: 8 of his 14 (57.1%) PA that have produced RBI have either either tied the game or put LHV ahead.

DO THE MATHI:

RHP **Scott Mathieson** -- now 5-for-5 in save opportunities -- has not allowed a R or a BB in his last 7 G (7.0 ip, 5 h, 11 k)... He started this season with 7.0 scoreless innings in 4 G (1-0, SV, 0.00)... and has allowed just 1 R in his first 12 G (14.2 ip, 5-5 in SV opps)... On 4/15 vs. ROC, the hard-throwing prospect earned the first LHV save of '10 -- after the pen collectively blew the first 4 opportunities... Mathieson also notched the first LHV win (4/11 @ SYR).

NATE THE GREAT!:

In his IL career (7/7/09-pres.) -- former Marlin **Nate Bump** is now an impressive 11-2, 2.51 in 16 GS (104 ip, 29 er).

WHO (ELSE) IS HOT:

OF **Rich Thompson** has hit safely in his last 7 G (11-28, .393-0-3, 3B, 4 SB, 4 R)... 2B **Luis Maza** has hit in 10 of his last 14 G (18-54, .333-0-6) and has only committed 1 E... INF **Melvin Dorta** has hit safely in 9 of his 12 games (12-35, .343-0-5, 7 R, 2 BB)... OF **Dewayne Wise** has hit in 6 of his last 7 GS (10-28, .375-1-2, 6 2B, 3B) and, in his last 10 G, is batting .333-1-2 (13-39, 6 2B, 2 3B)... In his last 3 G, C **Paul Hoover** is 4-10, 2 2B, 3B... OF **Chris Duffy** has hit in 17 of 23 G and is batting 9-18 (.500-0-14) with RISP...

• *Catching Offense*: LHV catchers (Hoover, Sardinha) have combined to bat .278-4-18 (30-108, 4 2B) this season.

TRACY SHOWING SIGNS?:

1B **Andy Tracy** has hit in 5 of his last 6 G (6-24, .250, 3 2B, 3B) and now has reached base safely in 20 of his last 22 G (he has walked a team-high 17 times)... The 36-year-old 2009 IL All-Star started last season batting .200-2-7 (8-40) in 12 G; and started 2008 hitting .143-1-1 (4-28) in 9 G...

• After striking out 21 times in the first 14 G, Tracy has fanned just 5 times in his last 14 G and 53 AB...

SAVERY WHOODINI:

LHP **Joe Savery** has been very effective his entire career in stranding baserunners... In his career, opponents have hit .233 (87-373) with runners in scoring position and just .220 (39-177) with RISP and two out...

BACON BITS, PT. 2:

• *Night Owls?*: In franchise history, the 'Pigs are now just 22-42 (.344) when playing during daylight hours (4-8 in '10).

• *Bombs Away*: LHV's 4 HR on Thu. tied a franchise record (6/16/09 @ DUR) and was their top career total at CCP... OF **Chris Duffy** had 2 of the HR last night, becoming the 1st Pigs to HR twice in a game in '10 (6th time in LHV history).

• *Still No Shutouts*: LHV has yet to be blanked through the first 28 G of '10... In 2008, they were blanked in G1 (4-0 @ SWB). In 2009, it took til G11 (2-0 @ PAW).
