TONIGHT'S GAME:

The IronPigs (6-8) play Game Two of four-game series against the Pawtucket Red Sox (8-5) at Coca-Cola Park. With a 13-3* thrashing of the Paw Sox last night, the 'Pigs finally beat Pawtucket in Allentown (the Sox were a perfect 8-0 in the LHV in '08) and have now won back-to-back games. Pawtucket snapped its mini two-game win streak.

- Take out the 13-1 Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Yankees, and the 'Pigs are 6-4 (winning six of the last 10 games).
- First-Pitch tonight is 7:05 p.m. for Go Green Grocery Bags Night, presented by Phoebe Richland Health Care Center.

*RECORD-SETTING NIGHT:

With their 13-3 win, the 'Pigs set/tied numerous franchise records: (1) Most runs in a game, 13; (2) Largest margin of victory, 10; (3) Tied Most hits in a game, 18; (4) Tied Most runs in an inning, 7; (5) Most doubles in a game, 7; (6).

With a win tonight, the IronPigs will:

- Set a franchise-high winning percentage (.467); eclipsing current mark of .429 (originally set 7/30/08 at 48-64).
- Win three-straight games since 7/27-7/30/08 (a span of 46 games) -- when they tied their franchise record four-game winning streak (which they did twice in 2008). The Phillies' Triple-A affiliates have not won 5 straight for the first time since SWB won 5-straight games 8/11-8/15/06.

TONIGHT'S PITCHERS:

RHP Kyle Kendrick -- making just his fourth career Triple-A start -- is a 24-year-old, 6-3, 190-pound righty drafted by Philadelphia in the 7th-round of 2003 out of Mt. Vernon (WA) HS -- turning down a scholarship to play QB at Washington State to sign with the Phillies. A member of Philadelphia's 40-Man Roster with 1.110 years of ML service time already accrued, Kendrick was initially promoted from Reading (AA) straight to the Majors on 6/13/07 -- and became a key cog in the Phils' run to capture the N.L. East. He went 10-4, 3.87 in 20 starts, leading all N.L. rookies in wins and ranking 3rd in ERA. Kendrick started 2008 right where he left off -- going 8-3, 4.47 in 19 starts before the All-Star Break. However, he struggled thereafter, finishing just 3-6, 7.59 in his next 11 GS before being left off the Phils' postseason rosters. In all, he is 21-13, 4.78 in 51 G, 50 GS w/ PHI (276.2 ip, 323 h, 147 er, 82 bb, 117 k).

- KK earned the 'W' in the first-ever game at CCP -- a 5-3 PHI victory over LHV in exhibition 3/30/08 (5 ip, 0 r).
- In ML Spring Training, KK went 1-3, 9.20 in 4 GS. In Triple-A S.T., KK went 0-1, 13.51 in 1 GS (3.1 ip, 5 er).
- KK, 4/20 @ PAW (L, 2-0): L, 4.0 ip, 5 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 3 k Allowed 2-R HR in 1st (McAnulty); stranded 7 in 1st 3 IP; ret'd last 5

RHP Charlie Zink, 29, is a 6-1, 190-pound, right-handed knuckle-baller signed by Boston as a minor league free agent 4/1/02. The El Dorado Hills, Calif., native was named 2008 International League Pitcher of the Year after going 14-6, 2.84 in 28 G, 28 GS -- numbers that also placed him on the 2008 IL midseason and postseason All-Star teams. Zink also made his ML debut in a 19-17 Boston win 8/12/08 vs. TEX -- but he didn't earn the win despite a 10-0 lead (4.1 ip, 11 h, 8 er, bb, k). In the process, he became the oldest pitcher (28 years, 352 days) to make his ML debut in a start for Boston since research was first available in 1956 (and oldest AL pitcher since Orlando Hernandez with the Yanks on 6/3/98). Zink started 2007 in Portland (AA) -- going 9-3 with a 3.98 ERA in 16 GS -- and throughout the year, made 8 appearances with PAW, going 2-3, 5.89 in 8 GS (47.1 ip, 51 h, 37 r, 31 er, 27 bb, 23 k). He was coached by former Boston pitcher Luis Tiant while pitching at Savannah College of Art and Design.

- Zink vs. LHV in 2008: 2-0, 1.96 in 3 G, 3 GS (18.1 ip, 13 h, 6 r, 4 er, 5 bb, 9 k, .197)
- Zink finished 2nd in the IL in ERA (2.84), but his ERA rose up from 2.22 over his final 8 GS, going 3-4, 4.44.
- CZ, 4/17 vs. LHV (L, 4-3): L, 6.0 ip, 4 h, 4 r, 4 er, 3 bb, 2 k 2 hb Up 1-0, LO BB in 3rd led to 2-R IP; tied 2-2, 2-R HR (Tracy) in 5th

SERIES INFORMATION:

LHV leads the 2009 series, 3-2... PAW won the 2008 series, 15-1 -- which included winning the first 9 G (and last 6 G) vs. LHV. PAW swept LHV in all 8 G at Coca-Cola Park, and the 'Pigs lone win in the series took place 7/5 @ PAW.

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT IS!

The 'Pigs bullpen has not allowed a R in their last 12 IP... and just 1 R in their last 20 IP... In the last 10 G, the 'Pigs bullpen is 1-1, 1.23 with 2 SV (36.2 ip, 5 er) -- retiring 54 of the last 61 BF (89%). The corps started 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb) -- allowing the first batter to reach in 14 of 18 IP (78.0%).

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *King Lehr!*: RHP **Justin Lehr** has won all 3 GS in '09 -- tying LHP Brian Mazzone's team record for most consecutive starts won (Mazone also won five straight decisions). In his IL career, he's now 9-2, 2.20 (81.2 ip, 20 er) in 19 G, 11 GS.
- *Comeback!*: The 'Pigs come from behind to win in the last 2 G -- & have trailed first in all 5 G vs. PAW (winning 3).
- *What a Difference!*: It took LHV 14 G to get Win #6. Last year, it took 36 G to get Win #6 -- 5/9 vs. COL (6-30).
- *No Pain, No...!*: As SWB keeps winning, LHV has not gained ground on 1st in '09, and none in last 18 days (8/29).
- *For Starters!*: Through 14 G, 'Pigs starters have combined to go 5-4, 3.46 (75.1 ip, 74 h, 36 r, 29 er, 24 bb, 56 k).
- The 'Pigs have now scored 64 runs in their first 14 G -- it took them until Game 28 (May 1) to get to 64 R in 2008.
- *In a Pinch!*: With **J.J. Furmaniak's** PH-2B on 4/22, LHV pinch-hitters are 3-4 with a HBP... they started 3-24 in '08.
- *April Showers!*: The IronPigs are now just 9-32 (.220) during the month of April in franchise history.
- *Northern Exposure!*: The 'Pigs are now 6-8 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (and starting 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 13-35 (.271) in their last 48 G vs. the ND and 28-66 (.298) in franchise history.
- *Past Last!*: Since 4/14, the 'Pigs have climbed out of the ND cellar for the first time in '09. LHV spent the first 5 days of this season in last place after starting in the cellar their first 70 days of 2008.

REHABS:

C **Carlos Ruiz** is expected to begin a ML rehab assignment with the 'Pigs on Saturday. Ruiz has been on the DL since suffering a strained right oblique on 4/10 at Colorado. Ruiz' rehab could continue at Coca-Cola Park through Monday's series finale against the Paw Sox. Prior to landing on the D.L., the 30-year-old was hitting .273 (3-for-11) with a double and a walk in four games. **Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Network** is the exclusive sponsor of all Major League rehabilitation appearances at Coca-Cola Park.

A native of Panama, Ruiz was originally signed by the Phillies as a non-drafted free agent in 1998 and made his Major League debut in 2006 -- batting .261 with 3 home runs and 10 RBI in 27 games. Since joining the Phillies, Ruiz has hit .242 with 13 home runs and 95 RBI. Saturday will mark the first time Ruiz has appeared in a Triple-A uniform since 2006, when finished third in the International League with a .307 average for the Scranton-Wilkes Barre Red Barons. Ruiz was also a member of Panama's inaugural World Baseball Classic squad in 2006.

Boston SS **Julio Lugo** is also scheduled to continue his ML rehab stint with Pawtucket beginning on Friday night at Coca-Cola Park. Lugo was placed on Boston's DL on 4/4 after undergoing surgery to repair torn meniscus cartilage in his right knee. Lugo began his rehab Wednesday, going 0-3 with a walk in an 8-7 win over Rochester. Lugo, who was originally selected by the Houston Astros in the 43rd round of 1994, has spent time in the majors with Houston (2000-03), Tampa Bay (2004-06), Los Angeles Dodgers (2006), and Boston (2007-present).

Other rehabs @ CCP: OF **Shane Victorino** (4/26-27), **Rudy Seanez** (8/11) & BOS' **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (6/16).

THE 'NEW'-HAN:

The Phillies have added infielder **David Newhan** to their player development staff as a player/coach for LHV, though he will not be activated as a player at this time. Newhan, 35, batted .260-2-12 in 64 G with Houston last season. A left-handed batter, Newhan also played in 60 games with Triple-A Round Rock in 2008, batting .308-9-36 with 14 2Bs. A 17th-rounder by Oakland in 1995, Newhan has hit .253-23-120 over his 413 games ML career with San Diego (1999-00), Philadelphia (2000-01), Baltimore (2004-06), New York Mets (2007) and Houston (2008). He was acquired by PHI on 8/7/00 as the player to be named later in a trade with the Padres for SS Desi Relaford (8/4). After appearing in 25 G with SWB, he made his PHI debut 9/16/00 as a PH and batted .176 in 10 G over the remainder of the season. In 2001, Newhan battled injuries, appearing in just 7 G with the Phils and 13 with SWB.

KING LEHR! FIRST EVER IRONPIG PITCHER-OF-WEEK:

The IL announced that RHP **Justin Lehr** has been named Pitcher of the Week for the period from **April 13-19**. Lehr is the first IronPigs pitcher in franchise history to receive the award. Lehr provided an enormous lift to the IronPigs last Monday in his first start of the year. The 31-year-old tossed 6.1 strong innings, allowing just three hits and one run in a 5-1 victory over Syracuse. Lehr finished off his impressive week with a victory at Pawtucket on Sunday afternoon. In the 6-2 win, he limited the PawSox to one run on three hits. Lehr was signed by the Phillies as a free agent last December. A ten-year veteran of professional baseball, Lehr has made 66 Major League appearances with Oakland and Milwaukee, going 4-3 with a 5.31 ERA. Interestingly, Lehr was the IL's Pitcher of the Week almost exactly one year ago while pitching for the Louisville Bats. 1B **Andy Tracy** won IL Batter of the Week honors twice in '08.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 75-124 (.377) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 92-161 (.364) & a combined 66.5 GB.

• The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. In franchise history, they've been in the cellar for all but 37 of 167 days (6/13-6/15; 6/23-7/3; 7/28-8/9; 4/15-Pres).
