TODAY'S GAME:

The IronPigs (13-15) play Game Three of a four-game series against the Toledo Mud Hens (13-16) at Fifth-Third Field. With an 11-7 loss to the Hens last night, the 'Pigs are 1-1 on this eight-game West Division road trip and are 3-2 in their last five games... Toledo -- previously swept in a four-game series at Pawtucket -- snapped a five-game losing streak, but has still dropped eight of its last 11 games. The Hens are just 5-14 since starting 8-2. First-Pitch is at 2:00 p.m.

TODAY'S PITCHERS:

RHP **Justin Lehr**, 31, is a 6-2, 215-pound righty signed by Philadelphia as a minor league free agent on 12/26/08. A native of Orange, Calif., Lehr was originally drafted by Oakland in the 8th round of 1999 out of USC (he had also spent time at UC-Santa Barbara). Lehr has an effective I.L. season with Louisville last year, going 6-2, 2.10 in 16 G, 8 GS with the Bats -- but his Triple-A season was interrupted by a stint with the Doosan Bears (Korea) from 5/23-8/7. While in Korea, he went just 0-6, 5.66 in 12 games before returning to the Reds as a free agent. A 2007 PCL All-Star with Nashville, Lehr has logged 1.049 years of ML service time -- beginning with his ML debut with Oakland on 6/17/04 vs. CHI-N. He earned his first ML win on 7/20/04 vs. TOR (2.2 ip, 0 er) and has an overall record of 4-3, 5.31 in 66 G, 0 GS with Oakland (2004) and Milwaukee (2005-06) -- where he was traded along with OF Nelson Cruz for INF Keith Ginter, 12/15/04. **In his IL career, Lehr is now 10-3, 2.33 (92.2 ip, 24 er) in 21 G, 13 GS.**

- Lehr became LHV's first-ever IL Pitcher-of-the-Week for April 13-19 (2-0, 1.43 in 2 GS, 11.1 ip, 6 h, 2 r, 2 er).
- JL started '09 by winning his first 3 GS (3-0, 2.60) -- tying Brian Mazone's LHV record for most consecutive GS won.
- JL, 5/4 vs. BUF (W, 3-0): SHO*, W, 7 ip, 3 h, 0 r, 2 bb, 4 k Ret'd 1st 7 BF; Runner gunned at plate in 3rd then ret'd 11 of last 14

*For RHP **Justin Lehr**, his last appearance was his first shutout (as well as CG) in his professional career (115 starts). Lehr joins Walrond (9.0 ip and 7.0 ip) and LHP Brian Mazone (7.0 ip) as the only LHV pitchers toss a shutout.

RHP **Ruddy Lugo** -- brother of Boston's Julio Lugo (who rehabbed at Coca-Cola Park 4/24-4/26) -- is a 6-0, 210-pound, 28-year-old righty signed by Detroit as a free agent on 1/30/09. Born in Barahona, D.R., the Brooklyn native spent the entire 2008 with the Mets' organization at Triple-A New Orleans, where he went 7-12, 5.36 in 24 G, 24 GS. Originally drafted by Milwaukee in the 3rd round of 1999 out of Xaverian (NY) H.S., Lugo made his ML debut in 2006 with Tampa Bay -- leading all American League rookies in appearances (64) and relief innings (85.0) while finishing 2nd among qualifying AL relievers in ERA, going 2-4, 3.81. In 2007, Lugo started with Tampa (2-0, 9.28 in 11 G) prior to being claimed off waivers by Oakland on 6/14. He wound up going 4-0, 4.30 in 27 G with the A's -- ending the 2007 season with the longest active winning streak in the Majors (6-0).

- RL, 4/30 @ LHV (L, 4-2): L, 6.0 ip, 7 h, 4 r, 3 er, 3 bb, 3 k Stranded RISP 1st 3 IP; First 6 BF reached in 3-R 4th; solo R in 5th

CAN'T GET TO .500:

The 'Pigs have never been at .500 in franchise history... They lost 11-7 in a chance to get to 14-14 last night, and are now 0-5 with a chance to get to .500+... The Phils' Triple-A affiliate hasn't been .500 since Ottawa was 22-22 on 5/25/07.

SERIES INFORMATION:

The 2009 series is tied, 3-3... TOL won the 2008 series, 6-2, taking 3 of 4 at both Coca-Cola Park and Fifth-Third Field. The 'Hens also won the 2007 series vs. OTT, 5-3 -- but the teams were an even 2-2 at Fifth-Third Field.

Crazy Series!: The team leading going into the 9th is just 1-3 in the last 4 G between TOL and LHV. The 6 G have been decided by a total of 12 R (2, 1, 3, 1, 1, 4) with 2 extra-inning G -- and have featured 12 lead changes.

BACON BITS, PT 1:

- *This -n- That:* The 'Pigs are now 0-5 on Saturday nights... 2-1 against LHP starters... 6-11 when opponents score first.
- *Ejections:* The ejections of manager **Dave Huppert** and OF **Jason Ellison** in the 9th were the LHV's firsts in 2009.
- The Rs allowed by Steve Green in the 6th were the firsts by the 'pen in the last 5 G -- snapping a 9.2 scoreless streak.
- *Road Warriors?:* The 'Pigs are 5-5 on the road this season. Last season, the 'Pigs lost 14 of their last 16 road games.
- *Thou Shalt Steal!:* During the 'Long Ball' Era, the stolen base base been coined 'a lost art.' Maybe it should be found. The 'Pigs have have a 92% success rate (24 of 26). Opponents have a 92% success rate (35 of 38).

WHO'S HOT (PITCHERS):

RHP **Dave Borkowski** has a current 13.0 scoreless IP streak (6+ G, 0-0, 8 h, 6 bb, 6 k) -- now the longest by any 'Pig in 2009. He has been unscored upon in his last 6 G (12.2 ip) after allowing Rs in first 3 G (5 ip, 8 er)... RHP **Tyler Walker** (on DL) has a season-starting 11.0 scoreless IP streak in his first 6 G. He has only allowed four batters to reach safely: 2 1Bs (inc. a hit-and-run dribbler), a BB and a HB. He's retired 32 of 37 BF (86.4%)... RHP **Jason Anderson** has not allowed a R in his last 5 G (6.0 IP). Combined with Reading stats, he has a personal 11.1 scoreless IP streak... LHP **Jake Woods** snapped his team-high 12.0 scoreless IP streak (8+ G) on 2-out 2-R 2B by Ryan Roberson on Sunday... He has since gone 2.2 scoreless innings in his last appearance... RHP **Mike Koplove** hasn't allowed an ER in last 10 G (1-1, SV, 2 H, 13.2 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 8 bb, 16 k)...

WHO'S HOT (BATTERS):

OF **Rich Thompson** has hit in a 2009 LHV-high 9 straight games (13-39, .333-0-5, 4 2B, 2 3B, 11 R, 5 SB). He is a perfect 9-9 in SB (100%) this season and is now 34-36 (94%) in IronPigs career... INF **Mike Cervanak** has hit in 9 of his last 11 G (17-43, .395-0-11, 6 R); inc. 4 multi-hit G. Has reached safely in his last 21 G (28 h, 6 BB, HBP) and is 9 for his last 15 w/ RISP (.600)... In his last 17 G, OF **John Mayberry** is batting .281-4-17 (18-64, 6 2B, 7 BB)... After a 3-28 skid, INF **Pablo Ozuna** has hit safely in his last 5 G (7-18, .389)...

PLOP, PLOP... FIZZ, FIZZ... OH WHAT RELIEF IT (STILL) IS!:

In the last 24 G, the 'Pigs pen is 5-4, 1.88 with 3 SV (91.0 ip, 19 er)... The corps had an **amazing run** over a span of 12 G (4/18-5/1) in which it allowed just 2 ER in 43.2 IP (0.41), retiring 143 of 180 BF, 79.4%... At one point, the corps had a combined 16.1 scoreless IP streak... They started '09 at 0-3, 13.00 in the first 4 G (18 ip, 28 h, 26 er, 19 bb, 2.61 WHIP).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES!:

- LHV is now 13-15. The IronPigs were 4-24 at this point in 2008. It took the 'Pigs 27 games to get win No. 13 in 2009. Last year, it took 47 games to get win No. 13 -- May 20 @ Buffalo, when they 'improved' to 13-34.
- The 'Pigs have scored 127 runs in their first 28 G of 2009. It took them until Game 43 (5/16) to get to 127 R in '08.

BACON BITS, PT 2:

- *Let's Get it Started!*: The 'Pigs are now 7-2 in series openers this season... 3-1 on the road.
- *Lead Story*: LHV scored first in the first 5 G vs. TOL & in 6 of last 9 G. Prior, the 'Pigs opponents scored first in 11 of last 13.
- *Walk the Way!*: The walk-off win Wednesday was the 2nd of '09 for LHV (Hoover had GW-1B in 12th 4/30 vs. TOL).
- *Comeback!*: With 2 R in the 9th on Friday, the 'Pigs won for the first time this season when trailing after 8 innings (now 1-11). In team history, they're now 5-88 in such instances. LHV has come-from-behind to win 8x in '09.
- With 16 DPs in the last 11 G, LHV has now turned an IL-best 34 double plays. The next closest teams have 28.
- *In a Pinch!*: With **Jeremy Slayden's** PH BB and **Pablo Ozuna's** PH 1B on 5/6, LHV pinch-hitters are 4-5 (.800) with a BB, HBP (.857 OBP)... they started 3-24 (.125) in '08.
- *Kyle Kan!*: In his last 2 G, RHP **Kyle Kendrick** is 1-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 ip, 7 h, 1 r, 1 er, 4 bb, 9 k).
- *Bowers Powers*: The 'W' recorded by LHP **Cedric Bowers** on 5/6 was his first in the IL since 8/20/03 vs. NOR (w/ DUR).
- *Northern Exposure*: The 'Pigs are 10-12 vs. North Division teams after starting 0-4 (started 1-20 last season). Going back to '08, the 'Pigs are just 17-39 (.304) in their last 56 G vs. the ND and 32-70 (.314) in franchise history.
- *April Showers*: LHV finished 9-11 in April and is now just 12-34 (.261) during the month of April in franchise history.
- *Past Last!*: Since 4/14, the 'Pigs have climbed out of the ND cellar. LHV spent the first 5 days of this season in last place after starting in the cellar their first 70 days of 2008.

PHILLIES TRIPLE-A STRUGGLES:

Going back to the 2007 season, Phillies' Triple-A teams (OTT, LHV) have gone 82-130 (.387) since 7/20/07. In fact, since Ottawa was last above .500 at 22-21 on 5/24/07, the teams have gone 100-167 (.375) & a combined 68.0 GB.

- The 'Pigs spent the first 5 days of the '09 season in last place... after spending the first 70 days of '08 in last. In franchise history, they've been in the cellar for all but 51 of 181 days (6/13-6/15; 6/23-7/3; 7/28-8/9; 4/15-Pres).

TOP PROSPECTS:

According to *Baseball America*, three of the Top 4 Prospects in the Phillies' system will start in the Lehigh Valley: the returning 22-year-old RHP **Carlos Carrasco** (#2), a three-time member of the World Team's Future Game roster and a pair of 2008 Olympians, C **Lou Marson** (#3) and SS **Jason Donald** (#4).

HUPPERT AMONGST WINNINGEST MANAGERS:

'Pigs skipper **Dave Huppert** entered 2009 in 3rd place in wins amongst all active managers. The Top 5 also includes two other current IL managers: (1) Marc Bombard, CHA -- 1,709; (2) Tom Kotchman -- 1,542; (3) **Dave Huppert** -- **1,480**; (4) Dave Miley, SWB -- 1,356; (5) Rick Sweet, LOU -- 1,352; (6) Buddy Bailey -- 1,309.

PHILLIES PHARM SYSTEM RANKED 12th:

Baseball America ranks the Phillies as having the 12th best system: up from 22nd in 2008 (21 in '07; 22 in '06).
